PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE IN RESPECT OF M/S. PRATAPNAGARI SAND BED MINES PROPOSED BY TAHASILDAR, CUTTACK SADAR ON RIVER KUAKHAI OVER AN AREA OF 5.26 HECTARE OR 13.00 ACRES AT VILLAGE PRATAPNAGARI UNDER CUTTACK SADAR TAHASIL OF CUTTACK DISTRICT

The Public Hearing meeting of M/s. Pratapnagari Sand Bed Mines proposed by Tahasildar, Cuttack Sadar on River Kuakhai over an area of 5.26 hectare or 13.00 acres at village Pratapnagari under Cuttack Sadar Tahasil of Cuttack district was held on 10.11.2021 at Dhakulei Nodal Bidyapitha, Pratapnagari, Cuttack Sadar Tahasil in Cuttack district, Odisha at 11.30 AM with reference to:

- 1. EIA Notification S. O. 1533(E) dated 14.09.2006.
- 2. Interim Operational Guidelines.

The Panel consists of the following members:

- 1. Sri Purna Chandra Mishra, OAS (SAG), Additional District Magistrate, Cuttack
- 2. Er. Rashmita Priyadarshini, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Cuttack

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting presided over by the Additional District Magistrate, Cuttack, the Representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of project proposed by the Tahasildar, Cuttack Sadar.

Welcoming the public, Er. Rashmita Priyadarshini, the Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Cuttack, explained the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. She asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public.

Sri Sambit Garnayak, Tahasildar, Cuttack Sadar (project proponent), addressed the committee members and the assembled public and informed that they have engaged Environment Consultant i.e. M/s. Kalyani Laboratories Pvt. Ltd., Bhubaneswar for this project and requested them to make a presentation about the project. Sri Jagabandhu Bisoi,

representative of M/s. Kalyani Laboratories Pvt. Ltd addressed the panel members and the assembled public. He made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management, afforestation programme and various other CSR activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Then Er. Rashmita Priyadarshini, State Pollution Control Board, Cuttack requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

The following speakers gave their views on the above said project, which is given as follows:

1. Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Pratap Nagari:

He welcomed the dignitaries and public presented in the meeting. He said that the sand mine is located near the village which is connected through the village road was in bad condition and the same has been repaired recently by R& B division. He questioned on fund utilisation for plantation, school development and repairing of road as proposed by project proponent. He said that the drinking water treatment plant exist near the sand ghat and the occupation of fishermen might be affected due to the sand mine. He raised his concern on the traffic movement on the village road as it is a busy road used by school students, small children and local people and the movement of sand loaded vehicles might be caused accident. He said the drinking water supply through the water treatment plant might be polluted due to dust, the Jain temple and Maa Dhakulei temple might be damaged due to the dust pollution, dust allergies might be generated and requested to stop the sand mine operation permanently.

2. Sri Ratikanta Nayak, Pratapnagari:

He welcomed the dignitaries and public presented in the meeting. He said that environmental pollution is an important aspect as well as economy condition of an area is also important. He said, as stated by the project proponent water sprinkling will be done to control dust pollution, sand loaded vehicles will be covered with tarpaulin and regarding pollution many trees have been planted by the villagers in the Pratapnagari area. He said if the sand mine will be operated the villagers will get benefit directly or indirectly and the villagers will take measures as per the suggestion of the administration. He said if the sand mine will be operated the truck & tractor owners,

drivers, labourers and other villagers will get benefits. He emphasized to give importance to environment as well as economy.

3. Sri Narayan Rout, Pratapnagari:

He welcomed the dignitaries and public presented in the meeting. He said if ditches will be created due to the operation of sand mine then the villages of his ward Pratapnagari, Banapur, Nayagada, Paisahi, Khandeyita might be submerged like 1982 flood. He expressed the Water Treatment Plant, Water & Land Management Institute, (WALMI) & Maa Dhakulei temple might be affected due to operation of the sand mine and accident might be caused due to increase of traffic movement. He requested not to allow the operation of the sand mine.

4. Sri Badal Kumar Jena, Pratapnagari:

He expressed that if the sand mine will be operated then drinking Water Treatment Plant will be polluted, traffic movement problem might be occurred in the newly constructed bridge, people of WALMI, tourist coming to Jain temple & Dhakulei temple, school children, villagers may be suffered due to pollution of the sand mine. He stated if sand will be excavated then water level will be reduced in the river and livelihood of fishermen will be affected and requested not to allow the operation of sand mine in this area.

5. Sri Dillip Kumar Sasmal, Pratapnagari:

He welcomed the dignitaries and public presented in the meeting. He said fifty years ago when the road was kachha the sand mine was operated whereas now a days road condition is far improved with many beautifications work so the possibilities of pollution will be less. He requested to government to allow the operation of the sand mine.

6. Sri Sanatan Parida, Pratapnagari:

He welcomed the dignitaries and public presented in the meeting. He said the sand mine of their village was in operation in the last forty years when WALMI and the school were operated in this area. He gave emphasis on operation of sand mine for betterment of their people economy condition. He stated that the both economy condition of people and the environment should be focused and requested to allow the operation of the sand bed mine.

7. Sri Niranjan Rout, Pratapnagari:

He stated, it is the responsibility of the government and people to save the environment. He said the dust pollution to be generated due to sand mine operation will affect the Water treatment Plant and Museum and the occupation of fishermen will also be affected due to the operation of the sand mine. He said the impact of corona on life and stated life is important not economy. He requested not to allow the operation of the sand mine.

8. Sri Dhuleswar Rout, Pratapnagari:

He did not give any relevant statement on environment.

