

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING IN RESPECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT OF M/S. CHILIKA DISTILLERIES PVT. LTD. FOR PROPOSED 110 KLPD GRAIN BASED DISTILLERY AND 5 MW CO-GENERATION POWER PLANT AT VILLAGE KANAKA, TAHSIL KHALLIKOTE IN GANJAM DISTRICT, HELD ON 23.02.2019 AT. MULTI PURPOSE CYCLONE SHELTER SITUATED IN VILLAGE PANA NUAGAON, DIST. GANJAM, AT : 11.00 A.M**

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At the outset, Sri Mitrasen Majhi, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Berhampur welcomed all the persons assembled in the hearing. He briefed about the EIA notification, 2006 and the objectives of the public hearing. He stated that M/s Chilika Distilleries Pvt. Ltd have proposed to have Environmental Impact Assessment for proposed 110 KLPD grain based distillery and 5 MW Co-Generation Power Plant At-Village Kanaka, Tahsil, Khallikote, in Ganjam District and has applied to obtain Environmental Clearance from the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India and carried out Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Study.


Publicity regarding public hearing was made in the following manner: –

- Advertisements through an Odia Daily “Dharitri” dated 22.01.2019 and an English Daily “The New Indian Express” dated 22.01.2019 regarding the venue, date and time of the public hearing along with the places of availability of Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) report, Executive Summaries (Odia & English) and soft copy in the office of the Collector & Dist. Magistrate, Ganjam, Chatrapur, District Industries Centre(DIC), Ganjam, Chief Executive Officer, Zilla Parishad, Ganjam, Chatrapur, Head Office of the State Pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar, Regional Office of the State Pollution Control Board, Berhampur & Department of Forest & Environment, Govt. of Odisha and also in the website of State Pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar ([www.ospcboard.org](http://www.ospcboard.org)).
- Executive summaries along with paper clippings regarding date, time, and venue of public hearing are made available to the Dimiria Gram Panchayat and Kanaka Gram Panchayat, in the Dist. of Ganjam.
- Further announcements are also made through Mikes regarding Public Hearing for information of the public in the surrounding villages.

The Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Berhampur requested the audience to give their opinions orally, written or in both, based on the Environmental aspects. Then he requested the Additional District Magistrate (Revenue), Ganjam, Chatrapur, Sri Laxmi Kanta Sethi, O.A.S (S) to kindly preside and supervise in the public hearing.

The Additional District Magistrate welcomed the people for attending the hearing with a message to the audience that they should give their comments based on the Environment related aspects only. He briefed about the project and elaborated the objective of conducting public hearing in respect of any project seeking Environmental Clearance from the Govt. of India. Then he asked the representatives of M/s Chilika Distilleries Pvt. Ltd. to brief about the project.

Sri Dillip Kumar Pattnaik, Public Relation Officer of M/s. Chilika Distilleries Pvt. Ltd. presented the salient features of the project, the present status of the environmental conditions, possible impact on the environment due to such activities and the remedial measures to be undertaken by the project proponent to reduce the impact while executing the project in Odia and English language.



He concluded that a suitable Environmental Management Plan has been formulated and will be continuously upgraded to mitigate the impact on the different components of the environment such as Water, Air, Noise & Soil.

The Additional District Magistrate, Ganjam, Chatrapur invited the public to offer their views, objections, opinions, comments and suggestions regarding the proposed project, specifically relating to environmental issues. About 200 persons were present in the public hearing meeting, only 07 nos. of persons signed in the attendance sheet, out of which 05 persons participated in the oral deliberation and signed in the oral deliberator's sheet. 01 no. of written representation was received in the hearing. The attendance sheets, the Deliberator sheets and written representations are enclosed as **Annexure-I, Annexure-II and Annexure-III** respectively.

The statements recorded are as follows.

**1. Sri Subash Chandra Sahu, Kanaka G.P.**

He addressed the chair and the gathering and stated that the Plant will consume huge amount of Ground water; as a result, the Ground water table may be depleted. He expressed his concern regarding the expected pollution which may affect the nearby villages. He further intimated that, the publicity made regarding the public hearing was not adequate and hence another date may be fixed for conducting the public hearing.

**2. Sri Manoj Kumar Gouda, Sarapanch, Dimiria**

He addressed the chair and the audience gathered in the public hearing. He insisted that the publicity made regarding the public hearing was not satisfactory and hence he requested that another date, time and venue may be fixed for conducting the public hearing.

**3. Sri Sudama Nayak, Sarapanch, Kanaka**


He addressed the chair and other dignitaries along with the audience present in the hearing. He said to the audience that they were intimated regarding the public hearing 7 days before the hearing and he also received the copies of the public notice and executive summaries at that time which were displayed in the notice board of the panchayat office. He further added that, even though formal notice was given, mike announcement was not made well before the public hearing. Hence he requested to fix up another suitable date and time for conducting the public hearing. .

**4. Sri J. Narasingh Patro, Pana Nuagaon**

He greeted the audience and the chair and stated that the publicity was not carried out properly. Hence as requested by his previous deliberators and Sarapanchs, he requested that another date may be fixed for the hearing.

**5. Sri H. Madhu Babu, Paryavaran Kryakarta, Visakhapatnam**

He welcomed the chair and the audience and submitted a written representation to the chair. He welcomed the project and contemplated that the company should focus on the local development by generating employment opportunities and he further added that the company should maintain the Ecological balance since most of the areas near the plant are forest areas.



## CONCLUSION:

During the hearing the project proponent addressed the apprehensions raised by the public. Further the Additional District Magistrate, Ganjam, Chatrapur & Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Berhampur also discussed on issues raised by the public.


Sri Mitrasen Majhi, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Berhampur & representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha prepared the summary of the public hearing proceedings accurately reflecting the views and concerns, expressed by the oral deliberators. The minutes of the public hearing were prepared which has been ratified by the Additional District Magistrate, Ganjam, Chatrapur with the views and concerns of the deliberators.
