PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING HELD ON 03-02-2015, 11 AM AT INFRONT OF M/S BALASORE ALLOYS LTD. OFFICE, VILLAGE KALIAPANI OF JAJPUR DISTRICT IN RESPECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FOR ISPAT SUKINDA CHROMITE MINES OF M/S BALASORE ALLOYS LTD. FOR EXPANSION OF PRODUCTION CAPACITY FROM 0.03 MTPA TO 0.4 MTPA AND CHANGE IN TECHNOLOGY FROM OPEN CAST TO UNDERGROUND MINING METHOD OVER AN AREA OF 35.6 HA IN KALIAPANI VILLAGE UNDER SUKINDA TAHASIL OF JAJPUR DISTRICT.

The public hearing in respect of Environmental Assessment for Ispat Sukinda Chromite Mines of M/s Balasore Alloys Ltd. for expansion of production capacity from 0.03 MTPA to 0.4 MTPA and change in technology from open cast to underground mining method over an area of 35.6 ha in Kaliapani village under Sukinda Tahasil of Jajpur District held on 03-02-2015 , 11 AM at in front of M/s Balasore Alloys Ltd. office, village Kaliapani of Jajpur District with reference to :-

- i. EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14-09-2006

The panel consisted of following members:

Sri Bharata Chandra Behera, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinga Nagar, Jajpur Road, Dist-Jajpur, supervised and presided over the meeting, assisted by Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinga nagar and the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, SPC Board, Kalinga Nagar welcome the other panel member and the public, gave a introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notifications 2006 in respect of Environmental Assessment for Ispat Sukinda Chromite Mines of M/s Balasore Alloys Ltd. for expansion of production capacity from 0.03 MTPA to 0.4 MTPA and change in technology from open cast to underground mining method over an area of 35.6 ha in Kaliapani village under Sukinda Tahasil of Jajpur District.

Sri Arun Kumar Samantaray, General Manager (HR) , Ispat Sukinda Chromite Mines of M/s Balasore Alloys Ltd. on behalf of the proponent addressed the committee members and assembled public and gave a brief description about the proposed project. He also briefed about expansion of Ispat Sukinda Chromite Mines of M/s Balasore Alloys Ltd., at Kaliapani village, Tahasil- Sukinda of Jajpur District. He also briefed about the peripheral development works that had been taken up in this area, and made a presentation about the environmental management, pollution control measures, waste-management of the related expansion project. The copy of the statement of the industry read out at public hearing proceedings is enclosed.

Regarding public hearing of Ispat Sukinda Chromite Mines of M/s Balasore Alloys Ltd., at Kaliapani village, Tahasil- Sukinda of Jajpur District was publicized at the office notice Board of Kaliapani Gram Panchayat, Chingudipal Gram Panchayat, Kankadapal Gram Panchayat office, Kansa Gram Panchayat office, Ransol Gram Panchayat office, BDO Office at Sukinda, Tahasil

Office Sukinda, Zilla Parisad Office, Jajpur and local villages of Tangarpal, Garh Sukinda, Kankadapal, Kusumia, South Kaliapani, Kaliapani, Bhimtanger, Kalarangiatta, Kankadapal, Ransol, Chingudipal, Sukinda and Kansa etc.

Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Kalinga Nagar , representative of State Pollution Control Board Odisha then invited the public to present their views about the proposed project on environmental consideration.

The views expressed by various participants are as follows:

1	Sri Bidyadhar patra, Ransol village
	He welcomed the expansion proposal of the mine. He expressed that mining is the only option for the surrounding villager's livelihood. He corroborated the peripheral developmental work as done by the proponent with respect to plantation, provision of drinking water etc. He supported the mining activity & expressed his views in support of the proposed expansion & underground mining.
2	Sri Baikuntha Mahanta, Chingudipal village
	He welcomed the expansion proposal of the mine and without elaborating anything, he supported the expansion proposal.
3.	Sri Baman Charan Dehuty, Kusumundia village
	He on behalf of the villagers welcomed the public hearing and expressed that this mine is operating since last 15 years. He corroborated the peripheral developmental work done by the proponent. He also expressed his happiness towards the Balasore Alloys for recruiting the adequate employment from this area. He also expressed that with the expansion proposal of mine there will be more generation of employment. He also expressed that there will be generation of less pollution with respect to underground mining. He gave more stress to the local employment and expressed his support for the project.
4.	Smt. Bhagabati Mohanta, Chairman, Sukinda Block
	She expressed that the peripheral work taken up by M/S Balasore Alloys Ltd. is commendable. She expressed that enhancement of production will lead to more development of the area. She stressed that drinking water supply at local villages to be initiated. More local employment, better school facility, and improvement of roads within this area should be taken care of. She supported proposed expansion project.
5.	Sri Bharat Chandra Mahanta, Kaliapani village
	He welcomed the villagers gathered in the public hearing and expressed that this public hearing is for expansion proposal of open cast & underground mining. He told that there will be the generation of less environmental pollution during underground mining. He corroborated the peripheral developmental work done by the proponent for providing drinking water through overhead tank and through pipeline at

