PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING HELD ON 19.09.2019 (AT 11.00 AM) AT MOUZA- GOBARDHANPUR, G.P- DEOJHAR, P.S-JODA, (PLOT NO. 526, KISSAM-UJJ), FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE IN RESPECT OF M/S. JSW UTKAL STEEL LIMITED FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF AN IRON ORE GRINDING AND DESLIMING PLANT OF 30 MTPA CAPACITY AND 312 KM DISTANCE SLURRY PIPELINE NEAR JODA IN THE DISTRICT OF KEONJHAR, ODISHA.

The public hearing in respect of the project proposed by M/s. JSW Utkal Steel Limited for establishment of an Iron Ore Grinding and Desliming Plant of 30 MTPA capacity and 312 Km distance Slurry Pipeline was held on scheduled date & time at Mouza- Gobardhanpur, G.P- Deojhar, P.S-Joda, Plot No. 526, Kissam-UJJ, in the district of Keonjhar with reference to:

L. EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006 and Amendments thereafter.

The Panel consisted of the following members:

- 1. Dr. Bhakta Charan Pradhan, Additional District Magistrate, Keonjhar
- 2. Shri Puskar Chandra Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar, Odisha

Dr. Bhakta Charan Pradhan, Additional District Magistrate, Keonjhar, supervised & presided over the public hearing process and was assisted by Shri Puskar Chandra Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting, the Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of the project proposed by M/s. JSW Utkal Steel Limited.

Shri Behera explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public, gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public. On behalf of the Project Proponent, Sri Biraja Kinkar Das, Deputy General Manager (Projects) addressed the committee members and assembled public, and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management and various other CSR activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Then Shri Puskar Chandra Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:

1. Sri Chhotray Dash, Gobardhanpur:

Welcoming the panel and gathering, he supported the proposed project of JSW Utkal Steel Ltd. He requested the District Administration and JSW authority to take an early action to set up the project. During his deliberation he requested the project proponent to provide wheel washing facility for the transportation vehicles to maintain clean environment in the road and vicinity. He also requested to maintain healthy environment in the project area and to provide good health and education facility to the locals.

2. Sri Kalicharan Munda, Sialijoda:

While welcoming the panel and gathering, he supported the proposed project of JSW and urged for employment. He also demanded the following facilities for local villagers:

- i. Employment to the eligible candidate of the land loser family directly on permanent basis. Priority should be given to the local people for employment.
- ii. Priority should be given to the local contractors in the project work.
- iii. Provision for old age pension to land looser family.
- iv. Priority should be given to the local people for security guard post.

- v. As per Govt. Rules, permission should be given to the employed labor to form union.
- vi. Employment should be given to local people as per their educational qualification in skilled or unskilled category.
- vii. There should no eviction of Basti & House for the company's benefit in future.
- viii. Natural resources nearer to the factory should be protected.
- ix. Local area development like education, health, communication, drinking water supply agriculture, fish farming, Plantation, Sports, electricity supply, construction of Bathing ghats and other cultural activities under CSR activities.

At the end he also told that they want to sign an agreement with the company authority for the future generation of land losers directly.

3. Sri Kanhu Charan Nayak, Bhagalpur:

While welcoming the proposed project of the JSW, he advised the gathering to welcome the project of the company with a clap. He told that set up of this project should be carried out as early as possible and look towards the development of the people. He demanded on behalf of the villagers and urged that company should give permanent job to the land losers and their successors. Employment should be given to all educated, uneducated, skilled and unskilled youths as per their eligibility. Provision of industrial training and each year employment to the village youth should be provided. Care should be taken for rehabilitation of the people who have no land, old age and no son. Provision should be given to the SHG groups, Seva Trust and Yuvak Sangha of each village for self-dependent. He demanded some development work like Medical facility, education, supply of drinking water, road, electricity connection to the village and over bridge/fly over near the railway crossing in the way from Bileipada to Balita & Baghalpur, Temple & Jatramandap for village.

4. Sri Praffula Chandra Nayak, Bhagalpur:

Welcoming the proposed project, he supported to JSW to setup the factory as soon as possible. He requested that after retirement their children should be provided with job from generation to generation. He also told that one over bridge or under pass should be provided near the railway crossing.

