The public hearing of M/s Vikram Private Limited, Badatumkela for Expansion of Sponge Iron Plant(2 X 100 TPD DRI Plant, 8, 50, 000 TPA Iron Ore Beneficiation Plant, 6,00,000 TPA pellet plant and 10 MW Power Plant) by process modification along with setting up of 1, 07,000 TPA SMS and 1, 00, 000 TPA Rolling Mill at Village- Badatumkela, P.S- Lahunipara, Dist-Sundargarh was held at Ground Near RMC Godown, Saleibahal, G. P-Rajamunda, Block-Lahunipara on 13.12.2017 at 11.00 A.M.

Mr. Bhaskar Chandra Turuk, Addl. District Magistrate, Sundargarh presided over the meeting along with Sri Hemendra Nath Nayak, Regional Officer, Rourkela, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha. ADM, Sundargarh welcomed the public who were present at the venue for participating in the public hearing and informed about the objectives of the Public Hearing meeting.

At the outset Sri Hemendra Nath Nayak, Regional officer, Rourkela, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha welcomed the public present in the meeting. He briefly described the objective of the public hearing as per the EIA Notification S.O. 1533(E), dated 14th September 2006 of the Ministry of Environment and Forests & CC, Govt. of India. He informed that the date, time and venue for conducting the public hearing of M/s Vikarm Private Limited for Expansion of Sponge Iron Plant(2 X 100 TPD DRI Plant, 8, 50, 000 TPA Iron Ore Beneficiation Plant, 6,00,000 TPA pellet plant and 10 MW Power Plant) by process modification along with setting up of 1, 07,000 TPA SMS and 1, 00, 000 TPA Rolling Mill at Village- Badatumkela, P.S- Lahunipara, Dist-Sundargarh was

advertised in Odiya daily "The Samaj" on 11.11.2017 and English Daily "The Times of India" on 12.11.2017. (Paper cuttings are enclosed).

On behalf of the project proponent, Mr. Dibyaranjan Behera, Director of M/s Vikarm Private Limited welcomed the gathering and gave a brief description about the existing plant facilities and proposed expansion project. He stated total 102 Acres of the land will be required for expansion facilities including existing plant facilities. Out of which 94.5 Acres of land has already been acquired by the proponent and rest 7.5 Acres is in the process of acquisition. He informed about the water requirement for this project, for which company has already obtained permission. He has also briefed about the environmental management & pollution control measures to be undertaken in the upcoming project. Water sprinkling in raw material storage yard will be carried out to control air pollution. The solid waste from Induction Furnace will be utilized for land filling and road making. Green belt will also be developed. He has mentioned that the company has already provided Rs. 45.00 Lakhs for peripheral development and 2.5 % of the project cost will also be allocated for peripheral developmental work during execution of expansion project. He concluded that due to this expansion project employment will be generated and it would also bring peripheral development and development of local inhabitants.

Addl. District Magistrate, Sundargarh invited the public to offer their views on environmental related issues of the proposed expansion project. Most of the participants have raised issues related to pollution control, local employment, plantation, health care facility, drinking water facility and peripheral development. The views offered by the participants are enclosed as **Annexure-IV**. Summary of the points raised by the participants in the public hearing in English and Odiya(vernacular language) is enclosed as **Annexure-V(A & B)**.



1.	Sri Muralidhar Munda, Sarpanch of Rajamunda G.P.	He welcomed the expansion project. However he expressed his concern about the pollution due to establishment of industries in that area. He demanded that the fund for peripheral development should be utilized for development of entire Rajamunda, Gram Panchayat. He has also demanded for providing employments to the local public on priority basis as per their educational qualification.
2.	Sri Arjun Mohan Kar, Tumkela	He welcomed the gathering. He has mentioned that so many industries were established in the Tumkela and adjacent areas within last 10 years and questioned that how the Government has given permission for this. He alleged that due to establishment of industries the level of pollution has increased. He has also expressed that they have made their grievance to the Collector regarding issues of pollution and illegal land encroachments by the industry; however they have not got any result. He has also cited the example of fetal accidents happened in M/s Bhaskar Sponge Plant. He welcomed the expansion project and mentioned that they are happy for this. However he has demanded that the company authority should control the pollution as per the norms, provide employments to the local public and undertake further peripheral developmental work especially for Tumkela village. At the end he has expressed that the villagers of Tumkela are in support of M/s Vikram Private Limited and they will continue to provide their support for the expansion project also.

3.	Sri Bhubanananda Kisan, Surupatla	He has demanded that the company authority should clarify the kind of assistance provided to the villagers since last 8 years. He further alleged that earlier commitments made by the indus / like engagement of the teacher in the nearby school; health care facility and water supply to the village have not been fulfilled yet. He has also mentioned that due to expansion the employment will be generated, however the level of pollution will increase. He has also alleged that due to pollution the villagers are facing various types of health problems.

He has also expressed that the company has failed to supply water to the local public. In this scenario how they will control the pollution and develop the plantation. He further alleged that public were not aware about this public hearing.
6.	Sri Bibhuti Bhusan Padhi, Tumkela	He welcomed the gathering. He has mentioned that the industry has already established and it is operational. Therefore it is the responsibility of the company authority to operate it in a better way for controlling the air pollution by operating ESP. He has also demanded to the company authority for providing employments to the public of Rajamunda G. P as per eligibility, take preventive measures to protect environment, provide ambulance facility and provide water supply facility etc. He has also requested to the authorities of District Administration and Pollution Control Board to look into the matters related to the welfare of the local public so that both the company and local public will prosper simultaneously.

On behalf of M/s Vikram Private Limited, Mr. Dibyaranjan Behera, Director has made following commitments in the public hearing:

- 1. Pollution Control:** He has assured that the company will install proper pollution control devices in the expansion project to meet the norms of the Pollution Control Board. He has further added that the industry is submitting the environmental compliances on half yearly and yearly basis to the regulatory authority. He has also assured that the company will abide the provisions of the Water (PCP) Act and Air (PCP) Act.
- 2. Local Employment:** He has informed that about 90 % of total employment is from local Rajamunda G.P. At present they have 120 nos. permanent employees and out of this about 105 nos. are from local public. He has also replied that the detail list is being submitted to the Labour Department. He has stated that the company is also paying wage and Provident Fund as per rule to the contractual employees. All the contractual employees are local public. Further he added that the company has not provided the employments as committed during last public hearing as project is not executed yet.
- 3. Health Care Facility:** He has informed that regular health checkup is being conducted for the employees working in the plant. Assistance is being provided to the general public during emergency health issues and generator has also been provided to the hospital as per the request of the authority. He further assured that health camps will be conducted for the local public as demanded.
