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**PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING CONDUCTED ON 23.09.2021 AT 11 AM AT BHAGABAT GRUHA, JATIA (KHATA NO. 24, PLOT NO. 696, AREA AC. 0.02, KISAM- GHARBARI) IN DHENKANAL DISTRICT IN RESPECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT OF PROJECT PROPOSED BY THE TAHASILDER PARJANG FOR BRAHMANI RIVER SAND QUARRY, JATIA OVER AN AREA OF 6.046 HA. AT/MAUZA- JATIA, PARJANG TAHASIL OF DHENKANAL DISTRICT.**

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Public hearing in respect of Environmental Assessment of project proposed by the Tahasildar Parjang for Brahmani River Sand Quarry, Jatia over an area of 6.046 Ha. At/Mauza- Jatia, ParjangTahasil of Dhenkanal District.

Sri Sasanka Sekhar Dash, Additional District Magistrate, Dhenkanal District, supervised and presided over the meeting, assisted by Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional officer, State Pollution Control Board, Angul and the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, SPC Board, Angul welcome the other panel member and the public, gave a introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notifications 2006 in respect of Environmental Assessment of project proposed by the Tahasildar Parjang for Brahmani River Sand Quarry, Jatia over an area of 6.046 Ha. At/Mauza- Jatia, Parjang Tahasil of Dhenkanal District.

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Sri Deba Prasad Choudhury, Consultant, Right source Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd. on behalf of the proponent addressed the committee members and assembled public and gave a brief description about the proposed project. He also briefed about Brahmani River Sand Quarry, Jatia over an area of 6.046 Ha. At/Mauza- Jatia, Parjang Tahasil of Dhenkanal District. He also briefed about the peripheral development work that will be taken up in this area, and made a presentation about the environmental management, pollution control measures, solid waste-management of the related project. The copy of the statement of the industry read out at public hearing proceedings is enclosed.

Regarding Public hearing in respect of Environmental Assessment of project proposed by the Tahasildar Parjang for Brahmani River Sand Quarry, Jatia over an area of 6.046 Ha. At/Mauza- Jatia, Parjang Tahasil of Dhenkanal District was publicized at the office notice Board of Saranga Gram Panchayat office notice Board, BDO Office at Parajang, Zilla Parishad (Zone-1) Office, Kamakhyanager, Tahasil office notice Board, Parjang, Sub-Collector, Kamakhyanager office and Jatia village.

Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Angul & representative of State Pollution Control Board Odisha then invited the public to present their views about the proposed project on environmental consideration.

The views expressed by various speakers are as follows:

1	Sri Susanta Kumar Sahu, Jatia village
	He expressed that the jatia village people mostly depends on cultivation. There is only single road exists through which the truck will move from sand quarry to NH. During movement of sand loaded trucks the nearby crops surrounding the road side may damage and senior citizens will not able to walk properly on this road. There may happen accidents. Due to operation of sand quarry the villagers will not able to get any benefit. He requested to the District Administration to look into this matter.

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2	Sri Dibesh Chandra Behera, Jatia village
	He expressed that till date Collector and District Magistrate, Dhenkanal District has not visited their village. He mentioned that due to movement of sand loaded vehicles, there may be every possibility of the village road getting damaged. Till date Government has not taken any steps to repair the village road. He mentioned that without the final decision of their village Secretary, they will not allow sand mining activity.
3	Smt. Jyotsna Rani Biswal, Jatia village
	She expressed that the proposed sand mining area of the Brahmani River which Government has selected for sand mining activity is being used by Jatia villagers as Bathing ghat. She mentioned that there is no separate bathing ghat exists for the Jatia village. Due to operation of sand quarry, the surrounding environment may degrade. She finally told that if sand mining starts the villagers will face problem with respect to bathing problem.
4	Smt. Satyabhama Sahoo, Jatia village
	Without elaborating anything in detail she expressed that she will go with the final decision of their village President.
5	Sri Saroj Kant Sahoo, Jatia village
	He expressed that if the jatia sand mining operation starts, the villagers will face so many problems. He on behalf village committee told that they will not support Jatia sand mining operation.
6	Sri Hemanta Kumar Sahoo, Jatia village, Ward Member
	He on behalf of the Jatia village committee expressed that they will not allow the operation of Jatia Sand Quarry over Brahmani river.
7	Smt. Jutin Dehury, Jatia village
	Without elaborating anything in detail she did not supported the proposed sand mining project.
8	Sri Sunil Kumar Sahoo, Jatia village
	He supported the proposed jatia sand mining project. But he also mentioned that they will not allow to use Jatia village road for movement of sand loaded

