

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING CONDUCTED ON 24.06.2022 AT 11 AM AT SANTHAPADA NUASAH PLAY GROUND, TALCHER TAHASIL OF ANGUL DISTRICT IN RESPECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FOR SANTHAPADA SAND QUARRY A (UNDER CLUSTER APPROACH) OVER ML AREA OF 14.56 HA IN VILLAGE SANTHAPADA UNDER TALCHER TEHSIL OF ANGUL DISTRICT.

Public hearing in respect of Environmental Assessment for Santhapada Sand Quarry A (Under Cluster Approach) Over MI Area of 14.56 Ha In Village Santhapada Under Talcher Tehsil Of Angul District.

Sri Santosh Kumar Pradhan, Additional District Magistrate (Revenue), Angul District, supervised and presided over the meeting, assisted by Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional officer, State Pollution Control Board, Angul and the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, SPC Board, Angul welcome the other panel member and the public, gave an introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notifications 2006 in respect of Environmental Assessment for Santhapada Sand Quarry A (Under Cluster Approach) Over MI Area of 14.56 Ha In Village Santhapada Under Talcher Tehsil Of Angul District.

Sri Deba Prasad Choudhury, Consultant of Santhapada Sand Quarry of Angul District on behalf of the proponent addressed the committee members and assembled public and gave a brief description about the proposed project. He also briefed about Santhapada Sand Quarry A (Under Cluster Approach) Over MI Area of 14.56 Ha In Village Santhapada Under Talcher Tehsil Of Angul District with the peripheral development work that had been taken up in this area, and made a presentation about the environmental



management, pollution control measures, solid waste-management of the related project. The copy of the statement of the industry read out at public hearing proceedings is enclosed.

Regarding public hearing of Santhapada Sand Quarry A (Under Cluster Approach) Over MI Area of 14.56 Ha In Village Santhapada Under Talcher Tehsil Of Angul District was publicized at one English Daily newspaper and one Odia daily newspaper before one month. It was also publicized at the office notice Board of Santhapada Gram Panchayat office, Tahasil Office Talcher, Jilla Parisad Office Angul, Block Chairman Office, Talcher and local villages of Santhapada etc. Public hearing also publicized through loud speaker at the Sirigida village area.

Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Angul & representative of State Pollution Control Board Odisha then invited the public to present their views about the proposed project on environmental consideration.

The views expressed by various speakers are as follows:

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| 01 | Sri Sahadev Sahu, Sarpanch Santhapada Gram Panchayat |
| | <p>He asked to the panel members that why Government has opened tender in respect to Santhapada sand mining project before conducting public hearing. He mentioned that existing sand mining projects operating the Brahmani river and for which surrounding villagers are affected in many ways such as</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">Due to sand excavation of sand from othersand mining project of Brahmani river (within Santhapada area), there is water pollution and the water is not fit for drinking in respect to human as well as cattle.Due to excessive mining of sand mining from this area depth of the river increases and subsequently ground water level in respect to dug well, tube well and ponds of Santhapada village have been decreased and villagers are facing problems.Sand loaded vehicles moving from Santhapada Sand mining area causing heavy traffic congestions.Due to excessive mining of sand mining the water level of nearby village water bodies are decreased and for which fish cultivation in village water bodies affecting. |

