

Proceeding of the public hearing conducted on 02.03.2021 for M/s IOCL, Paradip Refinery for establishment of 1.2 MMTPA PX-PTA Plant at IOCL, Paradip Refinery and Petrochemical Complex, Paradip in the district of Jagatsinghpur.

A public hearing was held on 02.03.2021 at 10.30 AM at Municipality Kalyan Mandap, Madhuban, Paradip of Jagatsinghpur district for the proposed 1.2 MMTPA PX-PTA plant inside the existing premises of M/s IOCL, Paradip Refinery. Sri Kanhu Charan Dhir, Additional District Magistrate, Paradip presided over the meeting along with Er. Dillip Kumar Dash, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Paradip. He welcomed the public who were present at the venue for participating in the hearing. Attendance sheets of the officials present in the hearing and that of public present inside the venue are annexed as **Annexure I and II** respectively. 54 persons were present in the meeting and have put their signatures in the attendance sheet, out of which 18 persons intended to deliver their views and their list is annexed as **Annexure-III**. Out of those, 17 people took part in the deliberations and one person did not come for deliberation. No written statement was received from anybody during the public hearing. Video recording of the entire proceeding of the public hearing was done and it will be forwarded to the Ministry of Environment & Forest, Govt. of India, New Delhi as such along with this proceeding.

At the outset, Er. Dillip Kumar Dash, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Paradip welcomed all the public present in the meeting. He briefly described the objective of the public hearing conducted as per the provisions of EIA Notification No.S.O. 1533(E) of Dt.14th September 2006 of the Ministry of Environment and Forests & Climate Change (MOEF & CC), Government of India and the importance of the actual views of local public regarding the project. He also informed that the date, time and venue for conducting this public hearing for Jagatsinghpur district was duly advertised in one Odia daily newspaper, Prameya, dtd. 30.01.2021 and in one English daily newspaper, The New Indian Express dtd. 30.01.2021 following due procedure for intimation of public. The venue, date and

timing of the public hearing meeting of the said project were also propagated through loudspeaker announcement in the area. Executive summary of the proposed project both in Odia & English were displayed at the meeting venue for ready reference of public. The executive summary was also made available in the website of State pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar (www.ospcboard.org).

Addl. District Magistrate, Paradip and Regional Officer explained to public to place their views about the environmental impacts of the proposed project and emphasized that their statements should be related to environment and pollution and its control aspects. Then the Regional Officer called the project proponent to describe before the public about the details of the project and its impact on surrounding environment.

Smt. Jhuna Rani Behera, Senior Manager, M/s IOCL, Paradip Refinery briefed about how IOCL, a maharatna company of Government of India has contributed in nation building and how IOCL, Paradip Refinery of 15 MMTPA capacity is contributing to the country in general and Odisha in particular. Since October, 2019 Paradip Refinery is supplying BS-VI fuel to the market for reducing vehicular pollution significantly. It has also installed a 8.5 MW of solar plant at the site and has developed greenbelt in 580 Ac areas in and around refinery. She also highlighted about provisions of rain water harvesting and installation of state of art ETP (RO based) for wastewater treatment and reuse. The industry is presently constructing a Mono Ethylene Glycol (MEG) unit and after installation of the proposed 1.2 MMTPA PX-PTA project, both MEG and PTA will cater to the raw material need of textile industries. PX-PTA plant will need 75 acres of land which has been earmarked inside the plant premises and no additional land will be required to be acquired. The production process will involve production of paraxylene from reformat followed by conversion of paraxylene to PTA. Air pollution potential will be marginal as natural gas will be used as fuel. A new separate RO based ETP will be provided for treatment of wastewater generated from the proposed unit which will be reused and RO reject will be discharged to deep sea through the existing discharge pipeline. Spent catalyst will be generated intermittently, which will be stored and disposed as per law. Noise pollution will be

marginal. The unit has already planted 8 lakh trees covering 580 acres of land and further plantation is being done as per land availability.


Sri Sitikantha Behera, Consultant engaged by M/s IOCL, Paradip Refinery briefed about the baseline study done within 15 km radius from the site in connection with ambient air quality, noise pollution, surface water and marine water. Fresh water requirement will be within the approved limit. No reserve forest and eco-sensitive zone is existing within the study range. Upon enquiry, it was reported by Sri Mukesh Mohan, CGM (TS) that the proposed plant will be commissioned in 2024.

Regional Officer, SPCB, Odisha, Paradip then invited public for their deliberations. Details of deliberations are annexed at **Annexure-IV**.

During the deliberations, ADM, Paradeep requested IOCL officials to clarify various critical points raised by public like CSR activities, direct and indirect employments and fundamental facilities required by local people. Those issues were intermittently clarified by IOCL. After the deliberations by the public was over, Regional Officer, SPCB, Paradip summarized various issues raised by the public and invited the project proponent to offer their views on those issues. Sri A K Bhagwati, CGM (HR) of IOCL placed his views on the issues raised by the public.

The summary of the views and concerns of the public and the commitments made by the project proponent are annexed in Oriya language & English language as **Annexure-V & VI** respectively.

Finally the meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair and other participants.

Statement of the public participated in the deliberation during public hearing conducted on 02.03.2021 at 10.30 AM for M/s IOCL, Paradip Refinery for establishment of 1.2 MMTPA PX-PTA Plant at IOCL, Paradip Refinery in the district of Jagatsinghpur.

1. Kishore Kumar Parida, Sarapanch, Dhinkia G.P

He welcomed the project and also showed his concerns about IOCL's failure in fulfilling prior commitments in local employment. He requested to provide facilities in local area to protect the villagers during high tide and cyclonic storm periods when salty water enters into their villages and agricultural land.

