

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING HELD ON 14.11.2018 (AT 9.00 AM) IN DANAGADI BHAWAN FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE IN RESPECT OF M/S JINDAL UNITED STEEL LIMITED, JAJPUR FOR THE PROPOSED ESPANSION OF HOT STRIP MILL FROM 1.6 TO 3.2 MTPA AND INSTALLATION OF 0.3 MTPA COLD ROLLING MILL AT KALINGANAGAR INDUSTRIAL COMPLEX, TEHSIL DANAGADI IN THE DISTRICT OF JAJPUR, ODISHA**

The public hearing in respect of the expansion project proposed by M/s Jindal United Steel Limited, Jajpur for expansion of Hot Strip Mill from 1.6 MTPA to 3.2 MTPA and Installation for 0.3 MTPA Cold Rolling Mill was held on scheduled date & time in Danagadi Bhawan in the district of Jajpur with reference to:

- I. EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006
- II. Interim Operational Guidelines till 13<sup>th</sup> September 2007 in respect of applications made under EIA-1994


**The Panel consisted of the following members:**

1. Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, Jajpur
2. Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Kalinganagar.

Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, supervised & presided over the public hearing process and assisted by Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of project proposed by M/s. Jindal United Steel Limited.

Welcoming the public, Sri S.K. Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the



public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He asked the project proponent to make a brief description before the public gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public. On behalf of the Project Proponent, Sri Satyanarayan Nayak, Manager, Environment of M/s. Jindal United Steel Limited addressed the committee members and assembled public, and made a brief description about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management, afforestation programme and various other peripheral development activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Then Sri Mishra, ADM, Kalinganagar, requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:

1. **Sri Prasant Kumar Ray, Dangadi, Jajpur**

He expressed his support to the proposed expansion project of M/s. JUSL and was demanded for local employment, economic growth, avenue plantation, supply of drinking water and control of environmental pollution in nearby areas.


