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PROCEEDING OF THE PUBLIC HEARING HELD ON 14.02.2019 AT 10.30 AM AT STADIUM FIELD NEAR JAGANNATH MANDIR, BASUNDHARA AREA, TIKILIPARA UNDER HEMGIR BLOCK OF SUNDARGARH DISTRICT, ODISHA OF M/S MAHANADI COALFIELDS LIMITED FOR BASUNDHARA (WEST) EXTENSION OPEN CAST PROJECT FOR COAL PRODUCTION CAPACITY OF 8.75 MTPA OVER LEASE AREA OF 323.92 HA IN BASUNDHARA AREA OF SUNDARGARH DISTRICT.

As scheduled, the public hearing for Basundhara (West) Extension Open Cast Project for coal production capacity of 8.75 MTPA over lease area of 323.92 Ha of M/s Mahanadi Coalfields Limited in Basundhara Area, Hemgir, Sundargarh was conducted at Stadium Field near Jagannath Mandir, Basundhara Area, Tikilipara, Hemgir, Sundargarh on 14.02.2019 at 10.30 AM. Shri Bhaskar Chandra Turuk, OAS (S), Additional District Magistrate, Sundargarh supervised and presided over the Public Hearing Process, assisted by Sri Ripu Kumar Sahu, Assistant Environmental Engineer, State Pollution Control Board, Jharsuguda. The State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar had advertised in Odia daily – The Sambad on 04.01.2019 and in English daily-The New Indian Express on 04.01.2019. The Public Hearing in respect of the above project stated as per the schedule and the venue decided by the District Magistrate in accordance with the EIA Notification S.O.1533(E) dated 14.09.2006 . The officers of MCL and people representatives and public of nearby villages were present. The attendance sheet of the members present in the public hearing is annexed as **Annexure – I** and the attendance sheet of the members delivered their views is annexed as **Annexure – II**.

At the outset of the meeting, Er. R. K. Sahu, AEE, State Pollution Control Board, Jharsuguda welcomed the panel member, the assembled public and the media. Er.R.K.Sahu briefly explained the objective of the proposed coal mining project and procedure followed for conducting such public meeting as per EIA notification No. S.O. 1533 (E) dated 14.09.2006 of the Ministry of Environment & Forests and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), Govt. of India.

ADM, Sundargarh, welcomed the SPCB officials of RO, Jharsuguda and Govt. officials as well as Police personals of Sundargarh district and the villagers of Ratansara and the public of Gopalpur Gram Panchayat for the Public Hearing. He requested the public to maintain peace & come forward one by one to put their views/ opinion for the project. He invited the public to present their views about the proposed project on environmental consideration only.

ADM, Sundargarh advised the Project Proponent to make a brief presentation about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken, for better understanding of the Public.

On behalf of the project proponent Shri P.C.Mishra, Astt. Survey Officer, Basundhara (W) OCP, M/s MCL briefed the Executive Summary of Environmental Impact Assessment /Environmental Management Plan for BASUNDHARA (W) EXTN. Open cast Project to the public. He said that the proposed Basundhara (West) Extension OCP has been formulated within Chaturdhara block in the Gopalpur Sector of Ib-valley coalfield. The Chaturdhara block is located in north-western central part of Ib River coalfield of Odisha, known as Gopalpur sector. The Project Report for

Basundhara (West) Extension OCP (8.75 Mty) has been approved by MCL Board on 28.02.2017. The Mining Plan and Mine Closure Plan of Basundhara (West) Extension OCP (8.75 Mty) has been approved by MoC vide Letter No. 4012/(04)/2011-CPAM dated 22-03-2017. Form-I and Prefeasibility report for Basundhara (West) Extension OCP (8.75 Mty) was discussed in 11th Expert Appraisal Committee (EAC) meeting held on 30-31st May, 2017 and 24th Expert Appraisal Committee (EAC) meeting held on 11th Jan, 2018.

