



PROCEEDINGS OF PUBLIC CONSULTATION (HEARING) OF EXPANSION PROJECT OF MAHULSUKHA IRON & MANGANESE ORE MINES OF M/S PATNAIK MINERALS PVT. LTD., HELD ON 08-10-2021 (11 AM) AT- BHUTUDA GRAM PANCHYAT OFFICE UNDER LAHUNIPADA BLOCK OF SUNDARGARH DIST. (ODISHA)

Public consultation (hearing) of M/s Patnaik Minerals Pvt. Ltd. was held on 08-10-2021 at 11 AM at- Bhutuda gram Panchyat Office under Lahunipada Block of Sundargarh district in the state of Odisha for their application relating environmental clearance on proposed expansion of Mahulsukha Iron & Manganese Iron Ore Mines. Addl. District Magistrate (ADM), Sundargarh presided over the consultation (hearing) meeting. In the beginning, the Regional Officer, Rourkela of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha and ADM explained the villagers on the aspects of consultation (hearing) for environmental clearance under E. I. A. Notification, 2006 and invited M/s Patnaik Minerals Pvt. Ltd, to address public on details of the expansion project of the existing Iron & Manganese Ore mines and its environmental aspects for their views onward. Sri Jitendar Nath Patnaik, Managing Director of M/s Patnaik Minerals Pvt. Ltd. addressed public on the expansion project and Dr. A. Biswal, representative of mines addressed its environmental aspects. ADM then invited the public to address their views on environmental aspects of the project. 41 nos. of villagers opined their views as mentioned below. Attendance sheets of villagers present & signed and who addressed views are annexed in Annexure – 1 & 2 respectively.

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
