

Collieries Company Ltd. for Naini Opencast Coal Mine for production of coal up to 10 MTPA and Coal Washery capacity of 8 MTPA (Peak 9 MTPA) in mine lease area of 912.799 ha at Chhendipada and Mandal village in the district of Angul. Sri Purna Chandra Raj, Senior Personal Officer, of M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. also briefed about the peripheral development work that had been taken up in this area, Environmental Management, Pollution Control Measures, and Solid Waste-Management of the related project. .

Regarding public hearing of M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. at Chhendipada and Mandal village in the district of Angul was publicized at the Office Notice Board of Brahmanbil Gram Panchayat Office, Kukurpeta Gram Panchayat Office, Tahasil Office Chhendipada, Jilla Parisad Office Angul, Block Chairman Office, Chhendipada.

Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Angul & representative of State Pollution Control Board, Angul, Odisha then invited the public to present their views about the proposed project on environmental consideration.

The views expressed by various speakers are as follows:

01	Sri Prashanta Kumar Pradhan, Village:- Karadabahal
	<p>He expressed that on 13th May, 2016, Government released coal mining notification for Naini Opencast Coal Mine of M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. After about three months later, the villagers of Chhendipada, Brahmanbil and Karadabahal came to know from Angul District Collectorate regarding coal mining lease of M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. for Naini Opencast Coal Mine and in this project five mauza like Karadabahal village, Brahmanbil village, Kukurpeta village Thaiposhi village and Chhendipada village will be affected due to proposed coal mining. Subsequently Collector, Angul and Sub-Collector, Angul have conducted meetings of different dates within Karadabahal and Brahmanbil villages regarding coal mining lease of M/S Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. for Naini Opencast Coal Mine and informed the villagers that Karadabahal , Brahmanbil, Thaliposhi and part of jungle within Gopinathpur, Kashidiha, Chhendipada village area will be affected. District Administration requested to the villagers to submit their views regarding M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. for Naini Opencast Coal Mine. He mentioned that the village committee submitted their views to District Administration and mentioned that out of five mauza two villages like Karadabahal and Thaliposhi will be severely affected due to major portion of land acquisition for coal mining. The villagers</p>

	<p>informed Angul Collector that the bench mark value of other coal mining area is much higher than this five mauza and they requested to increase the bench mark value so that the villagers will consider M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. for Naini Opencast Coal Mining. After few months the villagers demanded the valuation of land affected villages may increase with employment benefit to the family members of Thaliposhi and Karadabahal village. The villagers raised 30 demands to M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. and after so many meetings conducted with the villagers it was concluded by M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. that as per Government Rule 2013, 2016 the employment will be finalized in the RPDAC meeting. As on date valuation for lands has been finalized but they have not given any employment facility to the villagers. He mentioned that due to mining activity major portion of land will be occupied by company from Thaliposhi and Karadabahal village. The ground water level may decrease. Most of the village people depends on agriculture and only 5 persons engaged in Government job. Due to mining activity villagers will lose their livelihood and demanded employment facility to each family members. He also mentioned that there will be scarcity of water in this area, so he demanded to the company to make provision of irrigation facility in this area for cultivation. His other demands are:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Provision of drainage facility in Thaliposhi and Karadabahal village. b) Renovation of village ponds. c) Construction of bridge d) Two times of afforestation facility against cutting of trees within Chhendipada jungle e) Adequate pollution control measures.
02	Sri Santanu Kumar Pradhan, Village:- Karadabahal
	<p>He welcomed the public hearing. He expressed that on 12.01.2018 a meeting was conducted in the office chamber of Collector & District Magistrate, Angul in presence of Collector, Sub-Collector, Additional District Magistrate the members of Maa Raktamal Bisthapita Prajaha Jami Sangha, GM and staffs of M/s Singareni Collieries Ltd. There were 30 different demands were raised in the meeting. He mentioned that till date the demands are not fulfilled. Out of 30 demands he mentioned major important demands are mentioned below</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) One pay Rule facility shall be given for displacement, land loser and land affected villagers with permanent employment benefit by the company. Employment shall be considered as per educational qualification and as per law. b) Permanent employment benefit shall be considered to the family members of Karadabahal village those lands are not affected for coal mining. c) 50% of Contract and Sub-contract work within Naini Coal Block shall be considered for Karadabahal and Teliposhi village people. d) The villagers were depends on different activities upon reserved forest,

