PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF SRI NEMANI RAMAKRISHNA FOR KUNTESHU
DECORATIVE STONE (GARNETIFEROUS GRANITE GNEISS) MINES WITH PRODUCTION CAPACITY
OF 2400 CUM/ANNUM OVER AN AREA OF 13.703 HA IN VILLAGE KUNTESHU No. 53 UNDER
BANDUGAON TEHSIL OF KORAPUT DISTRICT CONDUCTED ON 29.09.2021 AT 11.00 AM IN
MUNDAPADAR VILLAGE UNDER BANDUGAON TEHSIL, DISTRICT: KORAPUT

The public hearing in respect of the above project was held on 29.09.2021 as per the schedule and at the venue in accordance with the EIA Notification S. O. 1533 (E) dt. 14.09.2006. The public hearing with regard to date, place and time was announced in Public Address System in nearby villages of proposed project site and also published in Daily News Paper. The process followed for public hearing was adequate.

Er P Kar, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Koraput welcomed the public to the hearing and briefed about the objectives, process & procedures followed for conducting such public hearing.

Shri Rajendra Majhi, OAS(S), Additional District Magistrate, Koraput presided over and supervised the public hearing. He briefed about the importance and objectives of such hearing and invited the project proponent to highlight on proposed project.

Sri Jagabandhu Bisoi, Consultant, Kalyani Laboratory (P) Ltd on behalf of Project Proponent explained about the proposed project and briefed about the Pollution Control measures to be adopted in the Project.

The following is the summary of the public hearing proceedings, reflecting all the views and concerns expressed by the assembled public at the venue. It was recorded by the officials of the Regional Office, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Koraput.

1. Sri Ashok Ku. Panda, Kumbhariput

Sri Panda expressed that the Mines hill protects the local environment & warned that if hill to be given for mining it will destroy the environment, affect agriculture & water will be dried up. He demanded to give commitment for compensation by the company for the damage to be occurred and for the peripheral development. He also cited the example of NALCO and stressed upon the protection of the environment and protection of paddy crops from the dust to be generated from the mining. Further, he strongly advocated for protection of Water, Forest and Land in their locality since it is coming under scheduled area. He strongly demanded for compensation, peripheral development and employment to the local youth by the project, otherwise they are not going to allow the mines to come. He enquired about the company to whom the lease has been given and strongly opposed to give mines to any Andhra company as Andhra trying to grab Kotia area of Odisha. He apprehended that if Andhra Company will take the mines, the Border village near to Kunteshu mine may be occupied by Andhra.

2. Sri Gouranga Patra, Zilla Parisad Member, Bandhugaon Zone-I

Sri Patra expressed that Andhra Company wants to take away their mines by offering money and they will strongly oppose the company. Further he expressed that mining will be allowed only with their consent and the local educated youth shall be employed in the mines. He informed that it is a tribal area and Andhra Government trying to take away the mines by giving attractive package to them and he apprehended that later they will be betrayed. He appealed to the local tribal people that no mines is required in their area as the soil, water and the air is good for them and he strongly oppose the mines for sake of their land.

3. Sri Pandu Haraka, Ex-Sarapanch, K-Jaguguda

Sri Haraka expressed his apprehension that Andhra Company may create problem for them. He urged that their children should be employed in the mines. He emphasized on proper action and informed that their livelihood depends on the mines hills and through cultivation. He demanded that if mines will provide better education and life, then mines may set up or else there is no need of the mine. He submitted a written representation to the chair.

4. Sri Bala Nag, Bada Sarupalli, Bandhugaon

Sri submitted a written representation to the chair and expressed that if mines to be established in their area then it must be welcomed. He hoped that the mines will develop their livelihood, education, health facilities and environment. He informed that Company made a provision of Rs 11.5 Lakhs for peripheral development and hoped that there will be overall development of 13 Panchayats & 169 villages. He cited the example of development of local people of Kashipur and Laxmipur due to Plant and Kodingamali mines respectively.

He informed that the mines area is completely barren and no scope for cultivation and grazing. Further he informed that there will be no blasting which will not affect the surrounding agricultural land and only cutting for blocks will be carried out.

5. Sri Ananta Bidika, Kunteshu

Sri Bidika informed that rock hill of the village exists since their ancestors and that hill has no use even not fit for grazing purposes. He expressed that the company has made commitment for providing roads, drinking water and education facilities to their village. He expressed that they are ready to give mines with the consent of local tribal villagers. He submitted a written representation to the chair.

