

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING CONDUCTED ON 07-03-2019 AT 10.30 AM IN TEHSIL OFFICE OF HINDOL IN DHENKANAL DISTRICT, IN RESPECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT OF M/S RUNGTA MINES LIMITED (DHENKANAL STEEL PLANT) FOR 2.85 MTPA CAPACITY AT JHARABANDHA, GALPADA AND TARKABEDA VILLAGES IN DHENKANAL DISTRICT.

Public hearing in respect of Environmental Assessment of M/s Rungta Mines Limited for Dhenkanal Steel Plant for 2.85 MTPA capacity at Jharbandh, Galpada and Tarkabeda villages in Dhenkanal District was held on scheduled date and time at Tehsil office of Hindol in Dhenkanal District.

Sri Purna Chandra Mishra, OAS(S), Additional District Magistrate, Dhenkanal District, supervised and presided over the meeting, assisted by Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Angul as well as representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, SPC Board, Angul welcomed the other panel member and the public, gave an introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notifications 2006 in respect of Environmental assessment of M/S Rungta Mines Limited for Dhenkanal Steel Plant for 2.85 MTPA capacity at Jharbandh, Galpada and Tarkabeda villages in Dhenkanal District.

Sri Gunanidhi Jena, Public Relation Officer of M/S Rungta Mines Ltd of Dhenkal Steel Plant on behalf of the project proponent addressed the committee members and the assembled public and gave a brief description about the proposed project. He also briefed about M/s Rungta Mines Ltd (Dhenkanal Steel Plant) of Dhenkanal. He also briefed about the peripheral development works that had been taken up in this area, and made a presentation about the Environmental Management, Pollution Control Measures, Solid Waste Management of the related project. The copy of the statement of the industry read out at public hearing proceedings is enclosed.

Regarding public hearing of M/s Rungta Mines Ltd (Dhenkal Steel Plant) at Jharbandha, Galpada and Tarkabeda villages of Dhenkanal District was publicized at the office notice Boards of Galpada Gram Panchayat Office, Kantimili Gram Panchayat Office notice Board, at Hindol Tahasil Office Hindol, Zilla Parisad Office, Mahisapat Dhenkanal, Regional Industries Centre, Dhenkanal and local villages of Jharbandha, Galpada and Tarkabeda etc.

Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Angul as well as the representative of the State Pollution Control Board Odisha then invited the public to present their views about the proposed project on environmental consideration.

The views expressed by various speakers are as follows:

1	Sri Rabi Parida, Galapada Village
	He welcomed the gathering of the public hearing and also welcomed the proposed project. He expressed that the proposed project would lead to more development in the area and generation of more employment opportunities for the nearby villagers. He told that villagers are still unemployed today. He also demanded that, the industry should provide local employment as per their educational qualifications. Health check up facilities, educational facility for local children, better employment opportunity and further development activities in the periphery areas should be provided. He supported the project.
2	Sri Antaryami Sahoo, Jharabandha village, Upasabhapati Gramya Committee
	He expressed that the villagers have given land for set up of the industry since 2006-07. Till date the company has not been able to establish the industry. Major land given by Jharabandha village. Simultaneously he stressed that there are many other industries which are operating nearby their village area are not given adequate local employment opportunity. He expressed that the company should be positive and demanded that the company should deploy more local people for employment. He requested that the Mango Trees which are existing inside the proposed industrial premises shall not be disturbed. He also requested to the project proponent for more plantation programme inside the industrial premises. Expecting better employment opportunity and further development activities in the periphery, he supported the project.
3	Sri Baikuntha Kumar Sahoo, Galpada Village
	He appreciated the views expressed by the earlier speakers. He urged that the industry should take more initiative for peripheral development programme with local employment opportunity, better health care facility, Drinking water facility, cleaning of village pond and should fulfill the demands raised by the earlier members. He appreciated the company towards their extensive support to the nearby villages with respect to different peripheral developmental works. Without elaborating in detail he supported the project.
4	Sri Shibanarayan Jena, Tarkabeda Village
	He expressed that regarding public hearing of Dhenkanal Steel Plant of M/s Rungta Mines Limited, the villagers were not informed properly. From the local daily News paper, they could be able to know about public hearing. He mentioned that Dhenkanal Steel Plant of M/s Rungta Mines Limited has signed MOU with the Government during the year 2005-06. Till date the Company has not established their industry and also not provided adequate peripheral development with respect to development of nearby village roads, proper drinking water facility and not cleaned the village ponds. Due to operation of other nearby industries, the local villagers are suffering from Air and Water Pollution. The Company has not provided adequate health care facility for the three local villagers those gave land for set up of the industry. He stressed that industries of Dhenkanal District have not followed with respect to proper local employment. He demanded that the company should take initiative for more local employment opportunity. There should not be any type of Water Pollution in this area as water is more and more valuable. He finally told that he will support the industry subject to there shall be better employment opportunity, health care facility, village road development, plantation, cleaning of village ponds and further development activities in the periphery.

