

**Proceedings of the Public Hearing meeting for a proposed project by M/s. Paradeep Municipality for Municipal Solid Waste Management (Landfill), At: Bitargarh in Jagatsinghpur district held on 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 At 10.30 AM, At: Municipal Kalyan Mandap,Paradeep of Jagatsinghpur district.**

Dr. Kahnu Charan Dhir, Addl. District Magistrate (ADM), Paradip presided over the meeting along with Dr. M. Mahaling, Regional officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Paradip.

ADM, Paradip welcome the public who were present at the venue for participating in the public hearing and informed about the objectives of the Public Hearing meeting.

At the outset Regional officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Paradip welcome the public present in the meeting. He briefly described the objective of the public hearing as per the EIA Notification S.O. 1533(E), dated 14<sup>th</sup> September 2006 of the Ministry of Environment and Forests & CC, Govt. of India. He informed that the date, time venue for conducting the public hearing of proposed project by M/s. Paradeep Municipality for Municipal Solid Waste Management (Landfill), At: Bitargarh in Jagatsinghpur district was advertised in Odiya daily "The Samaj" on 02.08.2018 and English daily "Times of India" on 02.08.2018. **(Paper clipping are enclosed as Annexure-I).**

Sri. Basanta Kumar Biswal, Chairman, Mrs. Pravati Nayak, Vice Chairman and Sri. Dillip Kumar Mohanty, Executive Officer of Paradeep Municipality have briefed about the proposed project and stated that the same project has been funded by World Bank, Central Govt and State Govt. This project will help the management of solid waste which is being generated from the household of township areas and make the city clean and green. They have requested the participants to co-operate the public hearing of the proposed project.

On behalf of the project proponent, Mr. Vinod Mohapatra, Social Consultant, IPE, Global, New Delhi and Mr. Purusottam, EIA, consultant, ASCENSO Enviro Pvt. Ltd, Noida, New Delhi gave a brief presentation about the proposed project of **M/s. Paradeep Municipality for Municipal Solid Waste Management (Landfill), At: Bitargarh in Jagatsinghpur district.** He also briefed about the environmental management, pollution control measures and safety aspects to be undertaken in the proposed project.

ADM, Paradip invited the public to offer their views on environmental related issues of the proposed project.

About 300-350 participants have attended the public hearing meeting and out of them about but **292** participants have put their signature in the attendance sheet whose list is annexed as **Annexure-II**. About 29 persons have registered their name to deliver their views and out of them 28 persons have delivered their views during public hearing and list is annexed as **Annexure-III**.

Statements of the public participated in the deliberation during public hearing meeting is as follow;

1.	<p><b>Sri. Siba Biswal, Madhuban,Paradeep:</b>            He stated that huge quantity of solid waste generated from the township area has been dumped at various places of Paradeep township which is major concerned for air, water and soil pollution. Therefore, the township people and surrounding villagers are affected by various diseases. Also he said that after coming up the proposed project,</p>

