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PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING FOR GRANT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE FOR THE PROPOSED PURHEIBAHAL IRON ORE BLOCK OF M/S. RUNGTA MINES LTD. OVER AN AREA OF 64.337 HA. FOR PRODUCTION OF 1.0 MTPA OF IRON ORE WITH TOTAL EXCAVATION – 1.064 MTPA (ROM IRON ORE: 1.0 MTPA + OVERBURDEN 0.064 MTPA) AT: BADAINDUPUR & SANINDUPUR VILLAGES UNDER KOIRA TAHASIL OF SUNDARGARH DISTRICT HELD ON DTD. 03.08.2022, AT 01.30 PM AT THE OPEN GROUND NEAR SANINDUPUR CHOWK OF SANINDUPUR VILLAGE, TAHSIL: KOIRA, IN THE DISTRICT OF SUNDARGARH.

The public hearing of M/s. Rungta Mines Ltd. for grant of Environmental Clearance for the proposed Purheibahal Iron Ore Block over an area of 64.337 ha. for production of 1.0 MTPA of iron ore with total excavation – 1.064 MTPA (ROM Iron Ore: 1.0 MTPA + Overburden 0.064 MTPA) was held on dtd. 03.08.2022 at 01.30 PM at the Open Ground near Sanindupur Chowk of Sanindupur Village, Tahsil: Koira in the district of Sundargarh. Sri Shiba Toppo, Additional District Magistrate, Sundargarh, supervised and presided over the Public Hearing Process. Dr. Binod Bihari Dash, Senior Environmental Scientist and Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Rourkela delivered welcome address, organized and conducted the public hearing meeting in association with District Administration. During the course of Public Hearing, the guidelines for Covid-19 has been duly followed.

The Public Hearing in respect of the above proposed Purheibahal Iron Ore Block stated as per the schedule and the venue decided by the District Magistrate in accordance with the EIA Notification S.O.1533 (E) dated 14.09.2006 and subsequent amendment therein. The State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar had advertised in newspaper in Odia daily– Sambad on dtd. 28.06.2022 and in English daily- The Times of India on dtd.28.06.2022. The Public Hearing meeting with regards to date, place and time was announced in public address system apart from its publication in local dailies. The attendance sheet of the public attended the public hearing is annexed as Annexure – I. Around 91 persons had attended the public hearing meeting where as 46 persons had delivered their views whose list is annexed as Annexure II.

At the outset, Dr. Binod Bihari Dash, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Rourkela welcomed the panel members and the public presented in the meeting. He briefly described the objectives and procedure followed for conducting the Public Hearing as


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

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per the EIA Notification S.O.1533 (E) dated 14.09.2006 of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change (MoEF & CC), Govt. of India. He also explained about the importance of such hearing for the proposed Purheibahal Iron Ore Block of M/s. Rungta Mines Ltd. over an area of 64.337 ha. for production of 1.0 MTPA of iron ore with total excavation – 1.064 MTPA (ROM Iron Ore: 1.0 MTPA + Overburden 0.064 MTPA) for grant of Environmental Clearance and also invited views, comments, objections & opinions of the public which are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project and he also told that those who want to give their written statement about the proposed projects, they can do so during the public hearing process. He requested Additional District Magistrate, Sundargarh to preside over the meeting.

Welcoming the public, the panel members, Press Media, Police Officers and the assembled public in the meeting, Sri Shiba Toppo, Additional District Magistrate, Sundargarh, briefly explained the about the purpose of the public hearing about the proposed Purheibahal Iron Ore Block of M/s. Rungta Mines Ltd., At: Badaindupur & Sanindupur villages under Koira Tahasil of Sundargarh District. He also described the importance of environmental impact studies carried out for the proposed Iron Ore Block and the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the Environmental Clearance of the project. He told that the project proponent will present the summary of environmental impact studies for the proposed project for the knowledge of the Public. He invited the villagers to present their views, opinions & objections about the proposed project on environmental consideration. He also told that the public can also submit written representations. The proceeding along with video recording of the meeting will be forwarded to the Government for further decision making process for grant of Environmental Clearance. He requested the Regional Officer, SPCB, Odisha, Rourkela to carry out further proceeding of the meeting.

Regional Officer, SPCB, Odisha, Rourkela asked the representative of Project Proponent of M/s. Rungta Mines Ltd., to make a brief presentation before the public gathered in the meeting about the details of environmental impact assessment report of the proposed project in a simple summarized manner for better understanding of the Public.


