AT- VILLAGE HATURIAPAL UNDER TALCHER TEHSIL OF ANGUL DISTRICT.**

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Public hearing in respect of Environmental Assessment for Haturiapal sand quarry having Khata No. 39, Plot No. 1, Kissam Nadi over ML area of 10.72 Ha. At Village Haturiapal under Talcher Tehsil of Angul District.

Sri Santosh Kumar Pradhan, Additional District Magistrate (Revenue), Angul District, supervised and presided over the meeting, assisted by Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional officer, State Pollution Control Board, Angul and the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, SPC Board, Angul welcome the other panel member and the public, gave an introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notifications 2006 in respect of Environmental Assessment for Haturiapal sand quarry having Khata No. 39, Plot No. 1, Kissam-Nadi over ML area of 10.72 Ha. At Village Haturiapal under Talcher Tehsil of Angul District.

Sri Jayant Kumar Sethy, Representative of Consultant of Haturiapal Sand Quarry of Angul District on behalf of the proponent addressed the committee members and

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assembled public and gave a brief description about the proposed project. He also briefed about Haturiapal sand quarry having Khata No. 39, Plot No. 1, Kissam Nadi over ML area of 10.72 Ha. At Village Haturiapal under Talcher Tehsil of Angul District with the peripheral development work that had been taken up in this area, and made a presentation about the environmental management, pollution control measures, solid waste-management of the related project. The copy of the statement of the industry read out at public hearing proceedings is enclosed.

Regarding public hearing of Haturiapal sand quarry having Khata No. 39, Plot No. 1, Kissam Nadi over ML area of 10.72 Ha. At Village Haturiapal under Talcher Tehsil of Angul District was publicized at one English Daily newspaper and one Odia daily newspaper before one month. It was also publicized at the office notice Board of Haturiapal Gram Panchayat Office, Tahasil Office Talcher, Jilla Parisad Office Angul, Block Chairman Office, Talcher and local villages of Dasanali, Haturiapal etc. Public hearing also publicized through loud speaker at the Dasanali, Jhaliamba, Santhapada, Haturiapal village area.

Dr. Anup Kumar Mallick, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Angul & representative of State Pollution Control Board Odisha then invited the public to present their views about the proposed project on environmental consideration.

The views expressed by various speakers are as follows:

01	Sri Subhendu Mohan Samal, Dasanali village
	He expressed that due non availability of sand all the construction projects are being delayed. Simultaneously local villagers are also facing problems for their small construction works due to non-availability of sand. He expressed that the proposed sand mining project will lead to development in the area and also for locals. He urged to the District Administration that with the proposed sand mining project the lessee shall provide sand to the villagers either minimum reasonable price or free of cost.
02	Sri Dibya Ranjan Sahu, Jhadiamba village
	He welcomed the gathering of the public hearing and also welcomed the proposed sand mining project. He expressed his happiness towards Hatufiapal

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	<p>sand mining project as govt. has declared this new source nearer to their village. He expressed that due to scarcity of sand, completion of all Government construction projects is delayed and villagers are not able to construct any type of work. He requested to the District Administration to provide necessary clearances as soon as possible. He requested that with the proposed sand mining project the lessee shall provide sand to the villagers either minimum reasonable price or free of cost.</p>
03	<p>Sri Bimal Kumar Samal, Ward member (11 no. Ward), Dasanali village</p> <p>He welcomed the gathering of the public hearing and also welcomed the proposed sand mining project. He expressed that the lessee should start its mining activity as soon as possible. He urged to the District Administration that during sand mining activity the mine proponent should follow the guideline in all respect and to ensure that sand mining is done in environmentally sustainable and socially responsible manner. He requested that with the proposed sand mining project the lessee shall provide sand to the villagers either minimum reasonable price or free of cost. He demanded that the with the sand mining work, the mine authority should provide local employment opportunity. He expressed his opinion in favour of the project.</p>
04	<p>Sri Chhabila Samal, Dasanali village</p> <p>He expressed that due to very high price of sand the villagers are not able to do their in-house civil works / village temple construction works. Local contractors are similarly facing problems in respect to Government construction projects like Biju Pakka Ghar / Indira Abs Yojona etc. He expressed that the lessee should start its mining activity as soon as possible. He demanded that with the sand mining activity local employment, proper dust suppression measures on village roads, Tarpaulin cover of sand loaded trucks and repair and maintain of village roads and afforestation should be taken up by the lessee with the production. He expressed his views in support of the proposed sand mining project.</p>
05	<p>Sri Soubhagya Samal, Ward member (10 no. Ward) Dasanali village</p> <p>He mentioned that due to scarcity of sand , the sanctioned road construction project under Prime Minister Sadak Yoyona, Prime Minister Adarsha Yoyona, Biju Pakka Ghar, local villagers sanitary toilets, roads could not able to start. He expressed that the lessee should start its mining activity as soon as possible. He demanded that local employment and proper dust suppression measures should be taken up by the lessee with the production. He expressed his views in support of the proposed sand mining project.</p>



