

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF BAGIABURU IRON ORE MINES OF M/S. ORISSA MINERALS DEVELOPMENT CO. LTD FOR PRODUCTION OF 3.6 LTPA IRON ORE OVER MINING LEASE AREA OF 21.52 HA. AT VILLAGE ULIBURU, TAHASIL BARBIL HELD ON 21.07.2022 AT 11.00 AM AT BARBIL VILLAGE, U. NO.7, KHATA NO. 483, PLOT NO. 1343/1772, AREA-AC 0.440 IN THE KEONJHAR DISTRICT.

The public hearing in respect of the above project was held on 21.07.2022 as per the schedule and at the venue in accordance with the EIA Notification S. O. 1533 (E) dt. 14.09.2006. The public hearing with regard to date, place and time was announced in Public Address System in nearby villages of proposed project site and also published in Daily News Paper. The process followed for public hearing was adequate.

Er P Kar, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar welcomed the public to the hearing and briefed about the objectives, process & procedures followed for conducting such public hearing.

Sri Jadumani Mahala, OAS(SAG), Additional District Magistrate(Revenue), Keonjhar presided over and supervised the public hearing. He briefed about the importance and objectives of such hearing and invited the project proponent to highlight on proposed project.

Sri Jairam Parida, Business Head of the mine explained about the proposed project and briefed about the Pollution Control measures to be adopted in the mine.

The following is the summary of the public hearing proceedings, reflecting all the views and concerns expressed by the assembled public at the venue. It was recorded by the officials of the Regional Office, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Keonjhar.

1. Smt. Godabari Patra, Thakurani

Smt. Patra requested to start the mines as soon as possible for the sake of education of their children and for maintaining their livelihood smoothly. She said that presently they are in great trouble due to closure of mine.

2. Smt. Madhuri Karva, ward No. 3, Thakurani

Smt. Madhuri earnestly requested for early commencement of mining activities as for a long period the mine has been closed.

3. Smt. Dukhini Das, Ward No. 3, Thakurani

Smt. Das requested to start the mine immediately.

4. Smt. Meena Munda, Dalki basti, Thakurani

Smt. Meena stated that since last 10 to 15 years the OMDC mine is closed for which they are in trouble & asked how they will maintain their livelihood. So, she requested to start the mines as soon as possible. She submitted a written representation to the Chair.

5. Sri Ritesh Mahanta, Thakurani

Sri Mahnata requested to give permission for starting the mines because since long the mine is closed and as a result young mass have remained unemployed. He said that if mine will open many unemployed youth will get employment.

6. Smt. Kanchani Naik, Thakurani

Smt. Naik submitted a written memorandum to the chair.

7. Sri Dharmendra Mahanta, Councillor, Ward No.7, Thakurani

Welcoming the public hearing Sri Mahanta stated that since last 12 years this mines is closed. He requested to give attention for giving employment to the local youth according to their qualifications and abilities. At the same time, he requested to give transportation contract to the local residents.

8. Smt. Renuka Behera, Dalki Basti, Thakurani

Smt. Renuka requested to give employment according to the qualification and ability and start the mining activities.

9. Smt. Laxmi Karva, Ward No. 3, Thakurani

Smt. Karva requested to start the mining activities as due to closure of mines since long the unemployed youths are sitting idle for want of job. She also said that they will have a good livelihood if the mine will start operating.

10. Smt. Basanti Devi, Ward No. 3, Thakurani

Smt. Basanti requested to give permission for mining operations.

11. Smt. Sunita Karva, Ward No. 3, Thakurani

Smt. Sunita requested to start the mining operations so that their children can continue their education and at the same time she requested to provide employment to the unemployed youth.

12. Smt. Sushila Mahanta, Ward No. 3, Thakurani

Smt. Sushila stated that since 10 to 12 years due to closure of mines their children are starving, hence, she requested to start the mines.

13. Smt. Satpathi Das, Ward No. 3, Thakurani

Smt. Satpathi requested to start the mines.

14. Sri Prasant Kumar Mahakud, Ward No. 8, Barbil Municipality

Sri Mahakud stated that this is an old company. Due to closure of mines since long the salary of the staffs are not regular. So he requested for grant of EC and to start the mining activities.

15. Sri Nata Kishore Mahakud, Belkundi

Sri Mahakud fully supported the public hearing.

16. Sri Sarangidhar Mahanta, Karakolha Basti

Sri Mahanta fully supported the public hearing and requested for start of the mine as soon as possible.

