

**Proceedings of the Public Hearing meeting of Raikela Iron Ore Mines of M/s Geetarani Mohanty held on 26<sup>th</sup> February, 2020 at 11.00 AM at Play field near Geetarani Hutting Project Primary School, Raikela, Block-Koira for enhancement in Iron Ore production from 0.864 Million TPA to 2.99 Million TPA over an area of 67.586 hectares at village Raikela, Tehsil-Koira District-Sundargarh.**

The public hearing of Raikela Iron Ore Mines of M/s Geetarani Mohanty for enhancement in Iron Ore production from 0.864 Million TPA to 2.99 Million TPA over an area of 67.586 hectares at village Raikela, Tehsil-Koira District-Sundargarh was held on 26<sup>th</sup> February, 2020 at 11.00 AM at Play field near Geetarani Hutting Project Primary School, Raikela.

Shri Nrusingh Ch. Swain, OAS (SAG), Additional District Magistrate, Sundargarh supervised and presided over the meeting along with Sri Hemendra Nath Nayak, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Rourkela, Odisha.

At the outset, Sri Hemendra Nath Nayak, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Rourkela welcomed the public present in the meeting. He briefly described the objective of the public hearing as per the EIA Notification S. O. 1533 (E), dated 14<sup>th</sup> September, 2006 of the Ministry of Environment, Forests & CC, Govt. of India. He informed that, the date, time and venue for conducting the public hearing of Raikela Iron Ore Mines of M/s Geetarani Mohanty for enhancement in Iron Ore production from 0.864 Million TPA to 2.99 Million TPA over an area of 67.586 hectares at village Raikela, Tehsil-Koira District-Sundargarh was advertised in the Odia Daily "The Sambad" and the English Daily, "The Times of India" on 28<sup>th</sup> January, 2020 (**Paper cuttings of the advertisements are enclosed**).

Additional District Magistrate, Sundargarh welcomed the public who were present at the venue for participating in the public hearing and informed about the objective of the public hearing.

On behalf of the Project Proponent, Mr. B. B. Sahoo, GM (Mines) welcomed the dignitaries on the dais and the gathering. He gave a brief introduction and location of the mine. He stated that this proposal is for enhancement of the Iron Ore production from 0.864 Million TPA to 2.99 Million TPA. The total area of the mine is 67.856 Ha. and the Mining Lease is valid up to 01.07.2041. This is an open cast mine and mining will be carried out by Fully Mechanized mode.

Class-III explosive will be used for blasting. Further rock breakers be used for breaking big rocks. Crushers and screens will be used for mineral processing. As per approved mining plan about 2, 03,986 cubic meters OB/Waste will be generated in 2019-20 and 2020-21, out of which about 30% will be utilized for road making and rest quantity will be dumped in the designated dumps. The dumped materials will be ultimately backfilled in the exhausted mining pits and plantation will be undertaken over it. They have undertaken plantation over an area of 2.477 Ha inside the mine. The survival rate is about 50-70 %. About 180 KLD water will be sourced from ground water for mining purpose. The harvested rain water will be used for dust suppression and for plantation. Power requirement is sourced from the State Grid and in addition to this 300 KVA generator will be established for power backup. About 200 numbers of manpower will have direct employment opportunity and about 300 numbers of manpower will have in-direct employment opportunity for mining activity. Priority will be given to local public during employment. The air pollution will be marginally increased due to enhancement of production; however it will be within the prescribed standard. Check dam and retaining wall will be constructed to collect the waste water and collected water will be re-used.

The Additional District Magistrate, Sundargarh invited the public to offer their views related to the enhancement in Iron Ore production of Raikela Iron Ore Mines of M/s Geetarani Mohanty. Most of the public has supported the proposed enhancement in Iron Ore production. The views offered by the participants are enclosed as **Annexure-IV**.

The summary of the issues raised by the participants in the public hearing in Odia & English (Vernacular language) is enclosed as **Annexure-V (A&B)**.

