

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING IN RESPECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT OF GOBINDAPUR DECORATIVE STONE MINES PROPOSED BY M/S. ODISHA MINING CORPORATION LTD., OVER MINING LEASE AREA OF 18.280 HECTARE AT VILLAGE GOBINDAPUR, PLOT NO. 1213, KHATA NO. 368 UNDER TANGI- CHOUDWAR TAHASIL OF CUTTACK DISTRICT

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The Public Hearing meeting in respect of Environmental Impact Assessment of Gobindapur Decorative Stone Mines proposed by M/s. Odisha Mining Corporation Limited (OMC) over mining lease area of 18.280 hectare at village Gobindapur, Plot No. 1213, Khata No. 368 under Tangi- Choudwar Tahasil of Cuttack district was held on 14.12.2021 at Sidhagiri Bidyapitha, Gobindapur under Tangi-Choudwar Tahasil in Cuttack district, Odisha at 11.30 AM with reference to:

1. EIA Notification S. O. 1533(E) dated 14.09.2006.
2. Interim Operational Guidelines.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting presided over by the Additional District Magistrate, Cuttack, the representatives of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of project proposed by M/s. Odisha Mining Corporation Limited.

Welcoming the public, Er. Rashmita Priyadarshini, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Cuttack, explained the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. She asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public.

On behalf of the project proponent, Sri Gangadhar Nayak, Addl. General Manager, M/s. Odisha Mining Corporation Limited addressed the committee members and the assembled public and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed

project, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management, afforestation programme and various other CSR activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Then Sri Purna Chandra Mishra, OAS (SAG), Additional District Magistrate, Cuttack welcomed the gathering and requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

**The following speakers gave their views on the above said project, which are given as follows:**

**1. Sri Prasanta Kumar Sahoo, Sarpanch, Gobindapur Gram Panchayat:**

He welcomed the dignitaries and public present in the meeting. He said that this public hearing is conducted for utilization of decorative stone of Gobindapur hill in the beautification for Shree Jagannath Temple, at Puri. He stated that our Hon'ble Chief Minister has taken steps in this regard and he is with the decision taken by his gram panchayat people.

**2. Sri Hrushikesh Nath, Gobindapur:**

He welcomed the dignitaries and public present in the meeting. He stated that Gobindapur Decorative Stone mine is situated in a small hillock which can be developed as a picnic spot. He questioned the project proponent regarding the need of employment, as their village people are earning enough. He also stated that Government should conduct proper survey of other similar resources so that stone may be supplied for the project of Lord Jagannath.

**3. Sri Udhaba Sahoo, Gopalpur:**

He welcomed the dignitaries and public present in the meeting. He stated that it is a beautiful place and trees should not be cut. He suggested that the administration should look into this aspect.

**4. Sri Madhusudan Pal, Gokulpur:**

He welcomed the dignitaries and public present in the meeting. He stated that Hon'ble Chief Minister of Odisha has announced to complete the beautification project of Sri Jagannath Temple at Puri within eighteen month. But OMC has prepared mining plan for 5 years. It indicates that OMC may use the decorative stone to derive commercial benefits which should not happen. He further suggested that the greenery of the hill should be enhanced by doing plantation.

5. **Sri Hrushikesh Nayak, Gokulpur:**

He welcomed the dignitaries and public present in the meeting. He stated that OMC has not clearly mentioned the exact quantity of the stone to be excavated and he apprehended that if the exact volume of the stone to be mined is not clearly indicated it may result in finishing the entire resources within one year by using modern technology. He stated that mining will cause deforestation which will affect the environment and the movement of heavy vehicles may damage the village road.

6. **Sri Malay Prusty, Bhatimunda:**

He welcomed the dignitaries and public present in the meeting. He said that if stone will be taken from the stone mine then the beauty of Gobindapur, Tangi-Choudwar area will be damaged. He said that it is a tourist place and ashram exists in this area. He questioned about the deforestation due to the proposed project and about the employment as many poor villagers of this area depend on the hill for fuel, stone for construction of their house. Further he suggested conducting another public hearing by inviting people of Gobindapur, Jaripada, Bhatimuna, Napanga and other area.

7. **Sri Bairagi Chinara, Gobindapur:**

He welcomed the dignitaries and public present in the meeting. He described the spiritual significance of the nearby religious places like Jalakgiri, Satasahabhaban cave, Mani Naga cave , Brahmacharika ashrama, Ananta ashrama, Nilagiri cave, Siddhagiri hadidas ashrama and Gupta Nilagiri. He expressed concern that mining activity may affect the environment of the nearby spiritual and religious places. He stated that earlier also a central team had conducted survey in search of gold mine in the same hillock. He requested to restore the scenic beauty of the hill. During the 1999 super cyclone, some people of Sabarapalli village were sheltered temporarily near Mani Naga cave. He described about the spiritual belief related to the surrounding places located nearby area and requested not to intervene.

8. **Sri Dillip Nayak, Gokulpur:-**

He welcomed the dignitaries and public present in the meeting. He Said that though in its report, M/s OMC has mentioned that the water level in the area is in good condition, but actually the people face sever water scarcity problem. He requested that the district administration should ask the RWSS to conduct proper ground water level survey for the water scarcity problem. He highlighted the problems caused by deforestation and suggested to look into this matter very seriously. He further stated that there is every

possibility of dust pollution inside the nearby school campus and it will affect the health condition of school children.