	<p>kaliapani village. He urged to the Additional District Magistrate & Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board that during plying of vehicles on mine approach roads causing dust pollution and this should be controlled by providing water sprinkling arrangement. He also pointed out that Damsala nala is polluted due to mining activity. He urged that the entire mine should adopt appropriate steps towards control of water pollution, so that the Damsala nala water should be used by nearby villagers in all respect. He supported the expansion project of the mine.</p>
6.	<p>Sri Duryadhan Mahanta, Kalarangiatta.</p>
	<p>He welcomed the expansion proposal of the mine and supported opencast as well as proposal for underground mining. He appreciated the peripheral work done by the mine and requested to the mine authority that the same shall continue with the proposed expansion.</p>
7.	<p>Sekh Jahangir Khan, Kaliapani, Ward no. 6</p>
	<p>He welcomed the expansion proposal of the mine. He told that there may be some hardships due to development of mining activity in the area, but expansion of mining will definitely lead to development in the area. He corroborated the peripheral developmental work as expressed by the proponent. He also expressed that the mine has been creating a forestation, adequate pollution control measures, upgraded Effluent Treatment Plant for treatment of mine water. He stress that scarcity drinking water is the main issue in this area, to be tackled by the mine authority. He demanded that local employment, extension of better health care facility in the area should be taken up by the proponent with the proposed expansion in production. He also demanded that the mine should take initiative with the help of District Administration for provision of a piece of land for Kabarsthan (Cremation). He apprehended that though there will be less generation of dust pollution during underground mining activity, but due to open cast mining activity, pollution level will increase with the expansion of the mine, so the mine owner should pay deep attention for control of Env. Pollution and also not to damage the Environment during proposed expansion. He expressed his opinion in favour of the proposed expansion project.</p>
8.	<p>Sri Sanjay Kumar parida, Kankadapal village</p>
	<p>He welcome the expansion proposal of the mine and without elaborating anything, he supported the expansion proposal.</p>
9.	<p>Sri Balaram Das, Ransole village</p>
	<p>He appreciated the plantation activity done in the surrounding villages by the mine authority. He welcome the expansion proposal of the mine and without elaborating anything, he supported the expansion proposal.</p>
10.	<p>Smt. Geetanjali Mahanta, Kalarangiatta.</p>

	<p>She welcomed the expansion proposal of the mine. She lauded the developmental works taken up by the company with respect to drinking water, infrastructure facility at different Schools, repair and maintenance of roads and plantation activity in different village area. She expressed her opinion in favour of the proposed expansion project. She supported the views expressed by the previous speakers. She expressed that the mine proponent is organizing health camp at regular intervals, but simultaneously she also demanded that health care facility, education and upliftment of financial status for the locals is essential. She expressed that periphery development work are to be strengthened and her other demands were</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Provision of Gynecologist for check up of female health, ii. Provision of pediatric specialist for health check up of children iii. Provision of drinking water facility at other villages through pipeline, iv. Monetary assistance for poor people those are living with below poverty line, v. Scholarships for poor students, vi. Common sanitary facility (Common Utility Toilets) for villagers, vii. Dust suppression measures at roads. <p>At last she stressed that after completion of Matriculation, students used to go far away for higher education/ Diploma education. So she demanded that with the initiation of all mines and District Administration, one Industrial Training Institute (ITI) should open at Sukinda.</p>
11	Sri Amalendu Behera, Sukinda Garh.
	<p>He expressed his sincere thanks to M/s Balasore Alloys for their extensive peripheral developmental work. He expressed that whatever demands rose during previous public hearing meeting, already fulfilled. He also expressed M/S Balasore Alloys Ltd. has given employment to 1100 to 1200 persons. He demanded permanent employment of the workers and expressed his opinion in favour of the project.</p>
12	Sri Bibekananda Bose, Vice Chairman, Sukinda Block.
	<p>He expressed that due to open cast mining activity, deforestation takes place. As this mine has proposed for underground mining, he supported the underground mining proposal. There will be generation of less environmental with respect to underground mining activity. He expressed his happiness towards M/S Balasore Alloys for their extensive plantation work. He stressed that there are other mines that showed more number of plantation in their official paper only but practically it is less in number, but this mine has done a good job. He stressed that during summer, local villagers are facing acute shortage of drinking water. He appreciated to the mine authority for providing drinking water to the Kaliapani village; simultaneously he demanded that this mine should take more initiative for supply of drinking water to the nearby villages.</p>
13	Sri Sakila Hansda, Kaliapani village.
	<p>He supported the views expressed by the previous speakers. He expressed that about 50% peripheral developmental work taken up by M/S Balasore Alloys Ltd. is</p>