	<p>environmental issues related with the air, water and solid waste problem of the Paradeep area will be minimized.</p> <p>At the end he welcomed and supported the proposed project.</p>
2.	<p><b><u>Mr. Pabitra Kumar Sahoo, Jhimani Kothi</u></b></p> <p>He expressed his dissatisfaction towards different industries operating in and around Paradeep area and stated that local people are suffering due to pollution of various industries.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He said that the local peoples are not financially and socially sound even though the various industries have been established and operating in this area.</li> <li>• He stated that environmental pollution is due to operation of the Paradeep Port Trust.</li> <li>• He expressed his serious concerned on dust pollution issues on the road due to plying of heavy vehicles near gate No.1,2,3 &amp; 4 of the M/s. Paradeep Port Trust(PPT). He also expressed about traffic related issues of the Roads connecting from Paradeepgarh to gate No-4 of M/s. PPT, and added that this road is unsafe for two wheeler riders. He informed that heavy vehicles and tankers are parking along the oil terminal road due to non-availability of parking facilities.</li> <li>• He suggested that road cleaning activities shall be carried out from Bhutmundai to Paradeep Port Gate.</li> <li>• He also raised the issues and said that Regional Peripheral Development Advisory Committee (RPDAC) meeting is not been conducted regularly.</li> <li>• He also suggested that the massive plantation should be undertaken by the various company authorities on both side of the roads in Paradeep areas.</li> </ul> <p>At the end he stated that he is not against the project.</p>
3.	<p><b><u>Sri. Seshadev Senapati, Anthrabanki</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He demanded before the authority to provide facility for water drainage network at the proposed site for smooth discharge of rain water.</li> <li>• He also demanded that the road connecting from main road to M/s.PPL Gate are needs to be repaired along with street light facilities.</li> </ul> <p>At the end he welcome and supported the proposed project.</p>
4.	<p><b><u>Sri. Bhagawan, Rout, Ward No-11, Madhuban</u></b></p> <p>He stated that he has spent 40 years of his service in M/s.PPT and expressed that pollution load in the Paradeep area has been increased which needs to be taken care.</p> <p>At the end he welcomed and supported the proposed project.</p>
5.	<p><b><u>Sri. Bikram Mohanty, Bhitargarh:</u></b></p> <p>He expressed his dissatisfaction and said that the village Bhitargarh has been resettled during 1988 by the M/s.PPT and since then no development activities have been undertaken in their village.</p> <p>He alleged that air and water pollution has been increased due to various industries located in close proximate to the village. No plantation has been done don in their village.</p> <p>He demanded that massive plantation shall be undertaken in their village</p>
6.	<p><b><u>Sri. Ashok Mohapatra:</u></b></p> <p>He welcome the project and expressed his views that air and ground water pollution may takes place due to solid waste dump at the proposed project site and demanded that the project authority should take proper steps for control of pollution.</p>
7.	<p><b><u>Mrs. Nalini Prava Sahoo:</u></b></p> <p>She welcomed the project and expressed her views that public are facing various</p>

	<p>problems due to improper management of solid waste in township area.</p> <p>She also expressed that Madhuban colony area has submerged during last rain due to choking of polythene in storm water drain.</p> <p>At the end she conditionally supported the proposed project with a demand before the authority to take necessary steps with respect to environmental issues at the proposed site so that the local people should not be affected due to the proposed project.</p>
8.	<p><b><u>Sri. Aishkant Ray, Paradeep Nagarika Manch</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He highlighted about their NGO's activities and stated that they have undertaken 5000 nos. of species saplings and tree plantation in the National / State High way of Paradeep and Jagatsinghpur area.</li> <li>• He added that their NGO have received with Prakruti Bandhu awarded from State Govt. Also he said that they are always being endeavored towards environmental protection work in association with Municipality Paradeep.</li> </ul> <p>At the end he welcome and conditionally supported the proposed project with a demand to mitigate the issues like depletion of ground water, water pollution, odour nuisance and Road dust pollution from Tarinigarh to Anthrabanki area.</p>
9.	<p><b><u>Sri. Prabhash Chandra Swain</u></b></p> <p>He expressed his views and said that the public are not aware of use of dust bin provided in the colony area and waste is being thrown into dust bin from a distance resulting littering of waste near the dust bin.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He apprehended that ground water contamination may takes place at the project site due to dumping of waste.</li> <li>• He demanded before the authority for massive plantation around the proposed project site.</li> <li>• He expressed his dissatisfaction for cutting of mangrove tress by M/s. PPT from Nehuru Banglow to Antahrabank due to expansion of the M/s. PPT and added that mangrove tress can protect the natural calamities like cyclone etc.</li> </ul> <p>At the end he supported the proposed project.</p>
10.	<p><b><u>Mr. Nagendra Kumar Rout:</u></b></p> <p>He expressed that people are facing lots of problems due to improper management of plastic waste in township area.</p> <p>He stated that the proposed project will be beneficial for the public and he supported the proposed project.</p>
11.	<p><b><u>Sri. Prakash Kumar Jena:</u></b></p> <p>He expressed that people are facing lots of problems due to improper management of plastic waste in township area and dumped in Balipolt area.</p> <p>He stated that the proposed project will be beneficial for the public and he supported the proposed project.</p>
12.	<p><b><u>Sushil Mohapatra:</u></b></p> <p>He expressed that the entire solid waste of Paradeep township is being dumped near Jagarnnath Colony which has become unhygienic and polluted due to improper management of solid waste. Hence, he suggested that, If the solid waste is being recycled then such type of issues can be minimized.</p> <p>He welcome the project and apprehended that such type of project will resolve the environmental issues related with solid waste management.</p>
13.	<p><b><u>Jhadeswar Manna:</u></b></p> <p>He welcome the proposed project and stated that this project shall be beneficial for the public at large.</p>