9. **Sri Sudarshan Das, Gokulpur:-**

He welcomed the dignitaries and public present in the meeting. He stated that the local people really want to know the details about the beautification projects of Lord Jagannath temple at Puri, but nobody from the temple administration has yet come to the village to discuss with the villagers about the same. He suggested that the amount of CSR activity towards providing medical facilities is not adequate. He highlighted the water scarcity problem being faced by the area and requested the administration to solve the issue.

10. **Sri Tarun Kumar Roul, Gobindapur:-**

He welcomed the dignitaries and public present in the meeting and said that people were unaware about the public hearing. He said that Government of Odisha is focusing upon plantation activities since last twenty years. By resorting to mining definitely this objective of government will be adversely affected. He highlighted the importance of large scale plantation for better condition of the environment. He expressed that development activity of the government should be carried out with detail discussion otherwise any alternative source which is away from human habitation should be considered.

11. **Sri Anadi Bai, Gobindapur:**

He welcomed the dignitaries and public present in the meeting. He complained that the Sarpanch has not informed many people about the public hearing. He further stated that as the stone will be utilized for the purpose of Lord Jagannath and the people of Odisha has faith on the lord. Lord Jagannath by his divine grace will always protect the village and the environment.

12. **Sri Bhagyadhar Sahoo, Gokulpur:**

He welcomed all and said that he has a serious doubt regarding the actual utilization of the stone to be mined from Gobindpur hill as nobody from Sri Jagannath Temple Administration has yet said anything till date, nor in this meeting that OMC will actually supply the stones for use in the temple of Lord Jagannath. He said that recently some puja has already been done by some agencies near the project site, even though public hearing was not done. He did not raise any specific environmental concern in his speech.

13. **Sri Rabindra Mallick, Gobindapur:**

He welcomed all and said that the local inhabitants depend upon the hill for cattle grazing, collection of woods, dry deaves and collection stone for house building. If mining activity will be carried out they will be affected.

14. **Sri Akshaya Kumar Maharana, Gokulpur:**

He stated that after Covid-19 now the world is affected by Omicron virus and the children are said to be at risk. Hence, at this moment the environmental pollution is a serious concern. It must be the focus of the administration to ensure that the children are not exposed to dust pollution. He further demanded that the project proponent can give a written commitment for generation of employment in the area. He demanded to know what benefits will be derived by the villagers from the project. He expressed concern that the road and water sources may be affected if the mining activities will be carried out rampantly in an unabated manner.

15. **Sri Manoj Das, Gobindapur:**

He welcomed all and said that the local people have adequate business opportunities they do not seek employment. Further he said that trees are planted on the hill which is going to be affected by the mining activity and they want to save the hill and plantation.

16. **Sri Pradeep Kumar Bai, Gobindapur:**

He welcomes the dignitaries present in the meeting and said that in the year 2017 government of Odisha has declared Govbindapur as a place of tourist attraction. Now the same government is planning for mining activities in the area which is antagonistic with its earlier objective. He advised that instead of transporting stone from a far away area like Gobindapur Government should also consider to find similar resources in and around Puri, Pipli and Khordha area. Apart from the above suggestions, he did not raise any specific environmental concerns.

17. **Sri Mahima Nanda Roul, Gobindapur:**

He welcomed all present in the meeting and highlighted the possible problem of dust pollution to be an outcome of mining activities and its effect. He also highlighted the water scarcity problem being faced by the local public. He stated that as the local people are depending on the hill. OMC should consider exploring in other areas.

18. Smt. Tukuni Nayak, Gokulapur:

She welcomed all the dignitaries present in the meeting and said that the local Sarapanch has not conveyed information to the 11 numbers of ward members of his her panchayat on this issue. So the people of the panchayat are unaware of it.

19. Sri Ranjan Kumar Das, Gobindapur:

He welcomed the dignitaries and public present in the meeting. He said that they will not allow OMC to take stone from the hill. He told that his villagers have represented their views peacefully in the meeting. He requested that the authorities should consider all such concerns and act accordingly to avoid public resentment.

Total nineteen nos. of people had registered their names to express their views, comments etc. and deliberated their views accordingly. About one hundred fifty Nos. of people were presented in the public hearing but all of them refused to sign in the attendance sheet. One written representation was received during the public hearing and the same is enclosed.

After all the speakers expressed their respective opinion and suggestion, the Additional District Magistrate, Cuttack asked the project proponent to give the reply, to the issues raised. On behalf of the project proponent, Sri Debendra Kumar Nanda, Chief Vigilance officer, M/s. Odisha Mining Corporation Limited addressed the committee members and the assembled public and put a reply on the issues raised by the public. The issues raised by the public and the commitments made by the project proponent has been prepared in English & Odia and attached separately.

The Additional District Magistrate, Cuttack ended the meeting with thanks to the public.

It is brought to the notice of all concerned that M/s Odisha Mining Corporation Ltd has proposed to have Environmental Assessment for Gobindapur Decorative Stone Mines over ML area of 18.280 Ha. in village Gobindapur, Plot No. 1213, Khata No. 368 under Tangi - Choudwar tehsil of Cuttack district to obtain Environmental Clearance from State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Odisha. The proponent has applied to the State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar for a Public Hearing.