The views expressed by various speakers present in the meeting are as follows:

(1) Smt. Nidrabati Patel, Tiklipara :

She said that she is supporting the public hearing and said that this mine should be opened for the benefit of all.

(2) Smt. Sudharani Raudia, Chairman, Hemgir block :

"Today this public hearing is going on and if you actually go to see, MCL is ruling over this area since last thirty years. Today this public hearing is going on for opening of mines in Gopalpur & Ratansara village, it may please be noted that Gopalpur village is not displaced till now. MCL is still to provide employment to about 200 people of Gopalpur. Where they will be displaced is still unknown. Survey work at Ratansara village has been completed. PAF list for Ratansara village has not been prepared till now. How many will get employment and where they will be rehabilitated it is unknown. No such report is available with us and with MCL. So on what basis this public hearing is being conducted. It is known to you all that 14 villages has been acquired by MCL and in 2010 as per the petition filed by Shri Mathais Oram and considering our problems, the payment of compensation, employment and rehabilitation of 14 villages are going on as per the order of Supreme Court. MCL may please tell, whether they have been able to displace any one village. Supreme Court is telling that before displacement you cannot open any mine. So, on what basis they have come forward for opening of mine and arranged public hearing here. You please go and see the pollution, see the road from Sundargarh to Taparia, if you ask any child what is the colour of leaf, they will say, it is black. All leaves have turned black. The children moving along these roads are unable to tell the actual colour of the leaves. This type of pollution is happening in this area. You please check the water; you find a layer of dust settled above the water. The administration is also supporting MCL in its works. We are thinking that there is no constitution? Those people who were shouting for cancelling of this public hearing, they are my brothers as I am the block chairman and they have sent me to present their opinion and I am putting forth their opinion that until and unless they are rehabilitated, provided with employment and full payment of compensation on account of land till then you cannot open any mines here. And we desire that this public hearing may be cancelled. Therefore, I am requesting the officers from State pollution control board and ADM, you have conducted public hearing not once, not twice but for three times in this area, but why people in this area are angry, because we are facing problems. You are requested to study the problems. Even if we write anything before 15 days to one month then also you are not taking any action. Actually what is happening we do not know. No one is there for us. I wish to state to all of you here, that if you are unable to provide us safety, arrange a rope for all of us to hang. We will happily be giving our life. We have given our land, air and water also we have given. What else can we give to give you peace? You arrange us rope to hang and we will hang on our own. We will end our

life for the sake of development of our area. Hence, this public hearing may be cancelled and this is the opinion of the people of this area".

(3) Ramji Patel, Gopalpur :

"Public hearing should be conducted in our village. MCL has not given employment to PAP (Project Affected People). On 22/08/218 Hon'ble Supreme Court ordered to give the employment by case no 38. We cannot give our land. I oppose the Public hearing".

(4) Danlot Dhurua, Ratnasara of Gopalpur Panchayat:

"Three public hearings held already. MCL has not delivered to the commitment made for 14 villages including Gopalpur. There is no employment provided to our people. I am unhappy by the insensitivity of MCL. MCL widened the road between Tikilipara to Sundargarh by 2009 but the parts up to Ratnasara are yet to be connected. Dust problem is affecting the villagers very badly & MCL is not doing anything about it. We have lost everything in return of helping MCL. MCL should see the works done & facilities given by other PSUs like NTPC. No efforts for resettlement are being done by MCL. I ask you to stop this hearing and I am against this."

(5) Khemesila Majhi, Gopalpur GP:

"Gopalpur village was surveyed, 138 posts are lying vacant for land oustees. All should get employment above 18 years of age. Claims Commission should look after the PAPs but that never happened. It has not acted as per the expectations. Mines extension cannot happen at the cost of well being of the people. People must be rehabilitated completely. New born infants get affected by the pollution & dust emitted by the mines. MCL has not considered about solving the problems of the local people affected by the project. Water pollution and dust are the grave problems for us. No dams are made. I am against this project."

