




The public hearing of M/s Rungta Mines Ltd. for expansion of Kamando Steel Plant capacity from 0.60 MTPA to 0.75 MTPA, at- Village Kamando, Dist-Sundargarh was held at- Playground in front of Kamando Steel Plant, At- Village Kamanado, Block-Koira on 19.07.2017 at 10.00 AM.

Mrs. Monisha Banerjee, IAS, ADM Rourkela has supervised and presided over the meeting along with Sri Hemendra Nath Nayak, Regional officer, Rourkela, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha.

At the outset Sri Hemendra Nath Nayak, Regional officer, Rourkela, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha welcomed the public present in the meeting. He briefly described the objective of the public hearing as per the EIA Notification S.O. 1533(E), dated 14th September 2006 of the Ministry of Environment and Forests & CC, Govt. of India. He informed that the date, time and venue for conducting the public hearing of M/s Rungta Mines Ltd. for expansion of Kamando Steel Plant capacity from 0.60 MTPA to 0.75 MTPA at- Village Kamando, District Sundargarh was advertised in Odiya daily "The Samaj" on 11.06.2017 and English daily "The Times of India" on 10.06.2017. (Paper cuttings are enclosed).

Addl. District Magistrate, Rourkela welcomed the public who were present at the venue for participating in the public hearing and informed about the objectives of the Public Hearing meeting.


On behalf of the project proponent, Mr. Bijay Kumar Sahoo, Asst. General Manager, Kamanado Steel Plant of M/s. Rungta Mines Limited, welcomed the gathering and gave a brief description about the proposed expansion project proposal of Kamando Steel Plant. He has assured that all the environmental protection measures will be undertaken in the expansion project to meet the environmental norms of Ministry of Environment and Forests & CC, Govt. of India and State Pollution Control Board, Odisha.

Addl. District Magistrate, Rourkela invited the public to offer their views on environmental related issues of the proposed expansion of Kamando Steel Plant project. Most of the participants welcomed the proposed expansion project for peripheral development and for employment opportunities for local peoples. The views offered by the participants are enclosed as **Annexure-IV**. Summary of the points raised by the participants in the public hearing in English and Odiya (vernacular language) is enclosed as **Annexure-V (A & B)**.

After the completion of the deliberation process ADM, Rourkela invited the representative of Kamanado Steel Plant of M/s Rungta Mines Limited to give a brief note on the issues related to the demand and grievances of the local people raised in the public Hearing meeting. Summary of the views of the project proponent on issues raised by the public, during public hearing in English and Odiya (vernacular language) is enclosed as **Annexure-VI (A & B)**. During public hearing the proponent has also submitted their commitments in writing, which is enclosed as **Annexure-VII**.

After deliberation of the above and concluding statement by ADM, Rourkela, Er. Deepak Kumar Sahoo, Asst. Env. Engineer, State Pollution Control Board, Rourkela gave vote of thanks at the end of public hearing.

The Attendance sheet of the members present in the public hearing is annexed as **Annexure-I**. Around 350 participants have attended the public hearing meeting and about 124 persons put their signature in the attendance

By virtue of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India Notification No. S.O. 1533 (E), dated 14.09.2006, the Board has been authorized to conduct environmental public hearing and as such invites suggestions, views, comments and objections on matters relating to environmental aspects of the proposed project from all the persons including bonafide residents, environmental groups and others located at the proposed site / sites of displacement / sites likely to be affected.</p>

Statements of the public participated in the deliberation during public hearing of M/s Rungta Mines Ltd. for expansion of Kamando Steel Plant capacity from 0.60 MTPA to 0.75 MTPA at- Village Kamando, Dist- Sundargarh held on dt. 19.07.2017 at 10.00 AM. At- Playground in front of Kamando Steel Plant, At- Village Kamanado, Block-Koira of Sundargarh District.

Sl. No.	Name & Address	Views expressed
1.	Sri Chandramani Patra, Village- Kamando	He welcomed the dignitaries on the dies and the gathering. He extended his full support to the public hearing for the proposed expansion project of M/S. Rungta Mines Ltd. However, he has demanded that the proponent should provide proper daily wages to the labour, employments to the land losers and local peoples in the proposed project on priority basis as provided in the existing plant. He also demanded to provide drinking water facility, education facility and health care facility to the local peoples as provided earlier. He also emphasized that Environmental Pollution should be minimum and controlled as per SPCB norms for betterment of the local inhabitants.
2.	Sri Yogeswar Naik, Village- Kamando	He welcomed the dignitaries on the dies and the gathering. He extends his full support to the public hearing for the proposed expansion project of M/S. Rungta Mines Ltd with a request to provide employments to the land losers and local peoples and to provide drinking water facility.
3.	Sri Bibhisan Ghana, Village- Kamando	He supports the statements made by the earlier speakers and requested the Company authority to construct an industrial training institute for skill development of local students.
4.	Sri Jayram Ghana, Village- Kamando	He extends his full support to the public hearing for the proposed expansion project of M/S. Rungta Mines Ltd.
5.	Sri Purna Chandra Dehury, Village- Kamando	He extends his full support to the public hearing for the proposed expansion project.

6.	Sri Tanamani Naik, village-Kamando	He welcomed the dignitaries on the dies and the gathering. He has expressed that he supports the statements of the earlier speakers. He has given proposals to the project proponent for construction of road from Koira Chawk to Rengalibeda and for opening of science stream in Koira College for better education of local students.
7.	Sri Binod Naik, Village-Kamando	He welcomed the dignitaries on the dies. He expressed that they came to know that Public Hearing is being conducted on 19.07.2017 and asked the general people to express their views without any fear and without any pressure. He also expressed that serving of notice to the ward members & Sarpanch and distribution of leaflets should be carried out prior to public hearing as per constitution. He also alleged that Company is using Police to suppress their views. He expressed that full independence should be given to the general public for expressing their views. He has requested that the public hearing should be stopped as the some villagers were unknown about the date, venue and purpose of public hearing. He has also requested to the media people that they should highlight the real facts and create awareness in odiya language among the general people as media is the fourth pillar of our democracy. He has alleged that local few people are not able to express their views as arrest warrants were issued to them. He has also submitted a written petition.
8.	Sri Surendra Naik, village-Kamando	He has expressed that he was unknown about the names of the authorities seating on the dies and mention that it will be not right to disobey or protest the authorities as they have power as per constitution. However warns that in future such situation should not arise. He expressed that they have more right than the police and other authorities as they are the real land looser. He has highlighted that the land acquired by the company will not be returned to them, as their mother and fathers have given their consent in written by committing the mistake. He has requested the authorities that this is a tribal dominated area and their right should be protected and it is also the duty of the police to protect their right.
9.	Sri Suresh Naik, Village-Kalta	He welcomed the dignitaries on the dies. He welcomes and supports the public hearing for the proposed expansion project of Kamando Steel Plant. He has highlighted that the proposed expansion project would create more employment opportunity for the unemployed persons and would also create self employment. He has expressed that this proposed expansion will bring more development and

		prosperity in the Panchayat level such as road and infrastructure, drinking water facility, health and education facility etc. in addition to the above facilities already provided by the company. In the end he again extends his support to the public hearing.
10.	Sri Sankheswar Barik , Village- Kamando	He has highlighted that he is a football player and requested the authorities of the M/s. Rungta Mines Ltd. for construction of a playground for them. He extends his full support to the public hearing for expansion project.
