**PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING IN RESPECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT OF KALYANPUR A & B SAND MINES (CLUSTER) AT KALYANPUR VILLAGE PROPOSED BY THE TAHASILDAR, BHUBANESWAR FOR SAND QUARRY MINING ON KUAKHAI RIVER OVER AN AREA OF 34.475 HECTARE OR 85.188 ACRE AT BLOCK CONFERENCE HALL, BHUBANESWAR UNDER BHUBANESWAR TAHASIL OF KHURDA DISTRICT**

The Public Hearing meeting in respect of environmental impact assessment of Kalyanpur A & B Sand Mines (Cluster) at Kalyanpur village proposed by the Tahasildar, Bhubaneswar for sand quarry mining on River Kuakhai over mining lease area of 34.475 hectare or 85.188 acres under Bhubaneswar tahasil of Khurda district was held on 15.12.2021 at 10.30 AM at Block Conference Hall, Bhubaneswar in Khurda district, Odisha with reference to:

1. EIA Notification S. O. 1533(E) dated 14.09.2006.
2. Interim Operational Guidelines.
3. Covid-19 Guidelines issued by MoEF&CC, Govt. of India vide OM No.22-25-IA.III, Dated.09/06/2021

At the outset, Dr. Sohan Giri, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar Regional Office on behalf of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha welcomed all the guests, dignitaries, public and other members present in the meeting. The meeting was presided over by the Additional District Magistrate, Bhubaneswar, on behalf the District Administration.

Dr. Sohan Giri, being the Representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing as has been cited in the EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, along with Covid-19 Guidelines issued by MoEF&CC, Govt. of India vide OM No.22-25-IA.III Dated. 09/06/2021 and the modalities to be followed for conducting the public hearing meeting in respect to sand mine project proposed by Tahasildar, Bhubaneswar.

Welcoming the public, the Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar, highlighted about the aim and objective of the public hearing and invited the

views, comments/opinions from the local public w.r.t the environmental clearance of the project. Then the Regional Officer requested to Sri Anuj Kumar Das Pattanaik, Additional District Magistrate, Bhubaneswar to preside over the public hearing meeting.

Sri Anuj Kumar Das Pattanaik, Additional District Magistrate, Bhubaneswar presided over the meeting and highlighted the purpose of the meeting and the procedure to be maintained by the gatherings till completion of the public hearing.

Then, the Regional Officer invited the project proponent to present the details of the proposed project i.e. area to be mined out, mining procedure to be followed, environment impact, restoration, peripheral development to be taken up for the benefit of local public. The Tahasildar, Bhubaneswar being the project proponent put forth/highlighted the gathering about the possible environmental impact over the said area during mining activity period. He explained about the various aspects to be covered up during of the operation of proposed project i.e. benefits for the local daily labourers, peripheral development etc. He also invited the opinion and objection of the public present in the public hearing and had sought their co-operation for smooth implementation of the project.

After the completion of deliberation, Dr. Sohan Giri requested the public gathered at the meeting of the area to put forth their views, comments, objections and opinions etc. about the commencement of the proposed sand mining project.

The learned Additional District Magistrate also suggested that since this is a cluster sand mining project, so the speakers can put forth their opinion first on Kalyanpur-A project and then followed by Kalyanpur-B for smooth conduct of the programme.

**The following speakers had presented their opinion on above said proposed sand mine project as cited below:**

**A. VIEWS REGARDING KALYANPUR-A QUARRY MINING:**

**1. Sri Susanta Kumar Parida:**

Sri Parida has raised his voice against operation of Kalyanpur-A sand mine quarry and informed that it should not be allowed to be operated as it is located within the proximity i.e. within the radius of 100 - 200 meters of nearest inhabitation along with existence of gramya jungle in some pocket of that quarry area. Also at the opposite side of the river course another habitation is existing which will be affected if the said quarry will be operated. So the proposed sand quarry mining proposal should be dropped.



**2. Sri Rajendra Sahu,**

Sri Sahu informed that as the villagers have already filed a case objecting to the commencement of the proposed sand quarry Kalyanpur-A and the case is still under sub-judice. So the said quarry should not be allowed to be operated. He had highlighted that during the movement of trucks the children and old age people will suffer a lot.

**3. Sri Pravat Kumar Swain :**

Sri Swain first of all advised all the gatherings to maintain Covid guideline in the on-going programme. Favouring the operation of Kalyanpur-B sand quarry mine but objected against the commencement of Kalyanpur-A sand quarry as children used to play in the nearby playground will be hampered. He also said that the nearby people including women generally go for morning walk in that area will be affected along with destruction of gramya jungle (Shursthi Bana).

