

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF BAITARANI SAND BED OF SRI MANAS KUMAR BARIK OVER AN AREA OF 8.284 HA IN VILLAGE ANANDPUR UNDER ANANDPUR TAHSIL OF KEONJHAR DISTRICT HELD ON 22.06.2022 AT 11.00 AM AT VILLAGE ANANDPUR (LOCALLY KNOWN AS "GHADADIAN PADA") (KHATA NO. 2/1, PLOT NO. 3359/5784 & 3359/5783 KISAM- BOTH AREA GHARABARI (PATITA) AREA- TOTAL AREA (AC. 1.30 DEC.) IN KEONJHAR DISTRICT.

The public hearing in respect of the above project was held on 22.06.2022 as per the schedule and at the venue in accordance with the EIA Notification S. O. 1533 (E) dt. 14.09.2006. The public hearing with regard to date, place and time was published in Daily News Paper. The process followed for public hearing was adequate.

Er P Kar, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar welcomed the public to the hearing and briefed about the objectives, process & procedures followed for conducting such public hearing.

Sri Bijon Kumar Thamba, O A S (S), PA, ITDA, Keonjhar presided over and supervised the public hearing. He briefed about the importance and objectives of such hearing and invited the project proponent to highlight on proposed project.

Sri Pabitra Kumar Swain (Consultant), Representative of the Project Proponent explained about the proposed project and briefed about the Pollution Control measures to be adopted in the Project.

The following is the summary of the public hearing proceedings, reflecting all the views and concerns expressed by the assembled public at the venue. It was recorded by the officials of the Regional Office, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Keonjhar.

1. Sri Krushna Chandra Ram, Councillor, ward No. 7, Anandpur

Sri Ram expressed his dissatisfaction over the lack of publicity about this public hearing. He hoped that Mr. Manas Kumar Barik would take appropriate step for maintaining the environmental norms as per Govt. guidelines when the sand extraction will start. He said that they are facing great difficulties for getting sand even though they are residing in the banks of river. They have to spent Rs.2800/- to Rs.3000/- for purchasing a tractor trip of sand. Actual rate of which is Rs.700/- to Rs.800/- per tractor trip. The PM Indira Aawas beneficiaries are also deprived of construction of a house due to high rate of sand. They are compelled to purchase sand from 50 KM distance in Rs.12000/- a trip. He requested Govt. authorities to immediately start the sand extraction process and ensure that they get sand at reasonable rate. He requested that Environmental impact/issues and other legal implications need to be monitored and appropriate measures by the Govt. authorities and lessee should be taken.

2. Sri Nirakar Dalei, Anandpur

Sri Dalei told that whatever the representative of Sri Manas Kumar Barik read out about the project need to be implemented and followed in reality. He showed his dissatisfaction for non-availability of sand in their locality at reasonable price even though they are residing in the banks of river Baitarani. He informed that for procuring sand they are facing great difficulties for different Government projects like PM Indira Aawas Yojana, road construction etc. Now a days many sand beds are not in operations and completely closed, as a result, people are in great trouble. People are compelled to purchase sand for Rs.2500/- to Rs.3000/- a tractor trip, actual rate of which should be Rs.700/- to Rs.800/-. He requested District Administration authorities to ensure smooth operations of the sand bed extraction. He said that Government should also monitor and regulate the movement of vehicles by issuing permit with respect to their capacity/type of vehicle etc. so that it will not damage the ring road. He requested administration





to consider the PM Indira Aawas & Biju Pucca Ghara beneficiaries for getting sand at reasonable price. He requested to ensure for protection of dam road, which should not be affected due to extraction of sand. In this regard, he demanded to demarcate the area of lease from where the extraction will take place. He requested to think for the labour class, for engagement in sand bed mining which will be great help for them for their livelihood.

3. Sri Nirmal Chandra Roul, Reporter, Sarbasadharana, Anandpur

Sri Roul requested to open the sand bed mining immediately, preferably before monsoon. He also said that the PM Indira Aawas Yojana or Biju Pucca Ghara beneficiaries who are very poor are deprived of construction of house due to high cost of sand getting from a very distant place. He once again requested for quick opening of the sand bed.

