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PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF M/S HINDALCO INDUSTRIES LTD.- ADITYA ALUMINIUM REFINERY PROJECT (HIL-AARP) FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF ALUMINA REFINERY OF 2.0MTPA ALONG WITH CO-GENERATION POWER PLANT OF 150 MW AT KANSARIGURHA VILLAGE UNDER KASHIPUR TEHSIL OF RAYAGADA & KORAPUT DISTRICT (FOR KORAPUT DISTRICT) CONDUCTED ON 07.10.2021 AT 11.00 AM AT KHATA NO. 21 PLOT NO 20, VILLAGE DHARADA UNDER LAXMIPUR TEHSIL, DISTRICT- KORAPUT. (7)

The public hearing in respect of the above project was held on 07.10.2021 as per the schedule and at the venue in accordance with the EIA Notification S. O. 1533 (E) dt. 14.09.2006. The public hearing with regard to date, place and time was announced in Public Address System in nearby villages of proposed project site and also published in Daily News Paper. The process followed for public hearing was adequate.

Er P Kar, Regional Officer I/c, State Pollution Control Board, Koraput welcomed the public to the hearing and briefed about the objectives, process & procedures followed for conducting such public hearing.

Shri Rajendra Majhi, OAS(S) Additional District Magistrate, Koraput presided over and supervised the public hearing. He briefed about the importance and objectives of such hearing and invited the project proponent to highlight on proposed project.

Dr Rama Chandra Rout, AVP of M/s HINDALCO Industries Ltd explained about the proposed project and briefed about the Pollution Control measures to be adopted in the Project.

The following is the summary of the public hearing proceedings, reflecting all the views and concerns expressed by the assembled public at the venue. It was recorded by the officials of the Regional Office, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Koraput.

1. **Smt Shantilata Kulesika, Bhalujodi, Odiapentha**

Smt Kulesika expressed that, this area is a backward area & about 90% peoples are poor. She demanded for development of education, Health, Drinking water supply, village roads & Health camp at least twice in a month by the company including Stipends to the old age people. She expressed her happiness that their struggles & dreams for last 16 years going to be fulfilled as the local unemployed & educated youths who are going to outside as migrant labourer will be employed in the company. She urged that company should extend help to give higher education to local students. She expressed that they lost their land for the company & hoped that company should address the various problems exist in the area. She further stressed on protection of environment & safety of local women by the company & hoped that local youth should get opportunities through the company. She welcomed the company hoping that it will bring development & improve the lifestyle & economic conditions of the locality.

2. **Smt Alay Hikaka, Sarapanch, Singaram, Odiapentha**

Smt. Hikaka urged that company should come in their area & children needs to be educated.

3. **Smt Subay Kulesika, Bhalujodi, Block Chairman**

Smt Kulesika expressed that they have given their land for the project & their children going to outside for their livelihoods. She welcomed the project hoping that their children will be employed & schools to be developed for education of students by the company.

4. Sri Parda Kulesika, Bhalujodi, Odiapentha

Sri Kulesika welcomed the project & emphasised that natural water quality of the area to be protected for their consumption. Further he expressed that there will be temperature rise, air & smoke pollution due to company & urged that pollution should be prevented & the environment & Plantation to be improved. He appealed to the villagers to be united for setting up of the company & expressed his happiness for the project. He urged that local educated youth will be employed for their livelihoods in the project & requested the public to come together for establishment of the project.

5. Sri Sakari Hikaka, Ranjan Panasiguda, Odiapentha

Sri Hikaka informed that, they lost their land for last 16 to 17 years for the plant without any benefit. He welcomed the project & demanded for repayment to the land losers & supply of drinking water to the villages. He expressed that those poor peoples who are not able to approach the company are suffering & requested to make provision of stipends for physically challenged persons of the locality by the company. He stressed on the Help to local poor people & as they have suffered for last 16 to 17 years after giving their land, so he demanded company should come or the land to be returned to them.

6. Sri Rabindra Pradhani, Dharada, Odiapentha

Sri Pradhani expressed that, the unemployed educated youths, Technical students, Engineers & Doctors of the locality need to be employed in the project. He submitted a written representation to the chair.

