

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING IN RESPECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT OF BADAMBADI SAND BED MINES PROPOSED BY TAHASILDAR, CUTTACK SADAR ON RIVER KATHAJODI OVER AN AREA OF 5.06 HECTARE OR 12.50 ACRES AT UNIT 37, VILLAGE BADAMBADI UNDER CUTTACK SADAR TAHASIL OF CUTTACK DISTRICT

The Public Hearing meeting in respect of Environmental Impact Assessment of Badambadi Sand Bed Mines proposed by Tahasildar, Cuttack Sadar on River Kathajodi over an area of 5.06 hectare or 12.50 acres at Unit 37, village Badambadi under Cuttack Sadar Tahasil of Cuttack district was held on 08.11.2021 at the entry point of Badambadi Sand sairat source, Badambadi, Cuttack Sadar Tahasil in Cuttack district, Odisha at 11.30 am with reference to:

1. EIA Notification S. O. 1533(E) dated 14.09.2006.
2. Interim Operational Guidelines.

The Panel consists of the following members:

1. Sri Bijay Kumar Khandayatray, OAS (SAG), Additional District Magistrate, Cuttack
2. Er. Rashmita Priyadarshini, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Cuttack

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting presided over by the Additional District Magistrate, Cuttack, the representatives of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of project proposed by the Tahasildar, Cuttack Sadar.

Welcoming the public, Er. Rashmita Priyadarshini, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Cuttack, explained the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. Then Sri Bijay Kumar Khandayatray, Additional District Magistrate, Cuttack welcomed all and asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public.

Sri Sambit Kumar Garnayak, Tahasildar, Cuttack Sadar, project proponent, addressed the committee members and the assembled public and informed that they have engaged

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Environment Consultant i.e. M/s. Kalyani Laboratories Pvt. Ltd., Bhubaneswar for this project and requested them to make a presentation about the project. Sri Jagabandhu Bisoi, representative of M/s. Kalyani Laboratories Pvt. Ltd addressed the panel members and the assembled public. He made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management, afforestation programme and various other CSR activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Then Sri Bijay Kumar Khandayatray, Additional District Magistrate, Cuttack requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

The following speakers gave their views on the above said project, which are given as follows:

1. Sri Santayan Mishra, Khannagar, Cuttack:

He gave his introduction and welcomed the dignitaries and public present in the meeting. He said that he heard detail about the project as presented by the Kalyani laboratory on behalf of project proponent. He said that when sand quarry operation was started initially here at that time there was no public hearing process. This public hearing has been arranged by the Government may be due to the area of sand mining is 12.50 acres. He stated that through public hearing Government represent about their facts and public clear their doubts and give suggestion in the public hearing meeting. He said that this quarry is given to Khannagar Khapurua Silpanchal Puja Committee which is one of the puja committee of Cuttack. He states that this puja committee has done different social and philanthropist work in Cuttack city during cyclone, COVID situation or any social activities. These social activities are done by the puja committee by utilising the income obtained from this sand quarry operation. Any social services like marriages, helping to the poor or any social activities as requested by the administration are done by this puja committee using the fund of sand quarry. He informed that the puja committee has made plantation in the premises of Khannagar High School to protect environment. He stated that the puja committee will do plantation to bring green revolution and to control the pollution due to the operation of sand quarry. He mentioned that the puja committee has made contribution to the Chief Minister Relief fund, during 1999 Super cyclone, during natural calamity and 2020 Covid situation. He said that if the sand quarry will operate some unemployment people will get employment. He informed that the Puja committee will do plantation and water sprinkling on transportation road to control pollution due to sand quarry operation.

2. **Sri Aksnay Kumar Behera, Gopal Sahi, Cuttack:**

He welcomed the dignitaries and public present in the meeting. He thanked to the government for organising the public hearing. He said that Khannagar Puja committee has made plantation from this place to Press chhak. Every year this puja committee do plantation as per instruction of district administration and Cuttack Municipality Corporation. He mentioned that poor people those work in truck and tractors have lost their jobs since last two years due to non operation of the sand quarry. They are also getting sand at higher cost as sand quarry of this area is not in operation. He said that the sand of this area is useful in many construction activities and he requested to the district administration to allow the sand quarry to operate. He mentioned that the puja committee has done contribution to the Chief Minister Relief Fund during the cyclone Hudhud and also done many social activities during COVID situation. All these activities have been done by utilising the fund obtained from the sand quarry operation.

