

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING HELD ON 16.05.2022 (AT 11.00 AM) AT VILLAGE AMRUTPUR (KHATA NO.159, PLOT NO.804, KISSAM-GRAMYA JUNGLE) WITH RESPECT TO ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT OF BAITARANI SAND BED MINES OF SRI PRADEEP BISWAL OVER AN AREA OF 6.07 HA. IN MOUZA AMRUTPUR UNDER HATADIHI TAHASIL OF KEONJHAR DISTRICT FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE.

The public hearing in respect of the project proposed by Sri Pradeep Biswal for Baitarani sand bed Mines on river Baitarani over an area of 6.07 Ha. in Mouza Amrutpur under Hatadihi Tahasil of Keonjhar district was held on scheduled date & time with reference to:

I. EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006 and Amendments thereafter.

**The Panel consisted of the following members:**

Shri Ghasiram Murmu, Project Director (DUDA), Keonjhar, supervised & presided over the public hearing process and was assisted by Shri Puskar Chandra Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting, the Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of the project proposed by Sri Pradeep Biswal.

Shri Behera explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public, gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public. On behalf of the Project Proponent, Sri Pabitra Kumar Swain (Consultant) addressed the committee members and assembled public, and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management and various other CSR activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Then Shri Puskar Chandra Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

**The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:**

- 1) **Sri Manas Kumar Das, Jungle Committee President, Amrutpur, Dimria:**  
While supporting the proposed sand mining project, he expressed that by opening of this river bed sand mines their village will definitely develop. He expressed his dissatisfaction that there is no good road condition at their village. He also told that before this no Govt. authority has visited their village, as this is a very remote area. He expressed his happiness for the presence of so many Government officers at their village.
- 2) **Sri Kirtan Bihari Jena, Raghavpur:**  
He supported the river bed-mining project at their locality. He told that he is 95 years old and hope that by this mining project their area will develop. He expressed his dissatisfaction as they have no electricity in their area. He requested for electric connection. He also told they are getting the food because of Government food programme otherwise they were unable to manage livelihood on their own.
- 3) **Sri Jugal Kishore Das, Advocate, Amrutpur Aitipur GP:**  
While supporting the sand bed mining project, he told that since long they were longing for this project. However, there is no possibility of environment impact within 3 KM radius due to extraction of sand. He requested the Govt. Authority to grant permission for sand extraction for which he will be grateful forever.
- 4) **Sri Bimbadhar Das, Amrutpur, Aitipur GP:**  
While supporting the Public Hearing, he told that the villagers have assembled during the hearing to see the Collector and before this public hearing nobody had visited their place so far. He requested for better road condition and for assurance of no pollution during mining process so that they can live happily.
- 5) **Sri Chaturbhuja Das, Amrutpur:**  
He said that it is matter of joy for them due to presence of all the Government Officers. Their area is at extreme end point of Keonjhar District. This area is famine prone area. He told that though public hearing is being held for commencement of sand excavation job but this activity is already going on since 3 months before the hearing. He also stated that due to mining activities heavy earth moving equipment like JCB, tippers will be operated. As a result of the vehicle movements, there will be noise pollution and education of their children will be affected. So he suggested that before commencement of sand bed mining the mine shall ensure all the requisite improvements required for the safety of the villagers and the environment.
- 6) **Sri Sashikant Das, Aitipur:**  
While supporting the proposed project, he stated that by this sand bed mining Maa Mangala Development Committee and everybody will be benefitted and developed.
- 7) **Sri Anadi Charan Jena, Retired Teacher, Raghavpur, Aitipur GP:**  
He has no objection for proposed commencement of this sand bed mining activities. Due to this lots of heavy vehicle will ply from their area and already thousands of vehicles have been picked up for this transportation job. He requested to develop the haul road and transportation road for transportation of sand towards Keonjhar, Mayurbhanj, Hatadihi. He welcomes overall development of that area once this activity will start. He also expressed his concern for flood during monsoon period that will arise due to sand mining.

8) **Sri Surendra Kandi, Gedua GP:**

He stated that after getting the Public Hearing notification they got happy. But listening to the commitment of the project proponent some persons are happy and some are not. After commencement of extraction of sand activities common people will be mostly affected in terms of education of their children, bad road conditions, farmers will be affected due to dust and their yield will be less. He raised question where the common people will go to resolve these issues as they are now totally confused. However, they want the sand bed mining should run and supported the Public Hearing. He requested to explain how people will get employment, how the affected farmers will be compensated and how their road condition will improve. He requested for plantation. He warned if their demands will not be fulfilled, they have no option then to oppose the mining in future.

9) **Sri Rabindra Kumar Das, Aitipur GP:**

While supporting the proposed project he told that though he has no complain/objection about the sand bed mining but by this activity their village Aitipur will be more affected in terms of air pollution. Their agriculture land will also get affected due to huge dust generations.

10) **Sri Surendra Kumar Jena, Raghavpur, Aitipur G.P:**

He told it is good that sand bed mining will start and he has no objection for these operations. His village is only 200 meters distance from the proposed sand bed mining site due to which there will be air pollution. The dust accumulates at their houses and their children are suffering from lung diseases. He said that though the economy will grow but he requested to look into their issues like repair of riverside embankment, construction of road and take appropriate steps to control noise pollution, otherwise they will oppose in future.

**Observation:**

The overall opinion of the public about the proposed project was favorable. However, the local people have some aspirations as laid down in their deliberations.







Underground water will not be affected through these mining activities.</p> <p>He said that overloading of vehicles will not be permitted.
