

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING HELD ON 13.05.2022 (AT 11.00 AM) AT VILLAGE JAMBHARA (HATAPADIA BRIDGE CHHAK, KHATA NO.234, PLOT NO.1072, KISSAM-BAGAYAT-II, AREA-AC 9.00 DEC) WITH RESPECT TO ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FOR BAITARANI SAND BED OF SRI GURUBRATA KHANDAI OVER AN AREA OF 8.62 HA. IN VILLAGE JAMBHARA UNDER HATADIHI TAHASIL OF KEONJHAR DISTRICT FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE.

The public hearing in respect of the project proposed by Sri Gurubrata Khandai for Baitarani sand bed over an area of 8.62 Ha. in village Jambhara under Hatadihi Tahasil of Keonjhar district was held on scheduled date & time with reference to:

- I. EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006 and Amendments thereafter.

The Panel consisted of the following members:

1. Shri Jadumani Mahala, Additional District Magistrate (Revenue), Keonjhar
2. Shri Puskar Chandra Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar, Odisha

Shri Jadumani Mahala, Additional District Magistrate, Keonjhar, supervised & presided over the public hearing process and was assisted by Shri Puskar Chandra Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting, the Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of the project proposed by Sri Gurubrata Khandai.

Shri Behera explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public, gathered in the meeting about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public. On behalf of the Project Proponent, Sri Pabitra Kumar Swain, Representative (Consultant) addressed the committee members and assembled public, and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management and various other CSR activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Then Shri Puskar Chandra Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:

- 1) **Sri Anadi Charan Panda, Jambhara:**
While supporting the proposed project, he stated that there are certainly some merits and demerits due to extraction and transportation of sand from river bed. Once the operation will start, people will be benefited. Certainly there will be issues like pollution, road conditions etc. which can be sorted out by dialogue. He requested to give permission for extraction of sand from river bed.
- 2) **Sri Muralidhar Jena, Jambhara sai Salabani:**
While supporting the Public Hearing, he expressed that if this sand bed extraction is started they will be benefitted and get employment by which they can earn their livelihood. Now most of the persons are jobless and compelled to live with starvation or half a day food.
- 3) **Sri Gurucharan Mahalik, Jambhara:**
He stated that in their village 80-85% residents are poor labour. Maximum people are living with starvation or one time food because they have no job. He requested for plantation, water sprinkling on the road to restrict the air pollution. He wholeheartedly supported the Public Hearing.
- 4) **Sri Manmath Muduli, Jambhara:**
He raised question whether anybody has gone to the site where the river bed mining has been proposed to be done. There is no road. He showed his dissatisfaction by saying that everybody is looking for their own benefit/interest. Once the job will start the owner will not bother and give attention to their issues, hence there will be disturbances.
- 5) **Sri Purna Mallick, Dimria:**
He requested Govt. Authority for his old age pension and one house for which he was compelled to come to the Public Hearing speaker dais at his 65 years of age otherwise he never attends any function.
- 6) **Sri Radhamani Jena, Jambhara, Salbani:**
She stated that they are daily wage earner and very poor. They are also unable to give good education to their children. She suggested to start river sand bed extraction job after proper road condition so that they can earn their livelihood. She supported the Public Hearing.
- 7) **Smt. Kabita Jena, Jambhara, Salbani:**
She stated that they have mortgaged their household belongings and borrowed money for this river sand bed mining lease. They are very poor and now a days they are unable to manage their livelihood through farming. She expressed her unhappiness to the audiences who is opposing this Public Hearing as there is no valid reasons to oppose. They have got this lease through proper bidding and auction process. Hence, she suggested to do the road repairing and after that they may start extraction job. She supported the Public Hearing.
- 8) **Sri Krupasindhu Mallick, Jambhara:**
While opposing the Public Hearing he stated that they wrote Collector for boulder pitching of the river side which has not been done but a result of extraction of sand the river embankment will be demolished and their village will go under water. He said that for transportation of sand the owner will certainly use heavy vehicles like hywa etc. as a result there is possibility of accident and

pollution. He also stated that all are looking at their own interest for their benefits and nobody has thought these issues.

9) **Smt. Parimita Perei, Jambhara, Salabani:**

While supporting the PH he suggested to repair the road and only after construction of road the river sand extraction job should start so that the poor people of their village will earn their livelihood.

10) **Sri Gadadhar Mallick, Jambhara:**

While opposing the project, he stated that as a result of extraction of river bed sand their village will be flooded due to damage of embankment.

11) **Sri Satyaprakash Senapati, Habelswar, :**

He raised question for the audience those who spoke that they borrowed money by mortgaging their house hold belongs for this getting lease. To whom they have paid money. He told that Sri Gurubrata Khandai does not belong to their locality he is outsider. He raised his concern that for transportation of 10/12 Hywa there is possibility of accident. By this sand extraction, activities only owner will be benefitted not the common people.

12) **Sri Prakash Mallick, Jambhara:**

He raised his concern that when this river bed sand extraction activates will start surely there will be huge movement of big trucks due to which their road will be damaged. He also stated that 99% people of their locality use cycle and bicycle for movement through this road and there are possibilities of accident. He told that without machine it is not possible to extract sand from the river bed.

13) **Sri Amulya Kumar Hati, Jambhara:**

While supporting the Public Hearing, he told that there are many other sand mines is working but why there is so much allegations. This river bed sand mine has been award by Govt. of Odisha through legal auction process and many took part in the auction process. This is nothing but a conspiracy to disrupt the Public Hearing. At the end he told that definitely there will be development of this locality.

14) **Sri Manoj Jena Jambhara:**

While supporting the Public Hearing, he requested repairing of road, water sprinkling on the road and plantation.

15) **Sri Nilamani Pradhan, Dimiria:**

He expressed his discontent by saying that there is no suggestion for saving the environment only looking at their own interest for profit making. He raised question that how many persons of their locality has come above the poverty line so far. If this sand mining activity starts, environment of this area will be damaged. He also told that if villagers will be in trouble nobody will come forward to support/save them except their own people. Nobody is interested to plant at least one tree. He also told that their area consists of 7 villages and 17 wards within 10 KM radius and he is talking for all of them. Now it is in the hand of Govt. whether this should start or not.

The Panel received **01 no.** of written representation of the local people demanding different facilities in the locality during the hearing which are enclosed herewith in original.


Observation:



It is brought to the notice of all concerned that Sri Gurubrata Khandai has proposed to have Environmental Assessment for Baitarini Sand Bed over an area of 8.62 ha. in village Jambhara under Hatadihi Tehsil of Keonjhar district to obtain Environmental Clearance from State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Odisha. The proponent has applied to the State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar for a Public Hearing.