14.	<p><b><u>Sri. Mahendra Pradhan, Rangiagarh</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He expressed his dissatisfaction and stated that the proposed project site is not coming under the jurisdiction of Paradeep Municipality and the proposed site is surrounded by the human habitation.</li> <li>• He demanded before the authority that the proposed project site should be shifted to suitable location away from the human habitation area.</li> <li>• He welcome such type of project but he demanded before the authority for shifting of the site to other suitable location away from the human habitation area.</li> </ul>
15.	<p><b><u>Sri. Pnya Ranjan Mandal:</u></b> He welcome and supported the proposed project for the benefit of local people at large.</p>
16.	<p><b><u>Sri. Sarbeswar Mandal:</u></b> He expressed his support for the proposed project for the benefit of local people at large.</p>
17.	<p><b><u>Sri. Balukrushna Jena:</u></b> He expressed his dissatisfaction that the Rangiagarh area has been polluted due to operation of various industries in that area. He welcome such type of project but he demanded before the authority for shifting of the site to other suitable location away from the human habitation area.</p>
18.	<p><b><u>Sri. Bijay Kumar Biswal:</u></b> He expressed that people are facing lot of problems due to plastic waste. He conditionally supported the proposed project with a demand before the authority to take necessary steps so that the local people should not be affected due to the proposed project from any type of pollution.</p>
19.	<p><b><u>Atal Parida:</u></b> He expressed that people are facing lot of problems due to plastic solid waste (polythene bags) in township area. He stated that the proposed project will be beneficial for the public at large and he supported the proposed project.</p>
20.	<p><b><u>Shishi Mahapatra:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He expressed that the proposed project site shall not be used for dumping of solid waste only.</li> <li>• He demanded before the authority that latest technology should be adopted for processing and recycling of the solid waste at the site.</li> <li>• He suggested that massive plantation shall be carried out along the road side from zero point to M/s.PPT gate No-5.</li> </ul> <p>At the end he welcome and supported the proposed project.</p>
21.	<p><b><u>Mr. Arakhita Das, Village: Kothi</u></b> He expressed his dissatisfaction and apprehended that the air, water, soil and odour pollution will takes place from the proposed project and surrounding area will be affected. At the end he vehemently opposed the proposed project.</p>
22.	<p><b><u>Sri. Kanaklata Mallick:</u></b> He demanded before the authority that the project site should be shifted to suitable location away from the human habitation area. At the end he strongly opposed the proposed project site.</p>
23.	<p><b><u>Sri. Mihir Ranjan Sahoo:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He expressed his dissatisfaction and stated that about 4000 people have been residing in Rangiagarh village where, ground water has been contaminated.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He also stated that there is no drinking water supply provision to their village.</li> <li>• He demanded before the authority that the project site should be shifted to suitable location away from the human habitation area.</li> </ul> <p>At the end he opposed the proposed project.</p>
24.	<p><b><u>Sri. Debi Prasad Sahoo:</u></b> He welcome and supported the proposed project for the benefit of local people at large.</p>
25.	<p><b><u>Sri. Sarat Kumar Rout:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He welcome the proposed project and stated that after establishment of the project the township area will become plastic free.</li> <li>• He informed that annual consumption of plastic/polythene has been increased and at present the consumption rate is 11 kg/head. Hence, generation of plastic waste is increasing which can be processed in the proposed project site.</li> <li>• He also raised the flare stack of M/s. Indian Oil Corporation Ltd, Paradeep and suggested that the company authority should adopt the state of art technology to stop of such flare in the stack so as to minimize the impact on surrounding area.</li> </ul> <p>At the end he welcome and supported the proposed project.</p>
26.	<p><b><u>Ashish Mohapatra:</u></b> He welcome and supported the proposed project for the benefit of local people at large.</p>
27.	<p><b><u>Sri. Shankar Prasad Rout:</u></b> He welcome and supported the proposed project for the benefit of local people at large.</p>
28.	<p><b><u>Sri. Adhir Kumar Sahoo:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He expressed that polythene is major concerned for water logging in the drain and causing flood situation in the township area. If proposed project would come then the solid waste and polythene waste can be managed properly.</li> </ul> <p>At the end he supported the proposed project.</p>
29.	<p><b><u>Dr. Kulamani Samal, Honble Member of Parilament(Lok Sabha), Jagatsinghpur</u></b> He expressed his views that the proposed project will be beneficial for the local people as this project involves scientific management of municipal solid waste which includes proper collection, segregation, processing and recycling of solid waste. It will reduce the haphazard dumping of solid waste and create healthy environment in the Paradeep Municipality area. At the end he welcome the proposed project.</p>

