


PROCEEDINGS OF PUBLIC CONSULTATION (HEARING) OF M/S SHREE HARI SPONGE PVT. LTD.
HELD ON 16.10.2020 AT MADHUPUR PLAY GROUND IN MADHUR VILLAGE
UNDER KENDRIKELA G.P. & BONAI BLOCK OF SUNDARGARH DIST. (ODISHA)

Public consultation (hearing) of M/s Shree Hari Sponge Pvt. Ltd. was held on 16.10.2020 at 11 am in Madhupur Play Ground of Madhupur village under Kendrikela village and Bonai block of Sundargarh district in the state of Odisha for their application relating environmental clearance on enhancement of production in the existing sponge iron plant. Addl. District Magistrate (ADM), Sundargarh presided over the consultation (hearing) meeting. In the beginning, the Regional Officer, Rourkela of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha explained the villagers on the aspects of consultation (hearing) for environmental clearance under E. I. A. Notification, 2006 and invited M/s Shree Hari Sponge Pvt. Ltd. to address public details of the expansion project and its environmental aspects for their views onward. Sri Satyabraja Mishra, Vice President (Project) of M/s Shree Hari Sponge Pvt. Ltd. and their consultant, M/s Kalyani Laboratories Pvt. Ltd, Bhubaneswar addressed public on the expansion project and its environmental aspects. ADM then invited the public to address their views on environmental aspects of the project. 37 nos. of villagers opined their views as mentioned below. Attendance sheets of villagers present (Annx. I) and addressed views (Annx. II) are annexed.

1.	Sri Narayan Tripathy, Village- Uparpada	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Due to air pollution by the plant, black dust is getting deposited inside the school which is only about 500 meters away from the plant and dust is also deposited in their village. He further anticipated noise pollution from the proposed power plant project.• He alleged that if project will be enhanced then natural drainage pattern of that area will be disturbed and about 150 acres of the agricultural land will be under water logging and about 100 Acres of land will face water scarcity.• About 15 persons have died in the locality due to kidney failure and many more are suffering due to pollution caused by the company. But the company has not financially assisted any of them.

2.	Sri Harish Chandra Ratha, Village- Ghosra	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He concluded that the plant should operate with existing capacity and no expansion shall take place. • He highlighted the problem of air pollution in the locality and its health impact. • He further stated that the industry should restrict discharge of waste water from its premises. • He also emphasized that the prevalence of kidney disease in the locality is due to the company. He demanded an ambulance at the PHC.
3.	Sri Giridhari Tripathy, Village- Uparpada	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Industry is discharging waste water along with sludge to outside and during summer, the animals are dying by drinking this water. • Demanded before the District Administration to postpone the Public Hearing as this may cause spread of Corona virus in the locality. • Due to establishment of this plant, the natural drainage pattern was disrupted leading to problem of water logging and water scarcity in the adjacent agricultural lands. • Due to establishment of 12 sponge iron plants in the locality, they are facing various problems and people are dying due to kidney and other problems like heart attack etc. • He concluded that the supporters should pay the compensation to kidney patients and demanded either to stop the expansion project or to accord their death.
4.	Sri Dillip Kumar Deo, Village- Babu Nuagaon	He demanded for written assurance on employment of local eligible youth and to take sufficient measures to check pollution.
5.	Sri Gajanan Patra, Village- Babu Nuagaon	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Questioned to the plant authorities what steps they have taken in last 14 years after establishment of their plant for welfare of the locality and environment protection. • Alleged that the company has failed to fulfill the commitments made earlier during Gram Sabha at the time of establishment of

		<p>this plant such as the company has not granted financial assistance to meritorious students for education. Further the company has not taken any step for welfare of Babu Nuagan village though they have declared it their adopted village. Also the company has not provided employment to the local people as per their eligibility and engaged experts and technicians from outside areas.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demanded to clarify what steps already been taken and what steps they will take for welfare of the locality in form of written statement before the public and seeks written assurance for permanent employment to eligible local youths. • Highlighted the problem of kidney failure and heart problem in the locality due to polluted drinking water and mentioned that company has not taken any step towards it.
6.	Sri Bhaskar Bramha, Village- Uparpada	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Due to air pollution black dust is getting deposited over their agricultural lands and local inhabitants for which they are suffering from kidney and heart diseases. • Company has not taken any step for welfare of the locality. • Alleged that the company is not providing employment opportunity to the local inhabitants. • At the end, he strongly opposed the proposed expansion project.
7.	Sri Rajendra Kumar Tripathy, Village- Uparpada	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plant is established in their locality with prior permission of villagers and he supported its further expansion. However, the plant authority should control pollution. • Provided more employments to the villagers as compared to the other plants in the locality. However, he demanded that the proposed 302 employment opportunity should only be reserved for local inhabitants and undertake development of nearby school on priority basis.


