


Proceeding of the Public Hearing meeting held on 22nd September, 2017 at 10.00 A.M., at- Khajurdihi Football Ground (Near EMRS, Laing),Tahasil-Rajgangpur of Sundargarh District in respect of M/s Suraj Products Ltd. for expansion of existing steel plant located in Village Barpalli, Kesramal, Dist-Sundargarh.

The public hearing of M/s Suraj Products Limited, for expansion of existing Sponge iron- 45000 TPA, Pig Iron(Mini Blast Furnace)-60,000 TPA, Iron Ore/Mineral Ore briquettes(mineral briquetting plant)-105600 TPA (20 TPH), Backup power generation(DG set)-500 KVA X 3 Nos + 320 KVA X 1 No = 1820 KVA, Iron ore & other mineral ore(Manganese, Chrome, Nickel Ore etc) beneficiation plant input basis(throughput)-105600 TPA (20 TPH), Coal washery-96000 TPA(20 TPH), Reduced metal power from metallic mineral ore such as iron powder and chrome ore, Manganese Ore etc(through Tunnel Kiln Process)-40000 TPA, Ferro Alloys/Pig Iron from submerged arc furnace-Ferro Alloys-20000 TPA or Pig iron 40000 TPA, Semi finished Steel(through Induction Furnace; LRF/GOR; converter & Continuous Caster)-110000 TPA, Rolled Steel(Rolling mill(Structure/rolled products))-100000 TPA, Captive power generation(CFBC power plant based on washery reject)-6 MW, Bricks(brick making from waste)-66000 TPA & Producer gas plants two nos. for firing these kilns-Each 600 Kg/hr or 3600 TPA coal gasification capacity or 2100 Nm³/hr i.e 14 million m³ per year producer gas located in Village Barpalli, Kesramal, Dist-Sundargarh held on dt. 22.09.2017 at 10.00 A.M. At- Khajurdihi Football Ground (Near EMRS, Laing),Tahasil-Rajgangpur of Sundargarh District.



ADM, Sundargarh welcomed the public who were present at the venue for participating in the public hearing and informed about the objectives of the Public Hearing meeting.

At the outset Sri Hemendra Nath Nayak, Regional officer, Rourkela, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha welcomed the public present in the meeting. He briefly described the objective of the public hearing as per the EIA Notification S.O. 1533(E), dated 14th September 2006 of the Ministry of Environment and Forests & CC, Govt. of India. He informed that the date, time and venue for conducting the public hearing of M/s Suraj Products Limited for expansion of existing steel plant at- Village Barpalli, Kesramal, Dist-Sundargarh, was advertised in Odiya daily "Sambad" on 19.08.2017 and English Daily "The New Indian Express" on 18.08.2017. The production capacities as per revised TOR are less than the production capacities as mentioned in original TOR. The EIA/EMP report has been prepared as per revised TOR and was circulated and displayed prior to the date of above public notices. Corrigendum with regard to production capacities as per revised TOR was also advertised in Odiya daily "Sambad" on 22.09.2017 and English Daily "The New Indian Express" on 22.09.2017. (Paper cuttings of news papers are enclosed).

On behalf of the project proponent, Sri Mahendra Kumar Hati, Chief Finance Officer of M/s. Suraj Products Limited welcomed the dignitaries on the dais and gathering. He gave a brief description about the existing plant facilities and proposed expansion project. He has stated that the EIA/EMP report has been prepared as per revised Terms of Reference by the authorized consultant. He has expressed that the company is following the norms and guidelines of the MoEF & CC, Govt. of India and SPCB, Odisha in their existing plant. They will also control the pollution as per the norms and guidelines issued by the MoEF & CC, Govt. of India and SPCB, Odisha in their expansion project. Green belt has already been developed by the company and plantation activity will continue to comply the norms of 33% area of green belt out of total area. He has stated that at present about 348 persons were employed in the existing plant, among them about 90 % are from the local public. This proposed expansion project will generate about 300 employments during the construction period and about 300 employments during the operational period. This project is also expected to

create opportunities for indirect employment to about 500 persons. He has assured that preference will be given to local people as per their eligibility during employment. The project proponent has earmarked 2.5 % of the project cost for the peripheral development through Corporate Social Responsibility. At the end he has also highlighted that this project will be beneficial to the society.

Addl. District Magistrate, Sundargarh invited the public to offer their views on environmental related issues of the proposed expansion project. Most of the participants have welcomed the new project for employment opportunity & peripheral development. However they have raised issues related to employment to local peoples, Environment protection and Pollution Control, land acquisition, health care facility and drinking water facility. The views offered by the participants are enclosed as **Annexure-IV**. Summary of the points raised by the participants in the public hearing in English and Odiya (vernacular language) is enclosed as **Annexure-V(A & B)**.

After the completion of the deliberation process ADM, Sundargarh invited the representative of M/s. Suraj Products Limited to give a brief note on the issues related to the demand and grievances of the local people raised in the public Hearing meeting. Summary of the views of the project proponent on issues raised by the public during public hearing in English and Odiya (vernacular language) is enclosed as **Annexure-VI (A & B)**. During public hearing the proponent has also submitted their commitments in writing, which is enclosed as **Annexure-VII**.