5. Dr. Niladri Bihari Mishra, President, Paribesh Surakhshya Samiti, Joda:

While welcoming the gathering, he told that presently Environment is a prime concern at everywhere and Environment should be understood and known properly. There shall be a provision provided by the project proponent for Air quality monitoring to be done in every month and report shall send to the higher authority though there is more chance of air pollution due to establishment of this factory. He told that proper care should be taken for solid waste management. He demanded for good health and education facility. He also demanded for a 100 -150 bedded hospital wherein local youths should be engaged after giving them training as staff nurse, LT and ANM. He also told that care should be taken towards protection of social and culture of the tribal people under CSR activities of the company. At the end of his deliberation, he supported the proposed project and requested to protect the environment and provide employment to the people.

6. Sri Hemanta Kumar Nayak, Gobardhanpur:

During his deliberation, he intimated about the noise and air pollution of the project and urged for its control measures by the project proponent. He also told that employment should be provided to the poor people of the village.

7. Ms. Champa Lohar, Gobardhanpur:

Welcoming the proposed project she demanded environment protection and development of women. She also told that employment should be given to the educated and uneducated people.

8. Sri Pandav Mahakud, Bhagalpur:

While welcoming the panel and gathering, he told that they lost their land since last 12 years and JSW project should be established over this land. At the end he demanded employment for their children.

9. Sri Sibanath Nayak, Bhagalpur:

Welcoming the panel and gathering, he requested the project proponent to solve their drinking water problem. He demanded that Balita-Bhagalpur road should be repaired. He also demanded that railway crossing gate should be provided near the rail crossing. At the end he welcomed the establishment of JSW plant.

10. Sri Baidhar Naik, Balita:

Welcoming the panel members, he demanded plantation & its proper care. He requested the company authority to give employment to the local youths and keep balance in the environment.

11. Sri Biswanath Singh Khuntia, Lahanda:

Welcoming the panel and gathering, he told that company authority should completely full fill all the commitments as stated in the bylaws of the company. The land looser should be provided with an identity card to give their grievance to the company authority. He requested on behalf of the 5 Gram panchayats and villagers for establishment of school for education, ITI, Diploma and degree college for skill development. All the villages loosing lands should built as a smart village. At the end of his deliberation, he welcomed the company.

12. Sri Sarat Chandra Nayak, Birikala:

Welcoming the panel and gathering, he supported the project of the JSW Utkal Steel Ltd. He told that due to the establishment of this industry there will be availability of permanent employment as well as different development work in the affected villages. He requested to the JSW authority to establish an ITI / Engineering college in land of project affected Gram Panchayat like Birikala, Deojhar, Kandara etc. He told that opportunity should be created for all the untrained members of the land loser family by giving training to them. Financial support should be given to the members of land loser family for higher study. He also told that an ESI hospital should be established in this area and project affected people should be treated here on priority basis. Boundary wall and modernization should be provided to the deity places of the affected villages.

13. Smt. Rebati Nayak, Ward Member, Gobardhanpur:

Welcoming the Panel and gathering, she told that all the villagers should welcome JSW Utkal Steel Ltd. She urged for employment of the poor and uneducated people of that area and establishment of a health centre.

14. Sri Dutta Barik, Nukuda:

Welcoming the gathering, he told that employment opportunity will be created for the people of this area due to establishment of JSW and they are supporting the

proposed project. He requested to OSPCB to take steps for PM₁₀ & PM_{2.5} generation and its control.

15. Sri Mithun Kumar Nayak , Bhagalpur:

Welcoming the panel and gathering, he told that the land was laying barren since 12 -13 years. He welcomed JSW to setup the factory as early as possible.

16. Sri Decpak Khuntia, Kaliabeda:

Welcoming to the panel and gathering, he expressed his happiness towards the establishment of the plant and also made aware that company should be polite towards them. He also told that huge pollution is observed in this area and proper care should be taken towards safety and environment. He also demanded good health care facility, educational institution and employment for local people.

17. Sri Rama Chandra Naik, Bhagalpur:

He welcomed the proposed project of the JSW Utkal Steel Ltd.

18. Smt. Malati Naik, Bhagalpur:

Welcoming to the gathering, she urged to provide card to the land losers and shows positive nodes to JSW.

19. Smt. Pabitra Rani Das, Gobardhanpur:

Welcoming the panel and gathering, she supported JSW Utkal Steel Ltd. to a maximum extent. She requested to JSW to establish a training center at Deojhar G.P from where all youth will be trained before joining the work.