06	Sri Basanta Kumar Samal, Dasanali village
	<p>He expressed due to acute scarcity of sand local construction projects are facing so many difficulties. Local market sand price is also very high. He expressed that opening of sand mine in this area &amp; production will lead to more development of surrounding villages and more employment generation of the area. He mentioned that the local contractors are procuring sand from far distance with high price. If local sand mining starts the sand price will go down and all the local villagers as well as local contractors will be benefitted. He expressed that due to very high price of sand the villagers are not able to do their in-house civil works / village temple construction works. Local contractors are similarly facing problems in respect to Government construction projects like Biju Pakka Ghar / Indira Ahs Yojona etc. He expressed that the lessee should start its mining activity as soon as possible. He mentioned that this is the only single road which is being used by villagers, school children and movement of sand loaded and unloaded trucks. So, he urged that while plying of sand loaded vehicles through this village road, they should adopt tarpaulin covering of vehicle, speed restriction while movement of School children during School timing, proper dust suppression measures by water sprinkling. The lessee should maintain village roads. He expressed his views in support of the proposed sand mining project.</p>
07	Sri Ratan Kumar Saal, Dasanali village
	<p>He welcomed the gathering of the public hearing and also welcomed the proposed sand mining project. He supported the views expressed by previous speaker. He expressed that due to scarcity of sand, completion of all Government construction projects is delayed. He requested to the District Administration to provide necessary clearances as soon as possible. He requested to maintain adequate pollution control measures, repair and maintenance of village roads and strict adherence of sand mining guideline.</p>
08	Sri Manoj Kumar Samal, Dasanali village
	<p>He expressed that due to non availability of sand all the Indira Ahas Ghar construction projects are being delayed. Simultaneously local villagers are also facing problems for their small construction works due to non-availability of sand. He expressed that the proposed sand mining project will lead to development in the area and also for locals. . He mentioned that this is the only single road which is being used by villagers, school children and movement of sand loaded trucks. So, he urged that while plying of sand loaded vehicles through this village road, they should maintain speed restriction within the village road, adopt tarpaulin covering of vehicle and proper dust suppression measures by water sprinkling. He expressed his views in support of the proposed sand mining project.</p>

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09	Smt. Bhudei Nayak, Dasanali village
	She expressed due to acute scarcity of sand in house village construction works are facing so many difficulties. Local market sand price is also very high. She expressed that opening of sand mine in this area & production will lead to more development of surrounding villages and more employment generation of the area. Expecting better employment opportunity and further development activities in the periphery, she made a strong opinion in favour of the proposed sand mining project and requested to the Administration to issue Environmental Clearance against the proposed project.
10	Sri Kalia Sahoo, Santhapada village
	He expressed his happiness about the sand mining project and he supported the sand mining project. Without elaborating anything in detail he supported the proposed sand mining project and he requested to the District Administration that if the sand mining projects starts the villagers as well as local contractors will be benefitted in all respect.
11	Sri Bhaskar Sahoo, Santhapada village
	Without elaborating anything in detail he supported the proposed sand mining project.

At the end one villager Smt Sushila Sahoo, Ward Member of Jhadiamba village submitted one written representation submitted before the panel members are enclosed separately. She also spoke that Due to existing sand mining project

- a) This tourist place facing problems,
- b) River bank soil degrading,
- c) After sand mining the area become more depth and tourist people are dying during bathing time
- d) Plying of vehicles moving through village roads causing road damaged and villagers are facing problem ,
- e) Air pollution in this area
- f) School children facing problem
- g) Accidents are happened and due to bad road condition villagers could not able to approach Hospitals,
- h) Village fisher men affected,
- i) Shortage of Grazing lands,
- j) Storage of sands in Gochar lands and
- k) Village Ashram is losing its identity.

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**Observation:**


Generation of local employment opportunity, repair and maintenance of village road, supply of sand to the locals with reasonable price and adequate air and water pollution control, repair and maintenance of village roads, speed restriction during school timings, tarpaulin coverage on trucks and aforestation etc. were the most important issues emerged during the discussion.