17. Sri Chandragupta Prasad, Mahanta Basti, Barbil

Sri Prasad stated that the residents of Barbil were eagerly waiting since 2 years for this occasion. He thanked Govt. authority for giving permission to conduct public hearing for this mine. He also said even though the mine is closed for 12 years, the company has not retrenched even a single person. He requested to start the mine soon so that everybody will be able to earn their livelihood. All Barbil residents have support to start the mine for early commencement of the mining operations.

He submitted a written memorandum to the chair.

18. Sri Indramani Behera, Barbil

Sri Behera stated that OMDC is a central government enterprise and he has very old relationship with OMDC. Since 12 years this mines is closed. It was told that when the mine was operational it gave employment to 5000 people. He told that definitely there will be adverse environment impact due to mining operation/activities in a small patch of 21.52 ha. in Uliburu forest but in broader perspective, benefit will be more and in large scale. So he requested to give permission to this mining operation as this project is a government enterprise. He also said that this is a Government enterprise not a private enterprise, so its aim is to earn profit and simultaneously to generate employment. He is hopeful when the mine will start they will definitely look into the problems of local residents which they have been facing since last 12 years and at the same time they will follow the environment issues as per the Govt. guidelines. He requested Government authority to give immediate permission to start the mine without any delay otherwise bank will fridge the company's account and employees will not be able to get their salary for delay permission.

19. Sri Dilu Swain, Barbil

Sri Swain said that this mine has been closed since last 12 years. Earnings of Barbil area will increase with the operation of mining activities. He said that the mines should run keeping in mind the environment impact. The trees which will be cut /destroyed due to mining activities, equal number of trees need to be planted. At the same time, water bodies need to be protected. In this regard he requested the Company & Government authorities to give proper attention to the environment. He supported the Public hearing.

20. Sri Indradev Yadav, Ward No. 7, Barbil Municipality

Sri Yadav supporting the public hearing requested the company to give importance to employment to the locals. He also requested to give more attention to control pollution and to protect river & nallahs.

21. Sri Bibhuti Mahakud, Ward No. 2, Belkundi

Sri Mahakud said that he is happy that OMDC mine will run. At the same time he requested to look after local village development, employment to local unemployed youth.

22. Sri Chinmaya Mahakud, Belkundi

Sri Chinmaya fully supported the public hearing. He said that today is day of joy because due to OMDC mine many people could get employment. OMDC is such a mine who always gives attention towards prosperity of the people. He said that they have full support for operation of the mine and

demanding to give first priority to the Patta holders (LR) for employment according to their qualifications and ability.

23. Sri Sashikant Khilar, Zilla Parishad, Zone No. 26

Sri Sashikanta fully supported the public hearing because there is acute unemployment problem. He said that people will get employment and maintain their livelihood when the mine will be operational.

24. Sri Nilamani Mahanta, ward No. 5

Sri Mahanta requested to start the mines as soon as possible. At the same time, he requested to give utmost attention for safeguard environment like dust, smoke etc. He requested for water sprinkling for dust suppression.

25. Sri Purnachandra Apat, Belkundi

Sri Apat supported the public hearing and given his consent to run the mine.

26. Sri Deepak Kumar Mahakud

Sri Kumar supporting the public hearing stated that OMDC is a very old company. When he was child his father was working in the mine. This company is always with them in their well and woe but due to closure of the mine there are in great trouble.

27. Sri Siba Shankar Mahanta

Sri Shankar supporting the public hearing demanded that all the mines should run which will be beneficial for them with regard to employment generation, running the business etc. At the same time, he showed his discontent by stating that even though they are supporting the company to run their mine but there is nobody to monitor/follow up given commitments of the company, whether the company is keeping their commitment or not with respect to employment etc. He demanded pollution control board or any other authority to properly monitor the road condition, dust pollution etc. He also said they have supported a lot many mines for operation so that the nearby villagers would get employment but all promises have gone vain. Still people are protesting for employment. So he demanded for employment to the local youth instead of outsiders.

28. Sri Subrata Kumar Patra, Councillor, Ward No.13

Sri Patra supported the public hearing. He raised a question that earlier few have said that the company have been paying salaries to 500 employees even if it is closed but has the company thought anything about 5000 families who are starving. So he requested to run the mine as soon as possible so that local youths will get employment and requested for priority to locals instead of outsiders. He has not signed in the Oral Deliberators Sheet.

29. Sri Arjun Patra, Pal Hutting, Ward No.8

Sri Patra supported the public hearing and requested to run the mine as soon as possible keeping in mind the issues like unemployment, environment management and socio-economic development. He has not signed in the Oral Deliberators Sheet.

