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PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING HELD ON 21.05.2022 (AT 11.00 AM) AT VILLAGE GANDHALAPADA (GP- GUALI), KHATA NO. 48 (AJA), PLOT NO. 194 WITH RESPECT TO ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT OF RENGALBEDA (NE) IRON ORE BLOCK OF M/S ODISHA MINERAL EXPLORATION CORPORATION LIMITED WITH PRODUCTION CAPACITY OF 2.0 MTPA IRON ORE OVER ML AREA OF 24.203 HA. AT VILLAGES NUAGAON AND GANDHALAPADA UNDER BARBIL TAHSIL OF KEONJHAR DISTRICT FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE.

The public hearing in respect of the project proposed by Rengalbeda (NE) Iron Ore block of M/s. Odisha Mineral Exploration Corporation Limited (OMECL) with production capacity of 2.0 MTPA iron ore over an area of 24.203 Ha located at villages Nuagaon and Gandhalapada under Barbil Tahasil of Keonjhar district was held on scheduled date & time with reference to:

- I. EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006 and Amendments thereafter.

The Panel consisted of the following members:

1. Sushma Bilung, Additional District Magistrate, Keonjhar
2. Shri Puskar Chandra Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar, Odisha

Sushma Bilung, Additional District Magistrate, Keonjhar, supervised & presided over the public hearing process and was assisted by Shri Puskar Chandra Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting, the Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of the project proposed by Rengalbeda (NE) Iron Ore block of M/s. Odisha Mineral Exploration Corporation Limited.

Shri Behera explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public, gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public. On behalf of the Project Proponent, Sri Uday Shankar Pattnaik, Sr. Manager (Mines) of M/s. Odisha Mineral Exploration Corporation Limited addressed the committee members and assembled public, and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management and various other CSR activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Then Shri Puskar Chandra Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:

- 1) **Sri Dabra Munda, Guali GP:**
While supporting the PH he stated that for achieving something we will lose something. However, he is in favour of the mines. At the same time he has requested the mine to give more attention towards the people those who are affected by the mining operations. Whatever developmental jobs Mr. Pattanayak narrated in his speech, if bring into effect everybody will be benefitted.
- 2) **Sri Charan Munda, Nuagaon:**
While supporting the project he explained the importance of environment, if environment is damaged our life will be affected. The trees help to cause rain and emit oxygen to our environment. So he requested the mine for tree plantation on mining waste dump and mined out area to safeguard the environment and to look after all other issues.
- 3) **Sri Jhuria Munda, Gandhalpada:**
While supporting the PH he expressed his concern that there is one small natural stream near Nuagaon-Dholki, adjacent to the proposed mining site on which villages like Ghorasahi, Nuagaon etc. are dependent and it may dry due to mining activities. This is a perennial source of water of this locality. Day by day the water flow is becoming less. So, he requested the mine to carry out their mining activities by giving utmost attention to this natural stream so that it would not be affected and flow will be spontaneous.
- 4) **Sri Padan Patra, Guali:**
While supporting this PH he stated that the mine is going to do its mining activities at some parts of Gandhalpada and Nuagon area. The mine has given many assurances for providing all sorts of facilities like road, health, electric connection, education, drinking water and employment to unemployed. He requested company to give more importance to fulfill those assurances, so that there will be improvement, otherwise there will be disturbance. Most of the mine does not fulfill the given commitments.
- 5) **Ms. Bilasini Oram, Sarpanch, Loidapada:**
While supporting the PH she told that the mine has given so many assurances. She requested the mine to take up CSR activities before and after starting of the mining activities. She expressed her concern that many companies give lots of assurances but they do not fulfill it after getting the clearances. She requested to look into the education & employment of the local people.
- 6) **Smt. Sabita Barik, Nuagaon:**
While she gave his consent for starting of the proposed mining activities, because everybody are dependent on mines but requested to see that people does not face any difficulties. She requested for providing drinking water, road, assistance to the SHG, school teachers in Nuagaon School for higher education, di-siltation of the nallah, stair case to the ghat, provide stitching machine along with stitching teacher, employment according to the qualifications to the local youth. All are dependent upon mines, so she requested the mine to critically survey for the requirement of the beneficial jobs and take steps accordingly. All companies give many assurances but do not fulfill their commitments; she also requested to give pension to the aged and physically challenged people. Necessary steps may be taken to impart education from small children to grown up children.
- 7) **Smt. Binapani Barik, Gandhalpada:**
While supporting the PH she requested to provide teacher to the school, bus services up to Joda and Koida for the school going children, drinking water supply, Bathroom, latrine, stitching machine and financial assistance to the SHG.

