

STATEMENT OF ISSUES RAISED BY THE PUBLIC AND COMMENTS OF THE PROPONENT IN THE PUBLIC HEARING FOR KHEMABEDA DECORATIVE STONE (DOLERITE/BLACK GRANITE) MINES OF SMT. DEVARA LATHA OVER AN AREA OF 8.353 HA IN VILLAGE KHEMABEDA UNDER BOIPARIGUDA TAHASIL OF KORAPUT DISTRICT CONDUCTED ON 22.12.2021 AT 11.00 AM IN KHEMABEDA VILLAGE OVER KHATA NO.247 PLOT NO.911 UNDER BOIPARIGUDA TAHASIL, DISTRICT: KORAPUT

i	Prevention of Pollution of Local environment & safe guard of health of villagers of surrounding villages due to cut down of trees and mining activities for longer period.	<p>The land use pattern of the mining lease area comes under the non forest agricultural land (Abada Ajogya Anabadi) with Kissam classified as Pahada.</p> <p>Opencast mining with semi- mechanised method will be followed for the mining of decorative stones.</p> <p>Blasting will not be carried out for excavation of decorative stone as it will damage the formation of decorative style of stones.</p> <p>The ground water table of the area occurs at maximum level of 645 mRL. The mining will go up to the maximum depth of 659 mRL. So there will be no chance of intersecting the ground water table during the course of mining activity.</p> <p>In order to reduce the air pollution level within the mining lease area; following measures proposed to be adopted.</p> <p>There is proposal of green belt development in the safety zone as well as in the dumping area alongwith the reclaimed area around 0.944 Ha. **PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING FOR KHEMABEDA DECORATIVE STONE (DOLERITE/BLACK GRANITE) MINES OF SMT DEVARA LATHA OVER AN AREA OF 8.353 Ha IN VILLAGE KHEMABEDA UNDER BOIPARIGUDA TEHSIL OF KORAPUT DISTRICT HELD ON 22.12.2021 AT 11.00 AM AT VILLAGE KHEMABEDA OVER KHATA NO 247 PLOT NO 911 UNDER BOIPARIGUDA TEHSIL, DISTRICT KORAPUT**

The public hearing in respect of the above project was held on 22.12.2021 as per the schedule and at the venue in accordance with the EIA Notification S. O. 1533 (E) dt. 14.09.2006. The public hearing with regard to date, place and time was announced in Public Address System in surrounding villages of proposed project site and also published in Daily News Paper. The process followed for public hearing was adequate.

Er P Kar, Regional Officer I/C, State Pollution Control Board, Koraput welcomed the public to the hearing and briefed about the objectives, process & procedures followed for conducting such public hearing.

Shri Rajendra Majhi, OAS (S), Additional District Magistrate, Koraput highlighted on importance of such hearing & presided over the public hearing.

Sri Jagabandhu Bisoi, Kalyani Laboratories Pvt. Ltd, Bhubaneswar, Consultant of M/s Khemabeda Decorative Stone (Dolerite/Black Granite) Mines has explained about the proposed project and briefed about the Pollution Control measures to be adopted in the Project.

The following is the summary of the public hearing proceedings, reflecting all the views and concerns expressed by the assembled public at the venue. It was recorded by the officials of the Regional Office, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Koraput.

**1. Sri Balaram Pujari, Katraguda, G. Majhiguda**

Sri Pujari informed that Mining Project will continue for 30 years & enquired about how many % of unemployed local people will get employment in the project. He explained that the Mine Hill extend near to his village & apprehended that the continuous mining activities for 30 years will affect their lively hoods, pollute their environment & will adversely impact their health due to cut down of trees. Further he informed that their village people are not in favour of giving the adjoining Forest & Hill for Mining.

He queried about the facilities to be provided by the company for development of Road, provision of Electricity, Bridge over nearby River etc if Mine will operate for 30 years. He expressed his dissatisfaction over non development of their Village Road for last 100 years in spite of placing their demand before Government. He informed that people of other area will be Rich by using their preserved Minerals but their village get neglected. He urged that there should not be any problem to their village due to mining or else local Tribal will protest.

**2. Sri Raghunath Mali, G. Majhiguda**

Sri Mali informed that there is no scope for getting job for people of the local Panchayat & Katraguda village in the District & demanded for their employment in the Mine Project based on their eligibility. He demanded for provision of Mobile Tower, development of Road for their village & expressed his happiness for the project.

**3. Sri Sindhu Barik, Katraguda, G. Majhiguda**

Sri Barik expressed that there is no road, communication & drinking water facilities in their village & the District Administration has not taken any steps for the development for last 40 to 50 Years. Local unemployed people used to go to Telengana for their Lively Hoods & hoped that the Mines in his village will provide job for them. He stressed on priority in employment of Local people in the Mine Project & if local people not able to eligible for any particular job then opportunity may be given to other people.

