Sri Debabrata Misra, Chief General Manager (Plant) of M/S Rungta Mines Ltd of Dhenkal Steel Plant on behalf of the proponent addressed the committee members and assembled public and gave a brief description about the proposed project. He also briefed about M/S Rungta Mines Ltd of Dhenkal Steel Plant in the District of Dhenkanal. He also briefed about the peripheral development work that had been taken up in this area, and made a presentation about the environmental management, pollution control measures, solid waste-management of the related project. The copy of the statement of the industry read out at public hearing proceedings is enclosed.

As per EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14-09-2006, notice for public hearing of M/s Rungta Mines Ltd. in villages Jharbandh, Galpada, Tarkabada, Kothalu, Beruanpal, Kankalu, Benipathar, Kadala, Badamunda, Paik Puranakote, Naraharipur, Chandrasekharapur, Sanamunda, kaliakoli, Kantimili, Sulanali, Janhamunda, Patala and Nuapada in Dhenkanal District was publicized at the office notice Board of Galpada Gram Panchayat office, Kantimili Gram Panchayat office, Paika Purana Kote Gram Panchayat office, Kadala Gram Panchayat office, Mahalunda Gram Panchayat office, Patala GP office, BDO Office at Hindol, Tahasil Office Hindol, Jilla Parisad Office Dhenkanal and local villages of Jharbandh, Galpada, Tarkabada, Kothalu, Beruanpal, Kankalu, Benipathar, Kadala, Badamunda, Paik Puranakote, Naraharipur, Chandrasekharapur, Sanamunda, kaliakoli, Kantimili, Sulanali, Janhamunda, Patala and Nuapada. The notice for public hearing was also published in Odia Daily and English Daily and displayed in the portal of SPCB website [www.ospcboard.org](http://www.ospcboard.org) for public information and comments.


	<p>European Countries establishment DRI has been banned due to pollution issues. Till date the company has able to establish the industry with a production capacity approximately 2 MTPA. He also pointed out that previous public hearing of Rungta Company was earlier conducted at Hindol Tehsil office premises which is far away from the industry. He mentioned that he is not at all against the industry. He requested to conduct public hearing within their village premises. He told that public hearing should be conducted within the village panchayat area instead of conducting this place. He expressed his displeasure towards environmental management of M/s Bhusan Steel Ltd. He requested to the Regional Officer, SPCB, Angul to physically verify the existing pollution control measures of the Dhenkanal Steel Plant. He finally requested the company to adopt adequate environmental pollution control measures with thick plantation around the factory premises.</p>