20. Smt. Lakhmi Munda, Sialijoda:

During her deliberation she told that JSW is an international company, so it will be develop the area. She also told that development committee should be formed at GP level to give incentive to the local youths & supervise the development work to be done by the company. She told that local people are much interested for this project which will help their livelihood. He told that focusing on education in the Gram Panchayat is required. There is inadequate infrastructure, teaching staffs in the schools.

21. Sri Bhubanananda Naik, Bhagalpur:

While welcoming to the panel and gathering, he told that maximum land of an area of 90 acres has been acquired from Bhagalpur village, so the villagers of Bhagalpur village should be provided with more employments. He also demanded that land losers should be provided with employment from generation to generation, a railway crossing gate at open railway crossing and Bhagalpur should be the upcoming plant address.

22. Sri Tuna Gope, Kitabeda:

Welcoming to the panel and gathering, he told that JSW is a number one international company. He requested to the administration and company authority to give attention to provide good communication facility, road, education & built an improved hospital for taking care of health. At the end of his deliberation he told that they should extend their support to JSW Utkal for establishment of the plant.

23. Sri Parsuram Naik, Bhagalpur:

He told that job should be given to poor and all people from generation to generation.

24. Smt. Sunita Mishra, Gobardhanpur:

Welcoming to the panel and gathering, she demanded that JSW should construct a new road from satasinga to the level crossing, supply drinking water to them as soon as possible & electricity connection. She also told that they are supporting JSW.

25. Sri Shyamsundar Badra, Lohanda:

Welcoming to the panel and gathering, he told that this area will develop if the company will fulfil all its commitment. He told that there will be good road, school and garden due to establishment of this project. He also demanded that all opportunity should be given first to land losers, secondly to the local peoples and in third to the regional people on priority basis. He also requested to the Govt. and company authority to streamline the same. Lastly, he supported to the project.

26. Smt. Sandhyarani Das, Gobardhanpur:

During her deliberation, she expressed her pleasure for the upcoming project of JSW. She demanded employment to unemployed people, good schooling facility, technical education for their children and good health care facility in their locality. At the end she welcomed the proposed project of JSW.

27. Sri Salman Naik, Bhagalpur:

While welcoming to the panel and gathering, he expressed his happiness for establishment of JSW Utkal Steel Ltd.

28. Smt. Pratima Naik, Gobardhanpur:

During her deliberation, she demanded compensation for losing her land.

29. Sri Bidyadhar Naik, Gobardhanpur:

Welcoming the panel members and gathering, he welcomed the establishment proposal of JSW Utkal Steel Limited and requested the plant authority to provide employment to the local villagers, who have sacrificed their lands for the establishment of the plant. He also requested for provisions of education and bus facility in the village for school children.

30. Smt. Kalpana Das, Gobardhanpur:

Welcoming the panel and the gathering, she expressed her pleasure regarding the establishment of JSW Utkal Steel Plant and requested the JSW authority to provide employment to the locals.

31. Sri Gyan Ranjan Khuntia, Kaliabeda, Lohanda:

Welcoming the panel and gathering, he welcomed the establishment proposal of iron ore grinding and desliming plant of JSW Utkal Steel Ltd. He said that the establishment of the plant will definitely lead to the development of the villagers. He emphasized on basic education, sports and culture. He said that besides the provision of employment, health and construction of road, the company should also focus on basic education as the children are depending on private schools where the education quality are very bad. So, he requested to provide a good quality school for the career development of the children. He also requested to build a sport academy in the village so that the nearby locals of five numbers of Panchayats can get chances for training as per their ability and show their excellence in international level.

32. Smt. Laxmipriya Das, Gobardhanpur:

Welcoming the panel and gathering, she expressed that the villagers have strong faith on JSW and they are very sure that the plant will certainly look after the growth and progress of the village and the villagers regarding employment, construction of road, medical facilities, sports, agriculture & education. So, they

are welcoming the establishment proposal of iron ore grinding and desliming plant of JSW Utkal Steel Ltd.

33. Sri Karmu Naik, Balita Ward Member:

He welcomed the panel and the gathering, and said that he and the villagers have full support towards the establishment proposal of JSW Plant. He also said the villagers are looking forward to be benefited out of it and they are eagerly awaiting for early establishment of the plant.