After completion of the deliberation process, the Additional District Magistrate, Sundargarh invited the representative of Raikela Iron Ore Mines of M/s Geetarani Mohanty to present a brief note on the issues related to the demand and grievances of the local people raised during the public hearing.






He extended his support to the public hearing for the proposed expansion proposal of the mines. He also requested to the mine authority for healthcare assistance, education facility, protection of natural streams and nalas, take necessary steps to prevent washout of silts from mines to nearby agricultural fields and local employments to the unemployed youths.
2.	Sri Ranta Munda, Raikela	He welcomed the dignitaries on the dais and gathering. He extended his support to the public hearing and mentioned that due to non-operation of this mine since last 8 years they have face various problems and recently the mine has resumed its operation and they are happy. The villagers are also in support of this mine. He further demanded to mine authority to provide a tractor to the local framers for agricultural purpose, better healthcare facility, education facility and provision of drinking water facility in the locality.
3.	Smt. Sugli Munda, Ward no-5, Raikela	She stated that the mine should continue its operation.
4.	Sri Sudarshan Patra, Raikela	He welcomed the dignitaries on the dais. He extended his support to the public hearing and also stated that his villagers are also supporting this public hearing. He requested to the mine authority to extend same kind of support to the villagers as they have supported during operation of mine prior to

But the mine has provided drinking water facility in the locality by establishment of bore wells and house to house pipe water supply. He further demanded to continue such assistance to the villagers and take-up the pending work in the locality. He also added that there are so many mines are operating in the locality; however none of the mines owners except this mine are directly interacting to the villagers. The owner of this mine belongs to same locality and approaching to the villagers directly to address the developmental issues. He further requested for assistance to the local farmers for development of agriculture and provision of local employment to the unemployed public. At the end he stated that this mine will continue its operation with mutual cooperation from both side.</p>

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

**Summary of the views raised by the public during the Public Hearing meeting of Raikela Iron Ore Mines of M/s Geetarani Mohanty held on 26<sup>th</sup> February, 2020 at 11.00 AM at Play field near Geetarani Hutting Project Primary School, Raikela, Block-Koira for enhancement in Iron Ore production from 0.864 Million TPA to 2.99 Million TPA over an area of 67.586 hectares at village Raikela, Tehsil-Koira District-Sundargarh.**


Most of the people present during the public hearing have supported the proposal of enhancement in Iron Ore production. They have also acknowledged that, this mine has created employment opportunity and undertaken various welfare activities during operational period. At the same time, the major demands/issues raised during the meeting are summarized below:

- 1. Environment protection & Pollution Control:** The public has demanded to take adequate measures for protection of environment.
  - a) Proper surface runoff management to prevent washout of silts along with surface runoff:** The issue of washout of silts from the mines was highlighted and they have demanded for construction of retaining wall, check dam, settling pits to arrest the flow of silts along with surface runoff during rainy season to the nearby natural streams and agricultural land. They have also requested to de-silt the nearby agricultural lands.
  - b) Protection of nearby natural streams:** Most of the public has demanded to take precautionary measures to protect the nearby natural streams.
  - c) Air pollution Control:** Issues of air pollution due to transportation is highlighted and they have demanded to take adequate steps to control it.
  - d) Plantation:** They have also demanded for plantation at vacant land in nearby villages.
- 2. Local Employment:** Most of the people have demanded that the mine should continue to provide employment to both educated and uneducated local public on priority basis in the mine.