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5	Sri Upendra Behera, RPDAC Member, Tarkabeda Village
	<p>He welcomed the gathering of the public hearing and also welcomed the proposed project of the industry. He expressed that he is a displaced person and gave his land for set up of the industry. He appreciated the company towards their extensive support to the nearby villages with respect to different peripheral developmental works and other so many developmental programmes. So he urged all industry to take more initiative for local employment opportunity, adequate compensation for the displaced persons, better education facility, health care facility and making the greenery within the industrial premises. He also urged to the industry to take some initiative for developmental works of Nimabahali village with respect to road development and drinking water facility. Expecting better employment opportunity and further development activities in the periphery, he made a strong opinion in favour of the proposed project.</p>
6	Sri Samarendra Sahu, Jharabandha village Secretary
	<p>He expressed that his village is situated far away from this venue of public hearing and did not receive any notice or communication regarding public hearing. Public hearing should have been conducted at village panchayat area instead of conducting at this place. He stressed that no other industry has given importance to local people for employment. He expressed that there are so many integrated steel plants operating in an around this three villages. Each and every industry during establishment time told that they will give local employment opportunity and will give attention towards local peripheral development, but after establishment of their industry, they forget the development works and as well as local employment opportunity. Most of the time it is seen the major numbers of employees including officer level are from outside State. He stressed that CSR activities of all the industries in the surrounding area are not adequate. The villagers are facing so many problems with respect to water pollution, air pollution, not able to bathe properly in the village ponds, not getting adequate medical treatment facility. So he finally expressed that he would support the proposed project subject to (i) there should be the provision of local employment opportunity (nearby village) (ii) Health check up facility , (iii) Drinking water facility and (iv) Peripheral development.</p>
7	Sri Nepal Senapati, Tarkabeda Village
	<p>He expressed that the villagers are facing acute drinking water scarcity problem along with not having any pond for bathing. Expecting better employment opportunity, drinking water facility and further development activities in the periphery, he made a strong opinion in favour of the proposed project.</p>
8	Sri Deepak Kumar Behura, Jharbandh Village
	<p>He expressed that they have given land to IDCO authority for setting up of integrated Steel Plant of M/s Rungta Mines Limited at Dhenkanal District. Since 12 year already passed, till date the industry has not completed their construction work. They have given land with a hope that after establishment of the industry, these three villages will be benefitted with respect to all types of developmental works. In this context the villagers also submitted a representation to the Collector and District Magistrate, Dhenkanal District to intervene the matter with the authority of the M/S Rungta Mines Limited. He also mentioned that due to operation of other nearby industries, the local villagers are suffering from air and water pollution. He urged to the Company authority to start the industry as soon as possible so</p>

	that the local villagers will be benefitted. He demanded that the company should take initiative for more local employment opportunity. There should not be any type of water pollution in this area as water is more precious and more valuable. He finally told that he will support the industry subject to there shall be better employment opportunity, health care facility, village road development, plantation and further development activities in the periphery.
9	Sri Chintamani Naik, Galpada Village
	He expressed that due to operation of nearby industries, the villagers are facing so many problems with respect to Water Pollution, Air Pollution. So he finally expressed that he may support the proposed project subject to (i) there should be the provision of adequate Pollution Control Measures in the entire industry, provision of local employment opportunity (nearby village) (ii) Health check up facility , (iii) Drinking water facility and (iv) Peripheral development. He also suggested that the industrial authority shall initiate regular awareness programme with respect to educating the locals towards sustainable development and environmental protection.
10	Sri Sandeep Kumar Pradhan, Tarkabeda Village
	He expressed that the public hearing should conduct within their village. He mentioned that most of the companies are not good with respect to their environmental management, peripheral developmental programmes and CSR activities in the surrounding area. The M/s Rungta Company should grow like M/s NALCO, so the locals will support the industry in all respect. He demanded that the industry shall provide (a) better road infrastructure facility in between industry and the village Tarkabeda, (b) local employment opportunity based on their educational qualification and (c) more CSR activities in the surrounding villages.
11	Sri Bijaya Kumar Panigrahi, Galpada village, RPDAC Member
	He welcomed the public hearing. He expressed that earlier a Palli Sabha has conducted regarding establishment of Dhenkanal Steel Plant of M/s Rungta Mines Limited at these three village area. Till date he has not received the proceedings of the Palli Sabha meeting. He requested to the Public Relation Officer of M/s Rungta Mines Limited to provide a copy of proceedings so that he could be able to know what are the demands raised during Palli Sabha meetings and whether the demands raised in the meeting were fulfilled or not. He expressed that they have given land to IDCO authority for setting up of integrated Steel Plant of M/s Rungta Mines Limited at Dhenkanal District. Since 12 year already passed, till date the industry has not completed their construction work. They have given land with a hope that after establishment of the industry, these three villages will be benefitted with respect to all types of developmental works. As per his knowledge that at present construction work of the industry is going on and they have engaged outsiders in the construction activity. He expressed that due to operation of nearby industries, the villagers are facing so many problems with respect to water pollution, air pollution. He requested to the project proponent to initiate for Industrial Training Centre at this area so that local young generation will be benefitted. He expressed that he is quite sure that M/s Rungta is a vast company and they will follow all type of environmental pollution control norms and CSR activities in this area. He requested to the Additional District Magistrate and District Administration to review during appointment time and ensure that there should be priority for the local employment. He also requested to the Additional District Magistrate to conduct quarterly basis "Jana Samkarka Sibira" for fruitful discussion for solving the local problems.

