

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE IN RESPECT OF M/S. NARANAPUR MAHANADI SAND QUARRY PROPOSED BY SMT. MAMATA SAMANTA ON RIVER MAHANADI OVER MINING LEASE AREA OF 5.40 HECTARE AT VILLAGE NARANAPUR UNDER BADAMBA TAHASIL OF CUTTACK DISTRICT

The Public Hearing meeting of M/s. Naranapur Mahanadi Sand Quarry proposed by Smt. Mamata Samanta on River Mahanadi over mining lease area of 5.40 hectare at Village Naranapur under Badamba Tahasil of Cuttack District was held on dtd. 27.12.2021 at Multipurpose Flood Shelter Centre near D.B.N.T. Nodal Bidyapitha, Bangarisingha under Bangarisingha Gram Panchayat, Badamba Tahasil in Cuttack District, Odisha at 11.30 A.M. with reference to:

1. EIA Notification S. O. 1533(E) dated 14.09.2006.
2. Interim Operational Guidelines.

The Panel consists of the following members:

1. Sri Purna Chandra Mishra, OAS (SAG), Additional District Magistrate, Cuttack
2. Er. Rashmita Priyadarshini, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Cuttack

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting presided over by the Additional District Magistrate, Cuttack, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of project proposed by Smt. Mamata Samanta.

Welcoming the public, Er. Rashmita Priyadarshini, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Cuttack, explained the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. She asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public.

On behalf of Smt. Mamata Samanta the project proponent, Sri Chintamani Samal addressed the committee members and the assembled public and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management and other aspect of the proposed project.





Then Er. Rashmita Priyadarshini, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Cuttack requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

The following speakers gave their views on the above said project, which is given as follows:

1. Sri Samir Parida, Naranapur:

He welcomed the dignitaries and public presented in the meeting. He said the level of sand on the river bed is higher than their cultivated land and there are chances of entering of river water into their land during flood so the sand is required to be excavated. Further he stated if the sand mine will be operated then they will get sand at lower price.

2. Sri Girish Dalei, Naranapur:

He welcomed the dignitaries and public presented in the meeting. He said that no sand mine is operated presently in the Badamba area. He said the sand from this area should be lifted as the river bed is at higher than their village and therefore river water was entered to their cultivated land during last year. Further he stated as sand will be transported by tractor so the chances of pollution will be less.

3. Sri Bijay Dalei, Naranapur:

He welcomed the dignitaries and public present in the meeting. He said that they are getting sand from distance area at higher price due to non-operation of sand mine in this area. So, if the if the sand mine will be operated they will be benefited.

4. Sri Sanjay Kumar Dalei, Naranapur:

He said sand from the river bed is required to be lifted as deposition of sand on river bed is high. He wanted to know about the provision of expenditure for the development work of their village.

At the outset total 04 Nos. of people had registered their names to express their views, comments etc. and deliberated their views accordingly. Total 39 numbers of public present in the meeting have signed the attendance sheet. Sri Hemanta Kumar Swain, OAS(S), Sub-collector, Athagarh was present and he addressed the gathering in the meeting.



Then the President of Public Hearing meeting, Sri Purna Chanda Mishra, OAS (SAG), Additional District Magistrate, Cuttack welcomed all the government officers and public presented in the meeting. He said, as stated by speakers lifting of sand from the river bed will increase the water carrying capacity of the river. He said the views of the public has been recorded and will be sent to SEIAA.

After all the speakers completed their respective opinion and suggestion, the Regional Officer, Cuttack asked the project proponent to give relevant reply, if any to the issues raised. On behalf of the project proponent, Sri Chintamani Samal stated that they will take necessary steps to protect the environment and comply with the stipulations made in the Environmental Management Plan.

The issues raised by the public and the reply of the project proponent has been prepared in English & Odia and attached separately. The meeting is ended with thanks to the chair.

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NOTICE

It is brought to the notice of all concerned that Smt. Mamata Samanta has proposed to have Environmental Assessment for Naranapur Mahanadi Sand Quarry over ML area of 5.40 Ha. in village Naranapur under Badamba tehsil of Cuttack district to obtain Environmental Clearance from State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Odisha. The proponent has applied to the State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar for a Public Hearing.

By virtue of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India Notification No. S.O. 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006, the Board has been authorized to conduct environmental public hearing and as such invites suggestions, views, comments and objections on matters relating to environmental aspects of the proposed project from all the persons including bonafide residents, environmental groups and others located at the proposed site / sites of displacement / sites likely to be affected.

For the above purpose, a person will only mean:

- Any person who is likely to be affected by the grant of Environmental Clearance.
- Any person who owns his control over the project with respect to which an application has been submitted for environmental clearance.
- Any association of persons whether incorporated or likely to be affected by the project and / or functioning in the field of environment.
- Any local authority within any part of whose local limits is within the neighborhood, wherein the project is proposed to be located.

Persons as above who desire to submit their views, comments, objections etc. relevant to the project may do so in writing within 30 days from the date of publication of this notice addressing the same to the Member Secretary, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha through Registered Post. Besides this, persons interested to submit their views relevant to the proposed mining project in writing or orally may also do so during the public hearing to be conducted on 27.12.2021 at 11:30 A.M. at Multipurpose Flood Shelter Centre near D.B.N.T. Nodal Bldg. Bhatia, Bangarisingha under Bangarisingha G.P. of Cuttack district. Public hearing shall be conducted strictly observing guidelines contained in COVID-19 pandemic restrictions issued by the MoEF&CC, Govt. of India vide OM No.22-25-IA. III dated 09.06.2021 as well as Govt. of Odisha.