- 3. Drinking water:** The public have demanded to provide drinking water facility by construction of bore well facilities in remaining villages along with overhead tanks. They have also requested to undertake proper maintenance of the existing drinking water facility provided by this mine.
- 4. Education:** The public have demanded for appointment of teachers (two numbers) in Bandhal Nodal School, engagement of private tutors for coaching of students and bus facility for school children. They have also demanded for construction of toilets in the nearby schools separately for boys and girls.
- 5. Healthcare facilities:** The people have demanded for additional ambulance facility to shift patients to nearby hospitals in case of emergency as there is only one ambulance provided by the Government for entire Koira Block. They have also highlight that in Koira, Hospital there is no Ultrasound facility; therefore the pregnant women are facing difficulties.
- 6. Peripheral Development:** The public have demanded to continue overall pending peripheral developmental works in the locality. They have specifically demanded for construction of an ANM center in Dengula. They have also requested to assist Swachhata Mission in the locality.
- 7. Skill Development:** The public have raised concern that the locals are only employed as driver, helper, khalasi and security guards in all the mines as they lack required qualification and skill required for higher management jobs. Therefore they have demanded for establishment of Industrial Training School and Diploma School in the locality.
- 8. Livelihood generation:** The public have demanded for financial assistance for the SHG groups and impart training to them for mushroom cultivation & for stitching. They have also requested to take steps for women empowerment in the locality. They have also requested to deploy the machineries and vehicles of local public for mining and allied activities.
- 9. Promotion of Agricultural:** They have demanded to promote agriculture in the locality by providing tractor, good quality seeds and fertilizers to the farmers.

**Summary of the views of the project proponent on issues raised by the public during Public Hearing meeting of Raikela Iron Ore Mines of M/s Geetarani Mohanty held on 26<sup>th</sup> February, 2020 at 11.00 AM at Play field near Geetarani Hutting Project Primary School, Raikela, Block-Koira for enhancement in Iron Ore production from 0.864 Million TPA to 2.99 Million TPA over an area of 67.586 hectares at village Raikela, Tehsil-Koira District-Sundargarh.**

On behalf of the Project Proponent, Mr. B. B. Sahoo, GM (Mines) welcomed the dignitaries on the dais and the gathering. Mr. Sahoo has made the following commitments to the public during the public hearing.

### **1. Environment protection & Pollution Control measures undertaken by the mine:**

**a) Water Pollution Control Measures:** He has stated that, the mine has adopted surface runoff management practices to prevent washout of silts by constructing garland drains, retaining walls and settling pits. Garland drains and settling pits are also de-silted regularly. He further mentioned that rain water harvesting structure is under construction, which will also help ground water recharge. In addition to this they have constructed STP for treatment of domestic waste water and constructed ETP for treatment of waste water generated from the washing of mining machineries and vehicles. Mechanized wheel washing facility is under construction, which will be operational within 15 days. They are also constructing ground water recharge structures for recharging ground water.

**b) Protection of nearby natural streams:** He has assured that they will take necessary steps to protect the natural stream i.e Karo. They will construct boundary wall along this nala for its protection.

**c) Air pollution Control measures:** They have adopted of wet drilling practices, regularly water sprinkling is being carried out over the roads and construction of concrete road from the mine entrance up to 300meters inside the ML area is under construction for control of air pollution.

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**d) Plantation:** The mine has undertaken plantation by procuring indigenous species from Forest Department and they will continue this plantation activity.

**2. Local Employment:** He stated that at present about 80% of total man power engaged in the mine is from local villages such as Raikela, Bandhal, Dengula and Kulla etc. He has assured that, during enhancement of production local public will also be employed in priority basis.

**3. Drinking water:** The mine has provided drinking water facility. The two numbers of defunct bore wells, pumps and pipe water supply were already repaired and made operational at Dengula Village. They will also de-silt the ponds during summer season.

**4. Education:** He has informed that as per demand of the local public they have already appointed two PDC teachers in the school and already provided school bus facility. In addition to this another teacher will be appointed very soon.

**5. Healthcare facilities:** They have already provided one ambulance for villagers. One dispensary has been setup in the mine for primary treatment. The villagers can avail treatment in this dispensary free of cost.

**6. Peripheral Development:** The mine has already undertaken various activities in the nearby villages in consultation with them. He stated that villagers and mine authority are cooperating each other. He has assured that similar cooperation will also be continued in future.

**7. Skill Development:** The mine authority will take steps for skill development of local public.

**8. Livelihood generation:** He has assured that the mine authority will assist financially for mushroom cultivation and dairy cow farming in the locality to the interested persons.

**9. Promotion of Agricultural:** He has assured that the mine authority will de-silt the agricultural lands as per requirement and assist local interested farmers for agriculture.