34. Sri Guru Charan Naik, Bhagalpur:

Welcoming the panel and the gathering, he strongly supported the establishment proposal of JSW plant and said that the villagers are immensely happy as JSW plant is going to be established in their village. He also said that the villagers have utmost belief that the plant will surely bring good development in the village and request JSW to specifically look after the construction of road, railway gate and educational institution.

35. Sri Shukla Lohanhaga, Bileipada:

Welcoming the panel members and gathering, he expressed that the company should provide permanent employment to at least two members of each family who have sacrificed their land for JSW. He also said that company should provide self-employment to the affected Panchayats as well as provision to be made for availability of drinking water, house to house basis electricity supply, free of cost medical facilities, construction of English medium school and roads in the village. He requested the district administration and the plant authority to take combined effort for development of the village.

36. Sri Laxmidhar Munda, Kaliabeda:

Welcoming the panel and the gathering, he said that he has no objection for the establishment proposal of JSW plant only if the company will provide employment to all the earning members of the families who have sacrificed their land for the plant. He also said that the company should keep its commitment whatever expressed before the public during the hearing.

37. Sri Sunil Kumar Naik, Bhagalpur:

He welcomed the panel and the gathering and expressed his support for the proposal of the JSW plant and requested the company to develop a playground in the Bhagalpur village as there is no provision of it. He also requested for provision of bus facilities for the school and college going children of Birkala Panchayat.

38. Smt. Lalita Naik, Bhagalpur:

Welcoming the panel and the gathering, she supported the establishment proposal of JSW Utkal Steel Plant on behalf of SAG group and the women self-help group.

39. Sri Harishchandra Dash, Gobardhanpur:

He supported the establishment proposal of JSW and said that the villagers are looking forward for quick establishment of the plant in the village without making any delay. He requested the plant authority to provide a medical college, an English medium school in the village so that children can stay at their native and study without going outside. He also requested for providing a hospital having operation theatre and other medical facilities so that villagers can get adequate treatment over there without going to Cuttack and Bhubaneswar.

40. Smt Basanti Naik, Balita:

She supported the establishment of the proposed plant and said that people of the village should be responsible and educate them and their children first. Then only they can understand where the actual problem is lying for which they are getting backward.

41. Sri Tiwari Nayak, Bhagalpur:

Welcoming the panel and the gathering, he supported the project proposal of JSW Utkal Steel Ltd and said that the plant should get established as soon as possible.

42. Smt. Chandrika Pradhan, Balita:

While supporting the proposed project, she requested the company to provide bus facilities to the school going children of the village which is situated at the backside of the plant.

43. Sri Mahesh Moharana, Bhagalpur:

Welcoming the panel and the gathering, he said that the villagers are very pleased to have JSW plant in the village. As it is a growing and renowned company, it is well known to everyone that its establishment will surely lead to the development of the village and its periphery. Growth will be noticed in case of employment, construction of road, medical facilities, education, science, sports and in various other aspects. It will not only develop the village, simultaneously it will lead to socio-economic development of the country. He also made the people aware that JSW is going to set up a 20 bedded hospital at Basudevpur even before its establishment. Lastly, he said the plant should get established soon and requested to engage technical people of the village and to provide a playground for sports loving person.

44. Smt. Bali Dash, Gobardhanpur:

Welcoming the panel and the gathering, she supported the establishment proposal of JSW plant and requested the JSW authority to provide drinking water and electricity to the villagers so that people can get rid of snake bites.

45. Sri sanjeev Kumar Jamuda, Bhagalpur:

Welcoming the panel and the gathering, he supported the proposal of JSW Utkal Steel Plant and said that its establishment will definitely lead to the development of the village and the locals will get employment facility.

46. Smt. Surekha Naik, Bhagalpur:

Welcoming the panel and the gathering, she said that the villagers are pleased to welcome JSW to their village. She also said that they are hopeful that the plant will surely fulfill the demand of the villagers which M/s. Crackers India Limited could not do since ten years, which was supposed to be established on the same land that has been taken now by JSW.

47. Sri Kali Charan Behera, Bodohundula:

He welcomed the establishment proposal of JSW and said to the plant and Sarpanch that, only establishing different projects will not help in development of the village, rather it should be implemented practically. He also requested the Regional Officer of State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar to adopt a monthly checking system to the plants and the mines to keep a control on the pollution level.