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- 8) **Smt. Rangabati Palei, Secretary, SHG, Nuagaon:**
She supported the PH but at the same time she expressed that till now nobody has helped them. As a result, there is no education facility, no good roads; SHG has not got any help so far. The old aged persons are also in great trouble. She is happy that this company has come here to open the mine for which she is hopeful that there will be overall improvement. Many companies have come here but they have not provided facilities like education, good road, pisciculture could not be done due to lack of pond, no drinking water facility. Due to scarcity of water, they could not do cultivation. There is no income source as a result the youth groups are compelled to sell Rasi and Handia (Rice Wine). So she requested to provide jobs to all according to the educational qualification and equally uneducated persons also should get employment and to provide education to the small children & Pension to the old.
- 9) **Sri Bidyadhar Naik, Guali:**
While supporting the PH he requested to provide compensation to displaced persons. He also requested to do mining activities only after providing houses to the displaced persons.
- 10) **Smt. Dipa Barik, Gandhalpada:**
While supporting the PH he stated that the local people were getting many things from their nearby forest but due to mining activities trees will be destroyed, they will be compelled to live with dust pollution and deprived of getting fire wood and other things. So she requested to provide gas connection to every household for their cooking purpose. She also requested for compensatory afforestation on the unused land, proper compensation, like house, land, employment etc. to the displaced persons, assistance to the SHG for their improvement, concrete road and facilities for the school going children.
- 11) **Smt. Jyotshna Palei, Nuagaon:**
While supporting the PH she was hopeful that this company will provide them help. At the same time she requested to take appropriate steps for safeguard of environment, appropriate steps for the education of the children.
- 12) **Smt. Sunita Munda, Nuagaon, Guali:**
While supporting the PH she demanded that before starting the mining activities, company should provide houses to them. At the same time, she requested to provide school teachers, computer training for the matriculate youths. She requested to provide all facilities to their locality. She stated situation of Munda community of their village as they could not do anything due to their innocence & bad financial conditions. She requested for providing old age pension.
- 13) **Smt. Janaki Kissan, Nuagaon:**
While supporting the PH she requested for drinking water facility, ambulance facility, education, computer teacher. She also requested to provide door to door Latrine & bathroom because when the mines will start gents will increase in number so it is essential. She requested for pucca house to those who will lose their land. Provide teachers to their schools through company as there is shortage of teachers.
- 14) **Smt. Basmati Munda, Gandhalpada:**
She supported the PH and proposed mining by M/s. OMECL. She requested for employment to unemployed youth, road repairing, school facilities & medical facilities. She requested to provide gas as during mining activities many trees will be destroyed and there will be scarcity of firewood. She also requested to provide help to their SHG for their future development.

