

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING CONDUCTED ON 20.12.2020 AT 11 AM IN TEHSIL OFFICE OF HINDOL IN DHENKANAL DISTRICT, IN RESPECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT OF M/S RUNGTA MINES LTD. FOR DHENKANAL STEEL PLANT FOR ENHANCEMENT OF ITS STEEL MANUFACTURING CAPACITY FROM 3.0 MTPA TO 3.55 MTPA FINISHED STEEL AND POWER PLANT CAPACITY FROM 385 MW TO 695 MW AT VILLAGE JHARBANDH, GALPADA, TARKABEDA, BERUAN PAL, KANIKALU, BENIPATHAR, KADALA AND BADAMUNDA IN THE DISTRICT OF DHENKANAL.

Public hearing in respect of Environmental Assessment of M/s Rungta Mines Ltd. for Dhenkanal Steel Plant for enhancement of its Steel manufacturing capacity from 3.0 MTPA to 3.55 MTPA finished Steel and Power Plant capacity from 385 MW to 695 MW at village Jharbandh, Galpada, Tarkabeda, Beruan Pal, Kanikalu, Benipathar, Kadala and Badamunda in the District of Dhenkanal.

Sri Sashank Sekhar Dash, Additional District Magistrate District- Dhenkanal supervised and presided over the meeting, assisted by Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Angul and the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Angul.

At the outset Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Angul welcome the other panel member and the public, gave a introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notifications -2006 in respect of Environmental Assessment for of M/s Rungta Mines Limited for Dhenkanal Steel Plant for 3.55 MTPA capacity steel along with 695 MW Captive Power Plant at Jharbandh, Galpada and Tarkabeda Beruan Pal, Kanikalu, Benipathar, Kadala and Badamunda villages in Dhenkanal District.

Sri Debabrata Misra, Sr. General Manager (Project) of M/s Rungta Mines Ltd of Dhenkal Steel Plant on behalf of the project proponent addressed the committee members and assembled public and gave a brief description about the proposed project. He also

briefed about the peripheral development work that had been taken up in this area, and informed about the Environmental Management, Pollution Control Measures, Solid Waste Management of the related project. The copy of the statement of the industry read out at public hearing proceedings is enclosed.

Regarding public hearing of M/S Rungta Mines Ltd of Dhenkanal Steel Plant at Jharbandh, Galpada, Tarkabeda, Beruan Pal, Kanikalu, Benipathar, Kadala and Badamunda villages of Dhenkanal District was publicized at the office notice Board of Galpada Gram Panchayat Office, Kantinili Gram Panchayat office notice Board, BDO Office at Hindol, Tahasil Office Hindol, Jilla Parisad Office Dhenkanal and local villages of Jharbandha, Galpada and Tarkabeda etc.


Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Angul & representative of State Pollution Control Board Odisha then invited the public to present their views about the proposed project on environmental consideration.

The views expressed by various speakers are as follows:

1	Sri Ganeswar Sahu, Village- Kadala
	He expressed that his village is situated at about 30 km distance which is far away from this venue of public hearing and due to inadequate vehicle facility, most of the villagers could not able to come here to deliver their views. He mentioned that some persons did not agreed to come this venue because of transportation cost. He told that public hearing should be conducted within the village panchayat area instead of conducting this place. He could not want to say anything about the public hearing. He told that today's meeting may be continued in this place but simultaneously he urged that next meeting shall be conducted at any village adjacent to Dhenkanal Steel plant.
2	Sri Rabi Parida, Village- Galapada
	He welcomed the gathering of the public hearing and also welcomed the proposed expansion project of the industry. He mentioned that local villagers gave land for set up of steel plant. He appreciated the company towards their extensive support to the nearby villages with respect to different peripheral developmental works with respect to drinking water facility, construction of roads, cleaning of village ponds and other so many developmental programmes. So he urged all industry to take more initiative for local employment opportunity, adequate compensation for the displaced persons, better education facility, drinking water facility, health care facility and making the greenery within the industrial premises. He finally requested to the villagers to give more land to Rungta Company for expansion programme.




