

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING CONDUCTED ON 07.12.2021 AT 10:00AM AT HATAPADIA, MARATIRA IN THE DISTRICT OF ANGUL, IN RESPECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT OF PROJECT PROPOSED BY THE TAHASILDAR, BANARPAL FOR KRUSHNACHANDRAPUR CLUSTER HILLOCK STONE MINES DEPOSIT OVER AN AREA OF 17.18HA AT/MOUZA - KRUSHNACHANDRAPUR, TAHASIL- BANARPAL OF ANGUL DISTRICT

Public hearing of project proposed by the Tahasildar, Banarpal for Krushnachandrapur Cluster Hillock Stone Mines Deposit over ML area of 17.18 ha At/Mouza - Krushnachandrapur, Tahasil- Banarpal of Angul District was conducted on dated 07th December 2021 at 10:00AM at the scheduled location at Hatapadia, Maratira in the district of Angul as per EIA Notification, 2006.

The panel consisted of following members:

- i. Shri Santosh Kumar Pradhan, OAS(S), Additional District Magistrate (Revenue), Angul-Representative of the District Magistrate & Collector, Angul District
- ii. Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, SPC Board, Angul- Representative of State pollution Control Board, Odisha.

Shri Santosh Kumar Pradhan, OAS(S), Additional District Magistrate (Revenue), Angul District, supervised and presided over the meeting and was assisted by Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional officer, State Pollution Control Board, Angul and the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, SPC Board, Angul welcome the other panel member, representative of the proponent and the public, gave an introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notifications 2006 in respect of Environmental impact assessment of project proposed by Tahasildar, Banarpal for Krushnachandrapur Cluster Hillock Stone Mines Deposit over ML area of 17.18 ha At/Mouza - Krushnachandrapur, Tahasil- Banarpal of Angul District.

Sri Mrutyunjay Dash, Consultant, M/s. Kalyani Laboratories Pvt. Ltd., Bhubaneswar on behalf of the proponent addressed the committee members and assembled public and gave a brief description about the proposed project. He also briefed about the peripheral development work that had been taken up in this area, and made a presentation about the environmental management, pollution control measures, solid waste-management of




the related project. The copy of the statement of the industry read out at public hearing proceedings is enclosed.

As per EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14-09-2006, notice for public hearing of Krushnachandrapur Cluster Hillock Stone Mines Deposit over ML area of 17.18 ha At/Mouza - Krushnachandrapur, Tahasil- Banarpal in the District of Angul was publicized at Sankerjang GP notice Board, BDO Office at Banarpal, Zilla Parisad Office, Banarpal, Zone-25, Tahasil Office notice board, Banarpal, Sub Collector, Angul Office and Krushnachandrapur, Golabandha, Bhubanpur and Paranga village. The notice for public hearing was also was published in Odia Daily and English daily and displayed in the portal of SPCB website www.ospcboard.org for public information and comments.


Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Angul & representative of State Pollution Control Board Odisha then invited the public to present to present their views about the proposed project on environmental consideration.

The views expressed by various speakers are as follows:

1	Sri Bishwamitra Sahoo, Golabandha
	He welcomed the gathering and deliberated that whatsoever explained by the consultant, none of such work has been done the proponent although it is an existing quarry. Air and water pollution control and plantation has not been done in their area. If all steps as explained by the consultant will be adopted then decision for operation of the quarry will be taken by the village members.
2	Sri Sarathi Pradhan, Krushnachandrapur
	He welcomed the panel members and gathering and said that we have been called here for proposed stone quarry and the quarry is located at 500m away from their village and explained that their lives, dwellings, animals, etc. will be affected due blasting in the quarry. Flying rocks from the quarry during blasting may fall on their head and cause their death. He requested the government not to allow the quarry.
3	Sri Anadi Pradhan, President, Golabandha
	He said that proposal for quarry has already been passed in their village meeting and we don't have any problem with proposed quarry.
4	Sri Ranjan Pradhan, Krushnachandrapur
	He welcomed the gathering and expressed that survey should done for the proposed