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| | <p>e) Due to excessive mining of sand mining the Brahmani river banks area has started eroding and there is possibility of flow patter change. Due to mechanized sand mining the water flow has changed its direction towards nearby village area and in future the river will become very closed to Santhapada village. If this will continues the entire people of Santhapada village will be affected.</p> <p>f) Due to erosion of river bank the existing greeneries are affected.</p> <p>g) Due to excess sand loaded traffic movement there is deterioration of road and causing air pollution.</p> |
| 02 | Sri Saroj Kumar Samal, Santhapada village |
| | <p>He welcomed the gathering of the public hearing and also welcomed the proposed sand mining project. He expressed that Santhapada sand mine has been operating since 1972. It is an old operating sand quarry. He expressed that due to scarcity of sand, completion of all Government construction projects is delayed. Villagers are not getting sand properly in respect to the in house construction works. He requested to the District Administration to provide necessary clearances as soon as possible. He expressed that the proposed sand mining project will lead to development in the area and also for locals. He demanded to take plantation works in the surrounding area.</p> |
| 03 | Sri Baidhar Samal, Santhapada village |
| | <p>He welcomed the gathering of the public hearing and also welcomed the proposed sand mining project. He demanded that on the bank of river stretch a complete boundary wall shall be constructed from Santhapada village bathing ghat to end portion of village area so that air pollution in this area and river bank soil erosion can able to minimized. He requested to make mango plantation at both side of approach road from Brahmani rive to NH approach point. He also mentioned that due to sand mining in different pockets of Brahmani river water loging takes place and on the other side water from Talcher township are being discharged to Brahmani river near Santhapada village bathing ghat area and this water are not able to mix & flow properly in river stream and causing development of many organisms. This causes many types of diseases in the local villages. So he requested that lessee shall not make any pocket and shall not obstruct any type natural flow pattern of river water. He expressed his opinion in favour of the project.</p> |
| 04 | Sri Santosh Kumar Samal, Santhapada village |
| | <p>He expressed that due to very high price of sand the villagers are not able to do their in-house civil works. Local contractors are similarly facing problems in</p> |

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| | respect to Government construction projects. He expressed that the proposed sand mining project will lead to development in the area and also for locals. He expressed that the lessee should start its mining activity as soon as possible. If this sand mining projects, the local villagers can able to get sand with a reasonable price. He expressed his views in support of the proposed sand mining project. |
| 05 | Sri Amit Bhukta, Santhapada village |
| | Without elaborating anything in detail he supported the proposed sand mining project. |
| 06 | Sri Santanu Kumar Bhukta, Santhapada village |
| | He mentioned that letter no 1636 dtd. 22.05.2022 issued from RO SPCB, Angul had received by Sarpanch yesterday. He did not want to support this proposed sand mining project and wanted to have public hearing in another date. He mentioned that executive summary of the proposed should be pasted on the wall of every villager of Santhapada village which has not done. He also mentioned that though the Santhapada sand mining project has been operating since 1972 but earlier it was operating manually but now a days it is operated mechanically for which voids are being created inside river stretch. He requested to make DPR again. He finally asks to the panel members to conduct public hearing again. |
| 07 | Sri Arjuna Mohanty, Santhapada |
| | He welcomed the gathering of the public hearing and also welcomed the proposed sand mining project. He pointed out that at present this Santhapada-Ka sand mining activity is not in operation and duo scarcity of sand, completion of all Government construction projects is being delayed and locals are not getting sand in a reasonable price. Although opposite side of the river sand mining project towards Parjang area are in operation but the sand price is very high. He requested to provide local employment opportunity and maintain adequate pollution control measures and strict adherence of sand mining guideline. If local sand mining starts the sand price will goes down and all the local villagers as well as local contractors will be benefitted. He finally requested to the District Administration to give necessary permission as soon as possible. He urged to the District Administration that during sand mining activity the mine proponent should follow the guideline in all respect and to ensure that sand mining is done in environmentally sustainable and socially responsible manner. |

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| 08 | Sri Ranjeet Samal, Santhapada village |
| | He expressed that local villagers are also facing problems for their small construction works due to non-availability of sand. He expressed that the proposed sand mining project will lead to development in the area and also for locals. He urged to the District Administration that with the proposed sand mining project the lessee shall provide all types of assistance to the nearby villages. He expressed his opinion in favour of the proposed sand mining project. |
| 09 | Sri Bhaskar Sahoo, Santhapada village |
| | He expressed that opening of sand mine in this area & production will lead to generation of Government revenues and more development of surrounding villages and more employment generation of the area. Expecting better employment opportunity and further development activities in the periphery, he supported the proposed sand mining project. |
| 10 | Sri Mohan Samal, Santhapada village |
| | He expressed his happiness about the sand mining project and he supported the sand mining project. He mentioned that as on date the villagers are not getting sand for in house construction. The local market value of sand is more than Rs. 4000 per cft. but if this sand mining starts, the price immediately goes down to 200/- per cft. He requested to the District Administration that if the sand mining projects starts the local villagers as well as local contractors will be benefitted in respect to employment and development of poor villagers lifestyle. He requested to maintain adequate pollution control measures and strict adherence of sand mining guideline. |
| 11 | Sri Ranjan Kumar Samal, Santhapada village |
| | He expressed that different lessee has created an approach road over the Brahmaniriver for movement of sand loaded trucks and for which natural flow of river changes its flow pattern. About 5000n local people has been using this Santhapada bathing ghat of Brahmani river for bathing activity but due to obstruction of river water flow villagers were facing so many problems. He mentioned he has no objection with respect to proposed sand mining but the lessee has to ensure that during the course of sand mining natural water flow of the river should not diverted otherwise about 5000 people of this village will agitate by blocking the National Highway. Finally, he urged to the District Administration that during sand mining activity the mine proponent should follow the guideline in all respect and to ensure that sand mining is done in environmentally sustainable and socially responsible manner. |

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| 12 | Sri Prabhat Samal, Santhapada village |
| | <p>He welcomed the public hearing. He mentioned that during monsoon time river water level increases and subsequently river bank started eroding. The villagers submitted memorandum address to Collector and District Magistrate, Angul with a request to provide stone patching on the bank to river stretch from Paschimeswar to Dasanali area to prevent soil erosion of river Bank. He pointed out that at present this Santhapada- Ka sand mining activity is not in operation and duo scarcity of sand, completion of all Government construction projects is being delayed and locals are not getting sand in a reasonable price. Although opposite side of the river sand mining project towards Sarang village area are in operation but the sand price is very high. He requested to provide local employment opportunity and maintain adequate pollution control measures and strict adherence of sand mining guideline. <i>If local sand mining starts the sand price will goes down and all the local villagers as well as local contractors will be benefitted. He finally requested to the District Administration to give necessary permission as soon as possible. If local sand mining starts its operation, it leads to generation of local employment.</i> He expressed his views in support of the proposed sand mining project.</p> |
| 13 | Sri Gopabandhu Sahoo, Santhapada village |
| | <p>He mentioned that during monsoon time river water level increases and subsequently river bank started eroding. He demanded the Government shall take immediate steps towards construction of concrete wall from Paschimeswar to Dasanali area of River Brahmbani stretch to prevent the river bank soil erosion. He demanded that local employment and adequate plantation programme should be taken up by the lessee with the production. He expressed his views in support of the proposed sand mining project.</p> |
| 14 | Sri Gyanendra samal, Santhapada village |
| | <p>He mentioned that this sand mining area has been operating since long times and local villagers has been getting benefits in all respect. Particularly they are getting sand very reasonable price or sometimes completely free of cost. Although some of the people are not in favour of the sand mining project but he supported the sand mining activity. He mentioned that local sand mining leads to all type of benefit for the local villages. He requested to maintain adequate pollution control measures and strict adherence of sand mining guideline.</p> |


Observation:


Generation of local employment opportunity, repair and maintenance of village road, not to construct barrier over natural water flow, construction of concrete wall from Pachimeswar to Dasanali to prevent soil erosion, supply of sand to the villagers with free of cost or reasonable price, adequate air and water pollution control, repair and maintenance of village roads and aforestation etc. were the most important issues emerged during the discussion.

Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Angul & representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, prepared the summary of the public hearing proceedings accurately reflecting the views and concerns expressed by the speakers with the inclusion of comments of the applicant read over to the audience at the end of the meeting explaining the contents in the ODIA Language and the agreed minutes of public hearing meeting was prepared. Provision for repair and maintenance of village roads 5. Construction of concrete wall/laterite wall from Pachimeswar to Dasanali area to prevent soil erosion of river bank 6. Not to construct barrier over Brahmani river and river water flow should not disturbed 7. Strict adherence of sand mining guideline. | <p>Sri Sankarsan Nayak, Representative of M/s Sheranwali Infrastructure Pvt. Ltd., of Santhapada River Sand Quarry-A mining project was present at the public hearing gave her comments to certain demands raised by public as follows.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.