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

3	<p>Sri Soumya Ranjan Nath</p> <p>He asked the participants of the public hearing meeting that whether villagers gave land to Rungta Company for construction of steel plant or the Rungta Company given land to the villagers. If villagers given lands to Rungta company then any type of meeting shall be conducted within village Panchayat premises. Those villagers are in favour of the industry they may provide land to Rungta Company. He expressed that his village is situated far away from this venue of public hearing and due to inadequate vehicle facility, most of the villagers could not able to come here to deliver their views. He also mentioned that some persons did not agreed to come this venue because of road traffic congestion and there may be road accident. He told that public hearing should be conducted within the village panchayat area instead of conducting this place. He mentioned that he is having 11 to 12 acres of land but he will not provide any land to Rungta Company. He could not want to say anything about the public hearing and demanded that next meeting shall be conducted adjacent to any village of Dhenkanal Steel plant.</p>
4	<p>Sri Prakash Chandra Behera, Village- Galapada</p> <p>He expressed that the villagers given land for set up of the industry since 2006-07. Till date the company has not able to establish the industry. After facing lot of difficulties he presented here to deliver his views about the public hearing. He wrote a letter to Sub Collector, Hindol, about shifting the venue of public hearing place as this venue is far distance from the Rungta Company premises and villagers could not able to come in this place due to far distance from the industry. He also pointed out that another public hearing of Rungta Company has earlier conducted in this venue and they mentioned about the distance of public hearing venue. They requested to conduct public hearing within their village premises. The Sub Collector replied to him that the venue already fixed earlier and communicated to Department and local villagers, so he requested the villagers to come to this place and express their views about the public hearing. Simultaneously, Sub Collector told that any type of next meeting shall be conducted within the village area adjacent to Rungta Company. He expressed that the villagers given land for set up of the industry since 2006-07 with a hope that the villagers will be benefitted with respect to benefit of local employment engagement and generation of revenue for the Government . Till date the company has not able to establish the industry. He stressed that he gave 18 acres of land to Rungta Company and being a MBA qualified person, Rungta Company did not given employment benefit to him. He mentioned that he is having six brothers and all are educated and settled. He demanded to give employment benefit to their entire family members to this company. He told that there are many lands available which is not suitable for cultivation. He also mentioned that there are so many industries are operating surrounding their village and causing pollution. Due to dust pollution he could not able to move freely during night time. He complained to District Collector and Pollution Control Board but no improvement taken place. He</p>



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

	pointed out that during 2006 villagers given land to Company @ Rs. 1,75,000 per acre but during 2013 the land cost become much higher. So he demanded to provide more money towards for the villagers those given land during 2006. Finally he himself and on behalf of villagers concluded that he will not support for the expansion of industry.
5	Sri Jambeswar Behera, Village -Tarkabeda
	He expressed that M/s Rungta Company has provided their extensive support to the nearby villages in respect to drinking water facility and other developmental programme. Without elaborating anything in detail he supported the project.
6	Sri Nagen Pradhan, Village- Tarkabeda
	He supported the views expressed by Sri Prakash Behera. He mentioned that after facing lot of difficulties villagers gathered here to express their valuable views. He asked to the people of the meeting that whether they will agree to provide land for construction of industry or not. He urged to the company to follow strictly industrial policy guideline so that all the nearby villagers will be benefitted. He demanded that the company should take initiative for more local employment opportunity. There should not be any type of outside contractor and local contractors shall be given priority inside the industry. He finally told that he will support the industry subject to there shall be better employment opportunity, health care facility and further development activities in the periphery.
7	Sri Chandrahasya Panigrahi, Village- Beruan Pal
	He expressed that he will provide land to M/s Rungta Company. Without elaborating anything in detail he supported the project.
8	Sri Nata Behera, Village- Kothalu
	He expressed that he is having some land adjacent to Rungta Company boundary wall. Without elaborating anything in detail he requested to take necessary steps for acquire of that land.
9	Sri Biranchi Narayan Behera, Village-Galapada
	He welcomed the gathering of the public hearing and also welcomed the proposed project. He told that public hearing should be conducted within the village panchayat area instead of conducting this place. He expressed that the proposed project would lead to more development in the area and generation of more employment opportunity for the nearby villagers. He told that villagers are still unemployed today. He mentioned that villagers are ready to provide land for construction of industry. He also demanded that, the industry should provide exact valuation of the land cost, local employment as per their educational qualification, adequate pollution control measures and better drinking water facility. Expecting better employment opportunity and further development activities in the periphery, he supported the project.
10	Sri Sanjay Nayak, Village-Galapada
	He appreciated the company towards their extensive support to the nearby villages