	<p>cremation ground, Gochar land and ponds but due to displacement and land acquisition process the families will face different problem. So there shall be the provision for alternate area within one km range for cremation facility, Grazing lands for cattle and ponds for bathing. Whatever forest land will require for mining purpose, there will be destruction of trees. So there shall be provision of greeneries covering double land area against effected jungle kism land area.</p> <p>e) Pension facility for about 50 Senior citizens with remuneration of Rs. 10,000/- per month and free health check up facility.</p> <p>f) Advance health check up facility for villagers of Karadabahal and Thaliposhi with a English Medium School for children, supply of drinking water through pipeline, renovation of village temples, community center in both village, Library facility, one mini Stadium and street light facility.</p> <p>g) The name of M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. for Naini Opencast Coal Mine shall be changed and new name shall be given in the name of Goddess "Maa Raktamauli" coal mine.</p> <p>h) The main entrance gate of the proposed mine shall construct towards Thaliposhi village and main approach road shall be constructed through Karadabahal village and it should be mentioned in company's mining plan.</p> <p>i) Job card shall be given to all family members of Thaliposhi and Karadabahal village.</p> <p>He finally told that due to mining activity there may be generation of water and air pollution. He requested to the Company to adopt adequate pollution Control measures to minimize the environmental pollution. He on behalf of Maa Raktamauli Displaced land loser and land affected villagers of Karadabahal and Thaliposhi village expressed that they will support the mining activity if the company will adopt their village in all respect of development. Provision of greeneries covering double land area against effected jungle kism land area which will require for mining purpose.</p>
03	Sri Dilip Kumar Sahoo, Village:-Thaliposhi
	<p>He expressed that he has some demands which are mentioned below.</p> <p>a) Valuation of about Rs. 1 Cr. If the company fulfill their demands they will not make any problem for obtaining Environmental Clearance.</p>
04	Sri Nabin Kumar Motihari, Village:- Karadabahal
	<p>He welcomed the gathering of public hearing. He expressed that due to mining activity by M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. there may be environmental damage in this area. So to save the environment he put some demands which are mentioned below.</p> <p>a) Valuation of about Rs. 1 Cr. 	<p>She expressed that before starting any type of mining activity the displacement issue shall be solved. Young people who completed 18 years of age shall be given permanent employment benefit in M/s Singareni Collieries Ltd. The villagers will give land for mining activity and for which they will not have any land for their future generation. She urged to the Company to make necessary provision for development of future generation.</p>
06	Sri Balkunteswar Pradhan, Village:- Karadabahal
	<p>He expressed that this public hearing is being conducting for Environmental Clearance of M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. for Naini Opencast Coal Mine. Due to proposed coal mining activity different mauza under Karadabahal village, Brahmanbil village, Kukurpeta village Theloposhi village and Chhendipada village may be affected with respect to environmental issues. 	<p>He expressed that due to mining activity the Thaliposhi and Karadabahal village will be affected. He requested that young people who completed 18 years of age shall be given permanent employment benefit in M/s Singareni Collieries Ltd. The villagers will give land for mining activity and for which they will not have any land for their future generation. The company should take adequate pollution control measures. Additional benefit shall be given to poor people of Thaliposhi and Karadabahal village.</p>
08	Smt. Radharani Sahoo, Village:- Karadabahal
	<p>She expressed that her land will be affected due to proposed mining activity. Her demands were mentioned below</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Valuation of about Rs. 1 Cr. 	<p>He expressed that local employment opportunity shall be given most priority. Without elaborating anything in detail he mentioned that the land affected villagers shall be</p>

	given all types of assistance so that they will support mining activity.

Villagers are getting benefit directly and indirectly from the forest resources. This forest has been considered for mining activity, so the jungle must be destroyed and deforestation will occur. He urged to the company to plant more trees two time more as concerned to present forest area to be acquired for mining activity. He also mentioned that due to mining activity there must be the generation of environmental pollution. So he requested to the company to take all types of pollution control measures during mining activity.</p>
11	Sri Ranjan Kumar Pradhan, Karadabahal Village
	<p>He expressed that there are about 300 family exists in Karadabahal village. He mentioned that due to mining activity major portion of land will be occupied by company from Karadhabahal village. Due to mining activity villagers will lose their livelihood and demanded employment facility to each family members who completed 18 years of age. Permanent employment benefit shall be considered to the family members of Karadabahal village those lands are not affected for coal mining. There shall be provision of Pension facility for Senior citizens.</p>
12	Smt. Tapaswini Sahoo, Village:- Thaliposhi
	<p>She expressed that her land will be affected due to proposed mining activity. Her demands were mentioned below</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Boys and girls having above 18 years of age shall be given permanent employment opportunity in Naini Coal mine, Valuation of about Rs. 1 Cr. Per acre of land Land displaced persons shall be given all types of assistance Provision for grazing land for cattle's and Local employment opportunity. <p>Finally she mentioned that if the company fulfills their demands they will not make any problem for mining activity.</p>
13	Smt. Bilashini Bagha, Village:- Karadabahal
	<p>She welcomed the public hearing. Her demands were mentioned below</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> One pay Rule facility shall be given for displacement, land loser and land