30. **Sri Gyaneswar Patra, Karakhendra**

Sri Patra said that he is supporting the public hearing.

31. **Sri Deepak Karmakar, Ward No.7**

Sri Karmakar supported the public hearing for Bagiaburu Iron Mines and demanded for employment for the unemployed local youth.

32. **Sri Bipin Bihari Mahanta, Ward No.7, Mahanta Basti**

Sri Mahanta supported the public hearing and stated that earlier Barbil market was depending upon M/s. Kalinga Iron Works and OMDC for their livelihood. But as the mine has been closed for long they are facing difficulties so requested for early operation of the mine. He has not signed in the Oral Deliberators Sheet.

33. **Sri Md.Ziaullah Khan, Ward No.2**

Md. Khan requested to grant permission to Bagiaburu Iron Mines as this is closed since 12 years as a result the situation is worse. Due to corona the public hearing process got late so now the public hearing needs to make success. He requested Company to give a thought for giving employment to local people and also requested for operation of the mine.

34. **Sri Jhakirias Kispatta, Ward No.2**

Sri Kispatta supported the public hearing and stated that the local Adivasi people are depending mainly upon the forest products like mushroom, wood leaf etc. when mines will run the forest will be damaged and it will affect their livelihood. So he requested company to plant equal number of trees which will get cut due to mining operations. Due to transportation of ore dust will be generated, so he requested the company to think about this issue. He also demanded employment to the local youths as they are getting compelled to go other state in search of employment. Lastly he requested for early operation of the mine.

35. **Sri Debakanta Rath, Ward No.3**

Sri Rath supported the public hearing and demanded for giving priority upon providing employment to the local youth and said he is hopeful that if the mine will be operational definitely locals will be opted for employment.

36. **Ms. Subuni Munda, Karakanda GP**

Ms. Munda supported the Mines.
She submitted a written memorandum to the chair.

37. **Smt. Hiramani Munda, Karakanda GP, Ward No.4**

Smt. Munda supported the public hearing and said she is hopeful that this will generate employment for the local poor people. She also said that the company shall look after the dust emissions that will be generated during blasting. Lastly she requested for operation of the mine.

38. Sri Arun Kumar Patra, Dalki Basti, Ward No.2

Sri Patra demanded for 100% employment for local youths. He requested Pollution Control Board to take appropriate steps for control of dust generation due to transportation. He also requested to provide better facilities for OMDC hospital.

39. Sri Biswanth Patra, Uliburu

Sri Patra said that mine shall start operation so that nearby village people will get employment and supported the public hearing.

40. Sri Kishore Kumar Mahakud, Belkiundi, Ward No.2

Sri Kumar said that OMDC is 100 years old company. The residents of Belkundi have suffered a lot due to wash out during last rain. He is hopeful that they will get help and especially the affected persons need to be provided employment positively. He requested to grant Environmental Clearance and also requested the mine to give local employment.

41. Sri Dambrudhar Mahanta, Mahanta Basti, Ward No.7

Sri Mahanta said that the mine will come into operation very soon so the mine shall look after the dust emissions issues.

He submitted a written memorandum to the chair.

42. Sri Parsuram Palei, Uliburu

Sri Palei said along with others he is also supporting the public hearing. When mine will operate the highly educated local youths will get employment and villages will be developed. But, simultaneously there will be issues regarding dust emissions. So, he requested to provide medical facilities for the local people, permanent employment to the locals, supply of clean drinking water to the nearby villages as the water of the natural stream has become contaminated and not fit to drink due to increase in mining and industrialization. He suggested that an agreement shall be made between the company and Govt. authority with respect to employment promise, providing medical facilities etc. so that in case company violates the agreement they can approach to higher Govt. authorities for its fulfilment. Company should look into and take appropriate steps towards providing permanent employment to local youths, medical facility, afforestation, better road condition, control pollution etc. He stated that had this public hearing being arranged at Uliburu village instead of Barbil Municipality area, local Adivasi could also have participate in the public hearing. Bbut due to long distance, they were deprived of participating in the hearing.

43. Sri Vikash Sarwagi, MATOA President, Barbil

Sri Vikas said that everybody knows that Barbil Market is dependent upon M/s. Kalinga Iron Works and OMDC but both are closed. It is unfortunate that OMDC is closed since last 12 years. As a result, they become unemployed and sitting idle. He requested to run the mines so that all the shopkeepers from small to large will be benefitted and everybody will be benefitted. He is hopeful that OMDC will fulfil their necessities after operation of mine because it has stood with the people in their time of difficulties when the mine is closed. He once again requested the

company & both Central & State Government to mutually complete all the formalities and start the mine operation as early possible.

44. Sri Suresh Sandil, Ward-3, Thakurani

Sri Sandil stated that definitely mines would run but at the same time the environment need to be protected so that Global-warming problem will not arise. He informed that once mines Manager Mr. Mohapatra visited their colony and informed them that ground water level is depleting day by day. In this regard he advised not to cut trees because trees hold water level. The area where mining activities will be done is Adibasi populated area. Adivasi is such a community who live with nature and die in nature. So, he requested to promote Adivasi for protection of trees because they live in Jungle, and they know how to protect the nature. He also said that company needs to ensure the education facilities & medical facilities in reality. Lastly he supported the public hearing full-fledgedly.

45. Sri Durgeswar Barik, Ward-2, Dalki Basti

Sri Barik supported the public hearing.

46. Sri Ramchandra Naik, Ward No.3, Thakurani

Sri Naik supporting the public hearing requested to start the mine. He said that once the mine will start the local boys & girls, Basti people, people from affected areas will get employment and other facilities.

47. Sri Jagannath Nath Naik, Dalki Basti

Sri Naik stated that this company is closed since last 12 years as a result they are in great trouble. Their cultivation has stopped and their agricultural lands became infertile. He said there is no opportunity of employment and they may not get employment after operation of mine but still they want the mine to operate.

48. Sri Md.Nazir, Barbil

Md. Nazir welcomed the public hereaing and said that mines should start operation so that everybody will get employment and area will be developed. But, simultaneously he pointed out that many mines have opened recently, and residents of their area had extended their support to them. Nevertheless, every year out of 500 students pass out from Barbil College out of which even 100 students cannot manage to get employment. He also pointed out that dust pollution level of this area is so high that get settled in their foodstuffs. In this regard, he suggested the company to give proper attention into these problems and requested the Govt. to look after it.

49. Sri Khagen Mahanta, Ward No.7, Mahanta Basti

Sri Mahanta requested for early operation of the mine.

50. Sri Arjun Mahanta, Ward No.3, Thakurani

Sri Mahanta stated that the mines is going to start after 12 years which he welcome. He pointed out that even though there are other industries nearby but the local people are not getting

employment. Outsiders are getting employment. So, he requested company to provide employment to the technical and non-technical local youths. He supported for opening the mines.

51. Sri Rabindra Muni, Ward No.3, Thakurani

Sri Muni requested to start the mine as soon as possible which has been closed since last 12 years.

52. Sri Bijay Kumar Behera, Ward-2, Dalki Basti

Sri Behera pointed out that OMDC has never turned up regarding ambulance facility. Even after requesting for ambulance many a times the company has not provided rather they are getting the service from Mittal Company. So, he requested OMDC to give proper attention towards health services. Lastly he supported the public hearing full fledgedly.

53. Sri Prakash Chandra Palei, Uliburu, Ward-3

Sri Palei requested to start the mines. He requested for providing employment to the unemployed and to resolve other issues.

54. Sri Arun Kumar Mahanta, Ward No.2, Thakurani

Sri Mahanta supported the public hearing full fledge.

55. Sri Ghanshyam Jha, Thakurani

Sri Jha requested to start the mines as soon as possible which will solve hardships of everybody.

56. Sri Niranjan Mahanta, Thakurani

Sri Mahanta support the public hearing and requested to start the mines.

57. Sri Sahadev Patra, Ward No.2

Sri Patra supported Bagiaburu Iron Mines for operation.

58. Sri Sunny Singh, Ward-3

Sri Singh supported the public hearing.

59. Sri Vickey Sahu-Ward-3

Sri Sahu supported the public hearing.

60. Sri Amarpreet Singh, Ward No.6, Barbil

Sri Singh said that OMDC is closed since 12 years, as a result, unemployment is has increased at its high. He stated that there are many companies in this area, but no company is better than OMDC the reason is even though this is closed since 12 years the company is managing the livelihood of 500 employees. He said that the mine should operate as early possible fr which they are ready to extend every kind of support.



61. Sri Sahabaz Khan, Ward No. 8

Sri Khan supported to start the mine.

62. Sri Bijay Sahu, Ward No.4

Sri Sahu supported to start the mine as early possible.

63. Sri Kishna Gupta, Ward No.4

Sri Gupta supported OMDC.

64. Sri Akash Yadav, Ward No. 7

Sri Yadav supported OMDC mine.