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

Simultaneously he requested to the District Administration to verify the CSR developmental works whatever done by Rungta Company. He also mentioned that due to Covid 19 situation, villagers could not able to go outside for earning money and their family members faced lot of problems. At that time Rungta being the neighborhood company engaged themselves in their company and appreciated to Rungta Company. Expecting better employment opportunity and further development activities in the periphery, he made a strong opinion in favour of the proposed project.
11	Sri Santosh Pradhan, Sarpanch, Village- Kadala
	He expressed that most of the company agreed to engage local villagers in their industry during construction phase or during operational stage. But at the time of operation of the industry they did not follow the recruitment of local villagers and maximum outsiders are given priority. He expressed that there are so many ITI completed persons available in their Panchayat area but they are not getting employment opportunity in these industry. So he demanded that the company should take initiative for more local employment opportunity. So he finally expressed that he may supports the proposed project subject to (i) there should be the provision for involvement local ITI completed students (nearby village) (ii) adequate land compensation facility and (iii) Peripheral development.
12	Sri Baikunatha Sahoo , Village- Galapada
	He appreciated the peripheral developmental work as done in their village by Dhenkanal Steel Plant of M/S Rungta Mines Ltd. He also conveys his thanks to the company for engaging maximum workers from the nearby village. He welcomed the proposed project. He also urged the Company authority that with the industrial activity the industry should provide local employment based on their educational qualification. He also expressed his sincere thanks to District Administration of Dhenkanal District for taking initiative in respect to developmental activities in this area. He added that the company should give more attention towards PDC development in the area. His demands were <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Local employment opportunity, b) Repair and maintenance of nearby village roads c) Provision of one Primary Health Centre at Galapada village d) Adequate pollution control measures and e) More peripheral work.

	He appreciated the all-round environmental compliance done by the M/S Rungta Company Ltd. 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

	He appreciated the all-round environmental compliance done by the M/S Rungta Company Ltd. He mentioned that he is having 20 acres of land and agreed to provide the entire land to Rungta Company. He requested the company to engage some family members in their company. Without elaborating anything in detail he supported the expansion proposal of the industry.
15	Sri Prasanta Kumar Naik, Village- Galapada
	He welcomed the gathering of the public hearing and also welcomed the proposed project of the industry. He appreciated the company towards their extensive support to the nearby villages with respect to different peripheral developmental works and other so many developmental CSR programmes. He He expressed that it was his great pleasure that till date no accident happened inside the industry. Companies safety measures is highly appreciable. He mentioned that surrounding village peoples have been working in different metro cities like Mumbai, Kolkata, Chennai and other cties but due to Covid issue all the workers have left their job. But Rungta Company did not removed any employee from their industry. He also mentioned that if the villagers will support the industry, then so many local people will engage inside the industry. He expressed his displeasure towards environmental management of M/s Bhusan Steel Ltd. Expecting better employment opportunity and further development activities in the periphery, he made a strong opinion in favour of the proposed project.
16	Smt. Kalpana Naik, Village- Galapada
	She corroborated the peripheral developmental work as done by the proponent. She also welcomes the proposed expansion project. She appreciated the all-round environmental compliance done by the company. She expressed that Rungta Company has been doing all types of developmental work to the villagers, and conducting different environmental awareness programme. She also mentioned that many persons from a single family may not be necessary for employment benefit in the industry. She demanded to provide more educational help to the children's who may join the same company in future after getting proper education. She supported the proposed project.
17	Sri Chintamani Naik, Village Galpada
	He expressed that he is a well-known painter in this area. He expressed that the proposed expansion project will lead to development in the area and also for locals. He mentioned that he gave his valuable Kisam Gharbari land to industry. He expressed his happiness towards the developmental works done by the Rungta Company. Expecting better employment opportunity and further development activities in the periphery, he supported the project.
18	Sri Pranabandhu Sahu Village, Jharbandha
	He expressed that villagers who gave land to Rungta Company are still poor and not comfortably living. They already utilized the land cost . He requested to engage some

	family members to the company so that they will survive smoothly. He told that the company shall clarify in respect to how many local people given employment benefit to their industry. Without elaborating anything in detail he urged that the company shall give priority for local employment benefit, pension facility to Sr. Citizens and more CSR works in the surrounding villages.
19	Smt. Bini Sahu, Village Jharbandha She also welcomes the proposed expansion project. She appreciated the all-round environmental compliance done by the company. She mentioned that many previous speakers told that why the public hearing could not conducted in their village premises. But she mentioned that there may be more disturbance happened if the public hearing conducted within the village as different village people have different mind set up. She this public hearing venue is appropriate. She finally concluded that they will extend their extensive support to the industry in all respect.
20	Smt. Naban Naik, Village- Galpada She lauded the developmental works taken up by the company and supported the opinion as described by the previous speaker. She expressed that with the industrial activity will lead to all round development in the area. She supported the project.
21	Sri Sanjay Dhar, Village- Galapada She expressed that during the time of inauguration period of industry (Bhumi Puja) she was present at the site. She expressed that with the industrial activity will lead to all round development in the area. She told many persons will give different views that may be in favor of industry or against the industry. It depends on the industry to react it. Without elaborating anything in detail she urged that the company shall give priority for local employment benefit, pension facility to Sr. Citizens, provision of health center and more CSR works in the surrounding villages.
22	Sri Sanjay Dhar, Village- Galapada He expressed that industries, workers, contractors and villagers are busy with their own business. But what is the output. During land acquisition phase every industry assured to the local villagers that they will give first priority to engage the local people in their industry but ultimately the industry failed to comply it thereby disturbances occurred among the villagers against industry. Similarly, during land acquisition phase, Rungta Company assured the villagers that they engage maximum people from the nearby local village. But since 2006, the company has not completed its construction activity and local villagers could not able to engage in the company and facing many problems. after construction phase of the industry did not comply the provision of local employment benefit. He mentioned that there are many people who completed ITI course but till date could not able to get engagement in any industry. He added that the company should give more attention towards PDC development in the area. His demands were a) Local employment opportunity based on their educational qualification, b) Adequate land compensation and


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

24	Sri Mayadhar Pradhan, Village- Tarkabeda He expressed that expansion in industrial activity and production will lead to all round development in the area. 27	Smt. Sabita Naik, Village- Galapada She mentioned that some previous speakers were informed that they gave land to

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

	She supported the views expressed by the previous speakers. She demanded that local employment opportunity, better education facility for the poor children and provision of one health center for nearby village to be initiated by the proponent. She expressed her opinion in favour of the proposed expansion of the project.
29	Sri Antaryami Behera Village- Beruan Pal
	He expressed that M/s Rungta Company has provided their extensive support to the nearby villages in respect to drinking water facility and road infrastructure facility. He demanded that the company should provide local employment opportunity, one Primary Health Center with heath care facility for the villagers. Without elaborating anything in detail he supported the project.
30	Sri Devendra Kumar Nayak, Village- Beunran Pal
	He expressed that most of the previous speakers informed about land encroachment directly by Rungta Company but they does not know that any industry can not directly purchased land from the land owner. Industry acquired land through Government. He also mentioned that the industry has already obtained Environmental Clearance for set up of the industry. This public hearing is only for expansion proposal. He pointed out that very few people were given regular appointment by Bhusan Steel Ltd. Even company has not been paying adequate salary to this type of contractual or labor type employees. Most of the time it is seen the major numbers of employees including officer level are from Bengal and Bihar State. They are not interested for engaging the local people. Bhusan Steel has been creating air and water pollution. He mentioned that he was an employee of Steel Making Shop in M/s Bhusan Steel Ltd and presently he lost his job. The Administration and Pollution is not taking necessary steps towards control of pollution. He urged to the Rungta Company that they should not do this type of practice. Rungta Company shall follow all types of pollution control measures along with more peripheral developmental work.
31	Sri Antaryami Sahoo, Village- Jharabandha
	He asked to the District Administration that why public Hearing is being conducting in Hindol area and why not in their village area. He expressed that the villagers given land for set up of the industry since 2006-07. Till date the company has not able to establish the industry. Major land given by Jharabandha village. Simultaneously he stressed that there are many other industries which are operating nearby their






Till date the Company has not establish their industry doing some peripheral development work with respect to development of nearby village roads and drinking water facility. He will not give any land to Rungta Company. He mentioned that about 10 years passed no RPDAC meeting has been conducted in the District. He expressed that the company should be positive and demanded that the company should deploy more local people for employment. He finally concluded that there should not be any type of encroachment of additional land from Jharbandh village.
32	Sri Shatrughana Pradhan (Secretary), Village- Jharbandha
	He expressed that public hearing shall be conducted within close proximity of the industry and why it is conducted in Hindol area. He mentioned that due to elephanty attack, two person of their village died and elephant also damaged their crops. He expressed that the village committee demanded to clean their village ponds and concreting of road from Tarkabeda village to Jharbandh village. Till date part of road is being concreted. So they demanded to concrete the entire road. He expressed that two days before the village Committee has conducted a meeting and it was decided that the industry should take more initiative for peripheral development programme with immediate local employment opportunity, better health care facility, Drinking water facility, cleaning of village pond and adequate pollution control measures.
33	Sri Sashi Bhusan Samal, Village- Kadala
	He expressed that he is always in support of the industry. He mentioned that the older generation people were mostly depends on agricultural activity and they did not prefer for service. But at present our present generation are educated and not interested in any type of agricultural activity. In future generation people will not also prefer cultivation. They completed different types of education and doing service or business. It is the technological and generation change and we have to accept it. So industry is the only option for local development in all respect. He also mentioned that during 2003 there was a meeting in Kankalu village and he was present at that meeting. It was decided that every villagers will support the industry for construction. He pointed out that some employees of Tata BSL Ltd. are getting only Rs. 3000/-* per month which is not adequate to run his family members. Unless the villagers are not become main contractor of any industry there will not possible of any type of local development. We have to always act that the company belongs to us and we have to develop it. With the help of Government and Company there is possibility of development. We have to make the area clean and develop. Expecting better employment opportunity and further development activities in the periphery, he made a strong opinion in favour of the proposed project.
34	Sri Prakash Dash Village- Jharabandha
	He expressed that the company acquired land during the year 2003 to 2006. It was happened when Smt Usha Padhy was Collector, Dhenkanal. Under her supervision, villagers got land cost upto rupees two lakhs as compensation. Why villagers

The company always wanted to develop this area in all respect. Industrialization is the back bone of any development. He expressed that industrialization will lead to more development of the area with respect to health, wealth, education, peripheral developments etc. He welcomed the public hearing. He demanded that those villagers who gave land for establishment of the industry, so the authority should give priority for giving employment benefit to the family members of land owner.</p>

Dust suppression and water pollution control management practices will be complied as per norms of the State Government and as per the provision of Environment Protection Act. 2. Plantation has already started inside the factory and outside the factory premises. 3. Regarding employment issue he expressed that after construction phase, the locals will be given priority in employment as per their qualification and experience and it will be continued. Priority will be given from the land displacement person. 4. Keeping in view of the health and hygiene issue, the company told that they already appointed one Doctor on contract basis in this area for regular health checkup for the locals on forth night basis. Provision for primary health care facility in a centralized location will be considered in consultation with District Administration. 5. Ambulance is already their at site and will be available to villagers on their call. 6. Infrastructure facilities have already provided to the nearby village schools and it will be extended in future. 7. The company has already concreted major portion of village roads and in future phase wise more concrete road will be developed