9. Sri Muralidhar Rout, Pratapnagari:

He welcomed the dignitaries and public presented in the meeting. He said the Pratapnagari sand mine should be operated for economical development of the villagers. He requested to provide humps on road near Dhakulei temple, school area and water sprinkling should be done on road for dust suppression.

10. Sri Kishore Kumar Barik, Pratapnagari:

He welcomed the dignitaries and public presented in the meeting. He expressed that environment is more important than economy and said operation of the sand mine will affect the WALMI area, school area, bridge area and road as vehicular movement will be increased, so possibilities of road accident will be there. He requested to administration not to allow the operation of the sand mine.

11. Sri Sujan Kumar Behera, Pratapnagari:

He welcomed the dignitaries and public presented in the meeting. He said the operation of sand mine will affect the WALMI and the tourist coming to Dhakulei temple. Further he expressed the occupation of fishermen of this area also be affected due the sand mine operation. He said the water level on the upstream of the river is getting reduced due to sand mining activity carried out at the lower stream of the river and their fishing occupation is getting affected. He requested not to allow the operation of the sand mine as school and hospital are exist in this area and the movement of sand loaded vehicles may be damaged the road.

12. Sri Surendra Rout, Pratapnagari:

He welcomed all present in the meeting and said that the sand mine should be operated since it was operating earlier and they are also procuring sand at higher price. He said if the sand mine will be operated many unemployed people, labourers will get work and tractors will be used for sand transportation as during Corona people have badly suffered. He requested to the district administration to allow the operation of the sand quarry.

13. Sri Rajkishore Rout, Pratapnagari:

He expressed that as the sand mine is not in operation so the movement of their children are safe due to less traffic movement and he requested not to allow the sand mine to operate.

14. Sri Rama Chandra Rout, Pratapnagari:

He welcomed the dignitaries and public present in the meeting. He said when Pratapnagari sand mine was in operation earlier during that time fishing was done, the museum, school and WALMI were also in operation. If the sand mine will not be operated the people who depend on it for livelihood will be affected as due to Corona they are not going outside for work. He said the sand mine should be operated following the environmental guidelines.

15. Sri Jajati Kishore Jena, Pratapnagari:

He said the sand mine is in operation since forty years and at that time school children, WALMI staff and public movement was there. He said to control dust pollution on road water sprinkling should be done and sand loaded vehicles should be covered with tarpaulin so that public will not face any problem on road. He expressed if the sand mine will be operated the economic condition of the village will be improved.

16. Sri Dallar Kumar Rout, Pratapnagari:

He welcomed the dignitaries and public present in the meeting and expressed the effect of vehicular dust pollution on children while they are playing outside, on school and Dhakulei temple. He stated not to allow the operation of the sand mine.

17. Sri Sishir Kumar Rout, Pratapnagari:

He welcomed the dignitaries and public present in the meeting. He said that pollution of this area is not only for sand mine but also for brick unit. So, he gave emphasized on doing more plantation on vacant land in the village.

18. Ms. Urmila Behera, Pratapnagari:

She welcomed all and said about the effect of dust pollution on school children, public and tourist coming to the Dhakulei temple and requested to not to allow the operation of the sand mine.

19. Sri Sachin Rout, Pratapnagari:

He welcomed all and said about the effect of dust pollution on children, public and tourist coming to this area. He said that, operation of sand ghat will increase the movement of vehicles and the dust pollution in the area which might be caused diseases. He stated that the sand mine will not provide work to all unemployed youth and requested not to allow the operation of the sand mine.

20. Smt. Prabhashini Das, Pratapnagari:

She said that the children, people will be affected due to the dust pollution of the sand mine, so the sand mine should not be operated.

21. Sri Badal Kumar Swain, Pratapnagari:

He said about the dust pollution to be generated due to transportation of sand and said not to allow the operation of the sand mine. Further he stated that movement of sand loaded vehicles at the night time is more than day time. He questioned if an outsider lessee will operate the sand mine how the economy of their village will be improved.

22. Sri Pramod Kumar swain, Pratapnagari:

He said pollution level is increasing so operation of the brick kiln and sand mine should be stopped. Operation of the sand mine might be affected the museum, newly constructed bridge and Water Treatment Plant, so the sand mine operation should be stopped.

23. Sri Rohit Kumar Sasmal, Pratapnagari:

He said the sand mine was earlier operated and it should be allowed to operate by taking required pollution control measures.

24. Sri Charan Behera, Pratapnagari:

He said pollution due to the sand mine will affect the new bridge, school, WALMI, Water Treatment Plant and also water level is reducing in the river, so the sand mine operation should not be allowed.

25. Sri Dageswar Behera, Pratapnagari:

He said the occupations of fishermen are affected as water level in the river is reducing due to the operation of sand mine. He requested not to allow the operation of the sand mine.

26. Sri Bibhuti Behera, Pratapnagari:

He welcomed the dignitaries and public present in the meeting. He said public movement has been increased due to the construction of the new bridge and if the sand mine will be operated then possibilities of accident might be increased.

27. Sri Trinath Behera, Pratapnagari:

He said operation of the sand mine should be stopped permanently as the health of the children of this area may will be affected due to the dust pollution.

Total 27 nos. of people had registered their names to express their views, comments etc. and deliberated their views accordingly. About 52 Nos. of people were presented in the public hearing have signed the attendance sheet. One written representation was received during the public hearing and the same is enclosed.

After all the speakers completed their respective opinion and suggestion, the Regional Officer, Cuttack asked the project proponent to give relevant reply, if any to the issues raised. Sri Sambit Kumar Garnayak, Tahasildar, Cuttack Sadar as well the project proponent replied that necessary pollution control measures will be taken and the stipulations made in the Environmental Management Plan will be complied.

The issues raised by the public and the reply of the project proponent has been prepared in English & Odia and attached separately. Finally the Regional Officer