8.	Sri Kushal Patra, Village- Kendrikela	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Alleged that the company authorities have not taken any step since last 14 years for development of the locality such as healthcare facility, road infrastructure, street light facility and drinking water facility etc. Word no. 12 is very close to the factory and facing several problems. He opined that they are not opposing the expansion but at the same time pollution should be controlled and employment should be given to the local inhabitants.
9.	Sri Balaram Behara, Village- Kendrikela	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Highlighted the issue of pollution in the locality and apprehends that after expansion the level of pollution will also increase. The plant owner should stay at their purchased land in Colony Sahi of Kendikela Village so that they can feel the problem of pollution. The local inhabitants are suffering from various diseases like kidney failure. The three plant authorities there have not yet met treatment cost of Rupees 10.8 Lakh compensation to victims. He seeks clarification from the plant authorities that how many persons among the land losers from his village and his Panchayat are employed in the plant and what periphery developmental works were undertaken by them. He also added that the local club was yet to be renovated by the sponge iron factories though it was agreed and tentative estimate was also made and handed over to them. Supported expansion subjecting to permanent water supply and RO water plant at their village. At the end he stated that NOC was issued by the Gram Panchayat to the plant authorities for 10 years only but now the plant is operating after that.
10.	Sri Prasanna Kumar Das , Village- Uparpada	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Highlighted the issue of air and noise pollution in the locality and demanded to conduct survey to ascertain level of dust deposition in the locality, number of persons affected with respiratory and kidney diseases in last 10 years due to

		<p>operation of these plants etc.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The local school is situated just 300 meters away from the plant and expansion will lead to more noise level in the locality. • Expansion of plant may create depletion of ground water level because more ground water will be drawn by the company and local public will face drinking water problem. • At the end, he opposed the proposed expansion project.
11.	Smt. Sanjukta Bag, Village - Kendrikela	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • She mentioned that the plant authorities are not undertaking road repairing though they are using it. • 3 persons of her village have died due to kidney failure but company has not assisted them, the survived family members are also not employed in the plant. • Her son is also a heart patient but company is not financially assisting them after several requests.
12.	Sri Jagannath Pati, Village- Kendrikala	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School boundary is not repaired instead of repeated requests. • Black smoke causing clothes dirty. • No objection to the expansion proposal if the company undertakes construction of boundary wall at school, provide drinking water facility at school and provide water facility at the toilets of the school.
13.	Sri Arjuna Bhanja, Village- Babu Nuagoan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He expressed that they are land less and Govt. has allocated 2.5 acres of land to them but due to establishment of sponge iron plants adjacent to it, the land is not cultivable. • He requested for employment of his son and old age Madhu pension for him.
14.	Sri Chitranshu Brahma, Village- Uparpada	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The company has failed to undertake any developmental works in the Kendrikela village such as renovation of clubs, schools and appointment of doctors in the Bonai Hospital etc. • Company has not provided employments to the local inhabitants as per their qualification rather outsiders having same qualifications are engaged in the plant. Only few local public are engaged for labour purpose only. • Expansion will further lead to more pollution in the locality and



15.	Sri Himanshu Kumar Patra, Village- Uparbahal	He demanded to control pollution and qualification based permanent employment.
16.	Sri Shashanka Kumar Nanda, Village- Pandurisila	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Growth of industry though lead to development of local people, many times the assurance given by the company representatives are not fulfilled and local public are facing many problems. • Development of industry in parallel with local development and stated no development of industry without local development.
17.	Sri Subrat Kumar Tripathy, Village - Uparpada	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Due to air pollution, black dust is getting deposited in the nearby agricultural lands and cow and other animals are dying while grazing over contaminated land. • Demanded for development of locality and employment to local public. • Company should take prior approval from Palli Sabha and Gram Sabha before implementation of this project. • Demanded qualification based local employment.
18.	Sri Ganesh Mahakud, Village-Babu Nuagoan	He stated that expansion project should be implemented with mutual cooperation between industry and local public for benefit of both parties; people be not affected and black smoke remains under control.
19.	Sri Bhimsen Patra, Village- Alekhpur	He demanded to provide equal facility for entire Kendrikela G.P and not only Kendrikela village and engagement of local persons based on qualifications.
20.	Sri C. Patra, Village-Babu Nuagaon	He demanded for drinking water facility and requested to assist his children as they are land less.
21.	Smt. Minakhi Patra, Village -	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • She mentioned that due to air pollution, black dust is getting deposited everywhere and the plant authorities are neither