As the heavy lorry and other vehicles will move across the area, this will cause the deterioration of the natural scenario of the place. Also the approach road to Kalyanpur-A quarry being the usable road for the local inhabitants, and if the said Kalyanpur-A quarry get permission to operate then local villagers will face problems and other innumerable loss which can't be recovered in future. So he requested to grant permission to Kalyanpur-B project only instead of both the projects.

**4. Siba Swain :**

The speaker opined about the operation of Kalyanpur-A project and informed that if the project is granted permission, and then there will be unprecedented damage to the river bank. Since the local people use the river bank for their bathing and other purposes, naturally they will get affected. The functioning of all existing local institutions like schools, offices and others will be affected. Keeping the possible problems to be incurred, he had requested the chair to abandon the proposed project and allow only run the Kalyanpur-B sand quarry.

**5. Sri Trailokya Panda :**

At the outset he welcomed the gathering and asked everybody to maintain Covid guidelines for the safety of all. He suggested to stop the mining of Kalyanpur-A sand quarry and to carry out permission for Kalyanpur-B quarry, because there exists a playground near the Kalyanpur-A quarry on which children used to play and persons of nearby area used the ground for morning walk. Nearby the quarry area there exist a Shursthi Bana which will be

destroyed and public activities will be hampered due to sand mining. So he had requested the chair to suspend the Kalyanpur-A project and allow permission to Kalyanpur-B project.

**6. Sri Mangulu Das :**

At the outset Sri Das welcomed everybody and requested the chair to stop the mining activities of Kalyanpur-A quarry because of the existence of a playground where children used to play everyday and used for morning walk by the local people. Due to commencement of mining activities, various problems such as general movement of people during office hour will be hampered in the nearby places. So he had requested the chair to stop all the mining activities pertaining to the Kalyanpur-A project.

**7. Sri Gangadhar Barik :**

At the outset he welcomed everybody and informed that the public hearing is being conducted for the formal commencement of mining activities. He cautions the public that if the sand quarry mining will be operated, the following problems will arise for their villagers in future.


- a) Small children and women of the localities could not get the bathing facilities which they are using since long back.
- b) Due to transportation of sand dust problem will arise in the area, daily movement of the local people will be severely affected. The nearby agricultural land of the people will probably loose its production capacity. The details of the impact should be evaluated and be informed to the public. So he had requested to stop the Kalyanpur-A mining proposal activity with immediate effect.

**8. Sri Sushil Kumar Sahoo :**

At the outset he welcomed the gathering and informed that, if the mining of Kalyanpur-A quarry is allowed everybody in the locality will face problems and the children will not be able to school. The surrounding environment will get polluted since the quarry exists very near to the local inhabitation. So he requested to suspend the proposed project Kalyanpur-A mining.

**9. Sri Jogendra Sahoo :**

He welcomed the gathering and informed that, he being the Chair-person of Bapuji Nodal School and intimated that in the year 2014, a 9<sup>th</sup> class student has lost his life in road accident. Since nearby students depends upon the school, it is apprehended that if the



quarry is permitted to run, then the local residents will face lot of problem. So he urged to stop the Kalyanpur-A mining project without further proceeding.

**10. Sri Narahari Samal :**

He welcomed the gathering and informed that that since the school exists nearby to the sand quarry and safety of the school going children will be seriously affected. Therefore, it is requested to stop Kalyanpur-A project.

**11. Sri Prasant Rout :**

He informed that he being the President of Barimund G.P. and in toto, there will be no actual problem by the commencement of both the projects. However, due the narrow passage of roads in the villages, the regular movement of vehicles should be obstructed. So, it is requested that the authorities should provide a by-pass roads for the safe passage of the vehicles and smooth operation of sand mining.

**12. Sri Dushmant Swain :**

At the outset he had welcomed everybody and pledges no objection if both the proposed projects moves ahead as per the rules and guideline.

**13. Sri Sadhu Parida :**

He infavour of the villagers informed that issues persists with the commencement of the sand quarries. They want that the Kalyanpur-A project should be dropped while Kalyanpur-B project should be allowed.

**14. Sri Bikash Kumar Sutar :**

At the outset he welcomed everybody and suggested some of the following points with regard to the environment issues :

- a) There exists a Swasth Bana area in which almost 10,000 medicinal trees and plants available. If proposed mining is permitted, there is every chance of deforestation of the invaluable trees.
- b) A playground exists nearest to the lease hold area. The mining operation will seize/stop the recreation activities of the local children.

Two handwritten signatures are present at the bottom of the page. The signature on the left is 'Sutar' and the signature on the right is 'Parida'.

