

The views expressed by various speakers are as follows:


1	Sri Bharat Charan Mahanta, Kaliapani


5.	Smt Bhagawati Mahanta, Chingudipal, Ex- Chairman, Sukinda Block







The mine has provided dust suppression measures at all dust generating points. The mine also agreed to upgrade the existing air pollution control systems with new technology for control of dust pollution as and when required with the expansion programme. Dust suppression and Water pollution control system are already done in compliance with stipulated norms. The mine has constructed an Effluent Treatment Plant for treatment of waste water whatever generated during dewatering of the mine. The same will be continued in future with the proposed expansion.

7. The company has agreed to provide financial benefit to the nearby villages during different festivals.