	Kendrikela	<p>undertaken road maintenance, nor assisting them financially during festivals and not provided drinking water facility though her village is located adjacent to the plant.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The plant people should stay inside the village and understand to expand the plant.
22.	Sri Pramod Kumar Patra, Village-Babu Nuagoan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He stated that he was earlier working in the plant as contractual labour, but he lost his job during birth of his child when he was unable to attain duty for 15 days. • He expressed for no water supply and electricity to Babu Nuagaon village.
23.	Smt. Sushama Khamari, Village - Kendrikela	<p>She extended her support for the expansion project; however, demanded control of pollution, undertake peripheral developmental work, provide employment to the local people and organize free health camps.</p>
24.	Sri Bhaskar Kisan, Village - Uparpada	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • People are suffering due to pollution and the authorities are not taking any action therefore demanded to control pollution. • Company has not taken any steps for peripheral development yet. Demanded for road infrastructure, drinking water facility, construction of at least three houses per year for poor families, financial assistance for appointment of teachers in the local schools, plantation, street light facility, employment to each household, free health camp with further assistance to treat patients, take steps to prevent kidney failure etc.
25.	Sri Hemanta Patra, Village - Kendrikela	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Admitted that air pollution is an issue in the locality. • Due to establishment of various plants in the locality, the employment opportunity has increased as compared to earlier; people should think in a positive way and support the expansion project. • Demanded for local employment, drinking water facility, monthly health camps etc. • Urges local people to develop their skills so that they can also be engaged in the technical posts. • Regarding kidney disease, he stated that not only this plant is

		responsible but also other plants are equally responsible.
26.	Sri Anirudha Tripathy, Village - Kendrikala	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cautioned that expansion should not be at the cost of local public. He stated that they have approached several times to the local authorities for periphery development but till date all the plants have failed to undertake it in reality. • Demanded to undertake various developmental works in the locality, financially assistance to the kidney patients, renovation of the clubs etc. • Demanded to acquire forest land instead of agricultural land for expansion and if agricultural land will be acquired, then it should be purchased in the market rate and not in the Govt. rate fixed by IDCO. • 100 people have been affected for kidney problem and a single rupee has not been spent for peripheral development.
27.	Sri Manas Kumar Sutar, Village- Uparpada	He extended his support for the expansion project and demanded to undertake overall developmental activities in the locality.
28.	Sri Sushil Kumar Tripathy, Village - Uparpada	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stated that he is not opposing the project but the commitments given are not fulfilled. • He further added that expansion of industry should not destroy the agricultural land because in future, availability of foods will be limited and the industries should be established far away from the cultivable lands.
29.	Sri Baidhar Patra, Village - Babu Nuagoan	He demanded control of pollution, employment of local adopted villagers on priority basis, provide wages as per govt. rule and find out causes of kidney diseases prevalent in the locality etc.



30	Sri Shraban Kumar Patra, Village- Alekhpur	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mentioned that industrialization has developed Bonai and therefore industry should expand. • Stated that to mitigate pollution, plantation should be undertaken with its proper care. • Drinking water facility and local employment be provided.
31.	Sri Rajesh Kumar Das, Village- Kendrikela	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stated that the company should clarify the steps taken by them in last 15 years for development of locality as assured to them first and then think of expansion. • Told that due to expansion, air and noise pollution will increase and it will distrust the study in the nearby school. • Demanded for 70 % of local employment in all the level, financial assistance to the kidney patients, monthly health camps etc.
32.	Sri Kamal Lochan Senapati, Village - Gudhiali	He extended his support for this expansion project with conditions to control pollution, conduct free health camp, employment to the local public as per eligibility on priority basis, financial assistance for education, drinking water facility, development of road infrastructure etc.
33.	Sri Subhendu Sekhar Mishra, Village - Kendrikela	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Questioned to the authority whether it was very essential to conduct public hearing during such Covid Pandemic as the State Assembly and Parliament sessions were postponed. • Requested authorities to inspect the area and assess the pollution level. • Mentioned that due to air pollution, people are suffering from respiratory diseases and kidney problem. • Came to know from this meeting that the industry has not undertaken any step for development of the locality in last 10 years; then how they will fulfill present commitments in future. • He highlighted the issue of poor infrastructure of Anganwadi Centres and failure to fulfill commitments in long run by the plant authorities.
34.	Sri Ugrasen Kisam, Village	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Requested Pollution Control Board authorities to be more vigilant on operational status of ESPs to control pollution.

He demanded to take stringent action against the violators for protection of environment. • Cautioned the authorities that in case of failure, they will demonstrate mass protest.

Sri Panchanan Brahma, Village – Uparpada	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Supported the industry for engagement of local people for 15 years. • Asked for water supply, electricity etc. for the village school. • Expansion shall be followed with development activities and insurance of employees.

The proposed plant will be designed on concept of zero liquid discharge. • No comment • He stated that at present they are drawing ground water for their use with necessary permission. However for expansion, the required water will be drawn from River with intake well. They will also harvest rain water and recharge it for replenishment of ground water level.
