

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING HELD ON 30.12.2020 (AT 11.00 AM) AT KHATA NO.172, PLOT NO. 12, DEOJHAR VILLAGE (NEAR KATAMATI IRON MINE) WITH RESPECT TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FOR EXPANSION OF KATAMATI IRON MINE OF M/S TATA STEEL LIMITED FROM 8 MTPA TO 13.5 MTPA (ROM) WITH TOTAL EXCAVATION OF 15 MTPA ALONG WITH MINERAL BENEFICIATION PLANT OF 4 MTPA IN THE MINING LEASE AREA OF 403.3238 Ha IN DEOJHAR AND THAKURANI VILLAGE OF KEONJHAR DISTRICT FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE.

The public hearing in respect of the project proposed by M/s. Tata Steel Limited for expansion of Katamati Iron Mine from 8 MTPA to 13.5 MTPA (ROM) with total excavation of 15 MTPA along with mineral beneficiation plant of 4 MTPA in the mining lease area of 403.3238 Ha in Deojhar and Thakurani village was held on scheduled date & time at Khata no. 172, Plot No. 12, Deojhar village (Near Katamati Iron Mine) in the district of Keonjhar with reference to:

- I. EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006 and Amendments thereafter.

The Panel consisted of the following members:

1. Dr. Bhakta Charan Pradhan, Additional District Magistrate, Keonjhar
2. Shri Puskar Chandra Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar, Odisha

Dr. Bhakta Charan Pradhan, Additional District Magistrate, Keonjhar, supervised & presided over the public hearing process and was assisted by Shri Puskar Chandra Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting, the Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of the project proposed by Katamati Iron Mine of M/s. Tata Steel Limited.

Shri Behera explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public, gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public. On behalf of the Project Proponent, Sri S.S. Mishra, Sr Manager Mining addressed the committee members and

assembled public, and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management and various other CSR activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Then Shri Puskar Chandra Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:

1. Sri Janardan Naik, Ex.Sarpanch, Deojhar:

While speaking in favour of the expansion project, he said that employment generation and other developmental jobs need to be looked after by the Company.

2. Sri Ramachandra Bobonga, Jamukundia:

While supporting the expansion proposal of the mine, he said that Tata Steel has done a lot in providing drinking water and digging ponds. He expressed that road repairing job has not yet been undertaken. He also requested ADM to look into the matter. He also pointed out that proper recognition to be given to Adivasi Organisation.

3. Smt Jagyaseni K hilar, Sialijoda:

While speaking in favour of the project, she said that Tata Steel is doing adequate plantation activities, check dams are being constructed and the villagers are using that water for agricultural purpose. Through TSRDS, Tata Steel is doing many developmental jobs like provision of Education, Health Care and organising alcohol de-addiction programmes. At the end she supported the proposed project.

4. Sri Birsingh Munda, Thakurani:

He said that while mine owners of this area are extracting ore from the mine, no proper developmental jobs like provision of Education, Health care and employment opportunities for their children are provided by the Company. Though he supported the PH.

5. Sri Pabitra Mohan Barik, Mahadevnesa:

He supported the Project and said that Tata Steel has undertaken many developmental jobs like provision of Drinking Water supply and Electricity, maintenance of road, etc. Further he expected that after the commissioning of the expansion project, company will take up many more developmental jobs in future. He requested the Management that a bus should be provided to the villagers to attend their duty smoothly and safely.

6. Sri Dushmant Barik, Mahadevnesa:

We always support Tata Steel for expansion project. Company is providing drinking water, education, health care facility and employment to the villagers. Through TSRDS, training is

being given to the ladies for mushroom cultivation that has made them self-dependent. He requested Tata Steel for a bridge on kachha rasta at Masuribeda village.

7. Sri Kedarnath Barik, Mahadevnesa:

While speaking in favour of the Expansion project, he requested for an ambulance facility for the villagers and at the same time told that Tata Steel is taking up many developmental jobs.

8. Sri Prafulla Chandra Barik, Mahadevnesa:

While speaking in favour of the Expansion project, he expressed his gratitude as Tata Steel is providing education, health services, good quality seeds, etc. He requested for a technical training centre for the local unemployed which will help them for getting employment.

9. Sri Rasanand Behera, Member Native Voice (Social Environmental Organization) :

He has put forth their views in writing to Regional Officer, Keonjhar. He supported the PH.

10. Sri Manbodha Behera, Kitabeda, Deohjar:

He said that they are lucky enough to have mines around their village. He said that if production is enhanced, the collection of royalty and DMF will increase which will be further utilised for developmental work. Thus, there will be more employment opportunities. He also expressed his views that when a village is developed, the nation will be developed. He supported the proposed expansion of Katamati.

11. Sri Harihar Barik, Thakurani:

He said that almost all the houses in their village have toilets. Check dams and other developmental jobs have been taken up by the company. While supporting the PH, he requested to provide bus services to the children of the locality from Standard 8th to 10th as many times the students are unable to attend the school on time.

12. Smt Udipti Manjari Naik, Thakurani:

She supported the proposed expansion project and mentioned that the reason being is Tata Steel has done various developmental activities since long back. She requested for providing solar lights as they are facing electricity problem.

13. Sri Chandrasekhar Laguri, (Coach, Football Training Centre, Sialjoda):

He spoke in favour of the PH but requested for help for coaching facilities for Under-10 football players.

14. Sri Dilip Kumar Naik, Sarpanch, Anseikala:

He supported the proposed project and mentioned that Tata Steel has provided drinking water facility, deepening of the ponds, mobile health care, education facilities, distribution of scholarship to the students from Standard 7th to 10th, community centre etc. If the proposed expansion is granted then both the skilled and unskilled persons will get employment.

15. Sri Ramachandra Munda, Anseikela GP:

He spoke in favour of the expansion project and expressed that Tata Steel is taking up many developmental jobs like Education, Health care etc. Through RBC, the drops out students are given education and after that the students are admitted in different schools.

16. Smt Madhusmita Ghana, Kitabeda:

She spoke in favour of the proposed project and expressed her support because many developmental works like provision of drinking water, education, health care and SHG group activities have been taken up by the Company and she expects similar help in future also.

17. Smt Mamatamayi Naik, Deojhar:

While supporting the proposed expansion project of the company, she said that mostly Adivasi and poor people are staying in this locality and they need to be provided employment by the Company.

18. Smt Bharati Munda, Jamukundia:

She unconditionally supports the proposed expansion project of Tata Steel Ltd. because Company is taking up many developmental jobs like Tree Plantation, Education, Health and Agriculture etc.

19. Smt Bilasini Naik, Deojhar, Ward no.07:

While supporting the expansion project, she requested Company for providing direct and indirect employment to the local youth of Deojhar.

20. Smt Sumitra Dash, Gobardhanpur, Deojhar G.P:

She supported the proposed project and praised the efforts of Tata Steel for helping out Adivasi students in the field of education. With the joint venture of ASPIRE, Tata Steel and TSRDS, the dropout Adivasi students are given residential bridge course at designated places and finally admitted into Govt school with the help of local administration.

21. Smt Satyabati Naik, Narayanpur:

She expressed her support to the expansion project of the mine and said that Tata Steel has been doing a lot for improving the environment, helping out in cultivation activities by constructing check dams, providing drinking water by digging tube well and open well. Further she requested Tata Steel to create more and more employment opportunities for the local youth.

22. Smt Kasturi Oram, Narayanpur:

She said there is no adverse environmental impact in their village due to mining activities at Katamati. Company is providing Health Care and Education facility to their village. She supported the proposed expansion project of Tata Steel Ltd.

23. Sri Chintamani Behera, Aseinkala:

While speaking in favour of the project proposed by Tata Steel, he requested company for providing a Technical Training Centre at the locality to enhance the skill of the educated youth. Further, he requested for massive tree plantation in the open fields.

24. Srinibas Behera, San Barbil:

She supported the expansion proposal of Katamati iron mine saying that Tata Steel has been doing so many developmental jobs in the area for benefit of public. She also expressed her opinion on establishment of a small scale industry in the area since raw material is produced in this area.

25. Sri Bira Naik, Murgabeda (Ex. Zilla Parishad and Samiti Sabhya) :

He requested Company for creating forests by massive road side plantation & afforestation on unused land. He also requested for making check dams to control surface run off during rain, free medical treatment of the local people, employment of local youths and providing teachers in the schools. He requested to identify the technical qualified youth and provide employment on priority. He further said that 85 villagers residing adjacent to the lease have extended their support to the proposed project. 35 rehabilitated families out of 53 of Chirubera Dam have received their compensation but rest have not yet received as they do not possess the patta and therefore are facing difficulties.

26. Smt Bharti Giri, Joda Block, Zilla Parishad:

She praised Tata Steel for their firm commitment in all aspects and supported the expansion project of Company.

27. Gayatri Naik, Kandra:

She supported the proposed expansion project of Tata Steel Ltd.

28. Sri Basudev Munda, Parjanpur:

He said that due to expansion of mines there will be impact on environment. He mentioned that employment is not the only solution. He requested TSRDS to spread awareness on the use of bio fertilizers which helps the soil to develop pores with the help of earth worm and rain water can percolate. Due to the use of chemical fertiliser, their land is getting hard and the rain water is not able to percolate into the soil surface. The Company is promoting the use of bio compost. At the end he supported the proposed expansion project.

29. Sri Uttam Kumar Naik, Chamakpur:

He said that Tata Steel has been taking up so many developmental works for the education of poor and dropout children through the joint venture of Tata Steel and Aspire & is also organising orientation training programme for the teachers to improve their teaching skills. He supported expansion proposal of mine.

30. Smt Subasini Gope, Birikala:

While supporting the expansion proposal of mine, she requested for the maintenance and improvement of the public roads.

31. Smt Basanti Munda, Kandra:

32. Sri Benu Madhab Naik, Deojhar:

He said that the area around Murga Mahadev Temple is getting polluted and the flow of the natural streams getting reduced. He urged for the development of this sacred place. During his speech, he praised Sir Ratan Tata for his unconditional help to the society during Covid-19. He finally requested for provision of permanent employment. He supported the expansion proposal of company.

33. Sri Giridhari Naik, Kandra, Ex-Chairman, Joda Block:

While supporting the PH, he said that the public of this locality has been supporting Tata Steel since many years. At the same time, he requested the Company for providing direct or indirect employment to the local youth.

34. Sri Rajkishore Mahanta, Kuldum, Deojhar:

He mentioned that expansion of Katamati Iron Mine will directly and indirectly create employment opportunity for local youth. He said that Tata Steel has been doing a lot for the control of air and water pollution. He expressed his hope that Tata Steel will focus on the education, health and employment of local youth in future also. He supported the expansion proposal of the mine.

35. Sri Jaysingh Samad, Narayanpur:

While supporting the expansion proposal of katamati mine, he requested Tata Steel to focus more on afforestation, dust suppression and reduction of soil erosion. He emphasized on plantation of medicinal plants also.

36. Sri Sibananda Naik, Mahadevnesa:

He appreciated Tata Steel for the MANSI project being taken for reduction of mother and child mortality. He requested Company for ambulance facilities for the local villagers. He praised the efforts of the company saying that due to creation of check dams and deep wells, the ground water level is increasing. Hence supported the proposed expansion project of Company.

37. Sri Mangal Munda, Sarpanch, Deojhar GP:

While supporting the expansion proposal of the mine, he appreciated that Tata Steel has been perfect in fulfilling their commitment. While many companies are operating their mines around their village, only Tata Steel has been able to fulfill their commitments. Through TSRDS, many developmental jobs like Education, Health, Agriculture have been taken up by Company.

38. Smt Ratnamani Mahanta:

She supported the proposed project of Tata Steel and said that there is no adverse environmental impact due to mining in Katamati iron mine. She urged the company to provide permanent employment.

39. Smt Indumati Patra, Anseikala:

While supporting the expansion proposal of the mine, she expected that commitment be fulfilled by the Company with respect to Environment aspects.

40. Smt Subhashri Priyadarshini Mohanta, Kuldum:

While supporting the expansion proposal of the mine, she urged the company to fulfill its commitment in controlling the environmental pollution in and around the mine.

41. Sri Tanushree Naik, Ukhunda:



Issues raised by Public	Commitment of the Project Proponent
The issues raised at the public hearing meeting are the following:	Sri Atul Bhatnagar, General Manager (OMQ) of M/s Tata Steel Limited committed to certain issues raised by the public (speakers), details of which is as under:
➤ Employment to local people	The company will give priority to local people in employment. As direct employment opportunities are limited, company will conduct skill development programmes.
➤ Roads maintenance	Sri Bhatnagar informed that Company will take up construction/ maintenance of village roads as per norms and on getting NOC. In addition company along with villagers will discuss the matter with District Administration and request them to construct/ maintain roads using the DMF funds.
➤ Infrastructure development and welfare activities	Beautification at Budha Mahadev temple will be taken up. Developments of community centers are being done by TSRDS. Similar jobs will be taken up as and when required.
➤ Education	Company will take adequate steps for renovation/ construction of classrooms in Dhableshtar high school as per need. Company is already providing Jyoti Fellowship to students and will continue to do so.
➤ Medical Facility	One dispensary each will be established for Deojhar and Anseikela Panchayat. Ambulance facility will be provided for both Deojhar and Anseikela Panchayat so that the villagers get the health facilities at the right time.
➤ Tree plantation in village area	Company will do the afforestation with fruit-bearing trees if the land is provided (large contiguous area of at least 1 acre size) by the villagers. The plantation will be maintained for 2 years by the company post which they will be handed over to the concerned villagers.
➤ Provision of check dams	Check dams, rain water harvesting structures are constructed by the company as per the progressive mine closure plan (PMCP) of approved mining plan to manage the surface run-off. This will be done on a regular and planned basis. Deepening and maintenance of ponds is a regular activity and will continue in future.

➤ Provision of solar lights	He informed that solar light facility would be provided in priority areas as per evaluation.
➤ Support in agriculture practices	Company is providing training, through TSRDS, which is helping to increase the agricultural productivity. This will continue in future also.
➤ Football coaching facilities	He committed that Company will strengthen the football coaching centers at Murgabeda and Siyalijoda.