Summary of the points raised by the participants in the public hearing in English and Odiya(vernacular language)is enclosed as **Annexure-IV( A & B)**.

After the completion of the deliberation process ADM, Paradeep invited the representative of **M/s. Paradeep Municipality for Municipal Solid Waste Management (Landfill), At: Bitargarh in Jagatsinghpur district** to give a brief note on the issues related to the demand and grievances of the participants raised in the public Hearing meeting. Summary of the views of the project proponent on issues raised by the participants during public hearing in English and Odiya (vernacular language) are enclosed as **Annexure-V (A& B)**.



**Summary of the points raised by the public during the Public Hearing meeting for proposed project by M/s. Paradeep Municipality for Municipal Solid Waste Management (Landfill), At: Bitargarh in Jagatsinghpur district held on 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 At 10.30 AM, At: Municipal Kalyan Mandap, Paradeep of Jagatsinghpur district.**

1. Environmental protection measures including massive plantation, control of air and water pollution in the proposed project site should be undertaken by the project proponent to minimize the adverse impact on the surrounding area.
2. The project proponent should take necessary steps to prevent the ground water contamination due to dumping of solid waste in the proposed project site.
3. The project proponent should take necessary steps for proper collection, segregation and recycling of the solid waste for sound environmental management at the proposed project site.
4. The project proponent should take necessary steps to control odour nuisance at the project site.
5. The project proponent should adopt latest technology for processing and recycling of Municipal solid waste.


**Summary of the views of Project Proponent on the issues raised by the Public Hearing meeting for proposed project by M/s. Paradeep Municipality for Municipal Solid Waste Management (Landfill)., At: Bitargarh in Jagatsinghpur district held on 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 At 10.30 AM, At: Municipal Kalyan Mandap, Paradeep of Jagatsinghpur district.**

On behalf of the M/s. Paradeep Municipality for Municipal Solid Waste Management (Landfill), At: Bitargarh in Jagatsinghpur district Mr. Bharat Nagar , Solid Waste Expert, IPE, Global, New Delhi welcome the public present on the public hearing and he has addressed the issues raised in the public hearing as follows:

1. He has stated that the proposed project will consist of door to door collection of solid waste, transportation and processing in three stages which includes processing of Bio-degradable waste through organic waste converter, processing of dry waste through recycling center and final disposal of the inert waste material & rejects at the sanitary landfill site.
2. The sanitary landfill site shall be constructed with clay and liners at the bottom to prevent any ground water contamination and leachate water shall be collected through leachate collection pipe followed by tank and same shall be treated in leachate treatment plant to meet the prescribed standard of the Board. The treated water shall be utilized for plantation purpose.
3. It was proposed that odour nuisance can be minimized by putting a layer of soil over the inert waste material & rejects at the land fill site.
4. He also stated that there will be no processing plant at the landfill site hence air pollution problem will not arise to the surrounding area.