2. Ranjan Kumar Bardhan, Govindapur, Dhinkia GP

He welcomed the project with condition for spending CSR budgets in Dhinkia GP and nearby areas. He further requested to recruit land losers at least in contractual jobs, to reconstruct the by-pass road and to clean the drains for eradicating mosquito nuisance in the area.

3. Bishnu Charan Swain, Kujang, Jagatsinghpur

He expressed many things irrelevant to the project and highlighted general environmental condition of Paradip area.

4. Subash Pradhan, Trilochanpur, Dhinkia

Basic facilities to be provided to the nearby areas. He emphasized on boundary side drain cleaning in Dhinkia to eliminate mosquito nuisance. Agriculture land has been affected due to salty water intrusion for which sluice gate to be provided. Being the GP dominated by agro dependent population he emphasized on utilization of more CSR fund on education, road transport & health care facility by the unit. He stated that focus should be on the affected agriculture land and local employment.

5. Bikramjit Samantaray, Dhinkia

He highlighted about the existing pollution problems due to IOCL refinery and expressed his concerns about their adverse impacts. He supported the

project with a condition to minimize existing pollution problems and IOCL should look into the social issues of local area.

6. Arakhita Das, Kothi

He supported the project because no additional land is required. However, he highlighted the failure of IOCL in fulfilling previous commitments. He expressed that the project should come and IOCL should take up CSR activities including provision of medical facility and drinking water supply in the area. He also demanded about requirement of local people to the extent of 70 % at least in contractual jobs. He further emphasized that IOCL should resume its scheme of awarding scholarship to local meritorious student.

7. Pabitra Kumar Sahoo, Kothi

He supported the project. However, he requested district administration to take up all local concerns with IOCL for fulfilling their demand and minimizing pollution problems. He further emphasize on general environmental issues to road transportation, road conditions of Paradip area and appealed for introducing a road cleaning scheduled from Bhutamundai to Paradip.

8. Nrusingh Charan Das, Dhinkia

He emphasized about persisting issues related to air and noise pollution during operation of refinery. He further intimated about breeding of mosquitoes in nearby drain which are not cleaned by IOCL. He finally expressed that he does not opposed the project but IOCL should take up the existing issues for providing a better life to the nearby dwellers.

9. Shyma Sundar Sahoo, Bagadia

Though he signed in the attendance sheet but remained absent during deliberation.

10. Pramod Kumar Jena, Nuagarh GP

Mentioning that industrialization should be aimed at development he intimated about failure of IOCL in CSR activities, drinking water supply, medical treatment, providing green belt and providing minimum facilities to its contractual employees. He demanded IOCL to provide (i) a parking shed for its contractual employees (ii) medical camps in villages (iii) plantation by engaging NGOs and drinking water to nearby villages. He further requested

that IOCL should take up for establishment of a super specialty hospital. He supported the project with conditions to fulfill the above.

11. Rabindra Majhi, Jamihara Ekata Mancha, President, Gandakipur

He supported the project with a request to fulfill earlier commitments made by IOCL.

12. Bipin Kumar Tripathy, Mangarajpur

He supported the project with a request that IOCL should consult with more and more local people of the area through CSR activities. He further requested to complete drinking water supply to his GP for which Rs. 3 crores has already been sanctioned.

13. Jogendra Tarai, Mangarajpur

He supported the project with a request to fulfill earlier commitments made by IOCL.

14. Dr. Ayeskant Ray

He opposed the project and the public hearing and blamed the entire process of EIA. He threatened to go on strike if the project comes mentioning that IOCL has failed to provide 33% plantation as per EC conditions.

15. Surendra Mahanta

He expressed that the project should come and development of the area should be done. However, IOCL should consult more and more local people examining their demands and to fulfill them.

16. Siba Charan Biswal, Paribesha Surakhya Trust, Paradeep


He supported the project and emphasized to increase budget provisions for improvement of environmental status of Paradip area. He requested to maintain the road connecting Zero point to Atharabanki for minimizing traffic congestion and air pollution. He further appealed to start construction of the proposed 8 lane road from Paradip.

17. Sarat Kumar Rout, Paradeep

He questioned about the authenticity of data mentioned in the executive summary and asked IOCL to clarify if entire the CSR budget has been spent for betterment homeless people of Jagatsinghpur. He showed his concern about the flame visible from the flaring stack and its negative impacts on nearby area including Bhitarkanika Wildlife Sanctuary.

18. Dhirendra Biswal, Bagadia

He expressed that he supports industrialization in general but has no hopes on commitments made by IOCL. He further objected about not conducting public hearing inside nearby villages. He appealed before IOCL to take care of the health of water, forest, people, animals and agricultural land failing which people will be forced to go on strike.




The public raised the following issues and apprehensions for redressal by the project proponent.


1. To enhance CSR budget and its proper utilization for betterment of local people in the adjacent villages. Various activities to be taken up through CSR should include healthcare facilities, repair maintenance of roads, drinking water supply, drain cleaning and hygiene and scholarship to meritorious students.
2. To minimize noise, water and air pollution related issues from the existing plant and the proposed project.
3. To provide fundamental facilities to contractual workers like rest rooms, adequate drinking water and parking shed for their vehicles.

Views of Project Proponent on the issues raised by the public during the Public hearing

Sri A. K. Bhagwati, CGM (HR) of IOCL addressed the issues raised by public and committed that

1. All the demands of the public related to CSR will be fulfilled as per the discussions with local gram panchayats and recommendations by district administration.
2. Three drinking water supply projects have already been approved and will be executed shortly.
3. Provision of medical care to local villagers will be examined and executed after approval.
4. Scholarship to meritorious students is already in place and will be continued.
5. Five rest rooms for contractual workers have been planned and two have already been completed.