On behalf of the Project Proponent, Shri Dillip Kumar Parida, Senior General Manager (Mining), M/s. Rungta Mines Ltd. welcomed the panel members, public and all other


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participants and gave a brief description about the Purheibahal Iron Ore Block of M/s. Rungta Mines Ltd. He expressed the details of proposed project which are as follows:

- The virgin iron ore block of Purheibahal Iron Ore Block located at Villages, Bada-Indupur and Sana-Indupur has been awarded to M/s. Rungta Mines Limited as the highest bidder in the auction process conducted by the Government of Odisha. The Government of Odisha has issued Letter of Intent (LOI) for this Purheibahal iron ore block vide letter no. 8713 dated 28.10.2021. The proposed mine measuring 64.337 hectares will be leased for a period of 50 years from the date of execution of the lease.
- The new proposed mine located in Tehsil Koira, District, Sundargarh has proposed an annual production of 1 million tonnes of iron ore with a total mining capacity of 1.064 MTPA (including 0.064 million tonnes of Overburden) and will use mobile crushing plants and mobile screening plants for the same.
- Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of Odisha has issued TOR for preparation of EIA/EMP report of the project vide their letter No. 3995/SEIAA/ dated 07.02.2022. In this context, M/s. Ardra Consulting Services Pvt. Ltd. has been appointed for preparation of EIA/EMP report. The Indian Bureau of Mines has approved the proposed mining plan for preparation of 1 million tonnes of Iron Ore per annum vide letter No.MP/A/20-ORI-BHU/2021-22, dated 24.11.2021.
- Various programs for environmental management and development will be adopted if the proposed mine becomes operational. The emission noise and vibration will be controlled by plate tripod and control valve. Water will be sprinkled by tanks on Haul Road. Coir matting, plantation and grass seeding will be done for proper management of the dump. Retaining wall, garland drain and settling tank will be provided at the lower part of the dump. Extensive plantation of trees will be done in other vacant areas of the proposed mine, green belt area.
- Remedial measures will be regularly tested and displayed for public viewing through electronic boards. Extensive planting of trees around mine lease will minimize sound wave penetration. Mine operations and tailings will be treated as per regulations by regulatory agencies.
- Air quality in this area is within acceptable limits and even if there is slight increase after commencement of mining activities, it will be kept within the permissible limits by proper management by the company. Other environmental management plans will be done as per


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the environmental impact assessment and environmental management plan of the appointed M/s. Ardra Consulting Services Pvt. Ltd.

- In this project, the local people will be given jobs directly and indirectly based on their merit. Provision will be made for free health care, ambulance and medicines, etc. For the improvement of education, construction of school houses, provision of toilets, etc., improvement of rural roads, development of sports and culture, and various programs will be introduced for the development of livelihood and animal resources. Programs will be made for social development along with education, health, livelihood.

Then the Regional Officer, SPCB, Rourkela at then invited the public to register their names to put forth their views, suggestion, comments and objections on matters relating to environmental aspects of the project. Then the public deliberated on various issues one by one. which are as follows

1. Sri Ananda Barik, Teherai Village:

He greeted & welcomed the panel members, gathered public and all other participants to the meeting. He welcomed and extended full support for the proposed Purheibahal Iron Ore Block of M/s. Rungta Mines Ltd. Koida area is full of mineral resources and iron ore mines of this area were closed due to expiry of lease period granted by the Government. Hence, people were facing challenges for their livelihood in this area. He also said that company should carry out excavation but shall give employment to at least one person from each family of the affected area. M/s. Rungta Mines Ltd. is one of established & old company of this area & State. The company had been doing mining in co-operation with local people and had done appreciable works & facilities in health, education, environment protection, distribution of fruit bearing trees to the villagers. He also told that the Company had provided necessary help to the local community during the Corona pandemic period. Lastly, He said that, although the mine has not yet in operation, they have already started development works in the surrounding villages. He praised the Company as the synonymous of development in the area.

2. Sri Anadi Charan Palei, Teherai Village:

He expressed his support in favour of the project.