14	Sri Lalit Pradhan, Village:- Karadabahal
	<p>He expressed that he belongs to a farmer. He came to know from District Administration that land acquisition will start for coal mining purpose. He mentioned that village committee has raised 30 demands to M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. and if the mine fulfil their demands they will support mini activity.</p>
15	Sri Sudhakar Behera, Village:- Brahmanbil, Sarpanch,
	<p>He welcomed the public hearing. He expressed that M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. has proposed to start coal mining activity for which some of the family of Thaliposhi, Karadabahal and Brahmanbil village will be displaced due to land acquisition. He mentioned that if the mine fulfils their demands they will support mini activity. He also mentioned that about 10 km radius of mining area will be affected due to dust pollution. About 7000 people have been residing in this area out of which 90% people depends on cultivation and rest 10% people are employed. With the mining activity priority shall be given for engaging the local people and there shall also be the peripheral development like development of roads, health check up facility, electrification, better education, local transportation, employment facility to each family members who completed 18 years of age, permanent employment benefit and provision of Pension facility for Senior citizens. He also expressed that during mining activity there may be the deforestation, so the mine authority should take initiative for more aforestation activity in the surrounding area. He expressed that the development of the villagers can happen with the mining activities.</p>
16	Sri Agasti Behera, Village:- Chhendipada
	<p>He expressed that only Karadabahal village people aware about this public hearing. The Chhendipada village people do not received any notification regarding public hearing in this venue. About 1000 acres of forest land will be affected for proposed coal mining project. The villagers of Chhendipada and Brahmanbil village want to speak their views in this public hearing meeting. They should be given opportunity to speak their views. He mentioned that the Barhmanbil and Chhendipada villagers are not against the mining activity as this is a Central Govern and Telangana Government joint venture coal mining project. He mentioned that the Brahmanbil village committee raised some demands to M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. but till date the demands are not fulfilled and for which the Brahmanbil villagers are</p>

opposing the public hearing. He expressed his thanks to the Brahmanbil village committee as they have mentioned demands by covering the all aspect / problems of the village. He expressed that whatever demands raised by the Thaliposhi village to the company and after proper discussion in between village committee and company, the villagers supported the mining activity. He expressed that the company shall start mining subject to fulfil of local village demands. He demanded that the company shall give priority for local employment opportunity and their shall not be any type of employment from outside area particularly from Telangana State. Most of the villagers from Karadabahal , Thaliposhi, Brahmanbil and Chhendipada will be affected due to land acquisition process. About 1000 acres of Jungle Kisam land from Chhendipada village will acquire for mining activity. About 40 acres of land acquisition will take place from Brahmanbil village. Similarly about 400 acres of land acquisition will take place from Karadabahal village. He requested to the CMD of M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. to take necessary steps for fruitful discussion among the villagers of Brahmanbil and Chhendipada to solve the problems. Before starting the coal mining project all the village issues shall be solved properly and there should not be any type of conflict among the villagers. He requested to the Additional District Magistrate (Revenue) that the valuation of Chhendipada village land should be equal with other village lands. He demanded that the employment shall be given directly by M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. Engagement of local people shall not make through contractors. He stressed that about one lakh people will be displaced. All the displaced person should be given adequate compensation by following the Government R & R Policy. The rehabilitation shall be made to the nearest village from the affected area with all types of facility. He expressed his sincere thanks to Central Government for considering this mining project in this area. With the mining activity priority shall be given for engaging the local people and there shall also be the peripheral development like development of roads, health check up facility, electrification, better education, drinking water, local transportation etc. He also expressed that during mining activity there may be the deforestation, so the mine authority should take initiative for more afforestation activity in the surrounding area.