4. Sri Ramchandra Sahoo, Ex-Chairman, Anandpur

Sri Sahoo expressed that he was very happy that everybody will get sand as the river bed mining is going to start very soon. Nobody has any objection for opening of the river bed sand mining at their locality. It is necessary to open the sand mining because since long people of their area were harassed due to high cost almost in double rate of sand which they were purchasing from black marketers. Moreover, they need to pay Rs.50,000/- fine to administration when they are caught by the administration for illegal purchase of sand. In past it was observed by him that during the tender process the party quoted Rs.2007/- per Cum. whereas actual rate should be Rs. 35 to 40/-. He was surprised how the parties quote in so high rate and what profit margin they could earn after all other operational costs. So, he suggested the administration to accept the bid not more than 15% of the base rate. He told that lessee will not be able to pay royalty amount to the Government unless they earn through illegal way. He requested to immediately start the sand extraction job so that they can get sand in reasonable rate. At the same time he requested to ensure there shall be no damage to riverbanks owing to extensive excavation/extractions and requested to widen the riverbanks road as per government guidelines. He opined to think about the unskilled local labours for their livelihood smoothly along with operations through JCB machine hand in hand. At last, he requested Govt. authority to put a restriction or fixing a slab for charging high royalty rates.

5. Sri Asit Kumar Nayak, Anandpur

Sri Nayak requested to expedite the sand bed auction process. In past the auction process was completed by March every year. Due to late auction illegal mining of sand has increased manifold. So, he suggested starting the auction process much before the completion of existing mining lease period for continuity of sand extraction job for the benefit of the villagers.

6. Sri Satyabrata Ram, Ward No. 6, Anadpur

Sri Ram requested to start riverbed extraction job as early as possible because lots of PM Indira Aawas beneficiaries are being deprived of purchasing the sand at reasonable rate, as a result they are unable to construct a house for them. Poor people are compelled to purchase sand in very high cost even if they are residing in the banks of the river. They all are struggling for sand since long. He also said that he himself paid penalty 40 times for sand even when he took sand for charitable purpose for the poor people.

7. Sri Rabi Narayan Hota, Anandpur


Sri Hota said that he was unaware about the tent pitching but he could know from others that tent pitching has been done for conducting public hearing with regard to the River bed mining job. He informed the gathering, in past people were making their houses and sand was easily available. He showed his dissatisfaction to the Government for giving more attention to catch the illegal sand carrying vehicles even though people are not procuring sand free of cost and they pay for it. He raised question that how they could know the sand which they are purchasing has been extracted legally or illegally. As a citizen of independent India they are deprived of getting sand at their locality where sand is abundantly available. He finally said Government if needs can take money but anyhow they need sand.

The Regional Officer, SPCB, Keonjhar read over the issues raised by the public in the hearing. Sri Pabitra Kumar Swain (Consultant), Representative of the Project Proponent responded to the issues raised.



It is brought to the notice of all concerned that Sri Manas kumar Barik has proposed to have Environmental Assessment Sri Manas Kumar Barik has proposed to have Environmental Assessment for Baitarini Sand Bed over an area of 8.284 ha. in village Anandapur under Anandapur Tehsil of Keonjhar District to obtain Environmental Clearance from the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Odisha. The proponent has applied to the State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar for a Public Hearing.

By virtue of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India Notification No. S.O. 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006, the Board has been authorized to conduct environmental public hearing and as such invites suggestions, views, comments and objections on matters relating to environmental aspects of the proposed project from all the persons including bonafide residents, environmental groups and others located at the proposed site/sites of displacement/sites likely to be affected.

For the above purpose, a person will only mean:

- Any person who is likely to be affected by the grant of Environmental Clearance.
- Any person who owns his control over the project with respect to which an application has been submitted for environmental clearance.
- Any association of persons whether incorporated or likely to be affected by the project and / or functioning in the field of environment.
- Any local authority within any part of whose local limits is within the neighborhood, wherein the project is proposed to be located.

Persons as above who desire to submit their views, comments, objections etc. relevant to the project, may do so in writing within 30 days from the date of publication of this notice addressing the same to the Member Secretary, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha through Registered Post. Besides this, persons interested to submit their views relevant to the proposed mining project in writing or orally may also do so during the public hearing to be conducted on 22.06.2022 at 11.00 A.M Village Anandapur (locally known as "Ghodadian Pada") (khata no.2/1, Plot No.3359/5784 & 3359/5783, KISSAM-both are Gharabari (Ratita) Area-total area Ac.1.30 dec.) in village Anandapur under Anandapur Tehsil of Keonjhar District.
