

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING HELD ON 17.05.2022 (AT 11.00 AM) AT VILLAGE KALARANGIATTA UNDER SUKINDA TEHSIL OF JAJPUR DISTRICT FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE IN RESPECT OF M/S FERRO ALLOYS CORPORATION LIMITED, FOR THE PROPOSED ENHANCEMENT IN PRODUCTION CAPACITY OF KALARANGIATTA CHROMITE MINE FROM 0.05 MTPA TO 0.15 MTPA (ROM) WITH MAXIMUM EXCAVATION OF 0.438 MILLION CUM/ANNUM OVER ML AREA OF 23.80 HA AT VILLAGE KALARANGIATTA UNDER SUKINDA TEHSIL OF JAJPUR DISTRICT.

The public hearing in respect of the Ferro Alloys Corporation Limited for proposed enhancement in production capacity of Kalarangiatta Chromite mine from 0.05 MTPA to 0.15 MTPA (ROM) with maximum excavation of 0.438 Million Cum/Annum, at Village Kalarangiatta, Tehsil Sukinda in Jajpur District was held on scheduled date & time at Kalarangiatta Village, Sukinda in the District of Jajpur with reference to EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006 and amendments thereof.

Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, Jajpur, supervised & presided over the public hearing process and assisted by Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of Kalarangiatta Chromite Mines of M/s Ferro Alloys Corporation Limited, at Kalarangiatta, Tehsil Sukinda in Jajpur District.



Welcoming the public, Sri Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, Jajpur welcomed the public and explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. 