48. Smt. Ashamani Naik, Gobardhanpur:

She requested JSW to give the details of the land which she has sacrificed for M/s. Crackers India Limited, which is presently owned by JSW.

49. Sri Budharam Munda, Sialijoda:

He supported the project proposal of the JSW plant and requested to provide employment to the families only after verification, who have actually lost their land to the company.

50. Smt. Pinky Dash, Gobardhanpur:

She welcomed the proposal of JSW and said that the plant should get established and shall provide employment to the villagers.

51. Sri Narayan Munda, Sialjoda:

He expressed his grief that the plants and mines are not providing employment to the land losers even after giving assurance during the hearing. He demanded that first JSW shall make an agreement to provide employment to the families and their decedents who have really sacrificed their land to the company and then establish the project in the village.

52. Smt. Tikili Dash, Gobardhanpur:

She supported the establishment proposal of JSW Utkal Steel Plant.

53. Sri Ashok Kumar Naik, Balita:

He supported the proposed project of M/s JSW Utkal Steel Limited and requested the Government to give quickly all clearances so that the plant can get established soon.

54. Smt. Ashamani Das, Gobardhanpur:

She supported the establishment proposal of JSW Utkal Steel Limited.

55. Sri Dayanidhi Patra, Kolohundula:

Welcoming the panel and the gathering, he expressed his unhappiness that even though many projects have been completed in that area but still the poor, illiterates & handicap people of the villages are not paid attention yet. They are still leaving a miserable life. So, he requested the plant authority to look after the problems like supply of drinking water, medical facilities & arrangement of special vehicles for handicap.

56. Sri Nityananda Munda, Bhagalpur:

Welcoming the panel and the gathering, he expressed his pleasure for establishment of JSW in their village. Simultaneously, he requested the plant authority to take adequate steps for the development of the village and its periphery, to provide employment to the locals as per their skills and to provide permanent employment to the family members who have lost their land to JSW.

57. Sri Ramesh Kumar Naik, Gobardhanpur:

Welcoming everybody he supported the proposal of JSW and said that establishment of the project will certainly develop the village and the scope of employment will be opened for the locals.

58. Sri Yudhisthira Behera, Bodohundula:

Welcoming everybody present in the hearing he expressed his displeasure that though there are many industries and mines operating in the area, but still the educated youths are roaming unemployed. Employment opportunities are being provided to outsiders without giving chances to the locals. He also said that even if those are employed under contractual basis, they are being paid a very minimal salary which is not justifying their academicals degree. So, he requested JSW to provide employment to the local engineers, diploma holders, technical persons and graduates on priority basis such that the youths and the villagers will feel more contented.

59. Sri Padma Lochan Naik, Gobardhanpur:

Welcoming the gathering, he explained his dissatisfaction about how the poor people of the village are suffering from poverty till now even though many projects have been established. He also reflected that the locals of Kitabeda, Deojhar and Sialijoda villages are not given any employment opportunities yet who have lost their land to Jindal Steel Limited. He also said that people of the nearby villages have enough faith on the proposed plant and are looking ahead that at least JSW will not repeat the same with the villagers and will provide employment to the locals as well as should look after all the amenities required by the villagers.

60. Sri Manohar Behera, Gobardhanpur:

Welcoming the panel and the gathering, he told that the villagers are happy that JSW plant is going to be established in their village. At the same time he demanded that the company shall develop the village, provide employment to the locals, take adequate steps for construction of road, provide medical facilities, enhancement of sports, agriculture and education should also be taken into account by the company. He also said that even after occupying the land of the poor since long, M/s. Crackers India Limited could not come forward with any kind of development so the villagers have lot of anticipation from JSW. At the end, he supported the proposed project of the Company.

61. Sri Karmu Naik, Bhagalpur:

He expressed his grief regarding M/s Crackers India limited, how the plant could not provide any assistance to the people since long who have lost their land. He also said that the other projects operating in the area should first take steps to look after the need of the villagers which they have not done yet, then only he will support the proposal of JSW.

62. Sri Gautam Barik, Mutuda, Lohanda:

Welcoming the panel and the gathering, he said that as the people have showed their faith on JSW regarding all kinds of developmental work, likewise JSW shall leave no stone unturned to prove themselves before the villagers. He requested the Plant authority for construction of pucca roads to the villages, to take adequate steps to protect the river/streams/nallahs from the surface runoff water of the mines, to reserve the runoff water systematically for further use and to take steps to protect the agricultural field situated in the low lying areas of the mines

from accumulation of surface runoff water. Lastly he supported the establishment proposal of the JSW plant.

63. Sri Kalei Munda, Gobardhanpur:

He said that the company shall produce agreement papers before the villagers who have lost their plant to JSW, so that they can get the benefits.

64. Sri Janardhan Naik, Ex-Sarpanch, Deojhar G.P:

Welcoming the panel and the gathering, he supported the establishment proposal of JSW Plant and requested the Government authorities to issue Environmental clearance to the company as soon as possible.

65. Sri Umar Singh Munda, Chairman, Gobardhanpur UP School:

He supported the proposed project of JSW and requested to renovate the UP school of Gobardhanpur village and to provide every other facilities as required by the school.

66. Sri Bira Nayak, Ex-ZillaParishad, Zone-28:

Welcoming the panel and the gathering, he supported the establishment proposal of JSW plant and requested the plant authority to take steps to maintain the flow of Balita waterfall through the bypass of the village to protect the natural streams, rivers, forest and mountains of Balita and Bhagalpur village and to provide accommodation to the families who have lost their land.

67. Sri Yudhisthir palei, P.S Member, Deojhar G.P:

Welcoming everybody, he thanked the villagers for supporting the proposal of JSW and said that people are extremely happy that JSW is going to be established plant in their village. He also said that new employment opportunities will open up for the villagers by its establishment.

68. Sri Monobodha Behera, Deojhar, Kitabeda:

Welcoming the panel and the gathering, he supported the plant proposal and expressed his pleasure that establishment of JSW will now wide open all types of facilities. Simultaneously, he requested the District Administration for

construction of Joda-Barbil road and Bileipada-Murga road to minimize dust pollution, to provide medical facilities at Joda and Bileipada and to provide good quality schools by utilizing District Mineral Fund.

69. Sri Bagun Munda, Bhagalpur:

He said that all the projects established or going to be established just give fake assurances during public hearing. They promise to provide all sorts of amenities and employment to the villagers who have lost their land but in reality it does not happen.

70. Sri Guru Charan Munda, Sialijoda:

He said that afforestation is an important aspect to protect our mother earth which nobody does. So he requested everybody to plant trees and protect the environment.

71. Smt. Bilasini Naik, Deojhar:

Welcoming the panel and the gathering, she supported the project proposal of JSW and said that the villagers will feel more pleased if the plant will keep its commitment done at the beginning of the public hearing. She also requested the plant authority to make a combined effort with other industries and mines of the area and construct a 100 bedded hospital over there so that people of the nearby five numbers of Panchayats will get benefited out of it.

72. Smt. Irabati Naik, Deojhar:

Welcoming the panel and the gathering, she supported the establishment proposal of JSW Utkal Steel Limited.

73. Sri Sukram Munda, kitabeda, Dadangsahi:

Welcoming everybody, expressed his displeasure that employment is being given under contractual basis and that to under contractors. No opportunities are given to become the employ of the company. Employment is being given to only one member of a family who has lost their land, whereas, decedents were get ridden of that facility. So he requested JSW to look after that.

74. Sri Mangal Munda, Sarpanch, Deojhar G.P:

Welcoming the panel members and the gathering, he supported the proposal of JSW plant and requested the plant authority to keep the faith of the villagers

which they have on JSW. He also requested JSW to provide employment to the family members of the land losers to avoid mass agitation in future. He requested the officials of state Pollution Control Board to form a committee and conduct monthly monitoring to control air pollution and also requested the District administration to utilize the DMF to construct proper roads to minimize dust effluence issues.

75. Sri Jagannath Behera, Kitabeda:

Welcoming everybody, he requested the Government Authorities to issue all type clearances needed for quick establishment of the plant.

76. Sri Daitu Naik, Bhagalpur:

He supported the establishment proposal of the plant, at the same time demanded for employment in the company.

77. Sri Saroj Kumar Naik, Bhagalpur:

He said that employment should be provided to all family members who have lost their land to JSW.

