

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING IN RESPECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT OF BAURIAKAN SAND BED MINES AT LATAHARAN VILLAGE PROPOSED BY SMT. SAKUNTALA KABU FOR SAND QUARRY MINING ON DEVI RIVER OVER AN AREA OF 9.55 HECTARE HELD AT JOUBAN DANDA IN LATAHARAN MOUZA UNDER LATAHARAN G.P. UNDER KAKATPUR TAHASIL OF PURI DISTRICT

The Public Hearing meeting in respect of environmental impact assessment of of Bauriakan Sand Bed mines at Lataharan village proposed by Smt. Sakuntala Kabu for sand quarry mining on Devi river over an area of 9.55 hectare under Kakatpur tahasil of Puri district was held on 2.6.2022 at 11.00 AM at held at Jouban Danda in Lataharan mouza under Lataharan GP in Puri district, Odisha with reference to:

1. EIA Notification S. O. 1533(E) dated 14.09.2006.
2. Interim Operational Guidelines.
3. Covid-19 Guidelines issued by MoEF&CC, Govt. of India vide OM No.22-25-IA.III, Dated.09/06/2021

The Panel consists of the following members:

1. Sri Dillip Kumar Mohapatra, OAS (SAG), Additional District Magistrate, Puri.
2. Dr. Sohan Giri, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar

At the outset, Dr. Sohan Giri, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar Regional Office on behalf of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha welcomed all the guests, dignitaries, public and other members present in the meeting. The meeting was presided over by the Additional District Magistrate, Puri on behalf the District Administration.

Dr. Sohan Giri, being the Representative of State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, gave a brief introduction about the guidelines to be followed for the public hearing as has been cited in the EIA Notification, 2006 and interim operational guidelines till date, along with Covid-19 Guidelines issued by MoEF&CC, Govt. of India vide OM No.22-25-IA.III Dated. 09/06/2021 and the modalities to be followed for conducting the public hearing meeting in respect to sand mine project proposed by Smt. Sakuntala Kabu.

Welcoming the public, the Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar, highlighted about the aim and objective of the public hearing and invited the views, comments/opinions from the local public w.r.t the environmental clearance of the



project. Then the Regional Officer requested to Sri Dillip Kumar Mohapatra, OAS (SAG), Additional District Magistrate, Puri to preside over the public hearing meeting.

Sri Dillip Kumar Mohapatra, OAS (SAG), Additional District Magistrate, Puri presided over the meeting and highlighted the purpose of the meeting and the procedure to be maintained by the gatherings till completion of the public hearing.

Then, the Regional Officer invited the project proponent to present the details of the proposed project i.e. area to be mined out, mining procedure to be followed, environment impact, restoration, peripheral development to be taken up for the benefit of local public. Sri Ullash Kabu as the authorized person being nominated by Smt. Sakuntala Kabu, the project proponent put forth/highlighted the gathering about the possible environmental impact over the said area during mining activity period. He explained about the various aspects to be covered up during of the operation of proposed project i.e. benefits for the local labourers to get engagement in the mine work, peripheral development etc. He also invited the opinion and objection of the public present in the public hearing and had sought their co-operation for smooth implementation of the project during the proposed mining period.

After the completion of deliberation, Dr. Sohan Giri, the Regional Officer requested the public gathered at the meeting of the area to put forth their views, comments, objections and opinions etc. about the commencement of the proposed sand mining project.

The following speakers gave their views on the above said project, which is given as follows :

1. Sri Sudarshan Pal, Bauriakana:

Sri Pal informed that there is ban on the excavation of sand in that area and if excavation is undertaken there will be a heavy loss to the longevity of the river embankment and it will create damage to the spur. He had finally emphasised that the proposed sand mining project is to be cancelled.

2. Prananath Mallick, Dhutang:

Sri Mallick had informed that due to running of this type of project work there will be heavy damage at Bauriakana side, the trees at the bank of the river will be uprooted, the river embankment will be damaged, and the environment will be polluted along with loss of human life. So the sand mining proposal should be dropped.



3. **Sri Sukanta Kumar Nayak, Harinakabu**

Sri Nayak told that the local inhabitant are not aware about the propose project of the government and due to stoppage of the sand mining/excavation since last 12 years the inhabitants of Lataharan village area, the people have been saved from the worst sufferings of every year flood impact. If the embankment will collapse then there will be a great loss to human lives, cattle and agricultural fields etc. So this proposed sand mine project should be stopped.

4. **Sri Sarat Bhoi, Hata Sahi (Former Sarapanch of Lataharan G.P.):**

Sri Bhoi had stated that due to sand mining there will be heavy damage/loss to the local area, so the proposed project should be dropped.

5. **Sri Bipin Bihari Mohanty , Lataharan:**

Sri Mohanty had highlighted that due to sand mining the dust pollution will be inevitable to the nearby houses, due to continuous movement of vehicles carrying sand there will be damage to the environment. School going children will face many problems during the vehicle movement. So this proposed project should be cancelled to let the people of the area be allowed to live in a peaceful state.

6. **Sri Dillip Kumar Kandi, Lataharan :**

Sri Kandi questioned that who will give protection to the river embankment during flood? Due to continuous movement of the sand carrying vehicles the school going children will die. He questioned that what profit and development will be given by the government due to running of the project? If the local people will die who will be held responsible, so this proposed project should be stopped.


After all the speakers deliberated their respective opinion and suggestion, the Regional Officer, SPCB, Odisha, Bhubaneswar asked the project proponent to give relevant reply with regards to the opinion and view of the speakers.


Sri Ullash Kabu (authorised representative of Smt. Sakuntala Kabu, the Lessee of the proposed mine project had highlighted that the sand from the sand quarry will be transported to Jagatsinghpur, Vandi Sahi on the other side of the river. No vehicle will run through Lataharan village. There will be no environment damage to their area during the course of sand excavation period and the lessee will abide by all the guideline/rules of the Government and the same will be followed.

Then Dr. Sohan Giri requested the Tahasildar, Kakatput to put forth his comments with respect to the sand quarry and the objections raised by the public. The Tahasildar Sri Biranchi Narayan Behera in his reply informed the public that maximum portion of the Baurikan Sand quarry land lies towards the Jagatsinghpur district and the river water separates the land to Puri district and Jagatsinghpur district. But actually the land belongs to Puri district and the quarry area does not come towards the Lataharan village side. However the public raised objections with respect to land demarcation and informed the Chair that this public hearing meeting should be dropped/cancelled for all purpose.

At last the Regional Officer, SPCB, requested the chair to put forth the final comments and remarks about the public hearing before concluding the programme. Accordingly Sri Dillip Kumar Mohapatra, Additional District Magistrate, Puri finally put forth his concluding remarks and informed that the public hearing meeting has been entirely recorded and will be sent to the government for taking final decision and gave vote of thanks to everybody for successful completion of the programme.

The public hearing meeting was concluded accordingly and the whole proceedings have been video recorded.