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	vehicles.
9	Sri Kulamani sahoo, Jatia village
	He expressed that Jatia village road is being used by children's for their playing activities. If the road is being used by sand loaded vehicles there may be the accident. So, he did not support the sand mining project.
10	Smt. Rudni Sahoo, Jatia village
	Without elaborating anything in detail she did not supported the proposed sand mining project.
11	Smt. Mamata Sahoo, Jatia village
	She expressed that if the jatia sand mining operation starts, their village children will face so many problems. So, she did not support the sand mining project.
12	Sri Dukha Bandhu Sahoo, Jatia village
	He expressed that earlier the Jatia Sand quarry was operated by the villagers. It should not be auctioned.
13	Smt. Mandila Sahoo, Jatia village
	Without elaborating anything in detail she did not supported the proposed sand mining project.
14	Sri Dushmanta Sahoo, Jatia village
	He supported the proposed jatia sand mining project. But he also mentioned that District Administration should construct separate road for movement of sand loaded vehicles.
15	Sri Chikun Sahoo, Jatia village
	He expressed that if the jatia sand mining operation starts, the villagers will face so many problems. Particularly children may face accident. There may be air pollution. He finally did not support the project.
16	Sri Pradyumna Kumar sahoo, Jatia village
	He supported the proposed jatia sand mining project. But he also mentioned that District Administration should construct separate road for movement of sand loaded vehicles otherwise children may face many problems. He urged to

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	the District Administration that during sand mining activity the mine proponent should follow the guideline in all respect and to ensure that sand mining is done in environmentally sustainable and socially responsible manner.
17	Sri Bapuji Dehury, Jatia village
	He expressed that the proposed sand mining area of the Brahmani River which Government has selected for sand mining activity is being used by Jatia villagers as Bathing ghat. He mentioned that there is no separate bathing ghat exists for the Jatia village. He finally told that if sand mining starts the villagers will not get even a drop of water and may face problem with respect to bathing in Brahmani river.
18	Sri Citan Sahoo, Jatia village
	He expressed that if the jatia sand mining operation starts, the villagers will face so many problems. He on behalf village committee told that they will not support Jatia sand mining operation.
19	Sri Surya Kanta Sahoo, Jatia village
	He expressed that Jatia village road is being used by children's for their playing activities. If the road is being used by sand loaded vehicles there may be the accident. He expressed that the proposed sand mining area of the Brahmani River which Government has selected for sand mining activity is being used by Jatia villagers as Bathing ghat. He mentioned that there is no separate bathing ghat exists for the Jatia village. He also mentioned that if sand mining starts the nearby Lift Irrigation point may not function properly. He finally told that if sand mining starts the villagers will not able to go for open defecation on the bank of river and may face problem with respect to bathing in Brahmani river.
20	Sri Madan Parida, Jatia village
	He expressed that if the jatia sand mining operation starts, the villagers will face so many problems. There is only single road which approaches from the village to sand quarry. Finally, he did not support the sand mining project.
21	Sri Narottam Parida, Jatia village
	He expressed that if the jatia sand mining operation starts, there will be more agitation among the villagers. Due to past sand mining operation, there was

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	much agitation happened among the villagers. He mentioned that villagers do not want to face similar problem in future.
22	Sri Srikadar Sahoo, Jatia village
	As a senior citizen he expressed that if the Jatia sand mining operation starts, the villagers will face so many problems.
23	Sri Jogindra Dehury, Jatia village
	He expressed that from National Highway to Jatia village sand quarry there is a narrow single road exists. Two vehicles cannot cross at a time. He mentioned that if sand mining starts there will be movement of sand loaded heavy vehicles (HIYA) through this narrow village road for which entire village people particularly children and senior citizen will face many problems and there may be accident. He also mentioned that the proposed sand mining area of the Brahmani River which Government has selected for sand mining activity is being used by Jatia villagers as Bathing ghat. He mentioned that there is no separate bathing ghat exists for the Jatia village. He on behalf village committee told that they will not support Jatia sand mining operation.
24	Sri Dukha Bandhu Behera, Jatia village
	He expressed that since last 20 years villagers are facing different issues with respect to this sand quarry and due to illegal operation of Jatia sand quarry the villagers has filed case before the Hon'ble Court which still pending. He on behalf village committee told that they will not support Jatia sand mining operation.
25	Sri Ananda Sahu, Jatia village
	He expressed that few years before one contractor in the name of Sri Pramod Bal had operated this Jatia sand quarry illegally and at that time due to movement of sand loaded trucks the village road was completely damaged. Accordingly, the villagers filed a case to Hon'ble High Court of Odisha. Later Collector and District Magistrate, Dhenkanal solved the above issue. He also mentioned that another sand quarry was illegally operated and they have made sand barrier over the Brahmani river. In that context they had also made complaint to Collector and District Magistrate, Dhenkanal. He expressed that