3. **Sri Badri Bishal Sahoo, Khannagar, Cuttack :**

He welcomed the dignitaries and public present in the meeting. He said that this sand quarry was not in operation since last two years due to which the family of the truck drivers and labourers have suffered a lot during the COVID situation. So he requested the district administration to allow to operate the sand quarry so that the poor family will get benefit. He said that this sand ghat is operated by Khannagar Khapuria Silpanchal Puja Committee every year and the Puja committee has done many social services even during the COVID situation also. This committee has done plantation, tourist shelter and house construction at Dhabaleswar and other social activities. He said that the puja committee utilise its fund for the development work of this area and also extends help to students for their education. Finally, he requested to the district administration to allow the sand ghat to operate so that people depend on it for their livelihood will get benefits. Regarding pollution he stated that the issues of dust pollution due to the operation of sand ghat can be controlled by water sprinkling and road sweeping. Cuttack Municipal Corporation sweeps the Ring Road regularly and the puja committee will also engage labourers to clean the road and do further plantation.

4. **Sri Laxmidhar Sahoo, Khannagar, Cuttack :**

He welcomed the dais and the people and spoke that, as the Badambadi sand ghat is not in operation since last two hears so they are bringing sand from distance place at

higher price. So he requested to the authority to allow the sand quarry operate so that they will get sand at lower price for the construction activity.

At the outset total four nos. of people had registered their names to express their views, comments etc. and deliberated their views accordingly.

After all the speakers completed their respective opinion and suggestion, the Additional District Magistrate, Cuttack asked the project proponent to give relevant reply, if any to the issues raised. Sri Jagabandhu Bisoi of M/s. Kalyani Laboratories Pvt. Ltd on behalf of the project proponent committed that the sand bed will be operated as per the government guidelines. He said that employment will be provided to the local people as per their eligibility. Necessary pollution control measures such as water sprinkling, green belt development will be done and they comply with the conditions given in the Environmental Management Plan.

Finally, the President of Public Hearing meeting, Sri Bijay Kumar Khandayatray, Additional District Magistrate, Cuttack declared ending of the meeting.

CAD-1382: It is brought to the notice of all concerned that Tahsildar, Sadar, Cuttack has proposed to have Environmental Assessment for Badambadi Sand Bed mines on River Kathajodi over ML area of 5.06 Ha. at Unit 37, village Badambadi under Sadar Cuttack tehsil of Cuttack district to obtain Environmental Clearance from State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Odisha. The proponent has applied to the State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar for a Public Hearing.

By virtue of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India Notification No. S.O. 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006, the Board has been authorized to conduct environmental public hearing and as such invites suggestions, views, comments and objections on matters relating to environmental aspects of the proposed project from all the persons including bonafide residents, environmental groups and others located at the proposed site / sites of displacement / sites likely to be affected.

For the above purpose, a person will only mean:

- Any person who is likely to be affected by the grant of Environmental Clearance.
- Any person who owns his control over the project with respect to which an application has been submitted for environmental clearance.
- Any association of persons whether incorporated or likely to be affected by the project and / or functioning in the field of environment.
- Any local authority within any part of whose local limits is within the neighborhood, wherein the project is proposed to be located.

Persons as above who desire to submit their views, comments, objections etc. relevant to the project, may do so in writing within 30 days from the date of publication of this notice addressing the same to the Member Secretary, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha through Registered Post. Besides this, persons interested to submit their views relevant to the proposed mining project in writing or orally may also do so during the public hearing to be conducted on 08.11.2021 at 11.30 A.M. at the entry point to the said sand sairat source under Cuttack Sadar Tahsil of Cuttack district. Public hearing shall be conducted strictly observing guidelines contained in COVID -19 pandemic restrictions issued by the MoEF&CC, Govt. of India vide OM No.22-25-IA.III, dated 09.06.2021 as well as Govt. of Odisha.
