

Proceedings of the Public Hearing meeting held on 19th January, 2018 at 11.00 A. M., At- Mangala Mandir, Village- Kusumdihi, Block-Koira of Dist- Sundargarh for Kusumdihi Manganese Ore Mines of M/s Orissa Manganese and Minerals Pvt Ltd for expansion of production of Manganese Ore from 17, 376 TPA to 50, 680 TPA over an area of 31.549 Ha. in village- Kusumdihi, Block- Koira, Dist-Sundargarh.

The public hearing of Kusumdihi Manganese Ore Mines of M/s Orissa Manganese and Minerals Pvt Ltd for expansion of production of Manganese Ore from 17, 376 TPA to 50, 680 TPA over an area of 31.549 Ha. in village- Kusumdihi, Block- Koira, Dist-Sundargarh was held at- Mangala Mandir, Village- Kusumdihi, Block-Koira on 19.01.2018 at 11.00 A.M.

Sri Bhaskar Chandra Turuk, Addl. District Magistrate, Sundargarh presided over the meeting along with Sri Hemendra Nath Nayak, Regional Officer, Rourkela, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha. ADM, Sundargarh welcomed the public who were present at the venue for participating in the public hearing and informed about the objectives of the Public Hearing meeting.

At the outset Sri Hemendra Nath Nayak, Regional officer, Rourkela, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha welcomed the public present in the meeting. He briefly described the objective of the public hearing as per the EIA Notification S.O. 1533(E), dated 14th September 2006 of the Ministry of Environment and Forests & CC, Govt. of India. He informed that the date, time and venue for conducting the public hearing of Kusumdihi Manganese Ore Mines of M/s Orissa Manganese and Minerals Pvt Ltd for expansion of production of Manganese Ore from 17, 376 TPA to 50, 680 TPA over an area of 31.549 Ha. in village- Kusumdihi, Block- Koira, Dist-Sundargarh was advertised in Odiya daily "Sambad" on 14.12.2017 and English Daily "The New Indian Express" on 14.12.2017. (Paper cuttings are enclosed).

On behalf of the project proponent, Mr. Khiti Ranjan Ray, DGM Geology of Kusumdihi Manganese Ore Mines of M/s Orissa Manganese and Minerals Pvt Ltd welcomed the gathering and gave a brief description about the proposed expansion proposal. He stated that the total lease hold area is 31.549 Ha. He has informed that about 38.0 Lakhs will be invested for control of air and water pollution. Apart from it about 12.0 Lakhs per annum will also be invested for protection of environment. He has also mentioned that the mining lease is valid up to 31.03.2020. EIA/EMP report was prepared as per the TOR issued by the SEIAA, Govt of Odisha. He has also informed that the geological reserve of Manganese ore is 3, 74,114 MT. The life of the mine will be 8 years considering production of 50,680 TPA. The mining will be carried out by open cast semi mechanized method. About 345 persons will get employment opportunity in this mine during operation. About 4, 00,076.114 m³ of OB will be generated during three years of mining. About 70 % of the generated OB will be backfilled in the mining pits, 20 % of OB will be used for road making and rest 10 % will be dumped in the OB dump. About 70 KLD water will be required for this project. Pollution control measures will be undertaken by the mines to control the air and water pollution due to mining. Plantation will be carried out in OB dump, water sprinkling will be carried out to suppress the fugitive dust emission, garland drains, check dams and settling pits will be constructed to prevent flow of silts along with surface runoff; grass pitching will be carried out to prevent soil erosion etc. The will undertake various developmental work in periphery as per guideline of local administration. Free health camps will also be organized by the mine for local villagers.

Addl. District Magistrate, Sundargarh invited the public to offer their views on environmental related issues of the proposed expansion project. Most of the participants have welcomed the expansion of production of Manganese Ore proposal for peripheral development & employment opportunity. However they have raised issues related to Environmental Protection, Control of Air & Water Pollution, Payment of balance wages, local employment, Health Care facilities, Drinking Water facility and Education facility. The views offered by the

After deliberation of the above and concluding statement by ADM, Sundargarh, Er. Deepak Kumar Sahoo, Asst. Env. Engineer, State Pollution Control Board, Rourkela gave vote of thanks at the end of public hearing.

1.	Sri Bhimsen Dehuri, Kalta Panchayat	He welcomed the gathering. He extends his support for expansion of the production of this mine for employment generation.
2.	Suresh Nayak, MLA Representative	He extends his support for the public hearing. He urged that due to enhancement of production of mines local people will get employment. However he has requested to the company authorizes to provide drinking water facility, construct roads, undertake development in local villages, provide support to the SHGs, construct water harvesting structures etc.
3.	Sri Krushna Chandra Barik, Kalta	He extends his support for the public hearing. He stated that during operation of mine about 200 persons were employed, however local public were suffering as presently it is non-operational. He has requested to the mining authority to provide drinking water facility, local employment, protect environment during mining, undertake plantation and undertake overall developmental activities. He has also requested to company to provide balance pending wages to workers. At end he again extends his support for the public hearing.

5.	Sukanti Patra, Klata	She welcomed the gathering. She has express that the mine should resume its operation so that local unemployed youths will get employments and this would also leads to the peripheral development. At the end she supports this public hearing.
6.	Smt. Sukuamani Nayak, Kamando	She demanded that the balance wages should be paid to them before resumption of mining operation.
7.	Smt. Sunamani Kuanar, Kusumdihi	She demanded that the balance wages should be paid to them. She also urged to the authorities to takes steps to provide balance wages to them.
8.	Smt Jamuna Mahakud, kamando	She demanded that the balance wages, PF and bonus should be paid to them before resumption of mining operation otherwise they will not allow to operate the mine.
9.	Sri Gade Munda, Kusumdihi	He expressed that mine should resume its operation, however he demanded to take precautionary measures to avoid water pollution of nearby natural streams and water bodies. He has also requested to the authorities to provide financial assistances to the villages during festive occasions, views of local villagers should be taken during decision making, drinking water facility to be provided to the villagers, bathing ghats should be provided etc.

On behalf of the Kusumdihi Manganese Ore Mines of M/s Orissa Manganese and Minerals Pvt Ltd, Mr. A C Majhi, Dy. GM (Planning) welcomed the public present and highlighted the major demands raised by the public such as; Environmental Protection, Control of Air & Water Pollution, payment of balance wages, local employment, Drinking Water facility and Education facility etc. Mr. Majhi has made following commitments to the public during public hearing:

1. Employment: He informed that during mining operation they have provided local employments and assured that priority will also be given for employment to local people after resumption of mining operation.
2. Payment of balance Wages: He has assured that the company authority will discuss the issues of pending wages with the workers after resumption of mining operation and they will resolve it.
3. Education Facility: He assured the company authority will discuss with the local villagers and local representatives and will undertake steps for better education as per their capability.
4. Environment Protection: He has assured that Over Burden generated during course of mining will be mostly back filled inside the pit and rest quantity will be dumped inside the ML area in designated OB dumps. No OB will be dumped outside the ML area. Garland drains and settling pits will be constructed along the toe of OB dumps to prevent flow of silts along with surface runoff. He has also assured that they will take preventive steps to control Air and Water Pollution. They will also monitor the environmental parameters to ascertain the environmental quality during mining.