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12	Sri Gangadhar Das, Kothalu Village
	He appreciated the peripheral developmental work as done in their village by Dhenkanal Steel Plant of M/s Rungta Mines Ltd. He also conveyed his thanks to the company for providing Jaggery from time to time to the village workers. He welcomed the proposed project. He also urged the Company authority that with the industrial activity the industry should provide local employment based on their educational qualification. He also expressed his sincere thanks to Sub-Collector, Hindol of Dhenkanal District for taking initiative in respect to developmental activities in this area. He added that the company should give more attention towards PD development in the area.
13	Sri Sanjay Naik, Galpada Village
	He expressed his happiness towards District Administration for conducting public hearing of Dhenkanal Steel Plant of M/s Rungta Mines Ltd. He appreciated the company towards their extensive support to the villages with respect to different peripheral developmental works. He demanded that those villagers who gave land for establishment of the industry, so the authority should give priority for giving employment benefit to the family members of land owner. Without elaborating anything in detail he supported the project.
14	Sri Manoj Rout, Balisahi, Tarkabeada Village
	He expressed that M/s Rungta Company has provided their extensive support to the nearby villages in respect to drinking water facility and other developmental programme. Without elaborating anything in detail he supported the project.
15	Sri Baruna Behera, Jharabandha Village
	He expressed that M/s Rungta Company has provided their extensive support to the nearby villages in respect to drinking water facility and road infrastructure facility. He demanded that the company should provide local employment opportunity, one Ambulance with health care facility for the villagers. Without elaborating anything in detail he supported the project.
16	Sri Subhash Behera, Tarkabeda Village
	He expressed that he is a displaced person and gave his land for set up of the industry. He urged to all members in this gathering to support M/s Rungta Company for setting up of industry. He expressed his unhappiness towards M/s Rungta for not commissioning of industry though 12 years has already passed. He requested to the company that they should discuss with the local people for any type of developmental works in and around this area. So he urged the company to take more initiative for local employment opportunity, adequate infrastructure facility for the village roads, better education facility and other peripheral developmental works. Expecting better employment opportunity and further development activities in the periphery, he supported the proposed project.
17	Smt. Kalpana Naik, Galpada Village
	She expressed that the proposed project would lead to development in the area. But she mentioned that so many years have already passed they have not commissioned the industry. Till date, the villagers are not engaged in the company. She demanded that the company should deploy more local people for employment.
18	Sri Adikanda Naik, Tarkabeda Village
	He expressed that the Dhenkanal Steel Plant of M/s Rungta Mines Limited may be a good company. The company always wanted to develop this area in all respect. Industrialization

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	is the back bone of any development. He expressed that industrialization will lead to more development of the area with respect to health, wealth, education, peripheral developments etc. He welcomed the public hearing. He demanded that those villagers who gave land for establishment of the industry, so the authority should give priority for giving employment benefit to the family members of land owner. So he finally expressed that he may support the proposed project subject to (i) there should be the provision of local employment opportunity, (ii) Health check up facility, (iii) Drinking water facility and (iv) Village road development, (v) Primary Health Centre facility, (vi) Electrification to the villages and (vii) Other peripheral developmental works.
19	Smt Nabana Naik, Galpada Village
	She demanded that those villagers who gave land for establishment of the industry, so the authority should given priority for giving employment benefit to the family members of land owner. She also demanded that provision shall be made to give pension facility for the Senior citizens. Without elaborating anything in detail she supported the project.
20	Sri Jambeswar Behera, Tarkabeda
	Expecting better employment opportunity, health care facility, development of village roads, cleaning of village ponds and further development activities in the periphery, he supported the proposed project.
21	Smt. Lalita Naik, Galpada village
	She welcomed the integrated steel project. She demanded that regarding employment issue, priority shall be given first for those family members who given land for establishment of industry. She demanded that better health care facility, drinking water supply, better education, better road infrastructure facility shall be provided by the industry.
22	Smt Basanti Sahoo, Naib sarpanch, Galpada village
	She mentioned that earlier one meeting was conducted in their village towards setting up industry and the villagers were raised many demands which has not been fulfilled. She demanded that whatever demands were raised in their meeting shall be fulfilled as soon as possible. She demanded that better health care facility, drinking water supply, better education, better road infrastructure facility shall be provided by the industry.
23	Smt. Kanakalata Sahoo, Galpada village
	She expressed that earlier this area was full of trees. At present due to industrialization, deforestation takes place. She demanded that aforestation programme is highly essential. She demanded that better health care facility, drinking water supply, better education, better road infrastructure facility shall be provided by the industry.
24	Sri Chhakadia Naik, Tarkabeda Village
	He expressed that he is the first man to engage in the Rungta Company as a worker. He requested to M/S Rungta Company to repair and maintain the Tarkabeda village road. Expecting better employment opportunity and further development activities in the periphery, he supported the proposed expansion project.
25	Sri Akshaya Kumar Behera, Galpada Village
	He expressed that he is a land loser person and gave his land for set up of the industry. Till date he has not received any type of help from Rungta company. He welcomed the expansion project. He also urged the Company authority that with the industrial expansion

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	activity the industry should provide local employment based on their educational qualification. He added that the company should give more attention towards PDC development in the area particularly development at Galpada village and plantation programme.
26	Sri Prasanta Kumar Naik, Galpada Village
	He expressed that he gave his land to M/S Rungta Company for set up of the industry. He appreciated the peripheral developmental work (construction of village pond) as done in their village by Dhenkanal Steel Plant of M/S Rungta Mines Ltd. He expressed that there are so many integrated steel plants operating in an around this three villages. After establishment of their industry, they are not doing CSR activities in these areas. Though the industry is organizing health camps in this area but he demanded to provide one Ambulance for the villager's health related emergency time. Expecting better employment opportunity and further development activities in the periphery, he supported the proposed expansion project.
27	Sri Basanta Kumar Behera, Beruanpal village
	He expressed his pleasure towards Rungta Company Ltd. for giving the local employment opportunity. His demands were a) Local employment opportunity, b) Repair and maintenance of nearby village roads c) Adequate pollution control measures and d) More peripheral work.
28	Sri Makadami Pradhan, Tarkabeda Village
	He expressed his displeasure towards Rungta Company Ltd. for not given adequate valuation for his land. He expressed that the company has not taken any initiative for local employment and peripheral developmental works. He stressed that he has given land since last 11 to 12 years but till date the company has not commissioned.
29	Shri Sushanta Dalei, Galapada
	He introducing himself as the secretary of the village parichalana committee. He adored high of the company that no company in the locality has done as much good welfare of the people as has been done in our villages by this company Rungta Mines Limited (Dhenkanal Steel Plant), Dhenkanal. In his conclusion encouraged establishment of the industry so that all round development would take place in all the villages.

At the same time 11 people submitted their written statements before the panel members which are enclosed separately.

Observation:

Generation of local employment opportunity, education, drinking water facility, development of village roads, cleaning of village ponds, pension for senior citizen, adequate air pollution control. Adequate water pollution control, primary health center facility, Ambulance, Industrial Training Centre and aforestation etc. were the most important issues emerged during the discussion.

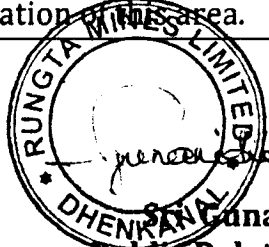

Plantation has already started inside the factory and outside the factory premises Plantation, dust suppression and water pollution control management practices will be complied as per norms of the State Government and as per the provision of Environment Protection Act. 2. Regarding employment issue he expressed that after construction phase, the locals will be given priority in employment and it will be continued. Priority as per eligibility will be given from the land displacement person. 3. Keeping in view of the health and hygiene issue, the company told that they have hired local doctors for health check ups as and when required. 4. Ambulance will be provided to the village within a short time period. 5. Infrastructure facilities has already provided to the nearby village schools and it will be extended in future. 6. The company has already concreted major portion of village roads and in future phase wise more concrete road will be developed. 7. The proponent has already provided drinking water facility to the nearby village and it will be continued to the nearby village in consultation with District Administration.