	commendable. He requested to the mine authority to complete rest 50% peripheral developmental work. He expressed that about 300 workers are engaged in the mine as 'B' category employee. He requested the mine authority to make them permanent. He also added that there are some workers engaged for loading and unloading activity and payment has been done to these workers as and when required. So he demanded that minimum salary should be given to them.
14	Sri Nilendra Pradhan, Chingudipal village.
	He welcomed the expansion proposal and supported underground mining proposal as there will be generation of less environmental pollution with respect to underground mining activity. He appreciated the peripheral developmental work that completed by the mine and simultaneously he requested that the mine should take annual maintenance work for each programme. As example he told that the mine has provided drinking water through pipeline, but the pipeline is also required some maintenance. For this reason the mine should have the provision of maintenance of certain machineries/equipments which they are providing to the villagers. He supported public hearing.
15	Sri Deepak Kumar Nayak, Sarpanch, Kuhika Gram Panchyat.
	He apprehended that though there will be less generation of dust pollution during underground mining activity, but due to open cast mining activity, pollution level will increase with the expansion of the mine, so the mine owner should pay deep attention for control of Env. Pollution and also not to damage the Environment during proposed expansion. His demands were <ul style="list-style-type: none">a. More plantation at Panchayat area,b. Construction of twenty rooms at weekly market at kaliapani,c. With initiation of all mines and District Administration, one Industrial Training Institute (ITI) should open at Sukinda.
16	Sri Krutibas Bhanja, Kalarangiatta.
	He welcomed the expansion proposal of the mine and without elaborating anything, he supported the expansion proposal.
17	Sri Biswajit Mohanty, Ransol, Secretary, Truck Owners Association.
	He welcomed the expansion proposal of the mine and expressed that during transportation activity there would be dust pollution. So he requested to adopt adequate dust suppression measures during transportation activity. He also demanded for local employment opportunity. Without elaborating anything, he supported the expansion proposal.

26	Sri Sarata Nayak, Kankadpal village.
	He opined that M/S Balasore Alloys mine is operating in full compliance to all the rules and regulations of various regulatory agencies and sufficient care has been taken for environmental protection. The peripheral development activities also have been very satisfactory. Expecting better employment opportunity and further development activities in the periphery, he made a strong opinion in favour of the project.

He opined that the same mine is operating in full compliance to all the rules and regulations of various regulatory agencies and sufficient care has been taken for environmental protection. The peripheral development activities also have been very satisfactory. Expecting better employment opportunity and further development activities in the periphery, he made a strong opinion in favour of the project.

	She urged to the mine authority that the mine should provide adequate dust suppression measures at mine haulage roads as well as approach roads. It is also requested to take plantation work around the nearby villages / mines area.
34	Sri Sanjay Purty, Kaliapani , Ward no. 7 .
	He welcome the expansion proposal of the mine and without elaborating anything, he supported the expansion proposal.
35	Sri Arun Pradhan, Chingudipal village.
	He corroborated the peripheral developmental work as expressed by the proponent. He demanded that regularization of unskilled employee to permanent employee, local employment; extension of better health care facility, provision of ITI in the area should be taken up by the proponent with the proposed expansion in production. He also demanded that the mine should construct one bridge over Damsala nala on the way from Kaliapani Police Station to Chingudipal village. He supported the proposed expansion project of the mine.

	He expressed that Kaliapani village is facing acute shortage of drinking water. So the urged to the mine authority to make a provision for supply of drinking water to the Kaliapani village. He also demanded from the mine authority that they mine should provide one Bus for the School Children.

	She lauded the developmental works taken up by the company with respect to provision of drinking water facility to nearby village. She also requested to the mine authority to adopt appropriate dust suppression measures at all mine haulage roads and other approach roads.

Monetary assistance to poor people 	<p>Sri Maheswar Behera, General Manager (Mining) of Ispat Sukinda Chromite mines M/s Balasore Alloys Ltd., At- Kaliapani village gave their commitments to certain demands raised by public as follows.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The industry has provided dust suppression measures at all dust generating points. The unit also agreed to upgrade the existing air pollution control systems with new technology for control of dust pollution as and when required with the expansion programme.