Er. Deepak Kumar Sahoo, Asst. Env. Engineer, State Pollution Control Board, Rourkela gave vote of thanks at the end of public hearing after deliberation of the above and concluding statement by ADM, Sundargarh.

The Attendance sheet of the members present in the public hearing is annexed as **Annexure-I**. About 650 participants have attended the public hearing meeting but only 115 persons put their signature in the attendance

sheet, whose list is annexed as **Annexure-II**. About 115 persons took part in the deliberation. However out of total 115 persons deliberated their views, 114 persons have put their signatures in the attendance sheet, whose list is annexed as **Annexure-III**. The video recording of the entire proceeding of the public hearing is enclosed in separate **Compact Disc (CD)**.

About 150 written petitions have been received from the various stake holders before & on the day of public hearing. Most of the petitioners have welcomed the proposed expansion project for peripheral development and local employment. However few petitioners have also raised the issue of land acquisition and pollution. Copies of the petitions are enclosed as **Annexure-VIII**.

It is brought to the notice of all concerned that M/s Suraj Products Ltd. has proposed to have Environmental Assessment for expansion of existing 45000 TPA Sponge Iron, Pig Iron from 24000 TPA to 60000 TPA, Mineral briquetting plant 200000 TPA, Beneficiation plant input basis (through-put) 264000 TPA, Coal Washery 185000 TPA, reduced metal powder 80000 TPA, Ferro alloys 25000 TPA or pig iron 50000 TPA, steel melting shop (through induction furnace) 110000 TPA mild steel billet, re-rolled steel 100000 TPA, 8MW CFBC power plant (based on washery reject), fly ash brick-200 TPD, producer gas plant of 2100NM³/hr located in village Barpalli, Post - Kesaramal, Rajgangpur Tahasil of Sundargarh district to obtain Environmental Clearance from the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India. By virtue of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India Notification, No. S.O. 1533 (E) dt. 14.09.2006, the Board has been authorized to conduct environmental public hearing and as such invites suggestions, views, comments and objections on matters relating to environmental aspects of the proposed project from all the persons including bonafide residents, environmental groups and others located at the proposed site / sites of displacement/sites likely to be affected.

For the above purpose, a person will only mean:

- Any person who is likely to be affected by the grant of Environmental Clearance.
- Any person who owns or has control over the project with respect to which an application has been submitted for environmental clearance.
- Any association of persons whether incorporated or likely to be affected by the project and/or functioning in the field of environment.
- Any local authority within any part of whose local limits is within the neighborhood, wherein the project is proposed to be located.

Persons as above who desire to submit their views, comments, objections etc. relevant to the project, may do so in writing within 30 days from the date of publication of this notice addressing the same to the Member Secretary, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha through Registered Post. Besides this, persons interested to submit their views relevant to the proposed project in writing or orally may also do so during the public hearing to be conducted on 22.09.2017 at 10:00 AM at Khajurahi Foot Ball Ground (Near EMRS, Laing), Laing under Rajgangpur Tahasil of Sundargarh district.





1	Land Acquisition	The expansion project will be established inside the existing operational unit having 45.26 Acre of land. The Company have 11.41 Acre of free hold existing plant land and obtained 33.85 Acre IDCO acquired land under lease from IDCO. No additional land will be required for this expansion. Thus, company is not going to acquire additional land for this proposed expansion.
2	Pollution Control	The company is having adequate Air Pollution Control equipment's like ESP, Bag Filters with Central Dust Collection System by which company is keeping Particulate Matter emission less than 100 mg/Nm ³ as per existing norms. In the proposed expansion also all the pollution control equipment with high efficiency are proposed to be installed, thereby PM emission limit will be maintain less than 50 mg/Nm ³ for the entire project activity. The company has installed online stack monitoring system which is connected to CPCB/ OSPCB Server which reveals that point source



		<p>connected to CPCB/ OSPCB Server which reveals that point source emission are being maintained within specified norms.</p> <p>In expansion project also the emission level will be kept within the standards prescribed by MOEFCC/CPCB/ OSPCB.</p> <p>Fugitive dust emission are being controlled through Water Sprinkling System in pucca internal roads, the transportation of raw material are being done in covered trucks, the dedicated approach road connecting to Rourkela Sambalpur Highway is provided for plying of trucks, vehicles for transportation of Raw material as well as finished product to the factory from Highway.</p> <p>Green belt has already been developed by the company and plantation activity will continue to comply the norms of 33% area of green belt.</p>
3	Employment	At the existing plant local people are given priority and about 90% workers are from surrounding areas. The company will give priority to local unemployed peoples based on their skill and knowledge.
4	Health Care Facility	The company is regularly doing Occupational Health checkup of workers. Health checkup facility every week is being carried out in surrounding villages, in which free medicine for common diseases are being given to people. Company will continue this for better health care facility in the locality.
5	Drinking Water facility	The company has already provided drinking water facility to nearby villages. In this regards company has already constructed about 45 bore wells. Company will continue this program in coming years as per demand of the villagers. The company has created a reservoir to store the rain water and this will also recharge ground water.