6. Sri Raghunath Uttarkabat, Kunteshu

Sri Uttarkabat informed that the villagers agreed to give that barren hill to the Government for mining. He submitted a written representation to the chair.

7. Sri Jagara Pidika, Kambesh, Jaguda

Sri Pidika informed that the villagers are agreed for establishment of the mines as they do not have to go to others state as migrant labourer for their livelihood. He strongly supported the company to set up in their village for employment of the villagers and to lead a good life. He submitted a written representation to the chair.

8. Sri Pandu Pidika, Yasada, Bandhugaon

Sri Pidika expressed that their youth going to Karnataka, Tamilnadu as migrant labourers and facing various difficulties. He hoped that if company will set up they will be benefitted and enjoy a good social relations. He expressed that they have faith on Government only and welcomed the project through Government.

9. Smt Tenchi Huika, Sarapanch, Jaguda

Smt Huika informed that their villagers and youth are going as migrant labourers and if company will come, they will be benefitted.

10. **Sri Suba Rao Huika, PukerIngi**

Sri Huika requested to start the mines for employment of the local youths who are going to other areas as migrant labourers. He expressed that the people of 13 Panchayats of Bandugaon Block will be benefitted due to the company and they will allow the company to operate as per their norms or else they will oppose. Further he added that company can operate with cooperation of all.

11. **Sri Ladu Huluka, HDC Bandhugaon**

Sri Huluka informed that no plant has yet been established in Bandhugaon Block and he expressed his happiness about the hearing for the project. He opined that any company even Andhra Company also helps for socio-economic development of the locality and if any problem will arise due to company they will oppose. Further he expressed that there will be no development without industry and there will be development of education and environment due to the company. He expressed that they are still living in jungle without any facilities including sanitation. He hoped that there will be overall development of the locality and suggested to form committee in each 13 Panchayats to look after the welfare of the local peoples through discussion with the company. Further he told that no development has been done in 13 Panchayats of Bandhugaon Block and hoped that local people will be benefitted by the company and sought the cooperation of the public to set up the company. He stressed on formation of committee in each Panchayat for betterment of the locality.

12. **Sri Nabin Ch. Pradhan, Kumbhariput**

Sri Nabin Ch. Pradhan welcomed the company for development of the village and the block and he urged that there should not be any pollution problem, cutting of trees, drying of streams, adverse impact on agriculture and any problem to the public due to the mines. He supported the development of education, drinking water, sanitation and health facilities by the company. He suggested for formation of committee in each Panchayat for the project and expressed his apprehension that the Andhra Company may betray the local Odia youths for employment which needs to be addressed. He emphasized on execution of agreement with the Government to ensure the employment of local Odia youth in the company instead of Andhra people and urged that the committee should monitor the employment of the locals.

13. **Sri Srinivas Pattanaik, Advocate, Bandhugaon**

Sri Pattanaik informed that there was no Industry in Badhugaon & local villagers used to cultivate Lemon Grass for their Livelihood. He welcomed the project & told that the unemployment problem is severe in the area. He urged that the local unemployed & educated youth should get job in the company. He stressed on development of educational facilities & protection of Forest & local Environment by the company so that local Tribals natural Environment should not be disturbed. He suggested that committee at Panchayat level needs to be formed to monitor the activities of the company in order to get support for its progress. He hoped that there will be development of the locality if company will operate as per their norms & they will welcome project.

14. **Sri D. Anketi, Bandhugaon**

Sri Anketi informed that peoples of the area are facing difficulties & no proper facilities like roads, water, electricity, network etc available in this area. Everybody hopes that the project will bring prosperity in the locality & urged that Government should look for development, maintain of Environment, law & order situation of the locality. He expressed Bandhugaon is a peaceful area &

appealed to maintain Peace & Tranquillity by the locals & the mines should operate as per consent of the committee. He emphasised on employment of local youths in the project as they are going as migrant labourers to other states. He demanded that part of revenue to be generated from the project should be utilised for local development & stressed on maintain of local environment & welfare of the public so that both Government & Local people will be benefitted. He warned that any deviation to their demand may lead to public protest in future.

15. Sri Marega Haraka, Jaguguda

Sri Haraka suggested operating the mines with the consent of the local committee for development of the locality. He appealed to the locals to unite for the development of Bandhugaon & welcomed the project.