7. Sri Sunadhar Hikaka, Ranjan Panasaguda, Odiapentha

Sri Hikaka expressed that, they had given their land for last 15 years for the project & they are unable to cultivate that land & land is still lying barren. He welcomed the project & hoped that if the company will be established they will get their livelihoods & all will be benefitted by the company.

8. Sri Krushna Hikaka, Ranjan Panasaguda, Odiapentha

Sri Hikaka reminded that Public Hearing for the company was conducted in 2006 & company assured to fulfil the demands of land losers. Based on that they all gave their land for the company but lands are still lying barren & company also not taken care of them for last 14 yrs. He hoped that the company will provide job to their educated children who are going to Mumbai & Andhra as migrant labourers. He welcomed the project & demanded compensation for land losers for last 14 years from the company.

9. Sri Jalandhar Halba, Biriguda Colony, Odiapentha

Sri Halba informed that, the company took their land in 2005 & they struggled for last 14 years for the company to come. He expressed the local children are coming back due to lock down & shut down from other states. He hoped for employment of local youths in the project & demanded that factory should come in their area & all facilities should be given to them. He informed that they have lost their land & houses & demanded for final decision of the project in the hearing.

10. Sri Subash Madinga, Biriguda Colony, Odiapentha

Sri Madinga informed that company made soil testing in 2002 & started survey in 2005 - 06 in which he was involved. They are waiting for the project for last 14 years. He welcomed the project & hoped that it will develop the state, the Panchayat, the Block & all will be benefited. Further he expressed they lost their land, Houses & cultivation for last 14 yrs & demanded for the declaration of date of commencement of the Factory for their survival.

11. Miss Ambika Khara, Ranjan Panasaguda, Odiapentha

Miss Khara urged that company should come at the earliest as they are waiting for the company for last 16 years. She explained that after getting education they have to go to outside for the jobs & they faced lots of difficulties during Corona period. She expressed that if company will be established at their village they need not to go outside for the job & they will be employed here. She demanded for development of education, Health, Drinking water in their villages by the project & employment of local youths in the factory. She welcomed the project for their employment & livelihoods and to get rid of exploitation being faced when going to outside for the job.

12. Sri Natha Miniaka, Biriguda Colony, Odiapentha

Sri Miniaka informed that they are waiting for last 15 years with a hope that company will be established. He compared the Kodingamali hill as their Rice Bowl & people residing around the hill are waiting for the project. He requested to declare for the project by the officers present for fulfilling his hope.

13. Sri Sahadev Bidika, Biriguda Colony, Odiapentha

Sri Bidiaka introduced himself as displaced person & land losers. He expressed that Factory will be established & there will be pollution. He questioned that what steps to be taken by Pollution Control Board to prevent Pollution.

14. Sri Agasti Halwa, Biriguda Colony, Odiapentha

Sri Halwa expressed that, ground was prepared in 1998 for establishment of the project & they are waiting for last 20-22 years for project to come. He welcomed the project & requested the Government & Project proponent to execute Rs 11000 Cr project as this area is poor region & unemployment of educated youth is high. He hoped that project will bring development in education, Health, Communication facilities of the locality & the educated youths will get employment. He requested the project proponent to set up the Industry at the earliest to mitigate their problems.

He informed that in 2007 in RPDS meeting Biriguda colony & Kansariguda was declared for displacement but later the dispute of Biriguda colony was not settled. In 2011 decision was taken for displacement of Biriguda colony but till date no declaration has been made for DP status of Biriguda colony. He requested to give DP status to Biriguda colony & to give similar facilities to them as in case of Kansariguda village. Further he demanded compensation for the loss made by them during last 14 years & repayment of land cost as per 2013 Act.

15. Sri Kameswar Kulesika, Bhalujodi, Odiapentha

Sri Kulesika welcomed the project.



16. Sri Bina Madinga, Biriguda Colony, Odiapentha

Sri Madinga compared this hearing with the engagement of bride & apprehended that it may not reach to marriage. He expressed that they struggled for the project since commencement of the mining activities of Kodingamali & today it seems to be successful for which they are happy. He welcomed the project.

