**Proceedings of the Public Hearing meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> September, 2017 at 11.00 AM, At: LPG Marketing Terminals Campus of Village Bhitargarh, Backside of IOCL Oil Marketing Terminal, Paradeep of Jagatsinghpur district for expansion of LPG import facility of M/s. Indian Oil Corporation Ltd., of Jagatsinghpur district.**

Sri Biswajit Biswal, Addl. District Magistrate, Paradip presided over the meeting along with Dr. M. Mahaling, Regional officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Paradip. ADM, Paradip welcomed the public who were present at the venue for participating in the public hearing and informed about the objectives of the Public Hearing meeting.

At the outset Regional officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Paradip welcomed as the public present in the meeting. He briefly described the objective of the public hearing as per the EIA Notification S.O. 1533(E), dated 14<sup>th</sup> September 2006 of the Ministry of Environment and Forests & CC, Govt. of India. He informed that the date, time venue for conducting the public hearing of M/s Indian Oil Corporation Ltd., of Jagatsinghpur district was advertised in Odiya daily "The Sambad" on 13.08.2017 and English daily "Indian Express" on 12.08.2017. (Paper cuttings are enclosed as Annexure-I).

On behalf of the project proponent, Mr. Amit Kumar Tripathy, Chief Manager (LPG-E) of M/s Indian Oil Corporation Ltd., of Jagatsinghpur district, gave a brief presentation about the proposed project. He also briefed about the environmental management, pollution control measures and safety aspects to be undertaken in the upcoming expansion project.

ADM, Paradip invited the public to offer their views on environmental related issues of the proposed expansion project.

About 150 participants have attended the public hearing meeting and out of them about but 125 participants have put their signature in the attendance sheet whose list is annexed as Annexure-II. About 13 persons have delivered their views during public hearing and list is annexed as Annexure-III.

Statements of the public participated in the deliberation during public hearing meeting is as follow;

Mr. Arakhita Das, Member, Panchayatsamiti, Kothi	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He expressed his dissatisfaction towards company authority for providing employment to the outsiders instead of providing employment to the local people in the existing project.</li> <li>• He stated that local environment is getting polluted due to industries like PPL, Essar &amp; IFFCO.</li> <li>• He also expressed that there are 35 villages &amp; 40,000 people are residing in the Paradeep area being neglected because these companies are not providing any financial &amp; other supportive assistant to the local people under CSR schemes. Though it becomes an industrial hub of the State of Odisha.</li> <li>• He also narrated the example of PPL Hospital Paradeep and alleged that there are no doctors in the Hospital and suggested that company authority should facilitated Medical facility to the local people.</li> </ul> <p>At the end he has vehemently opposed the proposed expansion project.</p>

2.	<p><b>Mr. Pabitra Sahoo, Kothi</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He expressed his concerned on the dust pollution issues on the road due to plying of heavy vehicles as large numbers of industries are operating in and around Paradeep area.</li> <li>• He also expressed that industries like M/s. PPT, M/s. IFFCO, M/s. Carbon factory and M/s. Essar etc. are increasing the pollution level in Paradip area. He narrated that acid water coming out from the gypsum pond of M/s. IFFCO &amp; PPL are polluting the nearby creek and water bodies during rainy season as a result of which fish mortality reported.</li> <li>• Also he said that there is every possibility of fire and explosion hazards due to storage of chemicals by different industries of the Paradeep.</li> <li>• He also concerned about unemployment and unavailability of better medical facility to the locals.</li> <li>• He also expressed his concerned on the issues of ground water, Local River, creek pollution and temp rise in Paradeep area due to industrialization.</li> </ul> <p>At the end he has conditionally supported the proposed expansion project with a demand before the company to provide employment &amp; other benefits to the local people.</p>
3.	<p><b>Mr. Chinmaya Das President, Paradeep Port Affected Land Loser Farmers Society</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He stated that about 52 acres of land has been acquired by the company from different land owners since long for which the company authority should pay the compensation to the land looser as per the revised Govt. rate.</li> <li>• Also he stated that local environment is getting polluted due to industries like PPL, Essar &amp; IFFCO and ground water is getting polluted due to seepage of oil from underground pipeline transportation and storage tank.</li> <li>• He expresses his concern on health and safety aspects of local people and demanded before the company authority that health and safety aspects of the local people should be given priority.</li> <li>• He also informed that due to operation of IOCL Refineries local temperature of the Paradeep area is rising and more skin related diseases in the surrounding villagers is reported.</li> <li>• He also informed that pollution index of the Paradeep area is 69.26 became the third polluted area in the state of Odisha after Angul- Talcher and Jharsuguda area.</li> </ul> <p>At the end he opposed the proposed expansion project.</p>
4.	<p><b>Mr. Amresh Naresh Samanta Secretary, Baba Balunkeswar Gramya Bikash Parishad, Jagatsinghpur</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He raised the issues regarding depletion of ground water level in Paradeep area due to industrialization &amp; demanded before the company authority to use surface water instead of ground water in their industrial purposes.</li> <li>• He narrated the example of Bhopal Gas Tragedy and said that similar disaster may takes place in Paradeep area in</li> </ul>

		<p>near future as the Companies are importing huge quantity of LPG and storing it in their plant premises.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• He informed that Pollution Index of Paradeep is 69 which indicates Paradeep region is coming under highly polluted area.</li><li>• He expresses his concern that due to transportation of oil through underground pipeline system, there would be every possibilities of disaster in these areas. He demanded before the company authority to be more vigilant on fire safety aspects.</li><li>• He also demanded before the company authority that the storage area should be shifted to another new location looking into the fire safety aspects.</li></ul> <p>At the end he opposed the proposed expansion project.</p>

Siba Biswal, Paradeep	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• He expressed his dissatisfaction towards proposed expansion project and said that there is a depletion of ground water in the areas.</li><li>• He informed that the investment of the proposed project is Rs. 600 crore however, it will create employment opportunity of 77 persons only.</li><li>• He opposed the proposal for use of ground water in the industrial purpose of the company authority and demanded that the industry should not draw ground water for industrial purposes.</li><li>• He draws attention about the road dust pollution taking place from Atharabanki to Badapadia due to plying of heavy vehicles and tankers.</li></ul> <p>At the end he opposed the proposed expansion project.</p>





1. Most of the public have demanded for providing employment to the local people in the proposed expansion project on priority basis.
2. Environmental protection measures including massive plantation, control of air & water pollution should be undertaken by the project proponent on priority basis.
3. The company authority should provide proper health care facilities to the local people.
4. The company authority should provide safe drinking water facility to the nearby villagers and Municipality area.
5. The company authority should undertake overall peripheral development works under CSR activities in the local area.
6. The company authority should submit the people's welfare plan to the district administration within a month.