- c) The lease area is situated at a distance of 200 meters from the nearby local villages. So due to mining transportation activities, there will be substantial generation of dust in and around the villages area and thereby will cause continuous air pollution. Consequently the people will face health hazard out of this activity.

**15. Sri Tukuna Rout :**

He told that the proposal for Kalyanpur-A quarry mining should be dropped and Kalyanpur-B quarry mining project to be granted permission as per the law.

**16. Sri Pradip Bhoi :**

He informed that as per his opinion, the proposal for Kalyanpur-A sand quarry should be suspended because of the possible unsafe movement of vehicle for school going children and for the general public whose daily movement will get disrupted due to commencement of mining operation.

**17. Sri Sukanta Kumar Panda :**

At the outset he welcomed everybody and spoke that he is against the commencement of the proposed Kalyanpur-A project since if the proposal gets the approval of the Government then innumerable issue will arise and local inhabitants will face a number of problems.

**18. Sri Rajendra Swain :**

He informed that if Kalyanpur-A project commences, then in his opinion there will be many problem, rather it will lead to all round development of the local G.P.

**B. VIEWS REGARDING KALYANPUR-B QUARRY MINING:**

**19. Sri Pravat Kumar Swain :**

Sri Swain informed that if Kalyanpur-B project commences, then in his opinion there will be no problem. So we welcomed the commencement of this project.

**20. Sri Akshaya Kumar Sahu :**

Sri Sahu informed that as this project is situated in the other side of the river and there are no habitations, so Kalyanpur-B project can be approved as per the rule.

**21. Sri Tukuna Rout :**

He informed that the proposed Kalyanpur-B sand quarry project can be approved with rule of Government.

**22. Sri Bikram Samal :**

He informed that the proposed Kalyanpur-B sand quarry should move ahead as they have no problems pertaining to the project.

**23. Sri Chagala Parida :**

He informed that since the nearest village is located at a distance of 600 meters, they have no objection and let the Kalyanpur-B sand quarry be given necessary clearance from the Government.

**24. Sri Trailokya Parida :**

He informed that since the sand ghat is situated far from the nearest human habitation, they welcome the commencement of the Kalyanpur-B project.

**25. Sri Manguli Das :**

He informed that since the local villages is far from the project area of Kalyanpur-B sand mining should be allowed to run.

**26. Sri Benudhar Parida :**



He informed that they have no objection, if the proposed Kalyanpur-B sand quarry project operates within the purview of law.

**27. Sri Sridhar Swain :**

He informed that since the villages are situated a bit far away from the lease area, Kalyanpur-B sand quarry can be allowed to operate.

**28. Sri Prasant Rout :**

He request the authorities/chair to take steps for non-operation of the proposed Kalyanpur-A sand project and permission may be given to the Kalyanpur-B sand mining project.

**29. Sri Sadhu Parida :**

He informed that if the proposed Kalyanpur-B sand quarry will be operated then they have no objection at all.

**30. Sri Sukadev Bhoi :**

He informed that there will be no problem if the proposed Kalyanpur-B sand mining is operated.

**31. Sri Dushmant Swain :**

He informed that, he along with other villagers request to stop the Kalyanpur-A sand quarry project and Kalyanpur-B sand quarry should be permitted.

Six (06) numbers of representations were received from the people with respect to non-operation of Kalyanpur-A sand mine quarry and four (04) numbers of representation in favour of operation of both Kalyanpur-A & Kalyanpur-B quarry. After all the speakers completed their respective opinion and suggestion, the Regional Officer, SPCB, Odisha, Bhubaneswar asked the project proponent to give relevant reply with regards to the opinion and view of the speakers.

On behalf of the project proponent, Sri Sudhir Kumar Barik, M/s. Kalyani Laboratories (P) Limited, Environmental Consulting Agency addressed the panel members, Guests, and Honorary members as well as all the persons present in the meeting and deliberated a brief note about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management plan to be carried out, pollution control measures to be adopted during operation of the quarry, waste management system to be adopted, afforestation programme, local employment generation and various other CSR activities to be addressed in the proposed project of Kalyanpur-A & B mining project situated in cluster.

Although there was no specific issue on environment raised by the public, the respondent deliberated in detailed about the possible effect may be incurred due to the project and the socio-economic issues as well as developmental measures to be undertaken for the benefit of the people like (i) Sand mining will be carried out upto 2 meter depth, (ii) Fixed timing for sand excavation, (iii) No noise pollution, (iv) Transportation road will be well maintained to reduce air pollution, (v) Ground water pollution will not occur, (vi) Plantation will be carried out on both side of the transportation road, (vii) No displacement of any family/house, (viii) Fruit bearing trees to be planted in the surrounding



area, (ix) Financial benefit will be provided to the school and health programmes will be taken up.