16. Sri Tankua Chitru, Bada Bankidai

Sri Chitru introduced himself as a Tribal Advocate. He emphasised on written agreement with the company for development of Bandhugaon prior to establishment of the company. He informed that Lemon grass being cultivated in the area & they are getting Rs 30000/- per Acre within two months & agreement required to keep this money.

17. Sri Dineswar Kalupa, K. Jaguguda

Sri Kalupa emphasised on benefits of the local people due to mines. He drew attention regarding advantage & disadvantage of mining & informed about air & noise pollution due to mining activities. He cautioned about infant mortality due to mining & asked the project to take preventive measures to protect their health. He further expressed that if any problem will be there due to mining company shall be responsible.

18. Sri Sriram Haraka, K. Jaguguda

Sri Haraka expressed it as a great day & sang a song on this occasion.

The Regional Officer, SPCB, Koraput read over the issues raised by the public in the hearing. Sri Ajit Kumar Sarangi on behalf of Project Proponent responded to the issues raised.

The issues raised by the public and corresponding comments of the applicant were prepared in Odia and English and it is annexed with the proceedings as Annexure I & II respectively, list of the oral deliberators and participants in the hearing is annexed as Annexure III & IV respectively. Six written representations received during public hearing is annexed as Annexure-V (a to f). The videography of proceedings are recorded and submitted as DVD (I).

IN MUNDAPADAR VILLAGE UNDER BANDHUGAON TAHASIL OF KORAPUT DISTRICT IN RESPECT OF KUNTESHU DECORATIVE STONE (GARNETIFEROUS GRANITE GNEISS) MINES OF SRI NEMANI RAMAKRISHNA WITH PRODUCTION CAPACITY OF 2400 CUM /ANNUM OVER AN AREA OF 13.703 HA. IN VILLAGE KUNTESU NO.53 UNER BANDHUGAON TAHASIL OF KORAPUT DISTRICT.

Issues raised by the public in hearing meeting	Response by the Project Proponent
A. ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES	
1. Protection of natural environment i.e. water, forest & land.	<p>Opencast mining with semi- mechanised method will be followed for the mining operation. Blasting will not be carried out for excavation of decorative stone.</p> <p>The lease area will be fenced with high wall cover surrounding the area in order to prevent illegal outside infiltration.</p> <p>The mining activity is not likely to intersect ground water as the ground water table occurs at 480 mRL in summer season and in Rainy season at 588 mRL.</p> <p>The mining will go up to the maximum depth of 588 mRL. So there will be no chance of intersecting the ground water table by the mining activity during the conceptual period also.</p> <p>During the life of the mine, a total of 12.473 Ha of lease area will be degraded under mining. The land under the quarry area will be converted to water reservoir and plantation will be carried out along the boundary of the reservoir.</p> <p>The dumping area, mineral storage area will be reclaimed and utilized for plantation. 2. Drying of Streams & affect agricultural land due to mining.	<p>There are no perennial or seasonal streams coming out of the Mines hillock. Water accumulation is observed in the low lying area formed by earlier excavation for boulders and road metals before the grant of lease.</p>

	<p>We have proposed for rain water harvesting through land surface catchments both in paved and unpaved area. The dug out area will be developed in to a pond for rain water harvesting for use in Mines for drilling and water spraying in roads for dust suppressing and for developing green belt around the mines.</p> <p>The agriculture of the locality is mostly rainfed and mostly paddy is cultivated in the area.</p> <p>The surplus water will be provided to the local farmers for cultivation of seasonal crops in Rabi season.</p>

1. Compensation on damage of Environment & Agriculture land.	<p>The entire area belongs to Pahad Kissam under the category of Abada, Ajogya and Anabadi. So, the mining area does not involve any private land nor would affect any agricultural land in any way.</p> <p>Moreso, Mining is essentially proposed by opencast and semi mechanized method with the deployment of machines and it does not have any blasting technology.</p> <p>Rather the mining activities is confined within the lease area itself Ha of the land will be utilized for green belt development. The quarry area will be converted to water reservoir with plantation along the boundary.</p> <p>The land under the quarry area will be converted to water reservoir and plantation will be carried out along the boundary of the reservoir. The dumping area, mineral storage area will be reclaimed and utilized for plantation.</p>
2. Employment to the local Odia youth in the project.	<p>It has been assured that direct employment will be given to 25 local people in the mines as per the qualification criteria.</p> <p>Further there will be indirect employment for about 100 people due to mining allied activities.</p>