3. Sri Parameswar Naik, Ex-ZillaParishad, Koira :

He greeted all and said that there were many companies in the Koida area, but out



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of that, Rungta company had been giving employment to the local people, doing various developmental work and extended co-operation to the local people. Company had provided 350 nos. of masks & 200 nos. of Sanitizer to the local community during the Corona pandemic period. He demanded the company to establish a big medical/ hospital and to take measures to control pollution by water sprinkling, planting more trees. He stressed on water conservation and simultaneously he expressed his satisfaction in respect of the company's activity on development of Koira Hospital which no other company has taken up. He requested the district administration to build a hospital from the DMF Fund. He also expressed his satisfaction that Rungta Mines Ltd. has appointed teachers in nearby Schools.

4. Sri Rajendra Kumar Dehury, Badaindupur:

He expressed his support in favour of the project and he agreed the views expressed by earlier speakers on environmental measures taken up by the company.

5. Smt. Jasoda Apat, Sanaindupur:

She said that they would not have any sorrow if the mine opens and expressed her support in favour of the project for getting employment, development and financial growth of the stakeholders.

6. Sri Nakaul Mahakud, Sanaindupur:

He said that he had full support for the proposed Iron Ore Block mines.

7. Sri Budhu Naik, Sanaindupur:


He said that, the Govt. has already conducted a Gram Sabha on forest right and local people were getting benefits from the forest. Local did not know anything and depend on forest for their the livelihood. He expressed his uncertainty the local people will get the benefit from the project or not.

8. Sri Bairagi Barik, Badaindupur:

He demanded boundary wall in the outer perimeter of their village temple and supply of drinking water from the Company's overhead tank installed at Sanindpur village to his house.

9. Sri Janardan Dehury, Ex-MLA, Bonai:

He supported the views of earlier speakers regarding developmental works taken up by Rungta Mines Ltd. since long. He requested the company to provide employment to the unskilled as well as ITI/Diploma holders and persons having technical qualifications. He also said that there were no. of mines surrounding the area and agriculture have not been carried out in this area. Hence, company should give direct


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& indirect employment for the livelihood of the local people. He again requested the company to plant more trees specially fruit bearing trees in outer perimeter of the surrounding villages so that the occasional movement of elephant from the buffer zone will be checked as the elephant will get fruits for their consumption and not entered into the villages. He requested the district administration to appoint more PDC teachers. Lastly he also supported the project.

10. Sri Batu Munda, Ghoda Baruni, Village:

He welcomed the public hearing and said that as M/s. Rungta Mines Ltd was a old company in this area and had won the hearts of the people, so people would welcome the public hearing. He also said that people of this area were mostly uneducated, company should take care about their employment & livelihood Since the local tribal people are dependent on forest products, he demanded to maintain financial stability of all scheduled tribe families of mundabasti. Lastly, he also told that Rungta mine has to do soil conservation and take steps on the outcome environment impact assessment of the area.

11. Smt. Sandhya Rani Naik, Koira:

She welcomed to the panel members and stated that since Rungta Company is synonymous with development of the area, she welcomed and supported the project keeping in view of interest of the local people.

12. Sri Sudhansu Sekhar Sahoo, Village Kolmong:


He said that previously Rungta Company had done various developmental works through CSR scheme. But last two years, it had stopped doing CSR work as manganese mines had been closed. He also told that the his village Kolmong is not although in the direct periphery of the mine, he request the company to develop their area and develop the road condition from Sanindpur to Kolmong. He also requested to do CSR work.


13. Sri Kulamani Apat. Badaindupur:

He wholeheartedly supported the project as the opening of the Purheibahal mine will add to further development of the area in particular and the Country in general.

14. Sri Baalaram Apat , Sanaindupur:

He demanded the improvement of road condition from Sanindpur Chaka to Teherai Chaka and requested the company to provide a new Tractor to their village since the tractor earlier provided by the company has got damaged.




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15. Sri Raj Kishore Patra, President, INC, Koira:

He welcomed the public hearing. There were no English medium school in the Koira area for the children of Government Servants and other people. He demanded an English medium School for Class-I to Class-V jointly by the Govt.'s DMF Fund and Rungta Mines Ltd.

16. Sri Hrusikesh Dehury, Sarpanch , Koira:

He welcomed the project and demanded an English medium School and hospital in Koira. He expressed his support in favour of the project.

17. Sri Prafulla Samal, Koira, Secretary, Odisha Mineral Workers Union:

He welcome all and told that Rungta Company had carried out various developmental works in the locality. Further, he opined that the expectation of the local people on the company for development of the area will be upheld by the company.

18. Sri Ranjit Barik Badaindupur:

He said that company has gathered outside villagers along with our villagers. He requested the company to control the fugitive dust from the transporting road and plant trees along the outer perimeter of Munda basti to attenuate the dust from Sanaindupur to Teheri and Teheri to Koira. He further requested to provide fruit bearing plants along with fencing to the people having valid RoR land. Now it was digital age and children of this area does not have digital Education. He also requested to install a JIO tower in their area to facilitate online education of the student.

19. Sri Sanjay Kumar Kisan, Malda Village:


He said that the road from Malda to Koida had been damaged due to development of pot & rut holes but everybody was neglecting the road. The local people who were going by Bikes-Two-wheelers were facing fugitive road dust & pollution due to plying of trucks & possibility of accidents. He requested to develop the road condition from Malda to Koira.


20. Smt. Baisakhi Dehury, Sanaindupur:

She supported the Rungta Company The company is helping the SHG Groups and extended her expectation to continue the support in future also.

21. Sri Biswal Apat, Badaindupur:

He expressed his support in favour of the project.


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22. Smt. Gita Dehury Sanaindupur :

She supported the proposed project ^{of} Rungta Company

23. Sri Govinda Kisan, Sanaindupur:

He said that there was no road for the cattle due to the mines and road for the cattle shall be left. He demanded a grazing land for their cattles and fuel woods for their villagers as although the villagers have been provided with LPG cylinders, they are unable to use it. He demanded a new tractor for their villagers as the old one provided earlier is not functioning now, a JIO tower for online education of students. The land loosers of tribal people should not be given financial assistance in lieu of the land, but to provide equal amount of land and house for their resettlement. Although they have been provided with drinking water facility with overhead tank by the company, due to frequent power cut, they are not able to lift water, so the company should arrange alternative electricity arrangement to lift water.

24. Sri Ananda Kumar Barik, Badaindupur:

He said that he supported the project.

25. Sri Gambha Munda, Sanaindupur:

He expressed his support in favour of the project and expected more employment opportunity.

26. Sri Dinabandhu Kisan, Sanaindupur:

He supported the project and said that the company has provided School Bus for student and doing various developmental works in their locality.

27. Sri Sridhar Patra, Kamalanga :

He expressed his full support to the project.

28. Sri Kitmar Munda, Badaindupur:

He expressed his full support to the project.


29. Bhagabata Dehury, Sanaindupur:

He said that mines of TISSCO & OMC has been closed. He appreciated Rungta Mines Ltd. for it's developmental works, which other company is not doing. He requested the company to provide access to the forest area passing through the mines.

30. Sri Karunakara Patra, Koira :

He wholeheartedly supported the project. He expressed that although the company is providing seedlings and fertilizers to the farmers, he demanded a new tractor for




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Sanindpur village. He requested the CSR team of the Company to provide guidance to approach the right authority for appointment of PDC teachers to the aspirants.

31. Sri Nath Dehury, Sanaindupur:

He supported the public hearing and demanded development of road of Sanindpur and BadaIndupur as well as the road to Kolmong.

32. Sri Sukadev Barik, Sanaindupur:

He said that Rungta Company had been carrying out the developmental works and giving employment to the locals where as other companies had not been doing. He expressed his support to the project.

33. Sri Nilamani Ghari, Sanaindupur:

He expressed his full support to the project.

34. Sri Jaladhar Apat, Badaindupur:

He expressed his full support to the project.

35. Sri Sunil Munda, Oraghat :

He expressed his support to the project.

36. Sri Braja Mohan Mahakud, Sanaindupur

He expressed his support to the project and expected more employment opportunity by the company.

37. Sri Rudan Naik, Sanaindupur :

He reiterated that they had not been doing any agricultural work and the local people of surrounding villages are given employment under contractor of the company where the job certainty is not there. So, he requested the company to give employment to the local people under the permanent pay roll of the company.

38. Jeta Munda, Oraghat :

He supported the public hearing.

39. Khageswar Barik, Badaindupur:

He expressed his support to the project.

40. Pradumnya Kumar Ghana, Sanaindupur:

He expressed his support in favour of the project.


41. Prafulla Barik, Sanaindupur:

He expressed his full support to the project.


45. Prafulla Apat, Badaindupur:




