PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF M/S MEENAKSHI ODISHA POWER PVT. LTD FOR SETTING UP OF SHAHEED LAKHAN NAYAK SMALL HYDROELECTRIC POWER PROJECT CAPACITY OF 25MW LOCATED AT TENTULIGUMMA VILLAGE IN THE DISTRICT OF KORAPUT CONDUCTED ON 17.02.2021 AT 11 AM AT THE PARK OF SHAHEED LAKHAN NAYAK SMALL HYDROELECTRIC POWER PROJECT ADJACENT TO BSF CAMP OF TENTULIGUMMA OF BOIPARIGUDA PS UNDER KORAPUT DISTRICT.

The public hearing in respect of the above project was held on 17.02.2021 as per the schedule and at the venue in accordance with the EIA Notification S. O. 1533 (E) dt. 14.09.2006. The public hearing with regard to date, place and time was announced in Public Address System in nearby villages of proposed project site and also published in Daily News Papers. The process followed for public hearing was adequate.

Er P Kar, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Rayagada welcomed the public to the hearing and briefed about the objectives, process & procedures followed for conducting such public hearing.

Shri Deben Kumar Pradhan, OAS (SAG), Additional District Magistrate, Koraput presided over and supervised the public hearing.

Er Binod Bihari Mishra, Chief Engineer & Sri Vivek Jhaldiyal Consultant of M/s Meenakshi Odisha Power Pvt. Ltd has explained about the proposed project and briefed about the Pollution Control measures to be adopted in the Project.

The following is the summary of the public hearing proceedings, reflecting all the views and concerns expressed by the assembled public at the venue. It was recorded by the officials of the Regional Office, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Rayagada.

1. Sri Budra Nayak, Sarpanch, Tentuligumma GP

Sri Nayak submitted written demands to the Chair. He extended Thanks to Meenakshi Power Project for constructing Hydro Project in Name of Saheed Lakshman Nayak & hoped that this project will provide employment opportunity to locals. Further he urged that the demands furnished by him shall be properly considered by the District Administration.

2. Sri Bansing Nayak, Tentuligumma

Sri Nayak informed that he is native of Tentuligumma. Further he told that Meenakshi Project completed 20 yrs & now proposed for another new project. He explained that when he was child a big meeting was conducted at Dandabadi for Meenakshi Project in presence of his father. He told that they were unaware about the developmental works carried out by the Project. Now they are aware & expressed that other village Heads expected Tentuligumma village would have been highly developed due to the project. He told that if village people want, company will develop the village. He expressed his happiness regarding setting up of Saheed Lakshman Nayak Power House & informed that they have given 45 demands to the company & questioned on fulfilling of their demands. He hoped that company will take steps for overall development of Tentuligumma & Kartanpalli GP without any falsification.

3. Sri Arjun Bhumia, Tentuligumma, Koraput

Sri Bhumia informed that his Birth place is Tentuligumma & hoped that the 3rd project of 25 MW will develop their locality & provide employment to the locals in position of Supervisor etc & people will be benefited. He supported the demands placed in writing by previous speaker i.e. Sarapanch for peripheral & overall development of his Panchayat by the company. He told that local people & village will be benefitted due to movement of Vehicles & Transportation. He urged that the development should be seen & expressed his trust over the company for their commitment for Development of the locality

4. Sri Padma Pujari, Tentuligumma, Koraput

Sri Pujari informed that he is 24 yrs old & observing the company functioning from last 20 yrs. He requested to the Meenakshi project for development of their village & queried about the fund provided to his village by the company for development. He also stressed upon the completion of the remaining developmental work by the company. He hoped that project will be beneficial for them & people will improve through jobs & will be aware through interactions.

5. Sri Sanadhar Nayak, Tentuligumma, Koraput

Sri Nayak introduced himself as Heir /descendant of Saheed Lakshman Nayak. He explained his struggle for studying in Gupteswar High School & appeared exam at Jeypore Municipal High School. He expressed his dissatisfaction over non availability of adequate Teachers, insufficient remuneration to Teachers & questioned on quality education to the students. Further he questioned that how Tentuligumma, Kartanpali GP & students will improve without proper education & becomes like Saheed Lakshman Nayak. He appreciated the Government for helping him to study at Gupteswar in such remote areas. He emphasised on proper education. He expressed that Project Proponent committed for establishment of college which has not yet been fulfilled.

He also expressed that project will come up & they are not going to oppose. He hoped that project will bring prosperity to the peoples of two Gram Panchayat, youths will get job as per their qualifications. He requested to the District Administration & Project Proponent for development of Saheed Lakshman Nayak School otherwise he will lock down the school.

6. Sri Trinath Bhumia, Kartanpalli, Malkangiri

Sri Bhumia introduced himself as resident of Kartanpali GP. He informed that it is the 3rd project of the company going to be established & all are excited for this project. He hoped that the 25 MW project will bring prosperity to the Village of Saheed Lakshman Nayak. He urged that some part of the profit from Hydro project should be used for development of the village. He informed that 200 Crores shall be invested for the project & after production of electricity we all will be benefitted. He further informed that company has done some developmental work in Tentuligumma, Kirtanpali GP & Udayagiri village & told the Saheed Lakshman Nayak Ashram School is Government School & having one Hostel where nearly 500 students are residing but only three Teachers are appointed. He described the contribution of Saheed Lakshman Nayak during 1942 for the independence of the country as well as for the development of such backward area. He elaborated the slow development taking place in their locality covered with Forest & surrounded by Hills.

Sri Bhumia drawn attention of the ADM Koraput for immediate appointment of more Teachers in Saheed Lakshman NayakAsram School as presently only six teachers are there & not adequate for teaching 500 students and to upgrade from existing class 8th to High School. He expressed that there is no graduates in their GPs & hardly few +2 passed students are there. He expressed his concern over the lowering of the education level & told that local youths are not even able to get any job for Teachers or Peons. He requested the District administration to consider for development of the village & urged that Meenakshi project will contribute from his profit for the development of 10 to 12 villages coming under the survey of the project. He relied on the submission of the project proponent that there will be no pollution &informed that 4 to 5 Ac forest land to be acquired by the project from Tulasi R F shall be compensated by the company through planting Trees over same area at Borigumma. He appealed to all for overall development of the locality.

7. Sri Dhanpati Barik, Tentuligumma, Koraput

Sri Barik introduced himself as like as Grandson of Saheed Lakshman Nayak. He described about the dream shown to them by Sri Parasuram Majhi on development of his village like facilities of roads, Electricity, fire office etc as company likely to come up in their village. He informed that 4 to 5 of his village people approached to the company for labour work but they did not get any work in the project. He urged that company should provide Teachers for the school so that their children

can be educated. He repeatedly requested the company to provide drinking water, Hospital of facilities, electricity etc to his village.

8. Smt. Phulmati Jiram, Sarpanch, Kartanpalli GP, Malkangiri

Smt. Jiram introduced herself as Sarapanch, Kartanpali GP & expressed that the dream of Saheed Lakshman Nayak has not yet been fulfilled. She informed that some of their youth got job in existing projects. She further emphasized on employment in proposed project for local people on priority basis as per their eligibility. She demanded for keeping copy of the report presented by the company in the Hearing at office of Tentuligumma & Kartanpali GP for their reference & to know about the compensation provisions made for them by the company. She expressed that this copy can also be referred in future that how much developmental work has been done by the company. She further expressed her dissatisfaction over the poor development of the Saheed Lakshman Nayak area in spite of funds released in his name as it gets misutilised. She requested the company to extend help for beautification of Tentuligumma village& again stressed on keeping copy of the report in both Panchayat office.

9. Sri Balaram Majhi, Kiang, Malkangiri

Sri Majhi expressed that Tentuligumma is an undeveloped area & there is no communication facilities for college going students of Tentuligumma area. He requested to provide Bus facilities for college going students by the company. He demanded ambulance for locals by the company to improve Healthfacilities in the area. He expressed his concern over the adverse impact on environment due to movement of heavy vehicles for the project & suggested for plantation along road side vacant lands & in Government lands.

10. Sri Madhab Nayak, Tentuligumma, Koraput

Sri Nayak informed that no development has been done in Tentuligumma village in spite of Government aid & Meenakshi Power Project has been functioning since 2003. He had drawn attention regarding problems of Tentuligumma boys & Girls along with problem of inadequate Teachers in the School having class up to 7th standard only. He requested to upgrade the school to High School & to make provision of college for improvement in education. Further he informed that there is no Hospital in his village & requested the company to conduct Health camp. He requested for development of environment & provision of Drinking water supply to the local villagers by the company. He asked to provide a copy of report circulated for the Hearing.

11. Sri Nanda Pujari, Tentuligumma, Koraput

Sri Pujari informed that he came to know about the new project & appealed to the public to bless the project so that Project can develop Tentuligumma Panchayat. He hoped that Saheed Lakshman Nayak School can be converted to High School by the project. He emphasised on education facilities for Tentuligumma students or else they will be spoiled. He informed that project proponent earlier committed for a college for which they selected land but later that proposal get dropped due to apprehension of indecent activities by the outside students. He urged that Provision of High School & College in Tentuligumma shall be considered as developmentdone by the project. He also demanded for the job for the local youths in the project based on their education. He requested the project proponent to develop a museum with park in Tentuligumma Panchayat for visitors in light of Hydrabad.

12. Sri Ram Chandra Nayak, Tentuligumma, Koraput

Sri Nayak expressed that they are not aware about the quantity of Power generation from the Saheed Lakshman Nayak project & demanded to supply the same quantity of electricity from the project to them as that of Government supplying to them. He informed that the village is in same condition as that was during Saheed Lakshman Nayak period & requested the Project Proponent for development of the village. He stressed up on the peripheral development of the Panchayat &

their Youth Club by the company. He urged that all will be benefitted from the employment in the project.

13. Sri Laba Bhumia, Udayagiri, Kartanpalli, Malkangiri

Sri Bhumia expressed his happiness about the new project & described the gradual improvement of that locality from 2000 to 2021due to the Government & the Project. He informed that company contributed for the Temple in each villages of Tentuligumma & Kartanpalli Panchayat & provision of 02 to 03 Teachers in schools including Udayagiri village. Further he informed that local peoples got job in the project & hoped that new project will provide job opportunities to remaining unemployed youths. He expressed that if the project will come up with the consent of villagers of two panchayats then there will be overall development & unemployed youth will get job opportunity in the project. He expected that if the projectproposal get pass through this Hearing then there will be development in the area & appealed for the co operation to start the project. He appreciated the project proponent for providing employment to the locals & urged that local youths should be given priority for the job in the new project.

14. Sri Dasrath Jiram, Mankadapani, Tentuligumma, Koraput

Sri Jiram introduced himself as ward member of ward no 11. He informed that Meenakshi project functioning since long back but proper development of Tentuligumma is yet to be done. He told that watersupply, electric provision has been made for Tentuligumma village but other villages like Nachaguda, Mediniguda, Kantabaunsaguda, Matuguda are still deprived from such facilities. He complained that the power being generated here get sold to other places. He further complained that they are even not getting water to drink but it is reaching to Andhra. He expressed his dissatisfaction over non fulfillment of the commitment made by the Meenakshi Project. Again he informed that they have to travel about 100 km to reach Boipariguda via Gobindapali in absence of the bridge otherwise the people of Kiang, Kartanpalli & Tentuligumma can reach directly. He demanded for construction of the Bridge. He further demanded for provision of Teachers in Bijliguda, Mankadapani & Aanalaguda schools. He warned that if half of his demand not fulfilled then new project should be stopped & if it will be imposed forcibly they will seek yes or no from villagers through voting.

15. Sri Tulsiram Bhumia, Lakaguda, Kartanpalli, Malkangiri

Sri Bhumia enquired about the expenditure made for development of Udayagiri & Tentuligumma Panchayat & wanted to know where developments are done. He strongly demanded to fill up posts of Driver, Helper etc in the proposed project by employing all educated youth of Tentuligumma & Udayagiri Panchayat & opposed the entry of outsiders in these posts. He expressed that even after 10 to 12 years company not able to provide Temples to all villages.

The Regional Officer, SPCB, Rayagada read over the issues raised by the public in the hearing and Er Binod Bihari Mishra, Chief Engineer & Sri Vivek Jhaldiyal Consultant of M/s Meenakshi Odisha Power Pvt. Ltd. responded to the issues raised. Then another deliberator expressed his views which is as follows

16. Sri Trilochan Jena, Vice Chairman, Boiparlguda Block, Koraput

Sri Jena expressed that establishment of the project will generate job opportunities & introduced himself as Samiti Sabhya of Tentuligumma Panchayat & Vice Chairman of Borrigumma Block. He informed that though he is representing the locals for last 04 years but could not able to see any peripheral Development activities made by the Meenkshi Power Plant. Further he informed that he had made many discussions with the Project proponent & with the ADM & given written representation to the Collectors to carry out peripheral development by the company. He also drawn attention for non issuance of appointment letter to its employees and employees are working under fear. He further informed that salaries given by the company to its employees are less than that of Government approved rate. He complained that the Teachers appointed by the company are even not able to get minimum life supporting wages. He further told that the company management

clarified him that all are getting good salaries & wages but after that he received written complaint from the employees& some of them is also not getting anything.

He informed that prior to the project the water depth in the river was less but after implementation of two projects at Tetuligumma & at Udayagiri the water depth increased to 40 to 50 ft due to blockage of stream. He told that Ganga Madkami of Vijiniguda died by drowning in the stream but no compensation was given by the company. He expressed his dissatisfaction for not providing any boat facilities from Madhuput to Vejiniguda Ghat & from Kantabaunsaguda to Lakhmiguda ghat though water gets accumulated due to the project. He recommended that since company has blocked the water for his project so company should make provision for communications of local villagers.

He demanded that company should give appointment letters to all its employees & to Teachers, Proper salaries & wages as per Government Rules, selection of good teachers through interview, Water supply, Power supply to all wards of Tentuliguma GPs. He also questioned on spending of money for peripheral development. He strongly demanded that part of the profit of the company should be utilised for the development works of the locality as per Government norms or else it will lead to Public agitation. He warned the company not to mislead the public regarding development. He welcomed the project & demanded the details of expenditure made by the company towards peripheral development during previous years. Further He asked the company to complete the remaining developmental work as pointed out by him or else they will oppose thenew project to come up.

Shri Deben Kumar Pradhan, ADM, Koraput has given concluding remarks on the hearing and elaborated the process to be followed for submission of the proceeding to the MoEF & CC, New Delhi for further action. He extended thanks to the public participated in the hearing for offering their views, suggestions and objections.

The issues raised by the public and corresponding comments of the applicant were prepared in Odia and English and it is annexed with the proceedings as Annexure-I & II respectively, list of the oral deliberators and participants in the hearing is annexed as Annexure-III & IV respectively. Seven nos written representations from a) Sri Budra Nayak and others of village-Tentuligumma, b) Sri Lachhaman Bhumia and other villagers of Teckguda, c) Sri Alekha Chandra Jena and other Teachers of Kartanpalli and Tentuligumma GP, d) Sri Jagabandhu Samartha(Nayak) and others of village - Bada Serpalli, e) Sri Hari Dalpati and others of village-Madupur, f) Sri Chaitanya Bhumia and others of village-Anlaguda and g) Sri Kam Lukhara and others of village-Kumbhikhari were received during public hearing are annexed as Annexure-V(a to g). The videography of proceedings are recorded and submitted as DVD(I& II).

Biodiversity Conservation Plan, Muck Management Plan, Air, Noise and Water Pollution Control, Green Belt Development, Restoration of Construction Site, etc. to ensure protection and preservation of local environment. There are provisions of environment quality monitoring on regular basis during project construction and operation to assess the efficacy of EMP implementation.

Provision for green belt development along the road and around project and office building has already been made in the EIA report. Total area of green belt development has been worked out as 1.8 ha in EIA report. If additional, government land is available, project will carry out plantation on additional area of 1.8 ha i.e. a total budget for green belt development on 3.6 ha will be made in project.

Preventive measures against pollution due to Transportation & use of Heavy machineries for the project.

Aspects of transportation of man and material, use of machineries and equipment, use of DG sets for back up power during project construction leading to increase in traffic have been identified as impacts in the EIA report. Mitigation measures have been recommended to minimise air and noise pollution due to transportation and use of machinery and same shall be implemented and monitored to minimise the impact.

Peripheral development

Development of the locality like road, Education, Free Electricity for local villages, Drinking water supply, Bus provision for local students, Provision of Ambulance, Development of Health facilities including Health campetc.

Project has made provisions for local area development during EIA study based on the assessment of the local needs and budgeted Rs. 1.00 crore for the same. Keeping in view the demands by the locals the budget will be increased to 1.82 crore (about 1% of the total project cost).

Village main road work has already been initiated and largely completed by state government, for the repair of other internal village roads a provision of Rs. 20.00 lakh has been made.

Education development in the local villages will be carried out a budget of Rs. 30.00 lakh in consultation with locals, which will ensure providing basic infrastructure and provisions of teachers.

A budget of Rs. 30 lakhs for health infrastructure such ambulance, health camps and strengthening local health centre.

A budget of Rs. 12 lakhs has been proposed for 3 years of construction period for provision of free electricity to peripheral village.

Other Peripheral Developmental work as per written representation submitted by local villagers.

For other peripheral development work, a list of 42 items are given in the representations. A committee will be formed including the important persons of the Peripheral Villages, project personnel and local authorities to
