PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING HELD ON 22.12.2021 (AT 2.00 PM) AT SARUABIL FOOTBALL GROUND FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE IN RESPECT OF KAMARDA CHROMITE BLOCK OF M/S TATA STEEL MINING LIMITED FOR PRODUCTION OF 0.30 MTPA CHROME ORE (ROM) WITH MAXIMUM EXCAVATION OF 2.5 MILLION CUM PER ANNUM OVER ML AREA OF 107.240 HA LOCATED AT VILLAGE TALANGI, KAMARDA AND BALIPADA UNDER SUKINDA TAHSIL IN THE DISTRICT OF JAJPUR, ODISHA

The public hearing in respect of the Kamarda Chromite Block of M/s Tata Steel Mining Limited over an area of 107.240 Ha at Village Talangi, Kamarda, Balipada under Tahsil Sukinda in Jajpur District was held on scheduled date & time at Saruabil Football Ground in the District of Jajpur with reference to EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006 and amendments thereof

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting, Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of Kamarda Chromite Block of M/s Tata Steel Mining Limited over an area of 107.240 Ha at Village Talangi, Kamarda, Balipada under Tahsil Sukinda in Jajpur District.

Welcoming the public, Sri S. K. Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, Jajpur welcomed the public and explained that the views, comments,



objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project.