65. Sri Suraj Mahanta, Ward No.4

Sri Mahanta requested for early operation of the mine and supported OMDC mine.

66. Sri Sohaib Akhtar, Ward No.8

Sri Akhtar supported OMDC mines.

67. Sri Kalpataru Minj, Councillor, Ward No-3

Sri Minj requested to start the mine and to provide employment to everybody. Lastly he supported the public hearing.

68. Sri Gurucharan Mahanta, Councillor, Ward No.8

Sri Mahanta extended full support to start the mines. He requested the company to resolve unemployment problem of their area and to provide every benefits possible to the local people.

69. Sri Subash Sitari, Sarpanch, Karakhendra Gram Panchayat

Sri Sitari supported to start early operation of the mine because it has been closed since last 12 years. He requested the company to resolve the basic issues.

70. Sri Rajendra Kumar Das, Ward No.4, Barbil Municipality

Sri Das said that even though he has full support to the public hearing but at the same he pointed out that before starting of the mining operations most of them has given assurances for employment to the local youth, but they are keeping outsiders in their mines depriving the local educated unemployed youths. So, he requested company to pay attention to the aforesaid issue. Lastly he said that mine should operate as early possible.

71. Sri Md.Hakim, Ward No.8

Sri Hakim supported the mine.

72. Sri Prasant Kumar Das, Councillor, Ward No.9

Sri Kumar supported the public hearing and emphasised on employment to the local youths. He said that on several occasions assurances was given for employment to local youths and development through CSR activities which has not been fulfilled. He stated that their ancestors have worked in this company this is a old and good company, but there are locals having good qualification working outside having no other option. He said that he himself being a geologist is working at Jharkahand as he didn't get chances here as he was a fresher. So he is hopeful that their issues will be given proper attention by the company. Lastly he supported the mine.

73. Sri Biswajit Sethi, Ward No.15

Sri Sethi supported for early operation of the mine.

74. Sri Saumyaranjan Naik, Ward No.6

Sri Naik support OMDC mine.

75. Sri Gobinda Soren, Ward No.6

Sri Soren supported to start the mines and requested for employment to the local youth.

76. Sri Gurucharan Patra, Ward No.3, Thakurani

Sri Patra supported OMDC mine.

77. Sri Aditya Jena, Ward No 06

Sri Jena support OMDC mine.

78. Sri Md,Shahil, Ward No.8

Sri Sahil supported OMDC mine.

79. Sri Chanchal Bahadur, Ward No. 3, Thakurani

Sri Bahadur support to start the mine.

80. Sri Rahul Singh, Ward No. 5

Sri Singh supported OMDC mine.

81. Sri Prashanta Palei Ward No-3

Sri Palei support to start the mine.

82. Sri Manoj Kumar Apat- Ward No-3

Sri Apat support to start the mine.

83. Sri Neel Kumar Sahu, Ward No.3, Thakurani

Sri Sahu stated that even though this mine is closed since last 12 years but, they are providing all sorts of facilities like medical services, medicines, drinking water, electricity, salary to the employees. No where will they see such a big and generous company. So, he requested to start the company as soon as possible. He also said that after operation of the mine OMDC is ready to provide many other facilities to this area.

84. Sunil Mahanta, Ward No.7, Barbil Municipality

Sri Mahant said that every resident of Barbil has supported the public hearing because this is only company here to look after them though this is a very small mine. He requested to pay attention to other big mines operating in the nearby areas. He said that Barbil residents are always with OMDC and OMDC is also always with them. Lastly he supported to start the mines.

85. Laxman Mahanta, Karakola village

Sri Mahanta said that already 99% people have supported the mine and finally gave a mass support on the podium for operation of the mine.

86. Dr. Padmasree Tulsi Munda

Dr. Munda said that it has been 12 years they were waiting when the mine will start operating but finally the day has come and advised to run the mine as soon as possible so that every face can have a smile on it. Lastly she supported the mine.

The Regional Officer, SPCB, Keonjhar read over the issues raised by the public in the hearing. Sri Jairam Parida, Business Head of the mine responded to the issues raised. Sri Jadumani Mahala OAS(S), ADM (Revenue) Keonjhar gave concluding remarks of the Hearing.

The issues raised by the public and corresponding comments of the applicant were prepared in Odia and English and it is annexed with the proceedings as Annexure I & II respectively, list of the oral deliberators and participants in the hearing is annexed as Annexure III & IV respectively. Eighteen numbers of written representations received during public hearing is annexed as Annexure-V (a to r). The videography of proceedings is recorded and submitted in pen drive (I).