17 Sri Subhash Sahoo, Village:- Karadabahal

He expressed that the families those are not affected in respect to land acquisition process will face so many problem. They will not able to cultivate anything in their land. So he requested that unaffected families shall be given employment opportunity before considering employment benefit to land affected families. Their salary shall be more than one lakh per month. This forest has been considered for mining activity, so the jungle must be destroyed and deforestation will occur. He urged to the company to plant more trees two times more as concerned to present forest area to be acquired for mining activity. Boys and girls having above 18 years of age shall be given permanent employment opportunity. He also mentioned that due to mining activity there must be the generation of environmental pollution. So he requested to the company to take all types of pollution control measures during mining activity.

19	<p>Sri Prafulla Kumar Sahoo, President, Village:-Brahmanbil,</p> <p>He expressed that State Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Angul communicated letter to the Sarpanch of Brahmanbil Gram Panchayat office one month before conducting the public hearing but the President and Secretary of Brahmanbil village did not aware about public hearing of M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. Later on dtd. 14.01.2021 the public hearing of M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. had informed to the villagers through announcement of loud speakers and then the Brahmanbil villagers could able to know about propose Singareni Collieries Project. He told that the Brahmanbil village Committee had conducted many meetings with officials of M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. and demanded to fulfil 17 points. Till date the Company provided 10 deep bore well to different places of Brahmanbil village but till date other demands are not fulfilled. The 17 demands which the Brahmanbil village committee raised are mentioned below.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Digging of kachha pond/two ten inch bore well for reserving all rain water in the pond. b) Construction of road from Baramunda to Maa Dakeswari temple c) Construction of Maa Dakeswari temple, boundary wall, bore well, park and beautification, d) Four gates one each at North, South, East and West direction for approach the villagers to Naini Coal Block, e) Construction of boundary wall, electrification and lights of the village Dola fair ground, f) Construction of Radha Krushna Temple (two storied) with 3000 sq. feet coverage area, g) Aid to Baral Balunkeswar Ananta Mahadev Temple, h) Construction of all the village ponds in Brahmanbil village, i) Construction of drains at both sides of the road of Brahmanbil village, j) Construction of Brahmanbil village High School play ground,

	<p>k) Creation of fund of Rs. 1.5 crore to encourage the poor tenanted students, l) Provision of drinking water for the villagers throughout the year, m) Construction of meeting hall, dining hall and cycle stand on Jambusahi Primary School, Brahmanbil Upper Primary School and High School, n) Electrification to whole villagers, o) Construction of 14 number of Kothaghar in each habitant of the village, p) Construction of Jhumpuli Pitha, q) Provision of funds for the development of village in the name of President / Secretary of Brahmanbil village. There shall be no third party/Government/Semi Government/voluntary organization to interfere in this regard.</p> <p>He also expressed that the Brahmanbil villagers are completely depends on cultivation. The company has not been discussed properly about the employment policy, resettlement and rehabilitation problems. He finally requested to the District Administration and Pollution Control Board to take initiative for solving the problems of village Brahmanbil.</p>
20	Sri Ashok Kumar Pradhan, Chairman, Village:- Chhendipada
	<p>He supported the views expressed by previous speaker. He expressed that most of demands already expressed by the previous speakers. He stressed that most of the time different companies agreed to fulfill the villagers demands but after few days / month the companies forget to fulfill the villagers demand. As an example of GAIL India, M/s JSPL etc. Villagers of Chhendipada submitted raised demands but till date no demands has been fulfilled. He also mentioned that this public hearing meant for environmental issues and due to mining activity villagers will be affected directly or indirectly. He requested to the District Administration to intervene the above issues raised by the Chhendipada and Brahmanbil village committee and shall take necessary steps to solve the problem after discussion with the Singerani Company and village committee.</p>

So he mentioned that Government should think in this respect and take immediate steps to resettlement and rehabilitation, employment facility of the villagers, alternate arrangement for drinking water, road infrastructure and other necessary developments. He appreciated the views expressed by Sri Agasti Behera, Chhendipada Village and Sri Ashok Kumar Pradhan, Chairman, Chhendipada. His demands are mentioned below.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Based on educational qualification permanent employment benefit by the company to boys and girls. b) Digging of kachha pond with four bore well for rainwater harvesting purpose. c) Construction of road from Baramunda to Maa Dakeswari temple d) Construction of Maa Dakeswari temple, boundary wall, bore well, park and beautification, e) Four gates one each at North, South, East and West direction for approach the villagers to Naini Coal Block, f) Construction of boundary wall, electrification and lights of the village Dola fair ground, g) Construction of Radha Krushna Temple (two storied) with 3000 sq. feet coverage area, h) Aid to Baral Balunkeswar Ananta Mahadev Temple, i) Construction of all the village ponds in Brahmanbil village, j) Construction of drains at both sides of the road of Brahmanbil village, k) Construction of Brahmanbil village High School play ground, l) Scholarship facility for the poor students, m) Provision of drinking water for the villagers throughout the year, n) Construction of meeting hall, dining hall and cycle stand on Jambusahi Primary School, Brahmanbil Upper Primary School and High School, o) Electrification to whole villagers, p) Construction of 14 number of Kothaghar in each habitant of the village, q) Construction of Jhumpuli pitha, r) Provision of funds for the development of village in the name of President / Secretary of Brahmanbil village. There shall be no third party/Government/Semi Government/voluntary organization to interfere in this regard. <p>He finally expressed that he did not oppose public hearing but he requested to the District Administration, Regional Singerani Company CMD and Pollution Control Board to take initiative for solving the problems of village Brahmanbil.</p>
23	Sri Kesabananda Sahoo, Village:- Brahmanbil
	He expressed that the Brahmanbil villagers submitted 17 different demands to M/s Singerani Company Ltd. Till date the company has fulfilled only one demand <i>i. e.</i> they

	<p>have provided 10 number of deep bore well to different locations of Brahmanbil village. He expressed that State Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Angul communicated letter to the Sarpanch of Brahmanbil Gram Panchayat office one month before conducting the public hearing but the President and Secretary of Brahmanbil village did not aware about public hearing of M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. Later on dtd. 14.01.2021 the public hearing of M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. had informed to the villagers through announcement of loud speakers and then the Brahmanbil villagers could able to know about propose Singareni Collieries Project. He told that the Brahmanbil village Committee had conducted many meetings with officials of M/s Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. and demanded to fulfil 17 points. He mentioned that about 90% people are completely depends on cultivation. He requested to the district Administration to conduct public hearing in another date after consultation with all the villagers of 10 km radius.</p>
24	<p>Sri Chandra Sekhar Pradhan, Village:- Brahmanbil</p> <p>He welcomed the public hearing. His demands were mentioned below</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Valuation of land of about Rs. 1 Cr. Per acre of land b) One pay Rule facility shall be given for displacement, land loser and land affected villagers with permanent employment benefit by the company those are completed 18 years of age. c) Employment shall be considered based on educational qualification, Minimum salary shall be about 45000/- per month d) Better drinking water facility e) Renumeration of Rs. 50 lakh one time to the family members those will not be considered for employment. f) Pension facility for about 50 Senior citizens with renumeration of Rs. 10,000/- per month and free health check up facility. g) Ambulance facility h) Maintenance of village temples and village roads i) Provision of ITI center j) Mining shall not start before finalize the recruitment process. k) Displaced family shall be given 20 Decimal of land with provision of 2000 sq feet home and land patta shall be given. l) In the rehabilitation area there shall be provision of road connectivity, street light, drinking water, education, free health checkup, Club, Post Office, Anganwadi, pond, Park, Puja Mandap. <p>Finally he mentioned that if the company fulfill their demands they will not make any problem for mining activity.</p>
25	<p>Sri Sudipta Kumar Pradhan, Village:-Chhendipada</p> <p>He expressed that about 1000 acres of forest will be affected due to proposed mining project and the Chhendipada does not aware about public hearing. He appreciated the views expressed by Sri Agasti Behera, Chhendipada Village and Sri Ashok Kumar Pradhan, Chairman, Chhendipada. He mentioned that this jungle has been created since 1950. There are many important trees like Sal and Teak exists. Some of the</p>

	<p>villagers depends on forest in respect to collection of leaves, local mushrooms and Sal flower. In the year 1994 the Chhendipada village received the "Prakrutimitra Award" for creating and maintaining this jungle. This jungle is used for Elephants walk ways. Maa Raktamauli Suraksha Samiti and Maa Hingula Suraksha Samiti has been protecting this jungle. He mentioned that after cutting of trees there must be completely deforestation. They are unhappy regarding encroachment of this jungle for mining activity. He urged to the CMD of M/s Singerani Collieries Company Ltd. to discuss with the villagers of Chhendipada for solving the villagers demands and after proper discussion the matter can be solved. He urged to the company to plant more trees five times more as concerned to present forest area to be acquired for deforestation activity. He also mentioned that due to mining activity there must be the generation of environmental pollution and water scarcity and rise in temperature. So he requested to the company to take all types of pollution control measures during mining activity. He finally urged to the District Administration and M/s Singerani Collieries Company Ltd. to take initiative in this matter so that the villagers will be benefitted.</p>
26	<p>Sri Abhay Kumar Nayak, Village:- Karadabahal</p> <p>He supported the views expressed by previous speaker. He mentioned that in this public hearing Additional District Magistrate, Sub Collector and Officers including Company representatives are present to discuss the various issues raised by the villagers. He mentioned that M/s Singerani Collieries Company Ltd. is a Government joint venture company. He requested to the District Administration to look into the problems of the villagers and should appropriate steps mining work could happen properly and simultaneously nearby villagers will be benefitted. Without elaborating anything he supported the proposed project.</p>
27	<p>Sri Bidyadhar Sahoo, Village:- Chhendipada</p> <p>He mentioned that about 1000 acres of Chhendipada Jungle will be acquire for proposed coal mining project but the villagers of Chhendipada is completely unaware about public hearing. He expressed that the village committee submitted memorandum to the Collector and Superintendent of Police, Angul mentioning that the Chhendipada jungle should not be considered for coal mining activity as this jungle has been created since 1950. The District Administration did not discuss with the Chhendipada villagers about land acquisition of 1000 acres of jungle. He mentioned that there was a meeting conducted by previous DFO of Angul in the month of October, 2019 and it was finalized that this jungle will be protected in all respect and it should not be used for any type of mining activity. The villager does not want to give jungle for mining activity. He asked to the District Administration that how GAIL India Ltd has got permission to start their pipeline project inside this jungle with consulting the local villagers. He finally mentioned that without proper discussion with Collector, Angul and District Administration, the Chhenedipada villagers will not allow any land for mining activity otherwise they will go for stroke.</p>
28	<p>Sri Akhil Pradhan, Village:- Kasidiha</p> <p>He mentioned that previous speakers expressed their different views about the proposed mining project but they does not know that this public hearing is meant for</p>

	<p>different environmental issues which may arise before and after operation of proposed mining project. People knows that there is a slogan that “to save the plant there must be more plantation” but in this proposed mining project how the Company is thinking about destroying of jungle. Every previous speakers demanded huge money against their land or employment. Nobody is thinking the if there will be the deforestation what will be its impact to this area. There must be environmental disturbance in this area. He pointed out that their village will be less affected in respect to land acquisition but due to opencast mining activity the village will suffer so many dust related problem. The company members will seat in AC chamber and they will not suffer from air pollution. Due to air pollution village ponds, crops and human will face so many problems. By drinking of polluted water the domestic animal will suffer many diseases. Due to cutting of trees from the jungle, mostly tribal people will be affected as they completely depend on jungle in all respect. So he asked that what type of action plan the company has prepared for control of air pollution, water pollution and rehabilitation plant before starting the mining operation. He requested that the families does not have any land shall be given more monetary assistance. The company should take all types of environmental protection management before considering the proposed mining project.</p>
29	<p>Sri Manoj Pradhan, Village:- Brahmanbil</p> <p>He mentioned that Company will not fulfill any demands of the villagers. Only Company will say that they will fulfill their demands but in later stage they will forgot completely. As concerned to 17 demands raised by Brahmanbil villagers, the company has provided only 10 bore well. He pointed out that the local Sarpanch and local MLA has not giving attention towards unemployment problem. He told that whether company will give full assurance that there will not be any dust pollution in this area? He requested to the villagers to quit this public hearing.</p>
30	<p>Sri Gobardhan Nayak, Village:- Chhendipada</p> <p>He welcomed the public hearing. He expressed that today the Karadabahal villagers are very happy because Government is conducting public hearing in Karadabahal village. One day will come the Karadhabahal villagers will face problem in respect to un employment problem. He told that company will acquire jungle in Chhendipada area and they will cut entire trees. Simultaneously aforestation will created in Athamalik area. In this process what benefit will get Chhendipada villagers as new jungle will be created far away from this village. He mentioned that problems can only be solved after proper discussion with the villagers. Definitely mining will be happened. So he requested to the CMD of M/S Singerani Collieries Ltd. that their representatives should discuss properly with the villagers to solve the issues. The Company should take more initiative for environmental management and unemployment issues.</p>
31	<p>Sri Jadav Sahoo Village:- Karadabahal</p> <p>He expressed that demands are already expressed by the previous speakers. He expressed that there was a rally happened in this area regarding proposed mining project of M/s Singerani Collieries Ltd. He told that the villagers demanded 30 points but out of which few demands fulfilled by the company. The other demands area mentioned below</p>

	<p>a) Exact valuation of land cost. b) Pension facility for Senior citizens. c) More Aforestation programme. d) Local employment opportunity.</p> <p>He also mentioned that due to mining activity there must be the generation of environmental pollution. So he requested to the company to take all types of pollution control measures during mining activity.</p>
32	Smt. Ritanjali Sahoo, Village:- Karadabahal
	<p>She welcomed the public hearing. She expressed that earlier people were doing cultivation. She also expressed that demands are already expressed by the villagers. With the mining activity priority shall be given for engaging the local people and there shall also be the peripheral development like development of roads, health checkup facility, better education, local transportation and pension for senior citizens.</p>
33	Sri Bhagirathi Majhi, Village:- Karadabahal
	<p>With the mining activity priority shall be given for engaging the local people and there shall also be the peripheral development like development of roads, health check up facility, better education, drinking water etc. He also expressed that during mining activity there may be the deforestation, so the mine authority should take initiative for more aforestation activity in the surrounding area. He requested to the mining authority take adequate steps towards environmental management.</p>
34	Sri Sarathi Sahoo, Village:- Brahmanbil
	<p>He mentioned that during the year 2016, the villagers of Brahmanbil village came to know about the Naini Coal Block to be acquired by M/s Singerani Collieries Ltd. After 2016 there were so many meetings happened with the villagers of Brahmanbil and Chhendipada village committee. The Brahmanbil village committee raised 17 demands. If the 17 demands are not fulfilled by M/s Singerani Collieries Ltd. the Brahmanbil village will not consider their support towards operation mining project. He asked to the company authority that there were many demands raised by different villagers and the company should clarify that how many demands they have fulfilled. If the villagers will satisfy with their demands then only they will allow to do mining activity. He requested that there should be equal selection of men and women in respect to recruitment to Singerani company. He finally mentioned that Company should talk with the villagers proper. Local employment shall be given priority. He expressed that whatever demands raised by the previous speakers should be completed as early as possible; otherwise they will protest the mining activity.</p>

At the same time 24 no of written representations was submitted before the panel members which are enclosed separately.

Observation:

Generation of local employment opportunity, education, drinking water facility, development of village roads, cleaning of village ponds, pension for senior citizen, adequate air pollution control. Adequate water pollution control, primary health center facility,

Industrial Training Centre and aforestation etc. were the most important issues emerged during the public hearing.

Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Angul & representative of State Pollution Control Board, Angul, Odisha, prepared the summary of the public hearing proceedings accurately reflecting the views and concerns expressed by the speakers with the inclusion of comments of the applicant read over to the audience at the end of the meeting explaining the contents in the ODIA Language and the agreed minutes of public hearing meeting was prepared.

The statement of issues and concerns of public with the comments of applicant, prepared in Odia and English language is annexed herewith separately.



1. It is proposed to operate Naini Coal Mine by outsourcing of all the operations in Mine Developer and Operator (MDO) concept.

SCCL will make a provision for skill development for the local unemployed youth of land affected families having required educational qualifications.

Mine Developer and Operator (MDO) will provide contractual employment to the local unemployed youth of land affected families as per the requirement in contractual operation of the project.

Further, this project will provide indirect employment opportunity to local community in unskilled works such as civil constructions, coal transport and other ancillary services.

2. SCCL will provide a dispensary/hospital in the colony for extending medical facilities to the employees.

Medical facilities will also be provided to the surrounding villagers/land affected families in the above dispensary/hospital.

Further, SCCL will also conduct medical camps regularly in the surrounding villages for monitoring of health of villagers.

3. SCCL will arrange an Ambulance in the above dispensary/hospital which will serve for the purpose of transportation of employees as well as surrounding villagers.

4. SCCL has already sanctioned funds for improvement of Karadabahal Upper Primary School. SCCL will arrange necessary infrastructure facilities to the existing schools in the surrounding villages nearby of the project for improving the educational facilities under CSR policy of the Company.