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	<p>Jatia village road is being used by children's for their playing activities. If the road is being used by sand loaded vehicles there may be the accident. He expressed that the proposed sand mining area of the Brahmani River which Government has selected for sand mining activity is being used by Jatia villagers as Bathing ghat. He mentioned that there is no separate bathing ghat exists for the Jatia village. He expressed that if the jatia sand mining operation starts, the villagers will face so many problems. He on behalf village committee told that they will not support Jatia sand mining operation.</p>
26	<p>Sri Samanath Pradhan, Jatia village</p> <p>He expressed that the sand quarry belongs to Jatia village. Last year the villagers requested to the District Administration to use the sand quarry for villagers different construction. But this year they came to know that auction will take place for this village sand quarry. He expressed that if the Jatia sand mining operation starts, the villagers will face so many problems. He on behalf village committee told that they will not support Jatia sand mining operation.</p>
27	<p>Smt. Jhunu Bala Sahoo, Jatia village</p> <p>She expressed that Jatia village road is being used by children's for their playing activities. If the road is being used by sand loaded vehicles there may be the accident. She expressed that the proposed sand mining area of the Brahmani River which Government has selected for sand mining activity is being used by Jatia villagers as Bathing ghat. The bank of the river is also being used for open defecation. She mentioned that there is no separate bathing ghat exists for the Jatia village. She said that the village road is very narrow and at a time two vehicle can not pass side by side. She expressed that if the Jatia sand mining operation starts, their village children will face so many problems. So, she did not support the sand mining project.</p>
28	<p>Smt. Jayanti Sahoo, Jatia village</p> <p>She expressed that if the Jatia sand mining operation starts, their village children will face so many problems. So, she did not support the sand mining project.</p>
29	<p>Smt. Sukanti Prusty, Jatia village</p>

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	She expressed that if the jatia sand mining operation starts, their village children will face so many problems. So she did not support the sand mining project.
30	Smt. Rangabati Dehury, Jatia village
	Without elaborating anything in detail she did not supported the proposed sand mining project.
31	Smt. Bhudia Dehury, Jatia village
	Without elaborating anything in detail she did not supported the proposed sand mining project.
32	Sri Purosattam Dehury, Jatia village
	He expressed that Government has taken up many developmental programme for the villages of Odisha but he mentioned that till date they have not given covid vaccination. Finally, he did not support the sand mining project.
33	Sri Dayanidhi Behera, Jatia village
	He expressed that Jatia village road is being used by children's for their playing activities. If the road is being used by sand loaded vehicles there may be the accident. He expressed that the proposed sand mining area of the Brahmani River which Government has selected for sand mining activity is being used by Jatia villagers as Bathing ghat. He, finally told that as per the decision of village committee he will not support Jatia sand mining operation.
34	Sri Prasanta Sahoo, Jatia village
	He supported the views expressed speakers. He added that if the sand mining starts there will be generation of noise due to movement of trucks. The domestic animals will suffer many problems due to noise pollution. He did not support the sand mining project.

At the same time Sri Sunil Kumar Sahu, Sri Durga Sahu, Sri Abhaya Sahu, Sri Rama Chandra Behera and Sri Pradumnya Kumar Sahu of Jatia village submitted their written representation before the panel members are enclosed separately.

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**Observation:**

Construction of separate road for sand loaded truck movement, repair and maintenance of village road, strictly follow of sand mining guideline, apprehension of road accident, narrow village road, maintain adequate distance from the bank of river etc. were the most important issues emerged during the discussion.


