PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF M/S. RENEWABLE ENVIROGIC PVT. LIMITED FOR SETTING UP A COMMON BIO-MEDICAL WASTE TREATMENT FACILITY (CBMWTF) OVER LEASE AREA OF 0.60Ha AT VILLAGE SIALBAHALI UNDER BALANGIR TEHSIL OF BALANGIR DISTRICT HELD ON 11.01.2022 AT 11.00 A.M AT JHANKARPALI GRAM PANCHAYAT BUILDING, DIST: BALANGIR

Sri Ananta Narayan Singh Laguri, OAS(S), Additional District Magistrate (General), Balangir presided over the meeting in presence of Dr. Satyanarayan Nanda, Asst. Env. Scientist, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Balangir/Sambalpur.

At the start while welcoming the public present in the meeting, Dr. Nanda, Asst. Env. Scientist, State Pollution Control Board, Sambalpur also briefed them about the objective of the public hearing being conducted under provisions of EIA Notification No. S.O. 1533(E) of Dt.14th September 2006 of the Ministry of Environment and Forests & Climate Change (MOEF & CC), Government of India. He further informed that the date, time and venue for conducting the Public Hearing Meeting ofM/s. Renewable Envirogic Pvt Limited (the Project Proponent) was duly advertised in Odia daily "PRAMEYA" dtd.11.12.2021 and in English daily "THE NEW INDIAN EXPRESS" dtd.11.12.2021(Paper clippings are enclosed as Annexure-I).

The Addl. District Magistrate has also briefed about the proposed project and requested the public present in the public hearing meeting to express their opinions and views on the proposed project. He also requested the representative of the proposed project to highlight about their proposed project before the public.

On behalf of M/s. Renewable Envirogic Pvt Limited, Sri Debasis Tripathy, Director, addressed the public during the public hearing meeting and briefly explained about the proposed project as described below:

1. M/s. Renewable Envirogic Pvt. Ltd. has proposed to setup a Common Biomedical Waste Treatment & Disposal Facility (CBWTF) at Mouza: Sialbahali, Tahasil: Balangir in the district of Balangir for treatment of 5 MT of biomedical wastes and has acquired 1.5 Acre or 0.607 Ha land for the facility. All wastes from hospitals and health care units of Balangir district and nearby districts may use this facility. This will be set up as per the provisions of Bio-Medical Waste (BMW) Management Rules, 2016 and guidelines of Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) made thereunder.

- 2. He explained different aspects of the proposed project and pollution control measures to be adopted.
 - Air Pollution: The gases after being burnt at 1050°C shall be run into multi cyclone and a ventury scrubber followed by a floated scrubber with quenching arrangement. The scrubber shall be an alkaline scrubber to neutralize the gases and ensure trapping of any pollutants escaping into the environment. They will also use quencher and two cyclonic droplet separators as pollution control devices.
 - Sprinklers will be provided to suppress dust inside the premises.
 - Water Pollution: Total requirement of water in proposed project will be 20 KLD out of which 15 KLD will be fresh water which will be sourced from bore well. Total waste water will be generated from the proposed project is 10 KLD. An ETP of size 10 KLD has been proposed for treatment of effluent generated from the unit Treated effluent will be recycled into the process.
 - Solid Waste: Wastes will be generated in the form of ash and other residues. Approx. 100-150 Kg per day of ash will be generated from the Plant. Solid waste generated from other source is about 10 to 20 Kg per day. It will be collected in containers/bags and shall be stored at temporary ash storage shed and shall be disposed into the secured landfill. All other Hazardous Wastes shall be disposed as per Hazardous & Other Waste (Management & transboundary Movement) Rule, 2016.
 - The unit has committed to examine/measure the air, water, noise quality in the plant premises and will take adequate measures to remain within the prescribed standard.
 - Plantation will be taken up at least 33% of the vacant land as per Govt. Rule.

Thereafter, the Addl. District Magistrate invited the public to offer their views on environment related issues on the establishment of the proposed project. About 40-50 people from surrounding local villages have attended the public hearing meeting; out of which30have signed the attendance sheet (annexed as **Annexure**-

After the deliberation process, Dr. Satyanarayan Nanda, Asst. Env. Scientist, Regional Office, State Pollution Control Board, Balangir/Sambalpur summed up all concerns/issues/points raised by the participants during the public hearing and read out before the public. The same in English and Odia (vernacular language) are enclosed as *Annexure-IV* (A & B).

Then the Addl. District Magistrate invited the representative of the project proponent to respond all concerns/issues/points raised by the participants in the public hearing meeting. Sri Debasis Tripathy, Director of M/s. Renewable Envirogic Pvt. Limited stated in brief on these issues and grievances raised by the participants which are annexed (*Annexure-V* (A& B)in English and Odia (vernacular language). The video recording of the entire proceeding of the public hearing is enclosed (Compact Disc - CD).

After the above-mentioned deliberations, the Addl. District Magistratehas announced the completion of public hearing meeting of the proposed project and Asst. Env. Scientist has proposed the vote of thanks to the Chair as well as to the Participants present in the public hearing meeting.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.


