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Proceeding of the public hearing conducted on 23.09.2021 for Adhapati Paika Nadi Sand Bed, Tahasil- Tirtol in the district of Jagatsinghpur

A public hearing was held on 23.09.2021 at 10.30 AM at the playground adjoining to Sreema Govt. Girls' High School, Adhapati of Jagatsinghpur district for the proposed sand quarry (5.059 Ha). Smt. Chinmayee Biswal, Additional District Magistrate (Revenue), Jagatsinghpur presided over the meeting along with Er. Dillip Kumar Dash, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Paradeep. She welcomed the public who were present at the venue for participating in the hearing. Attendance sheets of the officials present in the hearing and that of public present inside the venue are annexed as **Annexure- I and- II** respectively. 65 persons were present in the meeting, out of which 57 persons have put their signatures in the attendance sheet. 6 persons intended to deliver their views and their list is annexed as **Annexure-III**. One written statement was received from a group of people during the public hearing. Video recording of the entire proceeding of the public hearing was done and it will be forwarded to State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Government of Odisha as such along with this proceeding.

At the outset, Er. Dillip Kumar Dash, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Paradeep welcomed all the public present in the meeting. He briefly described the objective of the public hearing conducted as per the provisions of EIA Notification No.S.O. 1533(E) of Dt.14th September 2006 of the Ministry of Environment and Forests & Climate Change (MOEF & CC), Government of India and its amendment No. S.O. 141 (E) of Dt.15.01.2016 and the importance of the actual views of local public regarding the project. He also informed that the date, time and venue for conducting this public hearing was duly advertised in one Odia daily newspaper; Prameya, dtd. 19.08.2021 and in one English daily newspaper; The Times of India dtd. 19.08.2021 following due procedure for intimation of public. Further, the same information was also propagated through notices displayed at various places in the area. Executive summary of the proposed project both in Odia & English were displayed at the meeting venue for ready reference of public. The executive summary was also made available in the website of State pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar (www.ospcboard.org).

ADM (Revenue), Jagatsinghpur and Regional Officer, Paradeep explained to public to place their views about the environmental impacts of the proposed project and emphasized that their statements should be related to environment and pollution and its control aspects. Then the Regional Officer requested authorized person of the Project proponent Sri Saidatta Das to describe before the public about the details of the project and its impact on surrounding environment.


Sri Saidutta Das, on behalf of the project proponent Sri Haraprasad Senapati presented and briefed about the importance of sand mining in construction sector and how the same contributes towards nation building. He highlighted about the details of the sand bed spreading over an area of 5.059 Ha in Adhapati village of Jagatsinghpur district. Sand mining capacity in the cluster will be 15,180 m³/year as per the approved mining plan. The said quarry has been leased out for a period of 5 years and mining of sand will be carried out by manual open cast method while, loading and transportation will be done by semi mechanized method by using loaders/trucks/dumpers. All baseline environmental data are within prescribed standards and are not likely to be affected significantly due to the said mining. Additional plantation will be done in the river bank. Actions will be taken for abatement of pollution as per the environment management plan.

Regional Officer, SPCB, Odisha, Paradeep then invited public for their deliberations. Details of deliberations are annexed at Annexure-IV.

After the deliberations by the public was over, Regional Officer, SPCB, Paradeep summarized various issues raised by the public and invited the project proponent to offer their views on those issues. Sri Saidutta Das placed his views on the issues raised by the public. ADM (Revenue) instructed the project proponent to redress the issues raised by people in priority.

The summary of the views and concerns of the public and the commitments made by the project proponent are annexed in Oriya language & English language as Annexure-V & VI respectively.



Finally the meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair and other participants.

Statement of the public participated in the deliberation during public hearing conducted on 23.09.2021 for Adhapati Paika Nadi Sand Bed, Tahasil- Tirtol in the district of Jagatsinghpur

1. Ranjit Ku. Pal, At/P.O.- Dhanua

He stressed upon the environmental problems in general and urged that the sand mine should operate without overloading and transportation of sand should not damage the public roads. He welcomed the project saying that sand is a prime requirement for the construction sector. He demanded that the transporting vehicles should not ply during school opening and closing times. He requested the project proponent to provide speed breakers near the Polar school area.

2. Prasanta Kumar Mohanty, Nalapur

He welcomed the project saying that by operation of the sand mine, sand will be available in the area easily with cheaper price. However, plantation should be done for reducing pollution.

3. Diptimayee Ray, Sarpanch Kolara G.P.

She welcomed the project saying that local people will be benefited due to the sand mine. However, proper care should be taken to take care of the environment.

4. Shati Azam, Kolar

He stated that food, cloth and shelter are the fundamental requirements of life and sand is very helpful for the shelter. The proposed project will result in easier and cheaper availability of sand in the locality and therefore it is welcome.

5. Sarata Behera, Nagpur

He welcomed the project and requested that sand should not be stacked along the roadside and river bank so as to stop hindrance to cattle movement.

6. Sunil Kumar Acharya, Tartol

He welcomed the project saying that operation of the sand mine in the area will result in easier and cheaper availability of sand. However he demanded to provide speed breakers on roads near the mosque and the schools.

Points raised by the public during public hearing conducted on 23.09.2021 for Adhapati Paika Nadi Sand Bed, Tahasil- Tirtol in the district of Jagatsinghpur

The public raised the following issues and apprehensions for redressal by the project proponent.

1. To prevent overloading sand transporting tractors/ dumpers/ trucks so that damage of roads is minimized.
2. To plant trees in the river bank and other area to prevent pollution.
3. To provide speed breakers at the nearby mosque and schools.
4. Not to stack sand on the river bank and alongside the road so that hindrance to cattle is prevented.

Views of Project Proponent on the issues raised by the public during the Public hearing

Sri Saidatta Das on behalf of the project proponent addressed the issues raised by public and intimated that

1. Maximum loading in the dumper/ trucks will be 20/21 tons and overloading will not be done. In case of damage, the roads will be repaired immediately.
2. Plantation will be done along the roads, at the river bank and other area as advised by the villagers.
3. Portions of roads where speed breakers are needed will be identified with the help of Tahasildar, Tirtol and these will be provided within 15 days.
4. Help and assistance will be provided during flood and cyclone conditions for benefit of the local people.