(6) Rajendra Kumar Naik, Ratansara:

"I shall point out the contents of the report. Some laws are not followed till now specially regarding EIA/EEMP.

- Forest Rights Act 2006, Amended on 2012, Act 4- No tribal can be displaced from forest land until they are not given land ownership by Odisha Govt.
- It is mentioned in TOR pg - 17 that 226.62 Ha land is required. 323.92 Ha is total land but they have not got the complete approval.
- EIA/EEMP is not followed properly. EIA report by MCL is erroneous. Chapter 3 in page 88 discusses about noise pollution control. Green belt must be created with adequate tree plantation in core & buffer zones. No tree can be planted in mining area but in the report the authorities have emphasised to plant the trees there only which is completely contradictory.
- According to Chapter 3, page 85, village in core zone Gopalpur & Ratnasara do not have water source. But there are three ponds each in Gopalpur & Ratansara which are used by the inhabitants of the village for their domestic use. According to chapter 11, page 6- Tracks will dispatch coal and by chapter 3, page 88, conveyor belt will transport coal.
- Diseased people may die. Children will become orphans. MCL cannot guarantee anyone's life. Each point must be followed by the organisations and the companies of the government then the people shall automatically be dedicated

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for the projects of MCL. GM has been deceiving the people. There is no dust mask. Healthcare is being neglected. I am fighting for all my people including the employees of MCL. Chapter 3, page 47 discusses on economic upliftment of farmers, small scale cottage industries and local people. But these aspects are not taken into account. Tribals like Bhuyinas, Gonds, Dhanuas, Oras and Khadias will be affected by B(W) Extension Project. EIA/EEMP has not taken these things into account. Page 13 gives Amnesty International Report Annexure II published in 2016.

- Chapter 2, page 14 states that daily 80 trucks pass through Amrokachar village but even a layman can say that at least 100 trucks pass through this road. How can the management be so dumb not to consider it! Public hearing cannot be based on incomplete reports. Public hearing should be made only if the management accept all our conditions. The conditions are stipulated in the B(W)OCP-8.75 MTY EIA/EEMP report. Since the Basundhara East mine project all of us are adversely being affected without getting any benefit from the company. The laws are not followed properly. Regional Officer who was present at the time of previous hearing of Siarmal OCP, has not come here out of fear. All people in the area are affected. The land oustees are not getting employment. 500-600 children could not study for dust. Adivasi Dalits are worst affected. According to PR, B(W) Extension Project affects 1396 people. OB dumps create dust. Roads are not maintained properly. A mother has to walk carrying her infant child in the dusty mine road full of heavy vehicles. Aged and economically weak people who cannot afford a vehicle have to walk several miles on this ill maintained and dangerous road. People going by cars could not feel the pain. Tarpaulins are not used properly to cover the loads which include coal & OB, carried by the trucks. We are taking photos and remaining vigilant of all activities of MCL. Sprinklers, which should spray water to control dust, are not being used properly. Dust can have adverse health impacts not mentioned in the PR. 7m wall should be given in the Sardega Railway Siding. But the walls are not made facilitating illegal coal theft & transport. Plants that are planted are being wiped out by mining operations. No plants are planted in Gopalpur & railway siding thereby violating the guidelines.
- Regarding the land resource conservation, no tree has been planted for this cause. Forest Land Laws are being violated. Land Acquisition Act of 2013 must be followed instead of the old Act of 2006, followed here. No steps for backfilling & reclamation are being taken. Rampant fire is developed in the abandoned mine areas and dumps. Land thereby becomes unsuitable for cultivation.
- Soil in Khamarpada village is experiencing fire. No land is left cultivable. Polluted water is being mixed with Basundhara River. An MCL signboard near Bankibahal chowk clearly admits that the mines ejected water is unsuitable for drinking. Greenbelt is supposed to be created to check pollution but MCL is not taking care of the existing forests. SPCB also states that MCL has not taken adequate measures to curb pollution. The local villagers do not know any technical terms as they are not well versed in English unlike the educated people in MCL. Our children are not going to English medium schools unlike the children of the MCL