78. Sri Arun Kumar Dash, Gobardhanpur:

He supported the proposal of the plant and showed his pleasure towards the villagers for supporting the proposal. He requested the Plant authority to provide employment to the locals, to provide assistance to the poor and the sufferers, to provide an English medium school at Bileipada and to provide a large hospital in the village, so that poor people will not have to go long distance for treatment purpose.

N.B:- One person delivered his speech after the speaker i.e. at serial no. 15 without registering his name and told that land owners cannot get back their land once it is sold to someone.

The Panel received **345 nos.** of written representations of the local people demanding different facilities in the locality during the hearing which are enclosed herewith in original.



> Employment to local people	Sri Biraja Kinkar Das, Dy General Manager (Projects) of JSW Utkal Ltd committed to give priority to locals in employment. He told that JSW has also planned to develop the employability based skill of the locals. They will also organize vocational training for local boys and girls by which they can become self-dependent.
> Education	He informed the gathering that JSW will provide following support and infrastructure to strengthen educational institutions in the vicinity- 01. Renovation of existing School buildings 02. Electrification in schools (conventional as well as solar system) 03. Establishing toilets in schools 04. Up-gradation of Dinning hall in schools for ensuring Mid-day meal He also told that JSW foundation and NSDL e-Governance have signed an agreement for Corporate scholarship schemes. Scholarship schemes (10-60 thousands) are applicable for higher education for ITI, Diploma, Engineering, agriculture, Nursing, BCA/MCA, Architecture, Archeology and fine arts.

A. Comment

Medical facility

He informed that JSW Utkal Steel Ltd will take utmost care in healthcare and establishing a 20 bedded hospital at Basudevpur village, which will have facilities of general OPD, Delivery facilities, Mini Operation Theater, pediatric etc. so that basic treatment can be given to general public. Construction of a CHC will start soon after taking due approval from Government of Odisha. This will cater the need of about 30 villages under 5 Panchayats of project area. He further informed that JSW Utkal steel is ready to take lead in establishing a 200 bedded hospital in the project area after discussion with Govt. and local Gram Panchayats in this noble cause.

Road and infrastructure

He told that JSW Utkal Steel Ltd will establish village roads and railway crossing/flyover wherever required after taking necessary approvals from Govt of Odisha and concerned Gram Panchayat. He informed that JSW has also committed to repair the village roads, providing street lights phase wise. This will also ensure road safety and villagers will be benefitted.

Air Pollution Control & Environmental Management

Sri Das committed that JSW Utkal steel Ltd will adopt adequate pollution control measures in the proposed project. He also ensured that there will be no adverse impact on environment by adopting following measures —

- 01. In the proposed project, wet process will be adopted hence there is no much emissions from the process area. Dust suppression system will be provided at raw material feeding & transfer points and on road for control of fugitive dust emission.
- 02. Solid waste management by installing paste thickener and storing slime in lined slime storage area as per applicable statutory guidelines. In this regard research & development work is in progress to enhance the probability of reusing slime in cement/ brick etc manufacturing.
- 03. Installation of environmental quality monitoring systems and monitoring data will be displayed adjacent to the main gate of the plant for public view.
- 04. Noise pollution will be controlled by using noise free equipment/machineries, vibrating dampers and developing greenery in the plant.

A. ...

- 05.33% of the plant area will be developed as green coverage and about 80,000 tree saplings will be planted. In addition, they will also promote orchard development in village and Panchayat areas. They will maintain clean, green, safe and healthy work environment in the plant.
- 06. Rain water harvesting in plant to conserve water by recharging ground water.
- Supply of drinking water

Sri Das committed that JSW will install RO plant in the peripheral village of the project area to solve the drinking water problem.

> Sports promotion

He told that JSW will establish sports facilities and support sports talent and youth clubs. They will also trained to the local youth and select talent to access high class training, world class facilities and regular exposure to international tournaments. He also told that Company will develop sports ground after consultation with local Sarpanch if they will identify land in this regard.

CSR Activities

 (Women
 empowerment &
 Culture promotional activities)

He told that JSW Utkal Steel Ltd will take initiatives for women empowerment in the vicinity by taking following measures -

- 01. Initiating Women BPO
- 02. Establishing Self Help groups

By implementing these schemes there will be lots of entrepreneurship opportunities to local ladies. He also committed to support local public in conservation and promotion of local culture.

At the end he extended thanks to the public for supporting the proposed project of JSW Utkal Steel Ltd.
