

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING HELD ON 26.11.2021 (AT 10.30 AM) IN DANAGADI BHAWAN FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE IN RESPECT OF M/S JINDAL COKE LIMITED, JAJPUR FOR THE PROPOSED EXPANSION OF COKE PRODUCTION FROM 0.425 MTPA TO 0.78 MTPA BY INSTALLATION OF NEW STAMP CHARGE BY-PRODUCT RECOVERY COKE OVEN BATTERY (COBP#2) WITHIN THE EXISTING STEEL PLANT AT KALINGANAGAR INDUSTRIAL COMPLEX, TEHSIL DANAGADI IN THE DISTRICT OF JAJPUR, ODISHA

The public hearing in respect of the Jindal Coke Limited for proposed expansion project on Coke production from 0.425 MTPA to 0.78 MTPA by installation of new stamp charge by product recovery coke oven battery within the existing plant premises at Kalinganagar industrial complex, Tehsil Danagadi in Jajpur District was held on scheduled date & time in Danagadi Bhawan, Danagadi in the District of Jajpur with reference to EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006 and amendments thereof.

Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, Jajpur, supervised & presided over the public hearing process and assisted by Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of Jindal Coke Limited, at Kalinganagar industrial complex, Tehsil Danagadi in Jajpur District.




Welcoming the public, Sri Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, Jajpur welcomed the public and explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He reminded public that the Public Hearing meeting is being conducted following the Social distancing and COVID-19 guideline. He requested the public to follow the Social distancing and COVID guidelines during the public hearing process. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public.

On behalf of the project proponent, Sri Satya Narayan Nayak, Manager (Environment) of M/s Jindal Coke Limited briefed the expansion proposal and Environmental impact of the expansion project. He addressed the dais and assembled public and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed expansion project, environmental management, pollution control measures, afforestation programme and various other peripheral development activities envisaged in the proposed expansion project.

Then Sri Mishra, ADM, Kalinganagar, Jajpur, requested the public to give their views, comments and opinions on the proposed project.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:

1. **Sri Bhagirathi Tarai, Tikara**  
He expressed his support to the proposed expansion project of M/s. JCL and informed that the company has carried out many developments work in the peripheral area i.e. education, health, drinking water facility etc.
2. **Ms. Kaminibala Biswal, Jakhapura**  
Welcoming the panel, she expressed her support to the proposed expansion project of M/s Jindal Coke Limited.
3. **Sri Pratap Charan Dalai, Marutikar**  
Welcoming the panel & gathering, he expressed his support for the proposed expansion project.
4. **Sri Krupasindhu Samantaray, Damodarpur**  
Sri Samantaray expressed his grievance that Sukinda people are not getting any benefit from the industries in Kalinganagar area. He opposed the public




hearing and complaint on the pollution caused by the industry in the area. He further complaint deforestation, unemployment and environment pollution in the Kalinganagar area.

5. **Ms. Labani Tarei, Tikani**  
She supported the expansion proposal of the company.
6. **Sri Nasrin Kausar, Dhabaigiri**  
She expressed her support for the proposed expansion project and demanded the company to take step for pollution control in the area.
7. **Sri Trilochan Jena, Solei**  
Sri Jena supported the expansion project and demanded employment and plantation in the local area.
8. **Sri Abhimanyu Dalai, Mantira**  
He welcomed the expansion proposal of M/s JCL and requested local employment for the nearby village people.
9. **Sri Sagar Dhir, Dhuligarh**  
Sri Dhir expressed his grievance that local people are getting affected by pollution caused by industries of Kalinganagar industrial area. He demanded the Administration to resolve the local issues before conduct of the public hearing.
10. **Ms. Kshanaprava Nayak, Kambhiragadia**  
Ms. Nayak supported the proposed expansion project of the company. She informed the public that M/s JCL is preparing to construct a school and medical in the area but not able to complete due to land issue. She reminded that the local area has been developed due to industrialization. She hoped that some local people will get employed in the project and requested the company to take step for water and air pollution control in the area.
11. **Ms. Sasmita Parija, Jajpur Road**  
Welcoming the panel and gathering, she informed that M/s JCL is carrying out many development activity in the area and hoped for many more development work to continue in the local area. She requested to take step for water pollution control and demanded plantation, facility to local school & colleges. She expressed her support towards proposed expansion project.
12. **Sri Dayanidhi Palai, Satabainsia**  
Sri Palai signed the register to express his views on the expansion proposal but did not turn up to express his views.




13. **Ms. Urbasi Nayak, Jakhapura**  
She expressed her support for the proposed expansion project and demanded plantation in the area.
14. **Ms. Minati Maharana, Jakhapura**  
She demanded plantation, medical and education facility in the area.
15. **Ms. Rupashree Brahma, Jakhapura**  
She supported the expansion proposal of M/s JCL.
16. **Ms. Harapriya Ray, Pankapal**  
She expressed her support towards the expansion project.
17. **Ms. Madhusmita Mohapatra, Pankapal**  
Ms Mohapatra expressed her support for the expansion project and demanded employment and air pollution control in the local area.
18. **Ms. Sanjukta Nayak, Kumbhiragadia**  
She expressed her support for the proposed expansion project and reminded the public that the local area has been developed by the industry. She requested M/s JCL to construct a medical college for treatment of patient in the area.
19. **Ms. Aradhana Ray, Pankapal**  
She expressed her support for the proposed project.
20. **Ms. Sasmita Samal, Danagadi**  
She supported the project.
21. **Ms. Lilamprava Jena, Pankapal**  
She expressed her support towards the expansion project.
22. **Ms. Bilasini Mallik, Mangalpur**  
She expressed her support for the proposed expansion project.
23. **Ms. Kanchanbala Dhal, Jakhapura**  
She supported the expansion proposed and demanded local area development and employment to the local public.
24. **Ms. Usharani Behera, Pankapal**  
She expressed her support for the proposed expansion project.
25. **Sri Akshaya Singh, Mantira**  
He expressed his support to the expansion of M/s JCL.



26. **Ms. Lopamudra Nayak, Jakhapura**  
She informed that M/s JCL has taken many initiatives and carried out many developmental work in the local area. She demanded local employment, plantation & green belt development, medical & education facility in the local area. She expressed her support to the proposed expansion project.
27. **Sri Ranjan Kumar Dhir, Danagadi**  
Welcoming the dais & gathering, Sri Dhir expressed his grievance on the difficulty faced by the local public in the area. He supported the expansion proposal but demanded medical facility, road communication, plantation, education, local employment and dust pollution control in the area.

The Panel has received 41 nos. of written representations during the hearing. Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, ADM, Kalinganagar, Jajpur asked the project proponent to present their comments to the people with respect to the demands raised by the public in the public hearing meeting. Sri Tarun Kumar Rout, General Manager of M/s Jindal Coke Limited, made the commitment on issues raised by the public.