	quarry in Krushnachandrapur & Golabandha and distance of quarry from their villages may be verified. After the survey it can only be decided whether quarry should be permitted or not.
5	Sri Bijay Pradhan, Krushnachandrapur
	He expressed that if quarry is allowed near to their village, their life will be in danger, therefore, keeping the danger in mind it is better not to allow the project.
6	Sri Dhadia Behera, Golabandha
	He said that proposal for quarry has already been passed in their village meeting and we don't have any problem with proposed quarry. Proponent will provide facilities for the welfare of village people.
7	Sri Sanjay Pradhan, Krushnachandrapur
	He deliberated that quarry is 500m away from their village having cattle, children and old people and requested not to allow the quarry.
8	Sri Trinath Pradhan, Golabandha
	He informed that about 200-300 numbers of people are benefitted by the quarry, therefore, quarry should be operated.
9	Sri Dhananjay Pradhan, Krushnachandrapur
	He expressed that if quarry is allowed near to their village, it will be dangerous for all of us therefore quarry should not be allowed.
10	Sri Tusakanta Singh, Paranga
	He said that quarry is being operated near to their village sine last 08-10 years, no problem has ever occurred to them, blasting is done after giving warning to them.
11	Sri Narendra Kumar Sahoo, Golabandha
	He informed that proposal for quarry has already been passed in their village meeting but government should also consider the views of others.
12	Sri Shantanu Pradhan, Krushnachandrapur
	He deliberated that quarry is 500m away from their village Krushnachandrapur and they are having children who will feel difficulty in going to school, cattle, old people are also in their village, their life will be in danger due to the project, therefore, quarry should not be allowed.
13	Sri Dhiren Behera, Golabandha
	He said that whatever proposals have been passed in their village meeting should be implemented, therefore, if the government will carry out its responsibility towards



	welfare of their village, they will be agreed.
14	Sri Sujit Kumar Sahoo, Paranga He said that quarry is being operated near to their village sine last 08-10 years, no problem has ever occurred to them, he wanted that quarry should operate.
15	Sri Manoj Pradhan, Krushnachandrapur He expressed that first survey should be done for measurement of distance between their village and quarry.
16	Sri Bhanupratap Mahakud, Paranga Without explaining anything in details he said that quarry should be allowed.
17	Sri Shankar Behera, Golabandha He said that quarry proposal has been passed in their village meeting and if all environmental guidelines will be followed by the proponent then they have no objection.
18	Sri Pinku Nath, Bhubanpur He said that blasting has been done in the existing quarry for last 6-7 years and till now no such problem has happened and we don't have any problem in operation of the quarry in future.

During public hearing, Sri Bhagirathi Pradhan and other villagers of Krushnachandrapur village submitted their written representation (01 No.) before the panel members which is enclosed separately.

Observation:

Pollution control measures, plantation, impact of blasting, local development, etc. were the most important issues/concerns emerged during the discussion.


Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Angul & representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, prepared the summary of the public hearing proceedings accurately reflecting the views and concerns expressed by the speakers with the inclusion of comments of the applicant read over to the audience at the end of the meeting explaining the contents in the ODIA Language and the agreed minutes of public hearing meeting was prepared. The statement of issues and concerns of public with the comments of applicant, prepared in Odia and English language is annexed herewith separately.



Development of local areas. 	<p>Shri Jitendra Kumar Sahoo, Tahasildar, Banarpal, Angul, proponent who was present at the public hearing gave his comments to certain demands raised by public as follows.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Controlled blasting as proposed in the approved mining plan shall be followed to avoid any incident. Quarry operation will be carried out at a safe distant from the village areas and other establishments as per orders of the Hon'ble NGT and CPCB guidelines 2. All environmental management measures proposed in the EIA report will be implemented. 3. Peripheral development works as proposed in the EIA report will be carried in consultation with village committee. .

It is brought to the notice of all concerned that The Tahasildar, Banarpal has proposed to have Environmental Assessment for **Krushnachandrapur Cluster Hillock Stone Mines Deposit over ML area of 17.18 ha. in village Krushnachandrapur under Banarpal tahasil of Angul district.** to obtain Environmental Clearance from State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Odisha. The proponent has applied to the State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar for a Public Hearing.

By virtue of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India Notification No. S.O. 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006, the Board has been authorized to conduct environmental public hearing and as such invites suggestions, views, comments and objections on matters relating to environmental aspects of the proposed project from all the persons including bonafide residents, environmental groups and others located at the proposed site/sites of displacement/sites likely to be affected. For the above purpose, a person will only mean:

- Any person who is likely to be affected by the grant of Environmental Clearance.
- Any person who owns his control over the project with respect to which an application has been submitted for environmental clearance.
- Any association of persons whether incorporated or likely to be affected by the project and/or functioning in the field of environment.
- Any local authority within any part of whose local limits is within the neighborhood wherein the project is proposed to be located.

Persons as above who desire to submit their views, comments, objections etc. relevant to the project may do so in writing within 30 days from the date of publication of this notice addressing the same to the Member Secretary, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha through Registered Post. Besides this, persons interested to submit their views relevant to the proposed mining project in writing or orally may also do so during the public hearing to be conducted on **07.12.2021 at 10.00 A.M.** at Hatapadia Maratra in Angul district. Public hearing shall be conducted strictly observing guidelines contained in COVID-19 pandemic restrictions issued by the MoEF&CC, Govt. of India vide OM No. 22-25-I.A.III, dated 09.06.2021 as well as Govt. of Odisha.