17. Sri Bipin Kumar Madinga, Biriguda Colony, Odiapentha

Sri Madinga expressed that, it seems from the hearing that it is the end of their waiting for last 23 years. The hope & dreams of the area will be fulfilled whenever company will be established at Kansariguda. He requested to clarify in this hearing regarding steps to be taken to control air pollution. Further he questioned the company to what assurance has been given by the Government for establishment of the factory at this stage. He again wanted to know that by when company going to establish its plant. He further questioned about purpose & use of this hearing & demanded reply either in written or through verbal from the Government.

He strongly welcomed & supported the project hoping that large number of youth like him will get employment & livelihoods in the project

18. Sri Karna Halaba, Biriguda Colony, Odiapentha

Sri Halaba expressed that, he was child when Aditya Birla started soil testing & informed that they cooperate the company in every fields. He expressed his happiness for establishment of Aditya Birla Company in Kansariguda village & informed that many of them have died with hope of company to come. He urged that all efforts to be given by the Government for establishment of the company without further delay & strongly welcomed the project.

19. Sri Kailash Chandra Kulesika, Bhalujodi, Odiapentha

Sri Kulesika expressed that today is a great day for them & their wait for the project going to end. They never opposed the project rather they supported the Aditya Birla Plant in every aspect. He warned that if company will be established than Pollution will increase & requested Pollution Control Board to properly control as per Rules so that there will be no adverse impact on water, Air & Noise environment. Further he drew attention on increasing water pollution in their area & demanded for provision of clean water by the Government & Company.

He informed that their area was Tribal & illiterate area till 2014. He hoped that presently the educated youth of the locality will get job opportunity in the project for their economic development. He informed that land from 05 villages of Koraput has been acquired by the project & 95% of Raw materials will be sourced from Koraput district. Red Mud Pond & Ash Pond going to be established in Koraput. He demanded for provision of advanced Health Care Facilities, Adarsh Vidyalaya in Laxmipur Block area. He further informed that Biriguda of Koraput has not yet been obtained DP status & hoped that in future it will get DP status. He suggested for development of Town Planning for the economic growth of local business group. Further he demanded for pipe drinking water supply to them & provision of Mega Lift Irrigation facilities from Khalkona River to irrigate the complete land of Laxmipur Block. He urged that company will follow the norms of Pollution Control Board & advised to start Plantation on all Barren Hills by the company. He warned that if their demands & hope will not fulfil by the company it may lead to obstruction in progress of the company. He submitted a written representation to the Chair.



20. **Sri Tapan Kumar Halwa, Biriguda Colony, Odiapentha**

Sri Halwa expressed that the Hearing on Environment is going on & there will be air, water & noise pollution, He wanted to know what the parameters to be used are & explanation on PM₁₀, PM_{2.5}, SO_x & NO_x etc. either verbally or in written form.

21. **Sri Krushna Mandinga, Singaram, Odiapentha**

Sri Mandinga welcomed the Project & told that they want Plant to establish. He informed that they have given their land for last 14 years, but no plant has yet been set up. If company will not establish the plant their land should be returned. He emphasised to take decision on whether plant will be established or not. He demanded for Primary school in each village of Odiyapentha Panchayat.

The Regional Officer I/C, SPCB, Koraput read over the issues raised by the public in the hearing. Shri S K Mishra, Director of M/s HINDALCO Industries Ltd responded to the issues raised.

The issues raised by the public and corresponding comments of the applicant were prepared in Odia and English and it is annexed with the proceedings as Annexure I & II respectively, list of the oral deliberators and participants in the hearing is annexed as Annexure III& IV respectively. Six written representations received during public hearing is annexed as Annexure-V (a to f). The videography of proceedings are recorded and submitted as DVD (I).

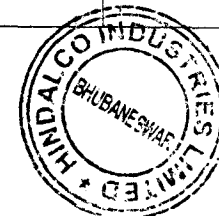

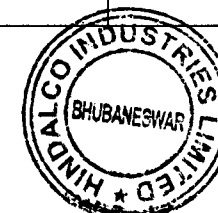