- 15) **Ms. Tulasi Munda, Nuagaon:**
While supporting the PH she requested to provide employment to the local youths. Land loser should be allotted land patta.
- 16) **Smt. Puspanjali Barik, Nuagaon:**
While supporting the PH she requested to provide drinking water, computer center, employment to local, school teachers, employment to the SHG, ambulance, employment according to the qualifications, old age pension. She demanded not do mining activities during night (night shift).
- 17) **Sri Sambhunath Barik, Nuagaon:**
While supporting the PH, he demanded employment for educated youths according to their qualifications and skill as well as to all unskilled youths to be provided other mining related jobs for their livelihood. Local youths need to be given raising and transportation contracts. He also demanded for providing hostel, providing teachers for coaching for enhancing the quality of education, Scholarship need to be provided for motivating the student and also requested to take care of orphans. At last he submitted written demands to the Govt. Authority
- 18) **Sri Santosh Kumar Palei, Nuagaon :**
While supporting the PH, he expressed that since long there is no development of existing schools in this area. Necessary arrangement should be done to start spoken English/Hindi course. Nobody is giving attention for development for the students. In their project report, company management has proposed to start water sprinkling on the Murom road for reducing dust generation, but instead of Murom road he suggest for blacktop road with avenue plantation on both side of the road. He also suggested for construction of drain for run-off water from mines otherwise their agricultural land would be damaged.
- 19) **Sri Niladri Bihari Mishra, President, Paribesh Surakshya Samiti, Joda:**
While supporting the PH, he expressed that definitely there will be impact on Environment. The company in their Executive summary has mentioned about their proposal for pollution control like making garland drain, avenue plantation, protective wall and wet drilling. But in view of more dust generation in the mining belt, the company should go for green belt and waste land plantation as only water sprinkling is not the solution. There will be also more sound pollution due to running of heavy vehicles and mobile crusher for which company should give more priority for plantation.
- 20) **Sri Bajiram Munda, Gandhalpada:**
While supporting the PH, he requested the Company Management for proper heavy vehicle parking arrangement. Parking should not be done on the road because accidents are taking place in these areas weekly two to three times. There should not be any parking from Rugudi to Rengalbeda.
- 21) **Sri Sunil Champia, Gandhalpada:**
While supporting the PH, he stated that this is a tribal area and hence very less number of educated people is here, they should also be considered for employment. Further he stated that company should provide school for orphan child and orphanage for their accommodation.
- 22) **Sri Thomas Munda, Ward No.9, Nuagaon:**
While supporting the PH, he demanded the Company to look for proper implementation of the rehabilitation plan for the displaced people. He also requested for providing employment to local youths, providing primary education facility in primary school at Nuagaon and opening computer

center, Supply of drinking water through pipeline, providing streetlight and community hall, to promote sports activities for district/state level participation, providing medical facility, one changing room in their bathing ghata and latrine facility.

23) Sri Issac Munda, Gandhalpada:

While supporting the PH, he demanded for employment to educated person as per their qualification and also to other unskilled people, education facility to dropout students, providing road, street light , drinking water supply and bus for school and college students, plantation on road side.

24) Sri Dillip Munda, Gandhalpada:

While supporting the PH, he stated that company should take care of proper pollution control measures.

25) Smt. Kalpana Barik, Nuagaon::

While speaking in favor of the PH, she stated that employment should be provided to the local youths. Further she stated that in past whenever we go for employment, at that time the Company Management call the police and harass us since we are the poor people, which should not be done by company any more. The mine should consider our issues without any harassment to us. Also the mine shall provide employment to the displaced persons.

26) Sri Prafulla Munda, Gandhalpada:

While supporting the PH, he told that the company should not harass them. Due to operation of mines in this area, the generation of dust will be more and nobody is giving proper attention to this. He requested for arrangement of washing facility for those heavy vehicles coming out from mines premises. He also demanded for a stadium at Gandhalpada and employment for the youths.

27) Sri Manglu Munda, Gandhalpada:

While speaking in favor of the PH, he expressed that employment and education facility should be provided by the Company.

28) Sri Mansingh Munda, Nuagaon:

While supporting the PH, he informed that he is the residents of the village of the proposed mines and the people who will be displaced are not educated and also unable to raise their issues. They should be compensated properly. The persons, who are giving their land to the Company, should be paid fair price for their land. Further he told that the local people have no education, no degree, only they know to use hand tools, used for manual mining, hence, he requested to provide manual mining jobs to those persons. Further he expressed that there is no teachers in their Nuagaon primary school. On many occasions, they have pointed out this issue in the Block office but of no use. One Headmaster posted in Nuagaon Primary school comes only twice a month. He requested the mine to provide teachers in primary school and employment to youths.

29) Smt. Sukrumani Munda, Gandhalpada :

She supported the PH and requested to provide school bus service for the students.

30) Smt. Mati Munda, Gandhalpada:

She supported the PH and requested for employment of the local youths.

31) Sri Gajendra Barik, Gandhalpada:

While supporting the PH, he stated that they will not oppose for the Mines, there will be overall development of the people with the operation of Mines. Outside people are earning from this area whereas the local people are unable to earn from this area. There should not be any partiality. Mines should not run 24/48 hours, it should run timely either for 2 shifts or 3 shifts not for 24 hours.

32) Sri Kishore Kumar Tamdia, Gandhalpada:

He supported the PH and requested the Company to provide employment to the local people.

The Panel received 05 nos. of written representations of the local people demanding different facilities in the locality during the hearing which are enclosed herewith in original.


Observation:




