PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING HELD ON 06.07.2022 (11.00 AM) AT MAHAGIRI ENCLAVE(KHATA NO 53/15, PLOT NO 664), VILLAGE KALIAPANI TEHSIL SUKINDA IN THE DISTRICT OF JAJPUR FOR ENHANCEMENT IN PRODUCTION CAPACITY FROM 3.00 LTPA TO 6.00 LTPA OF MAHAGIRI CHROMITE MINES OVER AN AREA OF 73.777 Ha. IN VILLAGE KALIAPANI UNDER SUKINDA TEHSIL OF JAJPUR DISTRICT OF M/S INDIAN METALS & FERRO ALLOYS LTD (IMFA)

The public hearing in respect of the project proposed by M/s. Indian Metals & Ferro Alloys Ltd(IMFA) for enhancement in production capacity from 3.00 LTPA to 6.00 LTPA of Mahagiri Chromite Mines over an area of 73.777 Ha. in village Kaliapani under Sukinda Tehsil of Jajpur District was held on scheduled date & time in Mahagiri Enclave in the district of Jajpur with reference to:

- I. EIA Notification S.O 1533 (E) Dtd. 14.09.2006
- II. Interim Operational Guidelines till 13<sup>th</sup> September 2007 in respect of applications made under EIA-1994

#### The Panel consisted of the following members:

Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar, supervised & presided over the public hearing process and assisted by Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, the representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, welcoming the members participated in the meeting Sri Pramod Kumar Behera, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Kalinganagar, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, in respect of project proposed by M/s. Indian Metals & Ferro Alloys Ltd (IMFA).

Welcoming the public, Sri S.K. Mishra, Additional District Magistrate, Kalinganagar explained that the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project. He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the

various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public. On behalf of the Project Proponent, Sri Lalatendu Mohapatra, Sr General Manager of M/s. IMFA Ltd addressed the committee members and assembled public, and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management, afforestation programme and various other peripheral development activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Then Sri Mishra, ADM, Kalinganagar, requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

The views expressed by various speakers on the proposed project are as follows:

#### 1. Bharat Ch Mahanta, Kaliapani

He welcomed to the administration, local gathering & media. He told that representative of IMFA had told that they would give opportunity to local employees but recently they have cancelled gate pass of 230 numbers local Peoples. They wanted to know the reason why gate pass of poor people was cancelled by IMFA. IMFA has not done developmental work for locality. IMFA has not given gate pass to local loading labors till now. They wanted local labors to be reemployed in the mine and opposed the project till local loading labors will be reemployed.

## 2. Kurtibas Bhanja, Ransol

He welcomed the panel and told that local peoples are not getting benefitted and the local trucks also not getting any loading permission in the mine. He told that IMFA should reengage the local 230 loading labour. He told that they will support the project after reemployment of local 230 villagers. He told that local villagers are not getting benefitted by IMFA and their trucks are also not getting loading permission. He suggested for local employment and plantation. He told that they will support the project if IMFA will give employment to local villagers and loading permission to local truck owners.

#### 3. Biswajit Mohanty, Ransol

He welcomed the panel and gathering and expressed that local villagers are not getting benefitted rather laborers are not reengaged in loading activity. They are not getting any medical facility from IMFA. He opposed the project and insisted others to oppose the public hearing.

### 4. Bhagabati Mohanta, Chingudipal

She expressed that local villagers were not getting employment opportunity, so she opposed the public hearing.

#### 5. Suresh Patra, Damadarpur

He told that they are not getting regular payment for their work and other benefits.

The Panel has not received any written representations during the hearing. Total ten persons registered their name to deliberate, but five persons deliberated their views. So, Sri Santosh Kumar Mishra, ADM, Kalinganagar again invited the people to deliberate their views, if any but no more people came to deliberate. Then the chair invited the project proponent to present their comments to the people with respect to the issues raised by the public in the public hearing meeting. Sri Lalatendu Mohapatra of M/s. IMFA Ltd. made the commitment on issued raised by the public. The statement of issues and concern of the public with comments of the applicant prepared in odia and English language is annexed separately. Finally, the meeting was ended with thanks to the chair.
