Proceeding of the Public Hearing meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 at 10.00 A.M., at-Playground of Gopabandhu High School, Rajgangpur, Block-Rajgangpur in respect of M/s OCL India Ltd. for establishment of New Cement Plant (Dalmia DSP Unit) for Clinker ( 3.0 MTPA), Cement (2.25 MTPA), WHRS (15 MW) and DG Set of 1000 KVA at Village & Tahasil- Rajgangpur, Dist-Sundargarh.

The public hearing of M/s OCL India Ltd, Rajgangpur for establishment of New Cement Plant (Dalmia DSP Unit) for Clinker ( 3.0 MTPA), Cement (2.25 MTPA), WHRS (15 MW) and DG Set of 1000 KVA at Village & Tahasil-Rajgangpur, Dist-Sundargarh was held at - Playground of Gopabandhu High School, Rajgangpur, Block-Rajgangpur on 20.09.2017 at 10.00 A.M.

Mr. Bhaskar Chandra Turuk, Addl. District Magistrate, Sundargarh presided over the meeting along with Sri Hemendra Nath Nayak, Regional officer, Rourkela, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha. ADM, Sundargarh welcomed the public who were present at the venue for participating in the public hearing and informed about the objectives of the Public Hearing meeting.

At the outset Sri Hemendra Nath Nayak, Regional officer, Rourkela, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha welcomed the public present in the meeting. He briefly described the objective of the public hearing as per the EIA Notification S.O. 1533(E), dated 14<sup>th</sup> September 2006 of the Ministry of Environment and Forests & CC, Govt. of India. He informed that the date, time and venue for conducting the public hearing of M/s OCL India Ltd. for establishment of New Cement Plant (Dalmia DSP Unit) for Clinker (3.0 MTPA), Cement (2.25 MTPA), WHRS (15 MW) and DG Set of 1000 KVA at Village & Tahasil- Rajgangpur District Sundargarh was advertised in Odiya daily "Dharitri" on 18.08.2017 and English Daily "The times of India" on 18.08.2017. 

On behalf of the project proponent, Mr. Ganesh W. Jirkuntwar, Executive Director of M/s. OCL India Limited welcomed the gathering. Thereafter, Mr. Saroj Kumar Rout, Assistant Executive Director of M/s. OCL India Limited, gave a brief description about the proposed project. He has stated that the EIA/EMP report has been prepared as per Terms of Reference by the authorized consultant. He has also briefed about the environmental management & pollution control measures to be undertaken in the upcoming project using latest modern technology. He has also stated that water requirement for the proposed project will be accommodated within approved quantity for existing plant. He has stated that about Rs. 95.00 Cores will be invested in the new project for environment management and about Rs 46.00 Cores will be invested for peripheral development. Each year about two percent of the profit of the company will be invested for peripheral development. About 800 persons will be employed in the new project. He also added that due to establishment of the new project the journey of development of Rajgangpur will continue and it will be more developed in coming future.

Addl. District Magistrate, Sundargarh invited the public to offer their views on environmental related issues of the proposed expansion project. Most of the participants have welcomed the new project for peripheral development & employment opportunity. However they have raised issues related to employment to local peoples especially to the unemployed youths, Environment protection and Pollution Control, construction of over bridge at Railway crossings, infrastructure for health care facility, educational facility and water scarcity in the town. The views offered by the participants are enclosed as **Annexure-IV**. Summary of the points raised by the participants in the public hearing in English and Odiya(vernacular language) is enclosed as **Annexure-V( A & B)**.

After the completion of the deliberation process ADM, Sundargarh invited the representative of M/s. OCL India Limited, Rajgangpur to give a brief note on the issues related to the demand and grievances of the local people raised in the public Hearing meeting. Summary of the views of the project proponent on issues raised by the public during public hearing in English and Odiya (vernacular language) is enclosed as **Annexure-VI (A & B)**. During public hearing the proponent has also submitted their commitments in writing, which is enclosed as **Annexure-VII**.

After deliberation of the above and concluding statement by ADM, Sundargarh, Er. Deepak Kumar Sahoo, Asst. Env. Engineer, State Pollution Control Board, Rourkela gave vote of thanks at the end of public hearing.

The Attendance sheet of the members present in the public hearing is annexed as **Annexure-I**. About 3000 participants have attended the public hearing meeting but only 528 persons put their signature in the attendance sheet whose list is annexed as **Annexure-II**. About 122 persons have registered whereas among them only 112 persons have deliberated their views in the public hearing. Apart from above others 56 persons have also deliberated, but not put their signatures in the attendance sheet. In total 168 persons took part in the deliberation. Attendance sheet is annexed as **Annexure-III**. The video recording of the entire proceeding of the public hearing is enclosed in separate **Compact Disc (CD)**.

About 500 written petitions have been received from the various stake holders before & on the day of public hearing. Summary of the petitions is enclosed as **Annexure- VIII**. Copies of the petitions are enclosed as **Annexure-IX**.

### NOTICE

It is brought to the notice of all concerned that M/s OCL India Ltd. has proposed to have Environmental Assessment for establishment of New Cement Plant (Dalmia DSP Unit) for Clinker (3.0 MTPA), Cement (2.25 MTPA), WHRS (15 MW) and DG set of 1000 KVA at village and Tahasil, Rajgangpur in the district of Sundargarh to obtain Environmental Clearance from the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India. The proponent has applied to the State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar for a Public Hearing.

By virtue of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India Notification No. S.O. 1533(E), dated 14.09.2006, the Board has been authorized to conduct environmental public hearing and as such invites suggestions, views, comments and objections on matters relating to environmental aspects of the proposed project from all the persons including bonafide residents, environmental groups and others located at the proposed site / sites of displacement / sites likely to be affected.

For the above purpose, a person will only mean:

- Any person who is likely to be affected by the grant of Environmental Clearance.
- Any person who owns his control over the project with respect to which an application has been submitted for environmental clearance.
- Any association of persons whether incorporated or likely to be affected by the project and / or functioning in the field of environment.
- Any local authority within any part of whose local limits is within the neighborhood, wherein the project is proposed to be located.

Persons as above who desire to submit their views, comments, objections etc. relevant to the project, may do so in writing within 30 days from the date of publication of this notice addressing the same to the Member Secretary, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha through Registered Post. Besides this, persons interested to submit their views relevant to the proposed project in writing or orally may also do so during the public hearing to be conducted on 20.09.2017 at 10:00 AM at the play ground of Gopabandhu High School, Rajgangpur under Rajgangpur Block of Sundargarh district.



1.	Local public to be given preference for getting employment.	The proposed project will generate more than 800 employments, where the preference shall be given to suitable candidates from local as per Company requirement.
2.	Necessary measures to be taken by the Company for environment protection and pollution control.	The proposed plant will come up with pollution control equipment's having advance technological features for the protection of environment. The Pollution Control Measures shall be undertaken as per the guidelines of MOEF, Govt of India and state pollution control board.
3	Construction of Railway over bridge.	The public support is required to be extended to the company to explore the feasibility of over bridge. The feasibility proposal is already under preparation.
4	Arrangement of Water to meet the requirement of Proposed Plant.	The water requirement for the proposed project will be managed within the present approved Quantity. The treated water from the STP will be reused for process requirement of new proposed plant.

The company is ready to work with the community to explore further requirement.
7.	The development of Rajgangpur town and adjacent villages through Corporate Social Responsibility.	Since inception the Company has committed for development of Rajgangpur and the peripheral areas. The same shall continue to undertake various areas like uplift-ment of lively hood of local public, health care, education, sanitation and soil & water related activities along with energy conservation measures.



**Summary of the written representation received from the public by ADM, Sundargarh and Regional Officer, State pollution control board, Rourkela, Odisha during and before Public Hearing meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> Sept 2017 at 10 am, at Play ground of Gopabandhu High School, Rajgangpur of Dist. Sundargarh in respect to M/s. OCL India Limited, Rajgangpur for establishment of new Cement Plant (Dalmia DSP Unit) Clinker (3.0 MTPA), Cement (2.25 MTPA), WHRS (15 MW) and D.G. Set (1000 KVA) at Village & Tehsil: Rajgangpur, District: Sundargarh (Odisha).**

About 500 written petitions were received before and on the day of public hearing from the public. Most of the petitioners have welcomed the proposed project with conditions of local employment and peripheral development by the project proponent. Some petitioners have also opposed the proposed project. The summery of the major issues of the petitioner are as below:-

1. The public have demanded to undertake various developmental works in the peripheral villages and in Rajgangpur through Corporate Social Responsibility to promote the lively hood of local people.
2. Some of the petitioners have alleged that the air and water pollution will increase due to establishment of proposed plant. The public have also demanded to take precautionary Pollution control measures as per norms of the regulatory body. They have also demanded for plantation in and around Rajgangpur.
3. Some of the petitioners have alleged that company has neglected the local public during employment. However most of the public has demanded for providing employment to the local people especially to the unemployed youths in the company on priority basis.
4. Most of the public have demanded for construction of over bridge at Railway crossings to save the commute time and other problem faced by them.
5. The company authority should provide better health care facility and establish a good hospital for the Rajgangpur public.
6. The company authority should provide educational facility like providing proper infrastructure, training & coaching facility to the local youths and financial assistance to the existing nearby educational institutes.