**4. Sri Damodar Khillo, Katraguda, G. Majhiguda**

Sri Khillo informed that efforts are given for last 12 years to start the Mines in his village & people lost the hope for starting of Mines. He expressed that his village people are also not interested to give that Hill for Mining. Further he informed that they are facing many problems & there is no facilities provided by the Government in his village. River exists in one side of their village & no proper road communication in other side. He queried about the facilities to be given by the Mines to them for its establishment.

**5. Sri Sonu Khillo, Katraguda, G. Majhiguda**

Sri Khillo explained that they went to Hyderabad as Migrant Labourer & suffered a lot. He hoped that the Mine in their village will provide job opportunity to them. He urged that local youth should be engaged for the job for which they are eligible. He questioned on compensation for the damage of their Cashew & Other plantation due to mining. He also queried about the compensation for loss of the agricultural land that exist between two quarries of the Mines.

**6. Sri Indra Nayak, Katraguda, G. Majhiguda**

Sri Nayak expressed his dissatisfaction on no development in his village for last 100 years. He stressed on employment of local youths in the Mine. He expressed that village people will support if the commitment made by the mines for development will get fulfilled.


**7. Sri M. Ashok Kumar, Limaput, Dasmantapur**

Sri Kumar stressed on protection of Agricultural land that exists close to the Mines. He expressed that since there is no scope of job in their area so local youths used to go to Andhra, Tamilnadu & Bangalore as Migrant labourer & suffered. He expressed his apprehension regarding development in their area even mines get established. He hoped that Local youth will get job in the project & they need not to go to Andhra for their lively Hoods. He informed that they have no proper road communication, Mobile Tower, Drinking water facilities etc & students are not getting proper education due to lack of mobile communication. He requested to the Government & the Mine for the development of their locality & proper education facilities for their students to get better job opportunity.

**8. Sri Prahallad Gouda, Baliapadar, G. Majhiguda**

Sri Gouda informed that their agricultural land exists at foot hill of the Mines from their forefathers. He apprehended that their cashew plantation, agriculture etc will be affected by dust, silt deposits due to mining activities & questioned on their survivability. He expressed that they have not got Patta for their agricultural land belongs to Forest & questioned on their Lively Hood if those lands get affected



  
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by the Mining activities. He stressed on employment of Local village peoples in the Mines to get lively hoods. He requested to redress their problems.

9. **Sri Dinabandhu Nayak, Katraguda, G. Majhiguda**

Sri Nayak informed that since last 12 years efforts are given to establish the Mines & now it is going to achieve. He apprehended the loss of agriculture due to mining. He expressed that they do not have proper Road communications for their village & they developed the road to their village through contribution. He emphasised on fulfilment of the commitment made by the Mines for developmental work like Road development, Drinking water supply, Ambulance provision & support to villagers at the time of need for their locality.

10. **Sri Prahallad Pangi, Sarpanch, G. Majhiguda**

Sri Pangi expressed his happiness for the project as villagers from surrounding 4 to 5 villages will get their livelihood from the Mines. He requested for development of the locality & stressed on improvement of road to their village, Provision of Ambulance for the benefit of locals & supply of free Books to the children to promote education in the locality. Further he emphasised on prevention of Pollution to avoid adverse impact on surrounding villages due to mining. He drew attention for protection of Agricultural land from siltation during rain that exist at Foot hill of the Mine & requested for compensation for any damage. He urged that provision for drinking water supply to local villages should be done for the benefit of locals.

He read over the demands of Katraguda villagers to be fulfilled by the Mines which include construction of Bridge over local River, Provision of 4nos of Tube wells in Katraguda village, Development of local Temple, construction of meeting Hall, Contribution for their local festivals, medical treatment facilities for villagers, construction of canals, provision of street lights, Marriage Mandap etc.

The Regional Officer I/C, SPCB, Koraput read over the issues raised by the public in the hearing and Sri Jagabandhu Bisoi of M/S Kalyani Laboratories Pvt. Ltd, Bhubaneswar on behalf of project proponent responded to the issues raised for Khemabeda Decorative Stone (Dolerite/Black Granite) Mines.

Shri Rajendra Majhi, OAS (S), ADM, Koraput has given concluding remarks on the hearing and elaborated the process to be followed for submission of the proceeding to the SEIAA, Bhubaneswar for further action. He extended thanks to the public participated in the hearing and for offering their views, suggestions and objections.

The issues raised by the public and corresponding comments of the applicant were prepared in Odia and English and it is annexed with the proceedings as Annexure-I & II respectively, list of the oral deliberators and participants in the hearing is annexed as Annexure-III & IV respectively. Three numbers of written representations were received during hearing and annexed as Annexure V (a to c). The videography of proceedings are recorded and submitted as DVD (One number).