employees. People are not getting clean drinking water & they have to beg for it in front of GM Neeraj Kalla. Displace people are only thanked on national holiday like Independence Day and then they are left neglected. GM asks people to give forest clearance in return of providing clean drinking water. He is getting all the luxuries for him & his family only because of the land given by our people. Public hearing cannot be conducted without following the terms to protect the environment. The poor pedestrians who walk up to 5km on the damaged road are the women, old people & economically backward people. No clean oxygen for my mothers & sisters and their small children. This is very saddening. This Public Hearing must be stopped."

The information about Public Hearing was also given through Public address system in all Project affected villages. OSPCB has uploaded the EIA report & executive summary of the proposed project to OSPCB's website.

During the Public Hearing, all have been given an opportunity to express their views on the proposed project. Er. Ripu Kumar Sahu, Assistant Environmental Engineer, Odisha State Pollution Control Board (OSPCB), who is representing OSPCB, recorded the views and concerns expressed, during the Public Hearing. Total 354 nos. of written statements have been received from the public during public hearing are enclosed.

Sri Bhaskar Chandra Turuk, OAS (S), Additional District Magistrate, Sundargarh who has chaired the Public Hearing, ratified the minutes of meeting along with the views and demands of the public hearing.

At the end, Additional District Magistrate, Sundargarh thanked all the person present there including the villagers, public representatives, press and media for smooth conducting the public hearing.

Issues concerning employment	<p>The Hon'ble Claims Commission appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court is looking after the R&R, employment, compensation and other benefits and these works are under progress.</p> <p>Maximum employment has been given in Gopalpur village. 500 employment in Cat-I has been given against 628 approved cases and there are 128 balance. 134 persons have been provided with cash in lieu of employment against approved 168 cases and there are 34 balance. Monetary compensation in Cat-I has been paid to 218 persons out of approved 280 cases and there are 62 balance. Monetary compensation in Cat-III has been paid to 68 persons out of approved 109 cases and there are 41 balance.</p> <p>The balance cases are not pending due to MCL's fault. The cases are pending only for change of nominee and for submission of succession certificate.</p> <p>For village Ratansara, work is under progress and some survey work is left as people have not co-operated.</p>

Issues concerning payment of compensation	<p>The Honourable Claims Commission appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court is looking after the R&R, employment, compensation and other benefits and these works are under progress.</p> <p>In Gopalpur out of 2490 Total Awardees, Compensation has been paid to 2302 Awardees</p>

Issues concerning dust pollution.	<p>The control measures as given in the EIA-EMP report shall be taken up and implemented fully for control of dust pollution.</p> <p>The control measures will be adopted for various operations like drilling operation, blasting operation, loading and transport, coal handling plant, fires at coalfaces and coal stock yard, OB dump(s) and workshop and stores, etc.</p> <p>Suppression of dust by fixed sprinklers in all critical points.</p> <p>All drills will be equipped with dust extractors and wet drilling has been recommended in all drilling operation. Coal production will be done by blast free environmental friendly Surface Miner. Controlled blasting technique will be done in OB benches to minimize generation of dust. All effort will be made to keep Un-metaled roads free of ruts. Covering of coal transportation trucks with tarpaulin at top and bottom. Suppression of dust by fixed sprinklers in Railway sidings, coal stocks etc.. By mobile water tankers on haul road/coal transport road. Provision of adequate fire-fighting arrangement will be there. Greenbelt & plantation in mining area, safety zone area, other places etc. would be taken up.</p> <p>The opinions put before has been worthy and steps would be taken for betterment of the environment.</p>



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
