Proceedings of the Public Hearing meeting held on 24th January, 2019 at 11.00 AM at Banjari village of Deogarh District in respect of M/s Western Integrated Waste Management Facility Pvt. Ltd. for establishment of Common Hazardous Waste Treatment, Storage and Disposal Facility (CHWTSDF) at Banjari village of Deogarh District.

The public hearing of M/s Western Integrated Waste Management Facility Pvt. Ltd. for establishment of Common Hazardous Waste Treatment, Storage and Disposal Facility (CHWTSDF) at Banjari village of Deogarh District was held on 24th January, 2019 at 11.00 AM at Banjari village of Deogarh District.

Sri Dharam Hansdah, OAS (S), Additional District Magistrate, Deogarh supervised and presided over the meeting along with Sri Hemendra Nath Nayak, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Rourkela, Odisha.

At the outset, Sri Hemendra Nath Nayak, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Rourkela welcomed the public present in the meeting. He briefly described the objective of the public hearing as per the EIA Notification S.O. 1533 (E), dated 14th September, 2006 of the Ministry of Environment, Forests & CC, Govt. of India. He informed that, the date, time and venue for conducting the public hearing of M/s Western Integrated Waste Management Facility Pvt. Ltd. for establishment of Common Hazardous Waste Treatment, Storage and Disposal Facility (CHWTSDF) at Banjari village of Deogarh District, was advertised in the Odia Daily "Dharitri" on 23.12.2018 and the English Daily, "The New Indian Express" on 23.12.2018 (Paper cuttings of the advertisements are enclosed in Annexure -IX).

Additional District Magistrate, Deogarh welcomed the public who were present at the venue for participating in the public hearing and informed about the objective of the public hearing.

On behalf of the Project Proponent, Sri Deepak Pani, Chief Executive Officer of the unit welcomed the dignitaries on the dais and the gathering. He gave a brief description about the proposed establishment of Common Hazardous Waste Treatment, Storage and Disposal Facility (CHWTSDF). He further informed that about 40 Acres of land has already been acquired by the proponent and the total project cost will be Rs. 41.50 Crores. The generated industrial waste from the western belt of Odisha will be disposed in scientific manner with use of latest technology and without causing any environmental degradation. About 20,000 Ltrs/Day water will be required





for this project, which will be sourced from the Deogarh Municipality. About 13.21 Acres of land will be utilized for green belt development inside the project. Water sprinkling will be carried out to prevent dust pollution, the generated waste water including leachate will be treated in the Effluent Treatment Plant, the treated water will be recycled and rain water will be harvested. Air, water and noise quality will be regularly monitored by the proponent and the quality will be maintained within prescribed norms. He further mentioned that a detail environment management plan has also been prepared for this project. He also stated that they will always focus on public welfare activities including healthcare facility, education facility, drinking water facility, promotion of sports, socio-economic & peripheral development work. At the end he appealed to the public to extend their support for this project.

The Additional District Magistrate, Deogarh invited the public to offer their views related to the establishment of Common Hazardous Waste Treatment, Storage and Disposal Facility (CHWTSDF) by the M/s Western Integrated Waste management Facility Pvt. Ltd. The views offered by the participants are enclosed as **Annexure-IV**.

The Summary of the Issues raised by the participants in the public hearing in Odia & English (Vernacular language) is enclosed as **Annexure-V (A&B).**

After completion of the deliberation process, the Additional District Magistrate, Deogarh invited the representative of M/s Western Integrated Waste management Facility Pvt. Ltd. to present a brief note on the issues related to the demand and grievances of the local people raised during the public hearing.

Summary of the views of the project proponent on issues raise, by the public in Odia & English (Vernacular language) are enclosed as **Annexure-VI (A&B).** The proponent has also submitted a written assurance during public hearing, which is enclosed as **Annexure-VIII.**

After deliberation of the above and concluding statement by the Additional District Magistrate, Deogarh, Er. Bijay Kumar Bhoi, Asst. Env. Engineer, State Pollution Control Board, Rourkela gave vote of thanks at the end of public hearing.
