PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING HELD ON 10.12.2021 (AT 11.00 AM) AT MOUZA-NAYAGARH (KHATA NO. 235, PLOT NO. 32/1) NEAR THE COMPLEX OF M/S SINDHUJA STEEL PVT. LTD. IN RESPECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT OF NAYAGARH IRON ORE MINES OF SHRI K. C. PRADHAN FOR ENHANCEMENT OF IRON ORE PRODUCTION FROM 80,000 TPA TO 3,00,135 TPA WITH OPENCAST SEMI-MECHANIZED MINING METHOD OVER MINING LEASE AREA OF 24.570 HA. AT VILLAGE NAYAGARH IN THE DISTRICT OF KEONJHAR FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE.

The public hearing in respect of the project proposed by Nayagarh Iron Ore Mines of Shri K.C. Pradan for enhancement of iron ore production from 80,000 TPA to 3,00,135 TPA with opencast semi-mechanized mining method over mining lease area of 24.570 Ha. at village Nayagarh under Jhumpura Tahasil of Keonjhar district was held on scheduled date & time with reference to:

I. EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006 and Amendments thereafter.

The Panel consisted of the following members:

- 2. Shri Puskar Chandra Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar, Odisha

Sushma Bilung, Additional District Magistrate, Keonjhar, supervised & presided over the public hearing process and was assisted by Shri Puskar Chandra Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting, the Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of the project proposed by Nayagarh iron ore mines of Shri K.C. Pradhan.

Shri Behera explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public, gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public. On behalf of the Project Proponent, Sri Manas Kumar Sahu (Mines Manager), Nayagarh iron ore mines of Shri K.C. Pradhan addressed the committee members and assembled public, and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management and various other CSR activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Then Shri Puskar Chandra Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:

1) Sri Somanath Munda, Zilla Parishad Member, Zone No.16, Jhumpura:

While supporting the Public Hearing and proposed production enhancement of the mine he expressed his happiness by stating that if the mine will enhance production, employment opportunity will be generated. He demanded for permanent employment, repairing of roads, drinking water, deep bore wells with overhead tank, arrangement of street lighting, recruitment of teachers to the local schools, loading & transporting contract to be awarded to the local, one Health Centre and ambulance services. He also stated that if in future company will go for transportation of ore through belt or pipe line, the company should discuss the proposal with the local villagers beforehand and obtain their consent.

2) Sri Krushna Chandra Mahanta, Sosial Welfare Member, Jalpaposhi:

While supporting the public Hearing he expressed that with the expansion of mine everybody will be benefited. He gave his consent with the view of his previous speaker.

3) Sri Radhakanta Naik, Adivasi Co-operative Society Secretary, Nayagarh:

While supporting the Public Hearing he state that this is a welcome step to enhance the production by which employment opportunity will be generated in all 7 villages which comes in around the mine lease. He requested for providing employment to the affected persons, construction of road, providing electricity, drinking water, pension to handicapped and old age persons. Afforestation to be done at the affected mine site as per CMPA Act, CSR fund to be allocated for development jobs like promotion of cultivation, irrigation facilities. Important shall be given for EIA report and social justice. He also stated that if in future company will go for transportation of ore through belt or pipe line, the company should discuss the proposal with the local villagers beforehand and minimum consent of 90% villagers is required. He also stated that to give priority for conservation of natural resources with proper utilization of natural resources. For transportation of mineral through rail, Nayagarh Adivasi Society to be involved. He also requested for Technical Education for their employability.

4) Sri Jaladhar Naik, Representative of Sarpanch, Nayagarh GP:

While supporting the proposed production enhancement of the mine he gave his consent to whatever his previous speaker Sri Radhakanta Naik briefed.

5) Sri Rabindra Kumar Naik, President, Nayagarh Adivasi Vikash Co-operative society:

While supporting the proposed production enhancement of the mine he expressed his happiness for the Public Hearing. At the same time he told that if the company will run the mine with the help/nexus of mafias, they will oppose. He demanded for employment to the residents of all the panchayats, better education facility, communication facilities, supply of drinking water, Electricity etc.

6) Sri Baburam Naik, Jhumpura:

While supporting the Public Hearing he told that by expansion of the mine they will be benefited and truck owners also will be benefited. He has given his consent whatever Sri Somnath Munda his previous speaker briefed. Further he told that now-a-days farming is not the ultimate source of their livelihood because often elephants destroy their agricultural products, so he requested for employment to the local youths. He further demanded for Medical facilities and drinking water facilities.

7) Sri Krushna Chandra Naik, Zone No.16, Jhumpura:

He supported the expansion proposal of the mine.

8) Sri Suresh Kumar Kandi, Nayagarh:

He supported the expansion proposal of the mine.

9) Maheswar Naik, Nayagarh:

While supporting the Public Hearing he demand health facility, employment to the affected villagers, afforestation project, conservation of natural resources, repairing of roads, street light, repairing of Maa Basuli Temple, proving educational facilities, drinking water, Electricity etc. Further, he told that if in future company has any plan for transportation of ore through belt line or pipe line before it they need to consult with the villagers and at-least 90% consent is required. He also told that to provide pension to handicapped and old age persons.

10) Sri Niladri Bihari Misha, President Paribesh Surakhya Samiti, Joda:

While supporting the Public Hearing he stated that now-a-days extraction of ore is being done scientifically, as a result of this the silicosis diseases are not found here. He requested to abide by the commitment mentioned in the executive summery read out by the company authority.

11) Sri Jayanta Kumar Naik, President Nayagarh Panchayat Development Committee:

He supported the proposal of the mine.

12) Dushasan Sethy, Nayagarh:

He told that since 2018 till date the company has done nothing for them and no facilities has given to them. Nobody from company listen to their issues/grievances. Lastly he begged apology for addressing the audience.

13) Smt. Baidehi Naik, Member of Co-operative Society Nayagarh:

While supporting the Public Hearing she gave his consent whatever his previous speaker Sri Rdhakanta Naik stated.

14) Smt. Saraswati Naik, Nayagarh

She supported the proposed production enhancement of the mine.

15) Sri Rabindra Patra, Nayagarh:

While supporting the Public Hearing, he requested the Company Authority to come forward for all round development of this locality.

16) Sri Sanjay Mohanta, Nayagarh GP:

He supported the Public Hearing and told that Company should fulfill all the demands already raised by other speakers.

17) Sri Gagan Kamar Naik, Active Member, BJDS Nayagarh:

While supporting the Public Hearing, he requested the Company to provide employment within the radius of 10 KM distance. Further he told that Company Authority should promote for vegetable farming in this area. In this regard, he requested for allocate CSR fund for all round development of this locality.

18) Smt. Nirupama Patra, Ward Member, Ward No.09, Nayagarh:

She supported the Public Hearing as told by their Jilla Parisad.

19) Smt. Jayanti Naik, Nayagarh:

She stated that as told by Sri Somnath, he also supported the Public Hearing.

20) Sri Jaladhar Mahanta, Nayagarh:

He supported the production enhancement proposed by the mine.

21) Smt. Sujuni Dwari, Nayagarh:

She supported the proposal of the mine.

22) Sri Dhaneshwar Mahanta, Jalpapasi:

He supported the Public Hearing.

23) Sri Prasanta Kumar Naik, Member Nayagarh Co-operative Society:

He stated that as told by their Somnath Munda, Radha Bhai, Ravi bhai and Gaganbhai, he also supported the Public Hearing.

24) Sri Hrushikesh Mahanta, Jalpapasi:

He supported the proposed production enhancement of the mine.

25) Sri Dasaratha Mahanta ,Jalpapasi:

He supported the Public Hearing.

Employment to local people	Sri Manas Ranjan Sahu said that as the iron ore production will be enhanced to 3,00,135 TPA there will be provision for employment. The mine will provide direct employment to the people of Nayagarh Panchayat and other villages of the nearby locality as per their qualifications and skills.
➤ Education	He said, for development in the field of education mine has already recruited teachers for the local schools and after expansion of the mine more numbers of teachers will be provided as per the requirement.
➤ Health Care Facility	He said that as it is a small mine with less production capacity it is not possible to provide a primary health centre. But he assured that the mine will provide vehicles and all assistance required to the villagers in need of emergency.
> Pollution Control	Shri Sahu said that the mine is taking adequate steps for protection of the environment and will continue the same.
➤ Ore Transportation	 Shri Sahu said that the mine has always given priority to the local people to engage their trucks for transporting of minerals. Further, even after expansion of the mine full support will be extended to the local transport.
	ii. He also said that presently there is no plan of pipe line transportation, but in future if it is required the mine will discuss the same with the local Sarpanch and the local people before implementing it.

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Shri Sahu said they have the proposal of carrying out avenue plantation in the nearby villages with expansion of mine. Moreover, saplings will be distributed to the villagers as per the requirement.

> Welfare Activities

Shri Sahu gave assurance for the following welfare activities:

- i. To maintain the transportation road for trouble free movement of the local people.
- ii. To carry out the repairing work of village Mukteswar temple.
- iii. To provide assistance to the villagers for vegetable farming according to the capability of the mine.
- iv. To provide old age pension for the elderly people of the village.
- v. To provide street light facilities after sanction of fund by the company.
- vi. To form a committee with help of local Sarpanch and to allocate CSR funds for utilization in different aspects as per the requirements.

At the end he expressed his gratefulness to the gatherings for supporting the expansion proposal of the mine.
